Placed on the outside through fractions of :22.31 and :44.75, Teddy's Promise hit the gas on the turn for home, struck the front while racing in hand at the head of affairs, and cruised under the line a sharp 2 1/4-length winner over **Sugarinthemorning** (Candy Ride {Arg}). Donald Dizney's homebred **Apriority** (Grand Slam) overcame a horrific early stumble to get his picture taken in the Gill Mr. Prospector S. at Gulfstream Park. Backed at odds of 5-2, he quickly recovered to chase the early leaders in fourth through swift early fractions of :22.20 and :44.74.

With Luis Saez in the irons, the bay shot through an opening along the inside in the stretch, and gamely fought past **Zero Rate Policy** (Trippi) to take it by a whisker. Slightly favored **Indiano** (Indian Charlie) came charging late to finish a close third. "I thought we were done at the start after he stumbled so bad," trainer David Fawkes revealed. "We're lucky the jock stayed on. It's amazing what he overcame to win it." Fawkes also saddled champion Big Drama (Montbrook) to win this race in January. He continued, "He grabbed his left front foot inside too; it appears to be superficial. If everything's all right he'll come back in the [Florida] Sunshine Millions Sprint [Jan. 28]." Apriority, second in the GI Carter H. and GI Churchill Downs S., entered off a seventh-place finish in the GI Vosburgh Invitational at Belmont Oct. 1 and a sixth-place finish in the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint at Churchill Downs Nov. 5. He was perfect in two previous attempts at Gulfstream against optional claiming company. "He's an amazing horse to do what he did today," Saez concluded. **Cont. p3**

Trainer Change to Ellis Makes the Difference...

Teddy's Promise won only two of eight starts for conditioner David Hofmans, but has really taken her game to the next level since joining the Ron Ellis barn. She hit the board in her first two starts for Ellis at Del Mar over the all-weather July 23 and on the grass Aug. 25, respectively. Freshened, Teddy's Promise delivered a win in a \$40,000 optional claimer at Santa Anita Oct. 10, and entered the La Brea off a \$62,000 optional claiming tally at Hollywood Nov. 25. Ellis considered opting for an easier spot in

Sunday's Kalookan Queen H. "It's hard to be very confident against Turbulent Descent, but I knew she was doing great," Ellis revealed. "I actually asked the owners if they wanted to scratch and run tomorrow, because I knew we could win tomorrow, but they wanted to go for the big show and I couldn't argue with them."

Disappointing Effort from Turbulent Descent...

There were no visible excuses for 1-2 favorite **Turbulent Descent** (Congrats), who reported home a lackluster sixth. It was the second straight off the board finish for the three-time Grade I winner following a troubled fifth in the GI Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Sprint at Churchill Downs Nov. 4. "She was behind a little further [than normal] and behind all the field and had to circle everyone and went really wide," trainer Mike Puype commented. "But she still didn't kick it in and the track's very fast so it's hard to make up that ground once you're in that position. She didn't kick it in like she's capable of, so I'll just have to go over her well physically and see where we're at." David Flores has been aboard Turbulent Descent in all 10 of her career starts. "This was a rough trip, what can I say," Flores offered. "The horse felt great, but it was too much to make up."

Tackleberry (Montbrook), hero of the 2011 GII Gulfstream Park Sprint Championship S. and the GII Gulfstream Park H., has returned to light training on the farm, according to owner/trainer Luis Olivares. The Florida-bred was placed on the sidelines following a ninth-place finish in the GI Metropolitan H. at Belmont May 30. "There was nothing wrong with him, but he had a long campaign and it was time for a break," Olivares commented. "He'll come back to me [at Calder] in a couple of weeks and should be ready to run here later in the meet." Tackleberry has posted a record of 14-8-2-0 and boasts \$806,892 in earnings.

Today's GII Robert J. Frankel S. may have attracted just a half-dozen turf specialists, but a case can be made for any one of the sextet. **City to City** may hold a slight advantage on class, with a victory in the GII Palomar H. at Del Mar and a runner-up effort in this track's GII Las Palmas H. Nov. 6. The chestnut was backed into 8-5 favoritism for the GII Bayakoa H. over the Hollywood Cushion Track Dec. 4, but looked one-paced throughout and could muster only a fifth-place effort. A return to her preferred surface helps the cause this afternoon. **Celestial Kitten** finished runner-up in the GIII Harold C. Ramser Sr. S. going a mile over this turf course Oct. 16, where **Bauble Queen** was another neck back in third. A disappointing fourth in a first-level Hollywood allowance going 10 panels, the chestnut cut back to a mile and was up late to defeat **Whisper Louise** by a neck in the restricted Spearfish S. at Hollywood Dec. 8.

In her last appearance, she was the one handing out the punishment, as she streaked away to best Churchill maidens by nearly seven lengths Nov. 10. Bet to Win added a handy Keeneland allowance victory in her subsequent appearance Oct. 16, but stopped to a walk and was last home in the GII Pocahontas S. at Churchill two weeks later. **Say a Novena** drops back to a better distance off a 10th in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies Nov. 4. In her start prior to that, the bay raced away to a 6 3/4-length tally in the Oct. 1 Brandywine S. going seven furlongs at Parx.

Gulfstream Cancels Quarter Horse Race:

A Quarter Horse race scheduled for 11:30 a.m. at Gulfstream Park Saturday morning and strongly opposed by local horsemen was canceled by track officials after a tentative purse agreement was struck between the track and the Florida Horsemen's Benevolent and Protective Association (FHBPA). Officials planned to conduct the Quarter Horse race to exercise a non-profit dormant Quarter Horse permit after being advised by counsel that they could otherwise lose it during the upcoming legislative session. The permit would have required the track to run one extra race Dec. 31 and Jan. 1, including one for Quarter Horses. But a deal was reached late Friday and the race was cancelled. "We're very happy a resolution was reached," said Gulfstream Park President and General Manager Timothy Ritvo. "We're very appreciative of the FHBPA's committee and the long hours they put into this. Our chairman, Mr. Frank Stronach, has always been committed to Thoroughbred racing and remains committed to Thoroughbred racing. By not running a Quarter Horse race we do jeopardize losing our second permit, but Mr. Stronach believed a long-term contract with the horsemen was well worth it." By not exercising the non-profit license, Gulfstream forgoes the opportunity for a second casino with 2000 Las Vegas-style slot machines.

Restrainor S. cont.

Unplaced in a pair of starts for trainer Derek Ryan to begin his career, Swag Daddy graduated in his first outing for this barn at Belmont Park Sept. 28. Well beaten when seventh in the Bertram F. Bongard S. on NY Showcase Day Oct. 22, he atoned for that performance with a game head success in the Dec. 4 Damon Runyon S. over this track and trip. Quickly in front beneath Junior Alvarado, Swag Daddy set a comfortable pace while prompted by Disco On (Disco Rico). Multiple Grade III-placed and a close fourth in the GI Preakness S. in 2010, the New York-bred came back from a similar layoff with a splashy Gulfstream allowance win this past February, but was upset in the restricted Kings Point H. the next month. A solid third in the GI Carter H. Apr. 9, he was last seen finishing well down the field in the GI Met Mile May 30. Closest to the early pace set here by Crossbow (Bernardini), Yawanna Twist went after that one leaving the quarter pole and streaked home to score by 6 3/4 lengths as the 2-1 choice. Viscount (Orientate) came from second last to round out the exacta. Sales history: \$70,000 RNA yrl '08 KEESEP. WALWYN HONOURED

Former champion trainer and Lambourn stalwart Peter Walwyn has received an MBE in the Queen's New Year Honours list for services to racing. Known as the "Father of the Valley of the Racehorse," the 78-year-old conditioner of the legendary Grundy (Ire) is the chairman of the Lambourn Trainers' Association. "I feel very privileged to receive the MBE, but it's not just about me, it's for the people who have worked alongside me and for me over the years," Walwyn told the *Racing Post*. "It's also for Lambourn, a place I loved even before I moved here in 1960." During his 38-year training career, Walwyn looked after horses owned by some of the most renowned figures in the post-war period, including the Wildenstein Family, Sheikh Hamdan bin Rashid Al Maktoum, Louis Freedman and Lord Howard de Walden, and captured the Epsom Derby in 1975 with the Vittadini-owned Grundy, who also landed a memorable renewal of the King George at Ascot that year. Among the other stars he handled were the brilliant filly Humble Duty (GB), whose feats in 1970 included the 1000 Guineas, and 1974 Oaks scorer Polygamy (GB).
