

EVH-1 POSITIVE AT GOLDEN GATE According to a California Horse Racing Board press release, a horse from Golden Gate Fields has tested positive for the equine herpesvirus (EHV-1). Three racetracks in Northern California--Golden Gate Fields, Bay Meadows and Pleasanton--are now under guarantine. Horses may be transferred between the quarantined racetracks, but aren't permitted to ship elsewhere. Horses that ship into the three guarantined racetracks will be subject to the restricted conditions. Racing at Golden Gate Fields will continue as scheduled during the guarantine period.

Holy Ground to Bridlewood:

Four-year-old Holy Ground (Saint Ballado--La Ville Rouge, by Carson City), a stakes-winning half-brother to GI Kentucky Derby hero Barbaro, will enter stud in 2007 at Bridlewood Farm in Ocala, Florida. His stud fee will be \$5,000. "Holy Ground has three key ingredients that I look for in a stallion: family, ability, and class," said George G. Isaacs, Bridlewood's general manager. "We are proud to bring a horse with this much potential to the Florida breeders. A half-brother to Barbaro by the successful stallion Saint Ballado, out of a proven graded stakes-placed and Grade I stakes-producing Carson City mare--which should add the speed and precociousness the Florida market is looking for." The chestnut captured three of nine career starts, including Delaware's Stanton S. by 13 1/4 lengths in his penultimate outing in August 2005. Holy Ground also posted thirds in the Woodlawn S. and Mel's Hope S. He is the first foal from La Ville Rouge, who earned \$262,594 while placing in four graded stakes.




