



WEDNESDAY'S DERBY REPORT: NO SHORTAGE OF 'CONFIDENCE'



Confidence Game continues to generate buzz on the Churchill Downs backstretch | *Sherackatthetrack*

LOUISVILLE, Ky. -- One of the more buzzed about workouts leading up to the first Saturday in May has been **Confidence Game** (**Candy Ride {Arg}**)'s eye-catching, five-furlong bullet in :59 for trainer Keith Desormeaux at Churchill Downs last weekend.

The steam behind the last-out Feb. 25 GII Rebel S. winner continued to build on a very lively backstretch as he led out the GI Kentucky Derby and Oaks horses with authority at 7:30 a.m. on another chilly and breezy Wednesday morning.

'TDN Rising Star' **Tapit Trice** (**Tapit**) is certainly another who has been separating himself from the pack from a physical standpoint, looking every bit worth that lofty \$1.3-million Keeneland September pricetag. The GI Blue Grass S. winner was joined by his Todd Pletcher stablemates, champion and 'Rising Star' **Forte** (**Violence**) and the unbeaten **Kingsbarns** (**Uncle Mo**) for rock-solid 1 3/8-mile gallops.

The Bill Mott-trained **Rocket Can** (Into Mischief) continues to get over the surface very nicely during his morning preparations. He'll be adding blinkers for the Derby following a disappointing fourth as the favorite in the GI Arkansas Derby. **Cont. p3**

CHURCHILL EXPRESSES CONCERN OVER DEATHS OF TWO SAFFIE JOSEPH HORSES

After four equine fatalities suffered on the track over five days at Churchill Downs, the track issued a statement Wednesday saying that it shares the concern fans have expressed over the past week, and would continue to "press for answers."

Kentucky Derby hopeful **Wild On Ice** (**Tapizar**) suffered a fatal hind-end injury Apr. 27 after a work at Churchill and was later euthanized.

Take Charge Briana (**Curlin**) broke down in the fifth race over the Churchill turf course Tuesday.

While there would appear to be no connection between those two, it is the deaths of **Parents Pride** (**Maclean's Music**) and **Chasing Artie** (**We Miss Artie**), both owned by Ken Ramsey and trained by Saffie Joseph, Jr., that have drawn attention.

It was another somewhat surprising light morning for leading **West Coast** contender **Practical Move** (**Practical Joke**). The GI **Runhappy** Santa Anita Derby winner, sporting a blue shadow roll and four matching wraps, jogged a mile just three days out from the main event.

The blinkered chestnut **Two Phil's** (**Hard Spun**), meanwhile, entered the track with the Derby and Oaks horses and continued to take in all of his surroundings like a complete gentleman as the special 15-minute training window concluded. With the floodgates to the main track now open, the GIII Jeff Ruby Steaks winner finally broke off with a powerful gallop just before 8 a.m.



Impressive Arkansas Derby winner **Angel of Empire** (**Classic Empire**) was not to be missed at this hour either, galloping 1 1/2 miles like a horse ready to take another step forward. Trainer Brad Cox's three other Derby runners **Hit Show** (**Candy Ride {Arg}**), **'Rising Star' Jace's Road** (**Quality Road**) and **Verifying** (**Justify**) trained in the previous set.


Live longshot **Skinner** (**Curlin**) proved well worth the wait, heading out for John Shirreffs with his mane braided at the usual time following the final break at 9:00 a.m. The Santa Anita Derby third-place finisher galloped for 1 1/2 miles after visiting the paddock.

Churchill expresses concern, cont. from p1

Parents Pride was the 2-1 second choice in the eighth race on opening day, Apr. 29, when, according to the Equibase chart, he “went wrong between horses at the five sixteenths pole, was pulled up in upper stretch, and got vanned off.”

Chasing Artie collapsed and died after finishing last as the 9-2 third choice in Tuesday's eighth race.

“Transparency is an important component of our commitment to safety and accountability in horse racing,” reads the statement from Churchill Downs.

“We share the concern of our fans who have questions about the recent equine fatalities at Churchill Downs Racetrack and we extend our sincere condolences to those who love and cared for these horses.

“Since Opening Night of Kentucky Derby Week, two horses trained by Saffie Joseph, Jr. have died suddenly of cause yet to be identified: Parents Pride on Saturday and Chasing Artie on

Tuesday. Two other horses sustained musculoskeletal injuries from which they could not recover: Wild On Ice last Thursday

while training on dirt and Take Charge Briana during a turf race on Tuesday. Wild On Ice was transported to Rood & Riddle Equine Hospital for care, but both were ultimately euthanized for humane reasons.

“While a series of events like this is highly unusual, it is completely unacceptable. We take this very seriously and acknowledge that these troubling incidents are alarming and must be addressed. We feel a tremendous responsibility to our fans, the

participants in our sport and the entire industry to be a leader in safety and continue to make significant investments to eliminate risk to our athletes. We have full confidence in our racing surfaces and have been assured by our riders and horsemen that they do as well.” **Cont.**

Churchill expresses concern, cont.

Joseph had entered **Accomplished Girl** (Street Boss) in Wednesday's Mamzelle Overnight S. at Churchill, but she was scratched from the race.

The trainer, who is scheduled to saddle **Lord Miles** (Curlin) in Saturday's Derby, along with six other horses on the card, told *Sports Illustrated's* Pat Forde Wednesday that he was considering scratching them as well while he waited for necropsy reports from the two who died.

"I don't know what we're going to do," Joseph told *SI*. "I have to decide whether we're going to scratch them or not. I'm very uneasy right now."

The Churchill statement continued, "Each horse was transported to the University of Kentucky Veterinary Diagnostics Lab for complete necropsies. We continue to press for answers and are working with regulators to conduct swift and thorough investigations. The safety and well-being of horses is a critical issue for which everyone in the industry shares responsibility; however, we will continue to take every measure to ensure that we are providing the safest possible environment for horses on our property."

Since Churchill released the statement, two additional horses were pulled up and vanned off the track on Wednesday. In Wednesday's third race, **That Khenny** (Khozan), the 7-2 second

choice, was prompting the pace when he "went wrong nearing the five-furlong pole, was pulled up around the turn, dismounted and untacked in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, and got vanned off," according to the Equibase chart. The race was a one-mile dirt race for \$12,500 claimers. Trainer Genaro Garcia reported that the horse was back at the barn, and appeared to be okay.

Two races later, in the fifth race, a six-furlong race on the dirt for \$10,000 claimers, **Loot the Moon** (Dialed In) was also pulled up and vanned off. "Loot the Moon laid off of the pace two wide, tucked to the inside entering the turn, but sustained an injury in upper stretch, was pulled up in midstretch and got vanned off," the chart reads. Trainer Darren Miller reported that the horse was "comfortable standing and taken back to the barn."

Daily Racing Form also reported that **Code of Kings** (Empire Maker) flipped several times in the paddock before the 10th race on Saturday night, and was later diagnosed with a broken neck and euthanized at Rood and Riddle.

A spokesperson for HISA said that CEO Lisa Lazarus was "on-site and not available" to comment on the situation.

KENTUCKY DERBY 149 EARLY IMPRESSIONS: DR. BARRY EISAMAN ON PRACTICAL MOVE

LOUISVILLE, Ky. -- TDN Senior Racing Editor Steve Sherack catches up with the connections of leading GI Kentucky Derby contenders to get their 'Early Impressions.'

After pairing up matching 100 Beyer Speed Figures for trainer Tim Yakteen while capturing the GII San Felipe S. and GI **Runhappy** Santa Anita Derby, **Practical Move** (**Practical Joke**) has firmly established himself as the best of the west heading into the Kentucky Derby.

Last term's GII Los Alamitos Futurity winner brought \$230,000 from owners Leslie and Pierre Amestoy and Roger Beasley out of the Eisaman Equine consignment (:10 1/5 breeder) as an OBS April 2-year-old.

"We first met him not long after the Keeneland yearling sale and he came to us to break for his breeders with the intent of selling him at the OBS sales," Dr. Barry Eisaman said.

"He was a different type of horse than many Practical Jokes that we've had. He was bigger than most and had a really laid-back personality. He had a two-turn physique look to him. He learned all his early lessons very well and was an ideal pupil. When we started doing any little bit of speed work, he would have plenty of speed and displayed it effortlessly. Whenever a little speed drill for the day would be over, he would just drop his head and head back to the barn oozing class and intelligence. He displayed a lot of speed and had an exceptionally good gallop-out at the sale."

Bred in Kentucky by four-time Eclipse Award winning-trainer **Chad Brown and Sol Kumin's Head of Plains Partners**, Practical Move previously RNA'd for \$90,000 as a KEESEP yearling. **Cont.**

He is one of 15 graded winners for young sire **Practical Joke** and is out of the grassy, multiple stakes-placed Afleet Alex mare Ack Naughty. She brought \$500,000 from Chester and Mary Broman in foal to **Upstart** earlier this year at Keeneland January.

"He's out of an Afleet Alex mare," Eisaman said. "I'm thinking that part of his gene pool could favor him giving him the ability to get Classic distances, hopefully. Tim's done a fantastic job with him. The horse really seems to have winning on his mind. He's been pretty courageous."

Champion I'll Have Another (Flower Alley), the 2012 GI Kentucky Derby and GI Preakness S. winner, was also a product of the Eisamans. He brought \$35,000 from agent Dennis O'Neill on behalf of Reddam Racing out of the Eisaman Equine consignment at the OBS April 2-year-old sale.

Runaway GIII Gotham S. winner **Raise Cain** (**Violence**) will give

the Eisamans two chances at a second Kentucky Derby win. The Andrew and Rania Warren colorbearer was broken by the

Eisamans and RNA'd for \$65,000 from their consignment at last year's OBS June 2-year-old sale. Bred in Kentucky by Rock Ridge Thoroughbreds, he was produced by a Lemon Drop Kid half-sister to GI Breeders' Cup Ladies' Classic heroine Unrivaled Belle (Unbridled's Song). Raise Cain was previously an \$180,000 KEESEP yearling.

"We'll have two chances," Eisaman said. "It's a lot of fun. We decided years ago not to have a racing stable. We're service providers to some of the largest racing outfits in the

country. When we have horses that we sell, we want them all to do wonderful things for the people that buy them. It's really rewarding and fun and we couldn't be happier for all these connections."

Here are the final TDN Top 20 rankings, listed in "likeliest winner" order for the main field (also-eligibles noted separately below).

1) PRACTICAL MOVE (c, Practical Joke--Ack Naughty, by Afleet Alex) O-Leslie & Pierre Jean Amestoy & Roger Beasley; B-Chad Brown & Head of Plains Partners (KY); T-Tim Yakteen. Sales history: \$90,000 RNA yrl '21 KEESEP; \$230,000 2yo '22 OBSAPR. Lifetime Record: GISW, 7-4-1-2, \$884,200. Last Start: 1st Apr. 8 GI **Runhappy** Santa Anita Derby. Morning Line Odds: 10-1.

Practical Move rates as the likeliest winner of the Derby and represents a sound investment at anything close to his 10-1 odds as co-fourth choice on the morning line.

Turn the clock back five months to when this son of **Practical Joke** was disregarded at the same price in the GII Los Alamitos Futurity. He upset the field with a sustained inside move, then continued his winning ways into 2023 by surging up the rail twice more for assertive, back-to-back scores in the GII San Felipe S. and GI Santa Anita Derby.

A strapping sort who is not easily discouraged, Practical Move at age two started five times over four months, but ran into a combination of hot competition and bad racing luck. He didn't even cross the wire first until the Los Al Futurity, having been put up on DQ in one of his three trip-troubled MSW races.

Since then he's led all Derby contenders with the two fastest 1 1/16-miles qualifying stakes in 2022-23, running a full :1.04 seconds faster than the third-fastest time. In the Santa Anita Derby, his winning clocking there was also quickest of all the nine-furlong stakes preps. He earned 100 Beyer Speed Figures for both efforts.

But it's not just the numbers. Practical Move has more than enough tactical speed to be placed within the first flight, which is a plus in a 20-horse race. And he has repeatedly

demonstrated he doesn't shy from slicing through tight passages while keeping ample torque in reserve to sustain his stretch bids.

'TDN Rising Star' and 2-year-old champ Forte arrives at the Derby commanding 3-1 morning-line favoritism after an authoritative victory in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile and having sailed through a two-race sophomore prep season.

What we saw at age two was a level-headed colt capable of carving out fortuitous trips while uncorking precise, far-turn bids and leaving the impression there was more in the tank. **Cont.**

What Forte has delivered at age three are wins in the GII Fountain of Youth S. (in which he always had an overmatched field at his mercy) and in the weak-on-paper GI Florida Derby (where Forte looked beaten on the far turn, yet snatched victory from the jaws of defeat, gliding home with his ears pricked).

There's no question this 6-for-7 son of **Violence** merits respect. But how much improvement he's made in the last six months is difficult to quantify.

In neither sophomore stakes did Forte fight A-list competition, and his inability to attain a forward position through the first turn of the Florida Derby forced Irad Ortiz, Jr., to call an off-the-pace audible that might be harder to execute in a crowded race like the Derby.

In addition, Forte's Beyers have backslid, from 100 in last November's Breeders' Cup to 98 and then 95. It's tough enough to win the Juvenile and then the Derby--only two horses have done it in 38 years (**Nyquist** and **Street Sense**). It will be even more difficult for a colt who has declined numerically from age two to three.

We might end up finding out Forte's athletic mojo renders speed numbers and historical comparisons meaningless. He's a "push-button" horse who willingly jumps into the bit, and he relishes reeling in the competition. Just because we've yet to see the full-tilt version of Forte at age three doesn't mean we won't be treated to it on Derby day.

For Skinner, there will be no shortage of pre-race comparisons to the late-striding Giacomo, who, off just a maiden win, was trained to a 50-1 Derby upset in 2005 by John Shirreffs. This colt is attempting the same pattern for the same conditioner.

But Skinner belongs in the Derby on his own merits. And he belongs this high in the rankings because, as a 20-1 shot, he represents a sweet spot in value where his considerable upside is likely not to be reflected in the mutuels.

This son of **Curlin** has been a patient work in progress for Shirreffs, with an eye toward longer races. Skinner twice raced as a maiden against Grade I company last year, then after a four-month break came back with discernibly more far-turn punch. **Cont.**

A maiden win at a mile followed by a pair of thirds behind No. 1-ranked Practical Move has Skinner poised for further progression while riding a 95-94-99 Beyer arc. He was only beaten half a length in the Santa Anita Derby, rallying wide while the winner drove inside.

As part of a stated strategy of wanting to save more ground after a series of loop-the-group rides, Shirreffs is taking a chance by replacing Victor Espinoza (and his experience of three Derby wins) with Juan Hernandez, who has never had a Derby mount, but has been tearing up the SoCal standings since relocating to that circuit in 2020.

Post two in a field of 20 doesn't compromise Verifying as much as it might have hurt others in this year's Derby. But the inner draw almost certainly compels his participation as a pacemaker.

Verifying has never outbroken the field in six races, but he's usually second or third out of the gate, and will have to leverage that quickness to escape the inevitable inside crowding.

This May 11 foal is a half-brother to 2019 champion distaffer Midnight Bisou. He's had a few growing pains at age three by not being able to put together back-to-back strong races, but a little polishing in the aftermath of his tenacious second in the GI Blue Grass S, just a neck behind 'TDN Rising Star' *Tapit* Trice (*Tapit*), puts this colt in it to win it.

In the Blue Grass, Verifying broke forwardly, conceded the lead, then re-seized control five-sixteenths out. Bracing for the quarter-pole challenge of favored *Tapit* Trice, Gaffalione deftly floated that favorite to the five path, then the two colts slugged down the length of the Keeneland stretch, bumping and brushing with Verifying twice clawing back the lead before *Tapit* Trice snatched it away at the wire. The two co-earned 99 Beyers.

If these rankings were intended to reflect which colt might end up at the top of the crop by the end of the year, this 'TDN Rising Star' by *Tapit* would be rated higher than No. 5. He has a bullish demeanor, is capable of sustaining a prolonged run from six furlongs out, and has the look of a take-no-prisoners heavyweight who could get scary-good with a little more seasoning.

Unfortunately for *Tapit* Trice, the purpose of this assessment is to gauge his ability to negotiate a field of 20 in a historically chaotic race that is traditionally not kind to deep closers.

Considering that *Tapit* Trice has been so slow into stride leaving the gate that jockey Luis Saez has had to scrub on him to get going in both two-turn tries, the fear of this colt's come-from-the-clouds tactics working against him in the Derby are very real.

In all four of his victories, *Tapit* Trice has given up ground and come around horses to win. He rumbled to victory from off the tailgate when vastly outclassing the field at 1-2 odds in the GIII Tampa Bay Derby, and looked beaten five-sixteenths out in the Blue Grass S. before outmuscling a determined Verifying.

In that Keeneland race, *Tapit* Trice closed with authority through a final furlong timed in :12.40, which is the fastest final eighth in the Blue Grass since Keeneland switched back to dirt in the fall of 2014.

Reincarnate at 50-1 is a price that really leaps out on the morning line. This long-striding son of **Good Magic** has the speed-oriented profile that wins Derbies, and he'll be ridden by John Velazquez, America's premier big-money rider when partnering with horses that can control the pace. Velazquez has crossed the finish wire first in three of the last six Derbies. All were on frontrunners. One was 12-1 and another was 8-1.

Reincarnate has never been out of the money from seven starts, all at a mile or longer. He debuted on grass at Del Mar and Santa Anita, transitioned to dirt, and broke through with a 95-Beyer win in the GIII Sham S. Jan. 8, after which Velazquez said he was "still learning how to run."

In the Feb. 25 GII Rebel S., Reincarnate caught a sloppy, sealed track for the first time. Shuffled at the start, he advanced into contention, then lost momentum late when checking out of a tight spot. He finished third (90 Beyer).

Reincarnate enjoyed a no-excuse stalking trip in the GI Arkansas Derby, but couldn't capitalize on that ideal setup. He was second and bearing down on a sacrificial speedster, but never flashed true spark, managing third (86 Beyer).

This 3-for-3 son of **Uncle Mo** led at every call through moderate fractions and light pressure to wire the GII Louisiana Derby by 3 1/2 lengths.

Although light on experience, Kingsbarns is developing a no-nonsense way of carrying himself, and will ride an upward Beyer progression (74-85-95) into a Derby where he will almost certainly have to find seven or eight more points of improvement to win.

Only two horses have won the Louisiana Derby and then the Kentucky Derby: Grindstone in 1996 and Black Gold in 1924.

From 1900 to the present, nine horses have attempted the Derby with exactly 3-for-3 records. **Justify** (2018), Big Brown (2008) and the filly Regret (1915) were the only ones to emerge from the Derby with undefeated status intact. **Cont.**

'TDN Rising Star' Disarm didn't have the most favorable timing or circumstances leading up to the Derby. But this Winchell Thoroughbreds homebred made the cut, and is highly likeable based on potential alone.

Disarm debuted while still green at Churchill last June, broke out with a MSW win at Saratoga, then was then shelved until a second-place try in a Feb. 19 Oaklawn allowance. He was second again, with inside trip trouble, in the Louisiana Derby. On both occasions he tried to rally against the grain of speed-conductive tracks.

To ensure he had enough qualifying points, Disarm started in the Apr. 15 GIII Lexington S. and secured third without being asked for an all-out effort.

"He's a very durable horse and I think the best is yet to come from him," trainer Steve Asmussen said Tuesday. "I think it's very obvious that the major players in this year's race lack a lot of early speed. I see a lot of jockeying in the first eighth of a mile."

Wood Memorial. His unfortunate post draw of the innermost gate has relegated him to ninth-most-likely winner. No horse has won the Derby from post one since Ferdinand in 1986.

This homebred for Gary and Mary West went off as the 17-10 Wood favorite from post 12, and was in the hunt five wide on the clubhouse turn before settling in fourth, Hit Show got bottled up off the far bend, had to be switched off heels in upper stretch, then absorbed repeated jostling in the middle of a three-way scrum through the final furlong.

This May 9 foal has already won at nine furlongs. His Beyers, although still short of what it will take to win the Derby, are moving in the right direction, with an 60-71-82-91-93 pattern through five career tries.

Angel of Empire owns a 4-for-6 lifetime record. Along the way, he's picked up two nine-furlong victories, and he closed with purpose through a final eighth in :12.12 in the Arkansas Derby, the fastest final furlong out of the nine stakes at 1 1/18 miles from the 2022-23 qualifying races.

His GII Risen Star S. win at 13-1 seemed like a fluke because this closer benefitted from a pace meltdown and got an inside trip in a stretch run that featured eight horses stacked across the track. That win initially got rated an 87 on the Beyer scale, but was subsequently upgraded to an 89.

This Pennsylvania-bred's win at Oaklawn was substantially more aggressive. He didn't wait for the speed to come back to him. Instead, he overpowered the pacemaker while getting the jump on two favorites who could not match his move (94 Beyer).

The only horses to pull off the Arkansas/Kentucky Derby double since 1980 have been [American Pharoah](#) (2015), Smarty Jones (2004) and Sunny's Halo (1983). This colt's sire, [Classic Empire](#), won the 2017 Arkansas Derby, then endured a brutal trip to manage an admirable fourth in the Kentucky Derby. **Cont.**

Two Phil's, the 101-Beyer winner of the GIII Jeff Ruby Steaks, started his career far off the national radar at Colonial Downs and Canterbury Park. He's only run two off-the-board races, and he had legit excuses for both. One was a trip-troubled seventh at 68-1 in the key GI Breeders' Futurity S. at Keeneland behind eventual champ Forte.

Two Phil's then won the GIII **Street Sense** S. at Churchill by 5 1/4 lengths at 7-1 odds over a wet, sealed track. He was later second in the GIII Lecomte S. and third in the Risen Star S.

The crossover back to dirt from Tapeta is the major unknown for a colt who took a 15-point leap off his previous-race Beyer. But his sire, **Hard Spun**, was adept at moving between a synthetic surface and dirt: He won Turfway's sophomore stakes in 2007 (then over Polytrack) and finished 2-3-4 in the Triple Crown races.

Mage's claim to fame through a three-race career was his big, swooping move in the Florida Derby that catapulted him to the lead before he was collared late by odds-on divisional champ Forte. He was second, beaten a length, with a 94 Beyer.

This son of **Good Magic** isn't the cleanest of breakers, but having to make up for lost ground hasn't really deterred him. You could argue that he'll be a transformed colt if jockey Javier Castellano gets him away cleanly from post eight with three potential speed horses drawn to his inside.

From 1900 to the present, 25 horses have attempted to win the Derby with exactly three lifetime starts. Three have won (see the write-up on Kingsbarns), but more dauntingly, only one of the remaining 22 even managed to hit the board (**Curlin**, third in 2007).

Rocket Can, an Into Mischief gray (\$245,000 FTSAUG RNA) with seven starts, took a big step forward on Oct. 30 when first tasked with two-turn races. He ran 1-2-1-2 in four consecutive routes while taking the Florida path to the graded stakes level. But he hit a developmental wall when fourth as the beaten fave in the Arkansas Derby.

His trainer, Bill Mott, and jockey, Junior Alvarado, have been candid about Rocket Can needing to grow up a bit before he can advance further. He's been hot and bothered in the post parade, and Mott has repeated several times that Rocket Can projects "the feeling there's a little more there, but he's just not quite giving it all to you yet."

Mott will experiment with blinkers on for the Derby. He's 13-for-116 (11%) overall with that move over the last five years, with a subset of 1-for-7 (14%) in graded stakes.

Derma Sotogake wired the G2 UAE Derby, a race in which the first four horses across the finish barely changed positions from the backstraight on home. Even though that Meydan race had a "conveyor belt" flow, it was clear that this colt had cracked his competitors while still in hand before widening his margin to the wire under light encouragement.

Since 2000, 12 winners of the UAE Derby have competed in the Kentucky Derby, and the best finish among them was sixth (along with two DNF's and a 20th-place try). But the global racing scene is shifting, with Japanese horses increasingly rising to the occasion in important graded stakes, so that statistic might not be as relevant as it seems at face value.

This late-running Into Mischief colt (\$400,000 KEENOV; \$495,000 RNA FTSAUG) has a second, two fourths, and a fifth in graded stakes this year while chasing robust company lines. But he's still winless beyond the maiden ranks.

Trainer Ken McPeck will add blinkers for the Derby, which is a 12-for-83 (14%) move for him over a five-year span. In that same time frame, he's made that equipment change five times in graded stakes, but it has yet to produce a win.

A career-best Beyer of 89 (twice) suggests Sun Thunder needs to run the race of his life to win the Derby while a significant portion of the field would have to throw in clunkers.

Lord Miles shocked the Wood Memorial with a 59-1 win. While most handicappers focused on his slam-dance stretch run (with this Curlin colt dishing out his share of roughhousing), his early-race trip under Paco Lopez was just as notable.

Lord Miles broke adeptly, pressed the pacemaker, then backed off to fourth. It looked for a few strides like he was starting to disengage into the far turn, but by the head of the lane this Vegso Racing Stable homebred regained steam, winning a three-way bob at the finish by a nostril.

The effort was a big step up--huge even, in terms of Beyers, from 79 to 93. But horses rarely get a chance to make two distinct runs in the Derby after falling back. A 30-1 morning-line price says Lord Miles can repeat. Yet realistically, even that double-digit mutuel seems like an underlay considering this colt's disadvantageous draw in post 19.

Confidence Game, the 18-1 upsetter of the Rebel S., cost just \$25,000 as a late-sale KEESEP bargain despite his dam, Eblouissante, being a half-sister to Hall-of-Famer Zenyatta. Somewhat unconventionally, he hasn't raced since that start 10 weeks ago. Since 1929 (the advent of complete records), the longest winning layoff for a (regularly scheduled in May) Derby was 42 days, equaled by Needles in 1956 and Animal Kingdom in 2011. Trainer Keith Desormeaux over the last five years has a 6-for-36 record with all layoff returnees between 9 and 11 weeks, and an 0-for-2 subset counting just his graded stakes starters.

Raise Can won by 7 1/2 lengths and earned a 90 Beyer at 23-1 odds. Horses exiting that race have been a collective 1-for-7 in their next starts, including a no-impact fifth that this colt delivered in the Blue Grass S.

ONE YEAR LATER, RICH STRIKE LOOKS TO GET BACK TO THE TOP *by Bill Finley*

After it had finally sunk in that he had won the 2022 GI Kentucky Derby with an 80-1 shot named **Rich Strike** (Keen Ice) that no one gave a chance, trainer Eric Reed started looking forward to when he would have his next taste of glory. Five races and 364 days later, he's still waiting. The year following the Derby has not been particularly kind to Rich Strike. He ran second in the GII Lukas Classic, but was out of the money in his four other starts. His 3-year-old campaign ended with a dull sixth-place finish in the GI Clark S. Nov. 25.

But a new year and a new race bring new opportunities and a clean slate. Rich Strike will make his 4-year-old debut Friday in

the GII Alysheba S., a day shy of a year and at the same track where he stunned the racing world with his 3/4-length win in the Derby. There's a lot of karma there, but karma isn't going to get him into the winner's circle. Reed knows this, but remains optimistic that Rich Strike will be competitive throughout the year in top-class races.

"He's smarter and he's stronger and he's more mature," Reed said. "He knows what's going on. He's turned out to be what we expected at four, stronger and smarter. He's ready. Last year, he was running on adrenaline and raw talent. This year, he's had the chance to mature out. He's a better horse this year. I think he'll run well in all his races and if he doesn't, we will be disappointed."

It's not that he was terrible last year after the Derby. He just wasn't good enough.

"Since the Derby, he ran well in every race except for the Belmont and I still say that was my fault," Reed said. "In the Clark, he was sick and we had no knowledge of that beforehand. He always showed up. He was a head away from beating Hot Rod Charlie in the Lukas Classic and had he won, that would have ended a lot of the talk."

Reed said the main problem Rich Strike will face this year is the same problem he faced last year. He has no early speed and can find himself in a hopeless position if the pace up front isn't fast. His Derby win came after there was a pace meltdown in which they flew through early fractions of :21.78, :45.36 and 1:10.34.

"He's not going to win a lot of races because of his running style," Reed said. "Even when everything goes right, it's hard for him to win because of the way he wants to run. We want him to do good and I think he will. I don't know how many races he will win this year, but he'll have to find a way to put himself into the races a little earlier to win."

The Alysheba is run at a mile-and-a-sixteenth and Rich Strike probably needs more distance. He'll also be facing a tough group of rivals. **Art Collector** (Bernardini) won the GI Pegasus World Cup Invitational, **Last Samurai** (Malibu Moon) has won a pair of graded stakes this year and **West Will Power** (Bernardini) is coming off a win in the GII New Orleans Classic. This may be the deepest group of older dirt males assembled so far this year. Rich Strike is 7-2 in the morning line, but that seems like an underlay.

"It's his first start back," Reed said. "I don't have high expectations for a win, but it would be great if he did. We just need to get in the first start and get ready for his next start, the Stephen Foster. I think that's where our season will really start to take off."

In the meantime, Reed said he plans to enjoy the week and treasure the memories. He said he has the same crew back from last year and they are going to gather for a barbecue on Thursday. **Cont.**

Despite Rich Strike's losing streak, Reed is still focused on how great that accomplishment was one year ago.

"I do tend to relive it, probably a couple of times a week," he said. "It's one of those things that will never go away. You have days when you get frustrated and then you take a step back and think about the Derby and everything is good."

Everything would be even better if Rich Strike were to win another race, preferably a big one. Reed will give him his chances this year. No excuses. Now he just needs to show that he's good enough.

SOUTHLAWN IN GOOD COMPANY WITH STABLE PONY JOHN JONES *by Sara Gordon*

A lithe, dappled bay daughter of Pioneerof the Nile, whose striking features and poetic stride make her easy to pick out on the main track at Churchill Downs, GI Kentucky Oaks contender **Southlawn** has certainly caught the attention of many leading up to her Run for the Lilies this Friday.

But what many may not know is that trainer Norm Casse's stable pony, who escorts the filly to and from the track each morning, is also a star in his own right, as he is none other than multiple stakes winner **John Jones** (Smarty Jones).

Bred in Maryland by Nancy Lee Farms, John Jones debuted as a 3-year-old at Pimlico for his breeder and trainer Ferris Allen. He continued on for those connections throughout his first 14 starts, picking up three wins along the way, until he was claimed for \$25,000 by trainer Lacey Gaudet and owner Matt Schera at Laurel Park in July of 2016.

And it was there he'd stay for the rest of his racing career, quickly evolving from the stable's newest addition to a staple of the Gaudet barn, known well enough in Maryland as he was

across the rest of the Mid-Atlantic circuit.

"His first race in the barn, when he won the [2016] Mister Diz S. [going three-quarters on the turf] and beat Ben's Cat, I remember Stan Stalter interviewing me and saying, 'What do you think you're going to do next?' And I said, 'A mile on the dirt,'" said Gaudet. "He never really ran back to that race on the turf, but he was an amazing dirt horse for us, we had so much fun with him."

Though the dark bay gelding wasn't the easiest of horses to deal with in the barn, he made up for it with his dedication and consistency on the track, in the mornings and during the afternoon, and most notably with his unique personality.

Gaudet recalls a morning that a tour group, with children whose ages ranged from 10 to 18, walked through the barn. John Jones, in one of the first few stalls by the office, watched with rapt attention.

"Most of our stable is kind and they're used to peppermints and treats, but the way John Jones just brought himself to the front and made himself such a presence to these kids, they just gravitated to him. He engaged so much with these children and everybody seemed to have to touch him and he just had to put his nose on everybody. It was just kind of a 'stand back and watch moment,'" said Gaudet. "He was always a tough horse, he was kind of aggravating and always wiggling, stuff like that, but when it came time for his attitude and personality to shine, people of all backgrounds just really gravitated to this horse. He knew he was something special and could give them something special too."

In his 33 starts across five seasons for Team Gaudet, he picked up two more stakes victories--taking the Jennings S. two years in a row--and hit the board in five others, including a trip down to Gulfstream Park where he finished third in the 2016 Claiming Crown Jewel S. **Cont.**

"I think it was in the week or two before Laurel Park shut down [due to COVID-19 in early 2020], he won a three-other-than and beat one of our other horses. He was set for such a big comeback, we thought he was going to have such a stellar year. When COVID-19 hit, we gave some of the horses time off and he came back and trained fine, but he never really raced quite as well. I don't know if he just thought it must have been his time to retire because he'd gotten time off, but it was kind of a confusing moment for him, as for all of us," said Gaudet. "His owner Matt Schera was so great about it. He was like, 'Look, we're at a crossroads. It's either run him for \$25,000 and watch him get claimed and probably go through the claiming ranks or we can retire him and find him a new job.'

"I jumped at the opportunity. I can't thank Matt enough for allowing us to be able to retire him and give him a happy home."

John Jones made his final start Nov. 20, 2020 at Laurel Park, retiring with a record of 12-4-6 from 47 career starts with a total of \$600,364 in earnings. Though Gaudet had hoped to find him a home where he could be a show horse or point toward the Retired Racehorse Project's Thoroughbred Makeover, those plans never panned out, so instead John Jones spent some time with Gaudet's string at Delaware Park before coming home to her family's farm in Upper Marlboro, Md.

The gelding spent nearly two years enjoying a life of leisure on the farm, sharing a field with fellow Smarty Jones gelding Concealed Identity, Gaudet's late father Eddie's first GI Preakness S. starter (2011). But earlier this year, Gaudet noticed a change in John Jones demeanor, as if he was trying to make it clear he had had enough of 'just hanging out.'

It was around that time, in mid-February, when Gaudet got the news that Blimey (Limehouse), her veteran trainee turned seasoned pony that she had sent to join Casse's team as the stable pony just a couple of years prior, had passed away in his stall at Fair Grounds. He was 16 years old.

"[Blimey] ran until he was 9 and he was just a fun racehorse to have. He was the first pony we sent to Norm and his assistant Will [Cano] loved Blimey. Norm was always very happy to have him in the barn and he did credit him with helping a lot of the fillies and the babies. I think it really gave Will, who rode him,

the opportunity to watch more and be more hands-on in the development of Norm's younger horses," said Gaudet. "I loved him. Will had that connection with him and he was absolutely crushed [when he died]. I just kept saying, 'We need to get Will another pony.'"

Gaudet pulled John Jones out of the field in March, rode him for a couple of weeks, and called her brother-in-law.

"He's very green but he's good. He's doing everything right and he just needs to be ridden, all morning long. I know Will wants a pony, so just let me send him out to you. If he doesn't work out, you can send him back," she said.

Though everyone was excited for him to embark on this new chapter, it was still a bit emotional for the team who had spent all of those years with him at the track in Maryland, particularly Gaudet's groom, Abel Sanchez. Though Sanchez no longer works full-time in racing, he still comes to help Gaudet on the weekends, and he was there Sunday, Apr. 16, the day they

loaded John Jones onto a van bound for Churchill Downs.

"I have so many videos of [Abel]'s son, who would just have to come in and see John Jones. The boy didn't know one thing about horses, didn't know one from another, but he knew John Jones and he would come in and just feed him peppermints. And John Jones would just stand there and eat a hundred if he could. He was so gentle with that little boy," said Gaudet. "Abel walked him to the van and he started crying."

John Jones has settled right into life as a pony in the Casse barn, serving an important role in the lead-up to the first Friday in May while also helping to ease the pain of losing Blimey as he follows in his hoofprints as Will's new partner.

"I really loved Blimey. He would follow me and he'd wait for me. He was my favorite. He'd know when I was coming and I'd give him peppermints. I'm trying to do the same with Mr. John," said Cano. "The more time I work with him and he gets to know me more, he'll be a nice pony. The first few days he was a little fresh, but that's normal because it was his first time at Churchill Downs, but now he's doing great. I'm happy with him.

"We're excited with Southlawn and it's nice to have a pony to walk up with her and wait for her. I really appreciate Lacey Gaudet helping us out. It's nice to have a pony in the barn, especially this kind of horse." **Cont.**

JUSTIFY COMMANDS AU\$77,000 AT**COOLMORE AUSTRALIA** *by Jessica Owers/TDN AusNZ*

Two winners in the space of a few days made it timely on Wednesday for Coolmore Australia to reveal its 2023 Australian fee for Triple Crown winner **Justify**. The big chestnut will return for the spring at an all-time local high of AU\$77,000 inc. GST (\$51,271).

Justify is part of Coolmore's 15-strong roster this spring, returning after a 2022 hiatus when he didn't shuttle to Jerrys Plains. Previous to that, he had covered books in 2019, 2020 and 2021 at fees ranging from private to AU\$55,000 inc. GST (\$36,622) and AU\$66,000 inc. GST (\$43,947).

Justify's fee release coincided with a very good week for the stallion.

At Warrnambool on Wednesday, his 2-year-old son Scentify won on debut for Ciaran Maher and David Eustace. Last weekend, his smart filly Legacies maintained her unbeaten run for Peter Moody and Rosemont Stud when winning the Listed ANZAC Day S. at Sandown.

Both of these results follow a vintage start for **Justify** in Australia. The chestnut stallion is currently leading the first-season sires' table by earnings, with close to AU\$1.8 million banked across 11 runners. His obvious star has been the Annabel Neasham filly Learning To Fly, who won the G2 Reisling S. and G3 Widden S. through the autumn.

As of Wednesday afternoon, **Justify's** Australian stats sit at two stakes winners from just 11 horses to the track, with four winners for seven wins. It's a very respectable record in a sharp amount of time. While Learning To Fly recovers from injuries sustained during the G1 Golden Slipper, Legacies has been put out with an eye to the G1 Thousand Guineas at Caulfield in the spring.

In the meanwhile, **Justify's** return is very welcome to everyone at Jerrys Plains.

"We look forward to welcoming **Justify** back to Australia this season at a fee that we believe represents great value for breeders," said Coolmore Australia's Colm Santry. "All the leading breeders want to use him and he will cover a select book of mares this spring."

"Coolmore's confidence in **Justify** has been well-documented and it hasn't taken long for his progeny in Australia to hit the ground running, just like they did in the Northern Hemisphere."



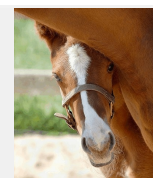

As he is prone to do, Wesley Ward will send members of his stable to Belmont--this time a pair of juveniles--who have been working at his home base at Keeneland.

The 4-5 morning line favorite is **PRINCESA CELINA** (Quality Road), who RNA'd at the Fasig-Tipton November sale in 2021 for \$545,000, and is out of dam Lastofthsummerwine (Sky Mesa). The mare produced a trio of solid earners in GSW Conquest Panthera (Kitten's Joy) and his full-brother, GSP Maniacal, plus GSW Happy Like A Fool (Distorted Humor), who went for \$1.45 million at the 2018 Fasig-Tipton Fall sale to Blanford Bloodstock.

Opposing Princess Celina will be another Ward runner, **SLAINTE MHATH** (Uncle Mo), listed at 7-2 on the morning line. The first of her dam Lady Worthington (Scat Daddy)'s offspring to make it to the races, the Fitri Hay homebred has mirrored the drills of her stablemate over the course of last month. Bred by Stonestreet, Lady Worthington brought \$650,000 with Ward signing the ticket at the 2017 Keeneland September Yearling sale. On the board in two prior starts at 12 furlongs, Warrant proved third time was the charm as he came from just off the pace to take Wednesday's Isaac Murphy Marathon at Churchill Downs.

Veering in at the start, he moved up to second in pursuit of favored Next in the early going. Still holding that position with six furlongs remaining, Warrant began to crank up the pressure at the half mile pole and collared his rival exiting the far turn.

Poking his head in front at the quarter pole, he ran on gamely late and had enough left to fend off Red Run by a desperate neck.

"The race went just as I'd planned," said winning rider Flavien Prat. "The other day [third at Oaklawn Apr. 2], I put him on the lead and he didn't respond. Today, I held him back and we had a target all the way around. This time I asked him and he responded. Perfect."


Winner of the Oklahoma Derby at three, the chestnut was winless in five starts at four, although did hit the board in four out of five of them, including runner up finishes in the GI Santa Anita H. last spring and the 1 1/2-mile GII Brooklyn in June. This term, the Twin Creeks homebred kicked off the season with a win at Fair Grounds in optional claiming company in January before coming home a troubled eighth in his return to the Big 'Cap Mar. 4. Well backed for his latest, the half to GSW Ms Locust Point (**Dialed In**) wilted to third last out in the 1 1/2-mile Temperance Hill S. at Oaklawn. The winner's dam Whisper Number produced an unraced 3-year-old colt by **Good Magic** named Magic City in addition to a yearling fill-brother to Warrant. She was bred back to **Constitution**.

PECKHAM BACK FOR MORE AFTER SUCCESSFUL FIRST BREEZE-UP FORAY

NEWMARKET, UK--Trueshan (Fr) (Planteur {Ire}) may have been overturned in Wednesday's G3 Sagaro S. at Ascot, but the five-time group-winning stayer remains a great advertisement of the diversity of horses on offer across the range of breeze-up sales in Europe.

We've seen plenty of those dubbed as 'Royal Ascot two-year-olds' over the last week or so, and as the British leg of the breeze-up action comes to a close at Tattersalls on Thursday, the focus generally adjusts slightly to more of a later-maturing specimen. It was at the Guineas Sale of 2018 that Trueshan was bought for 31,000gns by Alan King and Anthony Bromley, a duo which is now a regular fixture at these auctions. He was plucked from the draft of Thomond O'Mara's Knockanglass Stables and, as the sun and wind continued to dry the Rowley Mile on Wednesday morning, two of O'Mara's seven juveniles on offer in this year's sale posted times within the top five of the day.

Of course, every vendor and buyer will tell you that it's not all about the time, and indeed there have been some notable examples of slower breezers going on to success at the top, including Derby runner-up Libertarian (GB) and Gold Cup winner Trip To Paris (Ire). [Cont. p3](#)

But it can help when the clock speaks in your favour, as was seen a fortnight ago at the Craven Sale, when Glending Stables' son of Havana Grey (GB) sold for 15 times his yearling price at 650,000gns after posting the fastest breeze of the session. Roderick Kavanagh's outfit again had one of the fastest breezers on the unofficial times recorded for the Guineas Sale in lot 193, a colt by freshman sire Inns Of Court (Ire).

Last week we spoke to **Robbie Mills of RMM Bloodstock** about his burgeoning breeze-up and pre-training business, and one of his neighbours on Newmarket's Hamilton Road, George Peckham, is in a similar position.

Under the George Peckham Racing banner, the former trainer brings a colt and a filly to the Guineas Sale, only the second and third he has consigned to breeze following an initial foray in

2021 when selling treble winner Straits Of Moyle (Ire) (Prince Of Lir {Ire}) to the Cool Silk Partnership for 105,000gns.

"That's our only previous breezer at the sales," Peckham said. "We did have one last year for the Guineas that had a setback

before the sale so we sold him privately to Niels Petersen through Edgar Byrne. He won his first start by eight lengths in Norway and they quite like him, so I'm excited to see what he can do."

Now a sought-after pre-trainer in Britain's busiest training centre, Peckham's involvement in the breeze-ups remains on the select side at present.

"It's something that we wanted to give a go," he noted. "It's never going to be a big business for us. We're flat out with the pre-training, and that's our main

business, but we are lucky to have the facilities on the Heath in Newmarket. We'll see what happens but, we're very happy with how they went this morning." **Cont. p4**

His two-strong draft currently at Park Paddocks consists of lot 174, a colt by Twilight Son (GB) whose full-sister The Twilight Lady (GB) won twice at two last year. Their grand-dam Confidential Lady (GB) (Singspiel {Ire}) won the G1 Prix de Diane for her breeders Cheveley Park Stud.

He is followed by lot 258, a filly by Ardad (Ire) out of Broughton's Secret (GB) (Aqlaam {GB}) whose half-brother Spioradalta (GB) (Rajasinghe {Ire}) was another juvenile to win last year.

Peckham said, "The Twilight Son is a speedy little horse who does what it says on the tin, and the Ardad is a nice, big, rangey filly who will need a little bit more time. She probably wants seven furlongs or a mile at this stage, and the last few weeks it's all just come a little bit quick for her. She has a lovely, big stride on her, so it will be towards the back end of the season and into next year that she'll really come to the fore, I think. But to do what she's doing at the moment, I'm really happy with her."

For the breeze, both juveniles benefited by being in the experienced hands of Arc-winning jockey Luke Morris.

"Luke used to ride for us when we were training and he's obviously a very hard-working fellow and nice and light as well," Peckham explained. "We have a good relationship. He rode the one a couple of years ago for us, and we go back a long way."

He added, "I was a little bit disappointed that they watered the breeze strip. It was just a little bit tacky, which hasn't suited many people, and it was a little bit chopped up after the Craven, but it was the same for everyone."

George Peckham Racing is based in Yellowstone Stables next-door to trainers Simon and Ed Crisford, and with easy access to the vast expanse of the all-weather and Southfields turf gallops on 'racecourse side', behind the Rowley Mile grandstand.

There is a touch of déjà vu to this particular Classic runner, for the Channon stable, in the days of Mick's reign, sent Caernarfon's full-sister Dan's Dream (GB) to Newmarket for the 1,000 Guineas after she won the G3 Fred Darling S. at Newbury. Both fillies have run in the colours of their breeder, Steven Smith's Hunscombe Stud, with Caernarfon being owned in partnership with Paul Humphreys and Jonathan Sweeney.

"Funnily enough, seeing as they're full-sisters, they actually couldn't be more different as fillies," says Channon of the siblings. "Dan's Dream was a lot stockier, and she didn't get the mile. She was an out-and-out seven-furlong filly, whereas this filly I feel will be a mile-and-a-quarter filly in time.

"Even though, obviously, they share the ability, they're different types, which will hopefully grant Caernarfon better fortunes in the Guineas than her sister."

Though arriving at Newmarket without a prep run, Caernarfon is not short of experience. From her July debut, she ran seven times in 2022, winning twice and finishing in the top three on a further four occasions, including taking third in the Listed Silver Tankard S. over a stiff mile at Pontefract before her stakes victory on the Rowley Mile. The undulations should hold no fear for her.

Cannon continues, "She's a filly that doesn't need an awful lot of work. She's quite a light-framed filly, and I didn't feel like she needed a prep run to get her spot on.

"I think we've got her exactly where we want her. She's done some nice bits of work, and she's been there and done it over the course and distance. The track won't be a problem, so it's all down to ability now."

With nine wins to his credit already this year, Channon has ensured it's very much business as usual at West Ilsley, which has previously housed such star names as Queen's Logic (Ire), Youmzain (Ire), Samitar (Ire), Music Show (GB), Nahoodh (Ire) and Zafeen (GB) since Mick Channon bought the Berkshire stable from HM The Queen in 1999.

"I think if you've got good horses to aim at good races, there's a natural buzz that it creates around the place," says Channon of the current mood in the yard. **Cont. p6**

Sheikh Mohammed Obaid Al Maktoum's 3-year-old colt **Cold Case (GB)** (Showcasing {GB}--Killermont Street {Ire}, by Dream Ahead) closed his six-race juvenile campaign with victories in Doncaster's £300,000 Weatherbys 2-Year-Old S. and Redcar's Listed Two-Year-Old Trophy and came back off a 214-day break to register a game success in Wednesday's G3 British Racing School 40th Anniversary Commonwealth Cup Trial S. at Ascot.

The 5-1 chance was in the squat position as the gates flew

open and recovered to race on the front end after the initial strides. COLTRANE SLAYS SAGARO RIVALS IN STYLE

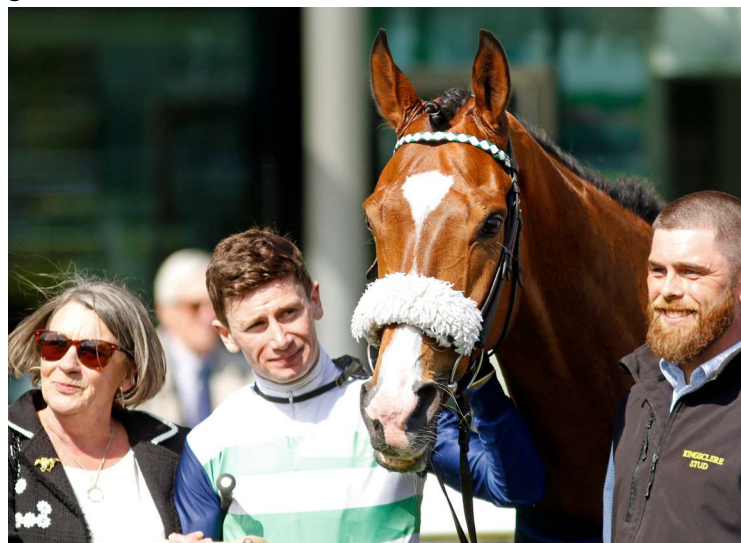
Mick and Janice Mariscotti's 6-year-old gelding **Coltrane (Ire)** (Mastercraftsman {Ire}--Promise Me {Ire}, by Montjeu {Ire}) failed by a head to get the better of **Trueshan (Fr)** (Planteur {Ire}) in last October's G2 British Champions Long Distance Cup at Ascot and exacted revenge on that rival with a 4 3/4-length triumph in Wednesday's G3 Longines Sagaro S. returning to the Berkshire venue for his seasonal debut.

Last term's G2 Doncaster Cup victor and G1 Goodwood Cup fourth employed patient tactics from flagfall and settled into a comfortable rhythm in rear for most of this two-mile marathon.

Inching into contention approaching the half-mile pole, the 11-4 chance was shaken up to seize control passing the quarter-mile marker and stayed on powerfully under urging inside the final furlong to defeat **Wise Eagle (Ire)** (Free Eagle {Ire}) by daylight.

El Habeeb (Ire) (Al Rifai {Ire}) was a head shy of second, with Trueshan unable to land a telling blow and finishing two lengths further adrift in fourth.

"He looked very good when he won the Melrose [as a 3-year-old] and he hasn't really looked back," said trainer Andrew Balding. "To come back here in June [for the G1 Gold Cup] is the plan, he's a course and distance winner and he's very versatile ground-wise."

With the win, rider Oisin Murphy notched a first pattern-race winner in the UK since returning from a 14-month ban and added, "This horse has very lucky owners who have 10 horses with Andrew [Balding]. Coltrane is in the form of his life and Andrew has done a terrific job getting him to his best."

Reflecting on the effort of Trueshan, Alan King indicated a possible rematch with the winner at the Royal meet is an option. "It's ground dependent, but we'll train him for the Gold Cup," the trainer said. "There's a strong possibility you might see him over hurdles in the autumn. He had a lot of tough races last year and I hope they haven't left their mark on him. I brought him back to win here and we had to come, but it was always going to be tough to beat Coltrane. His next race will tell us an awful lot, but whatever happens he's been the most wonderful servant."

Looming large on the stands' side at the quarter-mile marker, the 4-1 chance quickened smartly to lead approaching the final furlong and was ridden out by Robert Havlin in the closing stages to account for **Copy Artist (GB)** (**No Nay Never**) by two lengths. "This filly is still raw, but she has talent," the rider said. "She quickened up well, she'll have learnt plenty and she can only come forward for the run." Thady Gosden added, "She'd been going nicely at home and her mother won the Coronation S., while **Kingman** was a champion miler. So yes, we would take a look at the Coronation S. It's five weeks away, but another run would benefit her."

Queen For You, amazingly the 31st TDN Rising Star for her sire, whose best in that category so far are Persian King (Ire) and Palace Pier (GB), is the sixth of eight foals and fourth scorer produced by Fallen For You, whose progeny include the multiple group winner Glorious Journey (GB) (Dubawi {Ire}) and **Kingman's** Listed Radley S. scorer and G3 Nell Gwyn S. third Love Is You (Ire). A daughter of the Listed Silver Trophy scorer and multiple group-placed Fallen Star (GB) (Brief Truce), she is kin to the Listed Heron S. winner Fallen **Idol** (GB) (Pivotal {GB}) and to the G2 Lancashire Oaks runner-up Fallen In Love (GB) (Galileo {Ire}).

Fallen In Love was in turn responsible for **Kingman's** Serve The King (GB), who took the GII Red Smith S. and was second in the GI Joe Hirsch Turf Classic, and also for the G3 Prix de Flore scorer Loving Things (GB) (Pivotal {GB}) who was third in the Lancashire Oaks. Also connected to the G1 Lockinge S.-winning sire Fly To The Stars (GB) (Bluebird) and the G2 Mehl-Mulhens-Rennen winner Peace At Last (Ire) (**Oasis Dream** {GB}), Fallen For You's 2-year-old filly Fight For You (Ire) is by **Saxon Warrior** (Jpn) while she also has a yearling colt by Lope De Vega (Ire).

BEST KEPT SECRET IN CALIFORNIA

In this series, the TDN takes a look at notable successes of European-based sires in North America. This week's column is highlighted by the victory of Paris Secret (Ire) (Zoffany {Ire}) in the GIII Providencia S. at Santa Anita on Saturday.

City Of Lights In Southern California

Strand Beach, LLC's **Paris Secret (Ire)** (Zoffany {Ire}) won the Providencia S. for trainer Phil D'Amato in her second U.S. start after running fourth in the China Doll S. earlier in the year, also at Santa Anita ([video](#)).

The third foal and second winner for her dam Cite Veron (Fr) (Tomorrow's Cat), Paris Secret was bred by Al Mohamediya Breeding. She was sold for €8,500 as a Goffs Autumn yearling to trainer Andy Oliver, before capturing a Galway maiden race for Paul Hardy last March.

Coolmore's late Zoffany is the sire of five stakes winners in the U.S. from 53 starters (9%), with Paris Secret his fourth graded winner, joining GII Hollywood Turf Cup victor Oscar Dominguez (Ire), and Grade III winners Zofelle (Ire) and Zoffarelli (Ire). He boasts 26 winners (49%) in this locale. [Cont. p10](#)

Adaay To Remember In San Francisco

A winner of Keeneland's GIII Bryan Station S. last autumn, **Balnikhov (Ire)** (Adaay {Ire}) captured the GIII San Francisco Mile S. at Golden Gate on Saturday evening ([video](#)). Trained by Phil D'Amato, the Little Red Feather Racing, Madaket Stables, LLC, and Old Bones Racing Stables runner was unplaced in the GI Frank E. Kilroe Mile in March.

Bred by Thierry de La Heronniere and Gestut Zur Kuste AG, he brought €27,000 as an Arqana September yearling from Oceanic Bloodstock. Of his eight starts in France at two, he won three for Alain Jathiere, Ecurie Pandora Racing et. al. and trainer Rod Collet, his previous connections.

Out of the winning Leeward (First Defence), the 4-year-old gelding is a half-brother to 2-year-old filly L'Ardechoise (Fr) (El Kabeir), and a yearling filly by Almanzor (Fr). His second dam is a half-sister to GI Charles Whittingham Memorial H. winner Midships (Mizzen Mast).

Represented by only three runners in the U.S., Italy-based stallion Adaay also has GII San Gabriel S. hero Dicey Mo Chara (GB) to his name, and his third American runner, Have A Good Day (Ire), won the G3 Prix de Cabourg.

Sloppy Surface The Trick For Helmet Filly

John O'Connor's **Wildhawk** (Helmet {Aus}) relished a sloppy surface at Aqueduct to graduate in her third start for Tom Albertrani on Saturday ([video](#)).

Out of Wadia (Ger) (Campanologist) who won once in Germany as a 3-year-old, Wildhawk is kin to G1 Deutsches Derby hero Waldpark (Ger) (Dubawi {Ire}), and GI Man o' War S. winner Wake Forest (Ger) (Sir Percy {GB}). The April foal was bred in Kentucky by Anastasie Astrid Christiansen-Croy. Haras

d'Ombreville picked up Wadia on behalf of Christiansen-Croy for €26,000 out of Arqana's Vente d'Elevage carrying the winner in 2019. Wildhawk is followed by three half-sisters-- a juvenile named Westphalia (Arrogate), a yearling christened Whirlwind ([Always Dreaming](#)) and her dam foaled a [Promises Fulfilled](#) foal this spring.

Now based in Italy, Helmet has three winners from nine runners (33%) in America thanks to Wildhawk. Triple Grade I-placed Darley Japan sire Thunder Snow (Ire) is his top performer in the U.S.

OVERSEAS ENTRIES UNVEILED FOR ROYAL ASCOT

Dual Australian Group 1 winner **Coolangatta (Aus)** (Written Tycoon {Aus}) is one of the leading runners signed on from foreign climbs for the upcoming Royal Ascot meeting in June. Trained by Ciaran Maher and David Eustace, the G1 Lightning S. heroine is targeting the G1 King's Stand S.

David Eustace said, "Coolangatta galloped yesterday and will have her first proper workout next week. She has improved again physically from the Lightning S. and we feel we are ahead of the game in terms of her preparation.

"We are stepping into the unknown when it comes to international travel but Coolangatta has done a lot of travelling around Australia and is used to being in unfamiliar places. We are hopeful that she will handle that side of things well but you never know until you do it. We think the 1000 metres of the King's Stand, with the uphill finish, looks ideal and genuine fast ground will be to her advantage as well."

Coolangatta is not the only Australian runner signed on to the royal meeting, as both **Artorius (Aus)** (Flying Artie {Aus}) and **The Astrologist (Aus)** (Zoustar {Aus}), who are trained by Anthony and Sam Freedman, and Leon and Troy Corstens, respectively, are both aiming for the G1 Platinum Jubilee S. Artorius finished third in the Platinum Jubilee in 2022, and enters off a victory in the G1 Canterbury S. at Randwick earlier this year. In The Astrologist's case, he ran too good to lose when second by a head in the G1 Al Quoz Sprint at Meydan at the end of March.

Sam Freedman said, "Artorius had his first improving gallop the other day, having come off a bit of a fresh. He seems to be shaping up really well and will have a couple of trials over here before we put him on the plane." [Cont. p11](#)

He added, "I think he is definitely hitting Royal Ascot this year in better form than he was 12 months ago. His form lines are strong and I think you guys over there will see a more tactically versatile horse. He will be able to sit a lot closer, which will be important, whereas last year he was rattling home."

Troy Corstens said, "We were delighted with The Astrologist's effort in Dubai. He ran to expectations and came very close, which gave us the confidence to continue the journey with him."

"He has settled beautifully in Newmarket--he is a very adaptable horse and enjoys the travel. The plan is for him to have a racecourse gallop this week on the Rowley Mile in preparation for the G2 1895 Duke Of York S."

"He will then head to Royal Ascot for the Platinum Jubilee. We feel that this will be the perfect race for him. He is a renowned straight-track horse in Australia and we feel the testing course of Ascot will suit him immensely."

Strong American Contingent Ready To Go

Twelve-time Royal Ascot-winning trainer Wesley Ward is bringing a slew of Royal Ascot runners, anchored by **Love Reigns (Ire)** (**U S Navy Flag**) and **Twilight Gleaming (Ire)** (National Defense {GB}) for Stonestreet Stables to Royal Ascot. Both enter off of stakes victories at the recently concluded Keeneland Spring Meet, with the former pointing to the King's Stand S. and the latter eyeing both the King's Stand and the G1 Commonwealth Cup S.

Ward said, "Love Reigns and Twilight Gleaming are doing great. They are both coming off nice comeback wins and their owner Barbara Banke [of Stonestreet Stables] is really looking forward to getting them over there. She loves Ascot as much as me and we are all excited."

"I was really happy with Love Reigns in the Limestone S. She

had to switch a couple of times in the run but showed a great attitude to get up on the line, while Twilight Gleaming showed a lot of speed in her comeback race."

"Twilight Gleaming will definitely go for the King's Stand S., whereas Love Reigns will have an entry there and in the Commonwealth Cup."

Besides Ward's older horses, he has at least three juveniles making the trip for the storied 2-year-old prizes in '**TDN Rising Star**' **American Rascal (Curlin)** out of King's Stand and G2 Queen Mary S. victress Lady Aurelia (Scat Daddy); **Fandom (GB)** (Showcasing {GB}), and **Bledsoe (Igbaal)**.

Ward added, "American Rascal has come out of his first race in super shape. The team at Stonestreet really liked him and it was exciting to see him produce a performance like that."

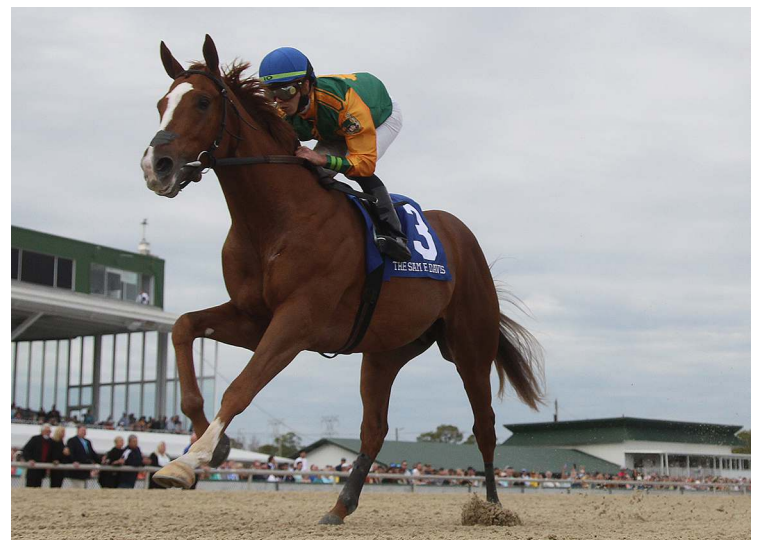
"Fandom looks another good prospect after his debut win on the grass and we also have some nice 2-year-olds to run at Belmont, so we will see what else unfolds in the coming days."

"Bledsoe has already travelled over to England and will run in a novice race at Ascot on 13 May. He won America's first 2-year-old race of the year on the dirt at Keeneland but his mother Shrinking Violet was a multiple stakes winner of the turf, so we are looking forward to getting him on the grass."

Brad Cox's GI Breeders' Cup Turf Sprint heroine **Caravel** (Mizzen Mast) is pencilled in to make the trip, and GI Belmont Derby victor **Classic Causeway** (Giant's Causeway) for trainer Ken McPeck is a potential starter in the G1 Prince Of Wales's S.

McPeck said, "Classic Causeway had a nice run first time up this year on the dirt at Oaklawn. Then we came back for the [GII] Oaklawn H. and he was off the board, so we have decided to switch back to the turf."

"He is going for a prep race in Kentucky on 3 June in the Arlington S. and, if he runs well there, we will point him towards the Prince Of Wales's S." **Cont. p12**

New York Thunder (**Nyquist**) for trainer Jorge Delgado holds a Commonwealth Cup entry, while Hong Kong runner **Wellington** (**Aus**) (All Too Hard) has been nominated for both the Platinum Jubilee and King's Stand.

Nick Smith, Director of Racing and Public Affairs at Ascot Racecourse, said, "We are very pleased to see entries for Royal Ascot 2023 from across the world including Group 1 winners from Britain, Ireland, France, the USA, Australia and Hong Kong.

"It is particularly exciting to see so many strong entries from Australia, including the Black Caviar Lightning S. winner Coolangatta, who looks set to try and follow Nature Strip's victory in the King's Stand S. It's also exciting to see Artorius is on track to try and go two better than when third in the Platinum Jubilee S. last year.

"Wesley Ward again has a strong team headed by Love Reigns and Twilight Gleaming along with the 2-year-olds while it will also be great to see Breeders' Cup winner Caravel represent America."

On the home front, defending champion Mendocino (Ger) (Adlerflug {Ger}) takes top billing for trainer Sarah Steinberg, and his compatriots with entries include last year's Deutsches Derby winner Sammarco (Ire) (**Camelot** {GB}) and Tunnes (Ger) (Giuliani {Ger}), the half-brother to 2021 Grosser Preis von Baden and Arc winner Torquator Tasso (Ger) (Adlerflug {Ger}).

Last year's G1 Preis von Europa winner Rebel's Romance (Ire) (Dubawi {Ire}), who went on from Germany to land the G1 Breeders' Cup Turf, heads the Godolphin list, with former Breeders' Cup Turf winner Yibir (GB) (Dubawi {Ire}) also entered.

Stephan Buchner, Managing Partner of Baden Galopp said, "We are already looking forward to September 3, when the 153rd Grosser Preis von Baden, one of the sporting highlights in European horse racing, will be held. Of course, we are a bit disappointed with the number of nominations but, as always, the accounts are only settled at the end. Maybe there will be one or two late entries."

The Grosser Preis von Baden is the feature race of five days of racing at Baden-Baden throughout the week of August 26 to September 3, with five further days of action scheduled at the

Iffezheim track during 2023 from May 18.

Taking a leap forward on this step up in trip, she tracked the early pace before being let loose at the top of the straight by Billy Lee and driving on with relish into a clear advantage.

"She settled beautifully through the race," the rider explained. "It opened up down the back straight and I let her go forward. I had to keep at her, thinking she was starting to pull up with me a bit, and when I had a look around didn't realise I was as far in front. She had been running over a mile and a quarter and a mile and a half in France, but has no problem going this trip and I'd say two miles into the future."

Second in the Oaks and G1 Preis der Diana and disqualified from first place in the GI Beverly D S., the G2 Middleton S.-winning dam is responsible for Godolphin's leading 1000 Guineas candidate Dream Of Love (Ire) (Shamardal) who was an eye-catching second in January's Jumeirah Fillies Classic. Bought by the operation for \$3.5 million at the 2016 Keeneland November Sale, she is a full-sister to Coolmore's Group 1-winning duo Japan (GB) and Mogul (GB) from a star-studded family that also features the Arc hero Sagamix (Fr). Secret Gesture's 2-year-old is a full-brother to the winner. **VIDEO.**
