



HIWU SUSPENDS TRAINER JEFFREY POOLE FOR 22 MONTHS

After a hearing before an arbitral body, trainer Jeffrey Poole has been hit with a 22-month suspension by the Horseracing Integrity and Welfare Unit (HIWU) after it was alleged that Poole possessed the banned substance Levothyroxine. He was also fined \$10,000 and ordered to make a payment of \$8,000 to cover arbitration costs.

Poole did not have a horse test positive for the substance. Levothyroxine, commonly known by the trade name Thyro-L, is a synthetic version of the naturally-occurring hormone thyroxine.

'RISING STAR' CARL SPACKLER AN 'ACE' IN HALL OF FAME

It was a performance worth waiting for.

Rescheduled from the end of last Friday's rain-cancelled card, the GII National Museum of Racing Hall of Fame S. finally got its day on course as 'TDN Rising Star' Carl Spackler (Ire) (Lope de Vega {Ire}) drove right on past his opposition to pick up his first graded-stakes win.

Second by a head on debut Jan. 21 to another 'Rising Star' in GI Belmont Derby winner Far Bridge (English Channel), the Chad Brown trainee responded with 8 3/4-length rout over the Gulfstream green Feb. 25, a performance that earned him a 92 Beyer Speed Figure. The 1 1/16 mile GII American Turf S. was next on the dance card but a troubled trip saw the race favorite toss up a bogey and tire to eighth.

With Tyler Gaffalione taking over the mount from Jose Ortiz for the first time Friday, Carl Spackler was outrun early by a host of horses to his outside and was nearly last in the opening furlong as the field passed the wire the first time by. Hugging the hedge inside of Ocean Vision (Ire) (U S Navy Flag) into the backstretch, he was comfortably second flight behind the pace-setting duo of his stablemate **Appraise (Ire)** (Kodica {GB}) and European invader **Mysterious Night (Ire)** (Dark Angel {Ire}) through an opening quarter on the inner turf in :24.37.

Thyroxine is produced by the thyroid and works with the brain to control metabolism. It can be prescribed to older horses to correct hypothyroidism, a condition in which the thyroid is underactive and the horse has an unusually slow metabolism. However, its use has raised concerns about potential risks that may come with artificially boosting the metabolism of a horse who doesn't need it and its use has been banned in some jurisdictions. Thyroxine overuse in racehorses was in the news in 2013 when the California Horse Racing Board launched an investigation into the sudden deaths of seven horses trained by Bob Baffert. Baffert told investigators at the time that he had horses in his care on thyroxine.

Once Poole was found to be in possession of the substance on June 2, he was provisionally banned by HIWU. His suspension was the first handed down by HIWU since it took over drug testing and the enforcement of penalties and suspensions on May 22. Poole's case is also the first to go through the arbitration process. Cases involving Anti-Doping Rules violations cases are heard by an Arbitral Body known as JAMS. Founded in 1979, JAMS describes itself as "the world's largest private alternative dispute resolution (ADR) provider."

Trainers who have been charged with violations on the Horseracing Integrity and Safety Authority's list of banned substances face suspensions of up to two years. The 22-month suspension is the longest suspension handed out by HISA/HIWU thus far.

According to Equibase, Poole has been training off and on since 1989. He is 50-for-459 during his career and 3-for-41 in 2023. According to the Jockey Club's Thoroughbred Regulatory Ruling's website, Poole has no prior suspensions or fines on his record.

When reached by the TDN Poole declined to comment. At deadline for this story, his attorney Brad Beilly had not returned a hone calling seeking a comment.

The field of nine began to bunch up as they swung into the far turn and Carl Spackler got just the gap he needed to tip outside of rivals passing the quarter pole. 

not looking well. He got sick on the trip and [owner] eFive Racing is always patient with their horses and Bob [Edwards] said, 'Listen, just point him to Saratoga and get him right' and the horse really blossomed. The last couple of weeks, his coat was shining, the horse had his energy back. His last two works were excellent. I felt even though it was off a layoff and it was a big race, he was ready to fire a big one."

Pedigree Note:

Carl Spackler is the 116th stakes winner and 65th group/graded winner worldwide for his prolific sire. The winner's dam was trained by Christophe Clement for Nat Rea's Regis Racing for the first 10 starts of her career, including stakes victories in the License Fee S. and Intercontinental S. at Belmont Park in 2015. Zindaya was offered as part of the Regis Dispersal at that year's Keeneland November Sale, where bloodstock agent Mike Ryan went to \$550,000 on behalf of eFive Racing. Turned over to Chad Brown, Zindaya gave Bob Edwards's operation its first black-type victory when winning the Intercontinental S. once again in the summer of 2016 and the 5-year-old would go on to win the GII Goldikova S., two days after New Money Honey (Medaglia d'Oro) gave Edwards a maiden graded-stakes winner in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies Turf.

Zindaya has gone on to become a commercial success. Her first foal, Title Wisdom (Ire) (Frankel {GB}), was a 280,000gns purchase by Godolphin at the 2020 Tattersalls October Yearling Sale and Edwards decided to retain Carl Spackler when bidding stalled out at 350,000gns--just shy of \$500,000--12 months later. Her now 2-year-old filly by Frankel fetched 450,000gns from Godolphin at the Moulton Paddocks last October and she produced a full-sister to Carl Spackler last season. She most recently visited Uncle Mo for a 2024 foal. Cont.



As reported by Jessica Martini last week, Edwards was also the breeder of Hall of Fame runners Bat Flip (Good Magic) and General Jim (Into Mischief). Edwards's Fifth Avenue Bloodstock was represented by three yearlings at Fasig-Tipton Saratoga this past Tuesday, a Good Magic filly that made \$300,000; a colt by Into Mischief that fetched \$500,000; and a Speightstown filly that was hammered down for \$385,000.

Both of the top two finishers, winner Sopran Basilea (Night of Thunder {Ire}) and runner up Ever Summer (Summer Front) suffered fatal injuries over the Saratoga turf in the last week.

Sopran Basilea finished fourth in the GII Glens Falls S. Aug. 3 but injured her left foreleg on the gallop out and was humanely euthanized. Ever Summer sustained her injury in an allowance race Aug. 6 which also saw Frivole (Fr) (Anodin {Ire}), the last-place finisher in the Robert Dick, get pulled up after a misstep early in the race. Delaware's fourth-place runner, Talbeyah (Ire) (Lope de Vega {Ire}) was a vet scratch out of that same allowance race the morning of Aug. 6.

The two scratched runners affected Friday, Parnac (Fr) (Zarak {Fr}) and Lady Rockstar (GB) (Frankel {GB}) were both reported to be fine.

"Of the seven starters exiting the Grade 3 Robert G. Dick Memorial at Delaware Park [7/1/23], two have suffered fatal injuries at Saratoga Race Course during the 2023 summer meet, one was eased and vanned off, and another was scratched out of a race at Saratoga based on the recommendation of the NYRA

veterinarian," said NYRA Vice **President of Communications** Patrick McKenna. "This highly unusual confluence cannot be ignored, which is why NYRA asked the trainers of Lady Rockstar and Parnac, the respective third and fifth-place finishers in the Robert G. Dick, to scratch from Race 3 today to allow for additional information to be gathered. To that end, PET scans will be performed on Lady Rockstar and Parnac at clinics chosen by their respective connections. The results will be evaluated by NYRA regulatory

veterinarians and New York State Equine Medical Director Dr. Scott Palmer."

"Should the PET scans and further examinations reveal nothing out of the ordinary, then those horses will be permitted to enter

races during the summer meet," McKenna continued. "While we understand this decision may be frustrating to the connections of Lady Rockstar and Parnac, the application of an extra level of scrutiny is appropriate in this instance. The health and safety of horses and jockeys competing at NYRA tracks is paramount. NYRA will apply the same requirements to all horses who started in the Robert G. Dick. NYRA will cover all costs associated with the PET scans."


ASMUSSEN STABLES TO PAY PENALTIES, REIMBURSEMENTS FOLLOWING DEPT. OF LABOR INVESTIGATION, LITIGATION

Steve Asmussen Stables has entered into a settlement agreement with the U.S. Department of Labor to reimburse grooms and hotwalkers nearly \$130,000 to resolve violations of the federal H-2B worker program, which enables businesses to employ temporary visa workers, according to a release from the Department of Labor. Asmussen was also assessed civil money penalties of just over \$75,000 for its violations in addition to the wage penalties.

According to the release, this is the fourth time in recent years that Asmussen has been ordered to make payments to workers, having most recently been ordered to pay more than a half-million dollars in back wages and damages. The DOL investigation in this instance found that the employer violated numerous commitments that it made during the H-2B application process to employ workers in the state of New York. The violations were said to have occurred between December 2016 and December 2019.

According to the release, the violations included:

- Failing to pay workers for costs they incurred during travel to and from the U.S. at the beginning and end of the racing season, including visa fees;
- Seeking and obtaining kickbacks from workers, supposedly to cover Asmussen Stables' attorney fees;
- Employing workers outside of New York, contrary to statements made to the government;
- Overstating the number of H-2B workers needed by the employer and;
- Not disclosing material terms of the position to potential U.S. job applicants, such as that free housing may be available onsite.

"H-2B workers too often find themselves vulnerable to wage shortages and other violations of their rights," explained Wage and Hour Division District Director David An in Westbury, New York. "Employers like Steve Asmussen Stables who employ H-2B workers must comply with the law or face sanctions, including fines and potentially being barred from the program."

The settlement also includes enhanced compliance measures, including hiring of an independent monitor by the stable to conduct regular audits, providing workers with updated training in languages they understand, forbidding certain managers from being involved in the H-2B program and allowing the division to provide training to Asmussen Stables' H-2B workers regarding their rights.

"The U.S. Department of Labor will pursue all necessary legal avenues to obtain proper compensation for employees and prevent future violations by employers," explained regional Solicitor of Labor Jeffrey S. Rogoff in New York. "This settlement reimburses these underpaid workers, requires Asmussen Stables to pay penalties and seeks to change this employer's behavior and prevent future violations by providing an independent monitor to perform regular audits."

The division's Long Island District Office conducted the investigation. Department of Labor Senior Trial Attorney Jacob Heyman-Kantor litigated the case for the division before the Office of Administrative Law Judges. View the consent findings and the order approving the findings.

PEGASUS WINNER GOES FOR VIRGINIA'S

FIRST 'MILLION' by Stefanie Grimm





In the absence of Godolphin standout and GI Longines Breeders' Cup Turf winner Rebel's Romance (Ire) (Dubawi {Ire}), the role of morning-line favorite for Saturday's feature at Virginia's Colonial Downs fell to GI Pegasus World Cup Turf Invitational winner Atone (Into Mischief). A Godolphin-bred gelded son of leading sire Into Mischief, the Michael Maker trainee, owned by Three Diamonds Farm, put a career best 103 Beyer Speed Figure to take down Ivar (Brz) (Agnes Gold {Jpn}) at Gulfstream Park Jan. 28. He'll stretch out to 1 1/4 miles for the first time off a quartet of 1 1/8-mile races including a last-out fifth after just giving up the lead close to home in the GIII Dinner Party S. on the Preakness undercard May 20.

And while their bigger name might be out, Godolphin is still going for the repeat here with last year's Arlington Million winner **Santin** (Distorted Humor). In the Churchill Downs edition held at 1 1/8 miles, the 5-year-old led nearly gate-to-wire and soundly defeated GISW Smooth Like Strait (Midnight Lute). Racing for trainer Brendan Walsh, Santin will have to overcome the widest draw of the field from gate 11 and gets back on the turf after a pair of main-track races at Churchill and Ellis respectively resulting in back-to-back off-the-board finishes.

Never far from Grade I turf action, trainer Chad Brown brings a pair of entries in last year's GI United Nations S. winner **Adhamo** (Ire) (Intello {Ger}) and GISW **Rockemperor (Ire)** (Holy Roman Emperor {Ire}).

And while Brad Cox may be more well known for his dirt horses, **Set Piece (GB)** (Dansili {GB}) will look to give his trainer another Grade I coming off a win in the GIII Arlington S. at Churchill two back June 3 and a narrow third in the GII Wise Dan S. last time out at Ellis July 1.


This field was also affected by a late scratch as Argentinian import **Didia (Brz)** (Orpen {Brz}) was withdrawn from contention Friday night by trainer Ignacio Correas. The *Daily Racing Form* was first to report the news.

Mark Casse's **Fev Rover (Ire)** (Gutaifan {Ire}) leads the field from the rail draw and will look to continue her run of trifecta finishes since coming stateside last year. A two-time graded stakes winner at Woodbine, the 5-year-old trailed Whitebeam (GB) (Caravaggio) and MGISW In Italian (GB) (Dubawi {Ire}) by just a half-length on the line in Saratoga's GI Diana S. July 15.

Peter Brant's **Gina Romantica** (Into Mischief) brought just over \$1 million at auction at Keeneland September and her value increased exponentially after winning last season's GI Queen Elizabeth II Challenge Cup at Keeneland. A further 2 1/4 lengths behind that pair, Nagirroc (Lea) has never been off the board in his eight career starts for Graham Motion and owners Little Red Feather Racing, Madaket Stables LLC and William Strauss. A winner two back in the James W. Murphy S. at Pimlico on Preakness Day, the colt was a narrow third last time out in Belmont's GIII Manila S. July 7.

Another Manila starter and an early-season Triple Crown trail colt, Spendthrift's **Major Dude** (Bolt d'Oro) has seen much

success since switching to the turf for nearly all of his 3-year-old season. A three-time graded stakes winner, he finished second behind the recently-retired Two Phil's (Hard Spun) in the GIII Jeff Ruby Steaks S. at Turfway Mar. 25 and came right back to win the GII Penn Mile two starts back June 2.

Saratoga's Fourstardave Is 'WAYI' Opportunity

Keeping to the grass but moving north to New York, a field of seven accomplished older horses vie for a slot in the GI FanDuel Breeders' Cup Mile with Saturday's GI Fourstardave H.

Already the earner of over \$2 million, **Casa Creed** (Jimmy Creed) took last year's rendition of this race and started this year off strong with a loss by a just a head in Saudi Arabia's G3 1351 Turf Sprint Feb. 25. Third in the GI Jaipur S., a race he also won last year, the Bill Mott trainee took the GIII Kelso S. at Saratoga in preparation for this spot. A true war horse, this is his fourth straight attempt at the Fourstardave.

Todd Pletcher's 'TDN Rising Star' Annapolis (War Front), a Grade I winner as a 3-year-old, has missed the trifecta only once his entire career and began his season with a win in the Opening Verse S. at Churchill before just failing to reel in Casa Creed in the GIII Kelso S. last month at Saratoga.

Another Pletcher runner, 'Rising Star' Emmanuel (More Than Ready) races for Siena Farm and WinStar Farm and posted a



victory last time out in the GIII Poker S. at Belmont Park June 10. He's raced exclusively on the turf since a third in last year's GI Toyota Blue Grass S. The 100 Beyer Speed Figure he put up in the Poker S. is a career best.

2-Year-Olds Tackle the Saratoga Special

A plethora of maiden winners make the jump into graded-stakes company Saturday in the 6 1/2-furlong GII Herb Moelis Memorial Saratoga Special S.

Courtlandt Farms has 'TDN Rising Star' Edified (Tapit) here for trainer Steve Asmussen. The Summer Wind Equine-bred, the \$650,000 Keeneland September yearling, rolled by 3 1/2 lengths in his Ellis Park debut July 1

under Joel Rosario, who retains the ride here.

Norm Casse jumps Rhyme Schemes (Ghostzapper) up in class after he broke his maiden in dominating fashion in his second career start, wiring an Ellis field by 9 1/2 lengths June 15 as an

and St. Elias Stables, went for \$260,000 at this year's OBS April sale and immediately rewarded his connections with a three-length debut win as the favorite at Belmont July 9.

The 2-year-old fillies make the grade at Del Mar Saturday in the GIII Sorrento S. Bob Baffert saddles **Dua** (Arrogate) for Zedan Racing Stables, the same connections who picked up the sale-topping son of Curlin at

Tuesday's Fasig-Tipton Saratoga Sale. The \$400,000 Fasig-Tipton July yearling won her Del Mar debut by a half-length July 22.



City of Light picked up his first 'TDN Rising Star' with Benedetta who flew home by three lengths for trainer Simon Callaghan and owner Kaleem Shah at Los Alamitos July 8. The bay brought \$750,000 at the OBS March sale and put in a near-bullet work at Del Mar Aug. 5 going four furlongs in :47 1/5 (3/82).

Already a stakes winner in her first start, **Dreamfyre** (Flameaway) has helped put her freshman sire (by Scat Daddy) on the map with a near gate-to-wire performance in Pleasanton's Everett Nevin S.

Yellow Ribbon Hosts on the Turf

Finishing out the evening on the West Coast, fillies and mares tackle the GII Yellow Ribbon S. at Del Mar going 1 1/16 miles on the turf. The race is led by the Harris Farm-homebred Closing Remarks (Vronsky) who breaks from the rail and has contested exclusively graded-stakes company since a third in last year's GII Buena Vista S. Grade I-placed in the 2021 GI Del Mar Oaks, the 5-year-old mare was sixth last time out in the GI Gamely S. at Santa Anita May 29.

Also in that Gamely S., **School Dance** (Animal Kingdom) checked in just behind Closing Remarks in last year's GII Royal Heroine S. and just missed by a head in the GI American Oaks.

Bob Baffert can never be counted out, even on the turf, and he brings in **Ganadora** (Quality Road) here. The 4-year-old sold for \$1 million as a yearling at Keeneland in 2020 and was tabbed a **'TDN Rising Star'** for her 6 1/2-length debut win at Santa Anita last year. She did her best running in last year's Dark Mirage S. but also just missed by a nose in this season's GIII La Canada S. Jan. 15.

MAGE DRILLS SIX FURLONGS FOR TRAVERS

OGMA Investments, Ramiro Restrepo, Sterling Racing and CMNWLTH's GI Kentucky Derby hero **Mage** (Good Magic) turned in his penultimate breeze ahead of his anticipated appearance in the Aug. 26, GI Travers S., going six furlongs in 1:12.98 over the Saratoga main track Friday morning under exercise rider J. J.

Delgado. According to *Daily Racing Form*, Mage galloped out seven furlongs in 1:26.31 and was up the mile in 1:40.66.

It was a stiffer breeze than last week, when he covered five furlongs in 1:01.03 over a track with a high moisture content following significant rainfall over the days prior to the work.

"He did pretty good. He was a little more in the bridle today," said Gustavo Delgado, Jr., son and assistant to trainer Gustavo Delgado, of Friday's move. "His exercise rider was happy about it and the best thing is how he came back. He took a couple rounds [cooling out] and that was it. It's always good to see that."

Delgado, Jr. said the plan is for the \$235,000 Keeneland September yearling turned \$290,000 Fasig-Tipton Midlantic juvenile to have one last maintenance work ahead of the Travers.

"It will depend on the weather, but hopefully Friday on the main track again," said Delgado, Jr.

Mage is expected to face a field that includes 'TDN Rising Star' and reigning Eclipse Award-winning 2-year-old Forte (Violence)-to whom he was runner-up in the GI Curlin Florida Derby--and GI Preakness S. winner National Treasure (Quality Road).

Mage was third, beaten 2 1/4 lengths at Old Hilltop and has since finished a bang-up second in the GI Haskell S. July 22. **Arcangelo** (Arrogate), last-out winner of the GI Belmont S., is also among the probable starters.

Mage will be ridden by Luis Saez in the Travers.

ORTIZ BARN SHINES BRIGHT WITH UNDEFEATED FILLY By Katie Petrunyak

John Ortiz draws the analogy of playing cards to what it feels like going into a stakes race at Saratoga. Everyone keeps their hand close and you never can tell who might be bluffing.

But the trainer of **Brightwork** (Outwork) may have let his poker face slip when he spoke with Irad Ortiz Jr. in the paddock ahead of the GIII Adirondack S. on Sunday.

"I walked in there confident and with a smile," Ortiz shared. "Irad had worked her and I said, 'You know what you've got and I know what I've got, so just ride her like a big horse.'"

Despite bobbling at the break, Brightwork delivered just as her up-and-coming trainer had hoped, achieving a perfect 3-for-3 record as she swung four wide in the stretch and drew away to win by five lengths sporting the silks of Bill and Tammy Simon's WSS Racing. The victory gave Ortiz his first stakes win in Saratoga.

"I'm very proud that we got to win here," he reflected. "I feel like I belong. I'm not a rookie trainer anymore. We've all got something to learn on the racetrack every day, but I feel like we know what we're doing. We're here to compete. All the hard work through my entire life, all the good choices and all the bad choices I've made in my life, have paid off."

Ortiz now has two wins and a stakes placing on his record during his first Saratoga meet this year, but it was only a few years ago that the young trainer was questioning his decision to launch his own stable.

After taking out his trainer's license in 2016, his numbers had dropped from seven horses to four by the end of the first year and he wondered if his dream was going to work out. But then, the Midwest-based conditioner got a call from two key clients–former Walmart CEO Bill Simon and Hootie Moore of

Hootie's Racing. Those two stables joined in with Ortiz's longtime client 4G Racing and the wins slowly started to collect.

"We had a lot of claimers and we went through a lot of emotions in those first years," said Ortiz. "But people noticed that it didn't matter what kind of horse we had, we just gave it our all. [Our owners] know how much we care about these animals day in and day out. From me and all through my grooms, we talk about how special we treat our horses."

Another key to Ortiz's early success was his connection with bloodstock agent Jared Hughes. Hughes picked up Barber Road (Race Day) for \$15,000 as a weanling and the colt went on to take WSS Racing to their first Kentucky Derby last year. The agent has since found another standout in Brightwork.

Hughes purchased Brightwork, a daughter of the unraced Malibu Moon mare Clarendon Fancy, for \$95,000 at the 2021 Fasig-Tipton November Sale. He believed that what the filly may have lacked in pedigree was made up for by a standout physical.

"That year we bought five babies and she was the first one we bought," recalled Hughes. "I try to focus on horses that really stick out to me. She was a beautiful foal--a big, frame-y filly and she really stood out above her peers. That's what stood out to me was how big and strong she was."

The WSS Racing model involves purchasing around half a dozen foals at the weanlings sales each fall and then refining the group the following year–adding in a few yearling purchases and re-selling one or two to pay for the new additions. Hughes explained that the system works to their advantage as it allows him to focus on finding the horses he likes physically instead of hunting down the most commercial prospects.

"It allows for a lot of flexibility and I think if we buy them early, we aren't paying a premium," he said. "We can get to know them and decide which ones we want to sell."

After spending time at Fallbrook Farm, Brightwork was sent to Ortiz's father Carlos Ortiz, a former jockey who now runs Ortiz Training Stables in Ocala. Ortiz said that after his father had spent just a few days with the filly, he told his son that she was one to watch out for.

Brightwork arrived at Ortiz's Keeneland barn in the springtime and, while Ortiz said he normally doesn't send out many 2-year-olds in April, he soon knew she would be an exception. Brightwork made her debut a winning one on April 26 after dueling with Stonestreet-owned Barbtourage (Into Mischief) in the stretch. The third-place finisher was future G2 Queen Mary S. winner Crimson Advocate (Nyquist).

"She wasn't there 100% fitness-wise, but she was 100% mentally there," Ortiz explained. "That's why we decided to give it a shot. Sometimes with baby races, I think if they have a little bit of an idea of what they're out there to do, they get the job done. We were amazed that she showed a lot of heart and toughness because she got bumped and then was able to come back and pass through the rail. Not a lot of 2-year-olds run on like that once they get passed."

Following the victory, Ortiz and his team sketched out a plan to get to the Breeders' Cup. After additional scores in the Debutante S. and the Adirondack, they are now on to the GI Spinaway.

"After her debut, I told Jared that he better get ready to pick out a purple tie," Ortiz said with a grin. "That was back at Keeneland and I'm still looking for that tie."

"If anyone knows me, I don't like to wear ties," added Hughes. "I told Johnny if he gets her to the Breeders' Cup, I will go buy the tie."

Ortiz is a native of Columbia, but he moved to New York as a child and grew up tagging along with his father at the Bill Mott barn. He started his career as a hot walker for Mott and would

later become a traveling assistant for the Hall of Fame trainer before working for Graham Motion and Barclay Tagg. He met Hughes in Kentucky while working for Kellyn Gorder and opened his stable shortly after.

"When he first came to Kentucky, he was just this kid from New York," recalled Hughes. "He was different from me, but I had a lot to learn from him. He's a great rider and a great horseman. Johnny just has the "it" factor. He speaks horse. He understands them and he listens. This is his first year in New York and it's a big deal for him to be here. We planned to bring a small group up here to try it, but it really came down to us needing Brightwork to be who she is to get to go. When she won at Ellis, it made it easy."

The Ortiz barn has been a Saratoga success outside of Brightwork's victory. Fellow WSS Racing colorbearers Unsung Melody (Maclean's Music) ran third in the Wilton S. and Urgent Fury (Creative Cause) broke his maiden on July 28.

During the week Ortiz returns to visit his strings in Kentucky, but he relies on the help of his 24-year-old brother Daniel to hold down the fort in Saratoga.

"We discussed this a long time ago," explained Ortiz. "I told my brother that I would need him to be able to step up and represent the Ortiz family, not just the barn. We're all working on this together. I don't have my name on the logo. It's just two stripes. He has risen to the challenge and made me very proud. He's been doing a great job not just representing me, but the horses themselves. They look incredible and he has taken a lot of pride in the work he's putting in."

Family is an important aspect of the Ortiz stable. From the horses to the clients to the grooms, Ortiz considers them all a member of his team.

"I have learned a lot from Mr. Bill [Simon]," he said. "He's a really good role model and a good mentor. To be able to win for these types of connections is incredible. Jared has been like an older brother to me and the fact that my dad is the one that always gets my babies started, we all have a really good connection." **Cont.**


"It is definitely like a family," Hughes added. "Bill and Tammy treat us like family. They allow us to make decisions. They allow us to make mistakes. This game has a lot of highs and lows, so you really need to enjoy who you're doing it with. We just enjoy being around each other and it means so much because we're doing it together."

Enjoying the talents of a filly like Brightwork, Ortiz and Hughes agreed, makes their experience together all the more special.

"It means so much because we're doing it together," Hughes explained. "To have a filly like this with unlimited potential, it means the world. I gave Johnny a big hug in the winner's circle and he said, 'I love you, bro' and that's what I'll remember."

"This filly brings us all together," Ortiz said. "Everybody takes pride in what we do for her, with her and because of her. She's just special."



A \$700,000 Ylg FTSAUG purchase, **INTEGRATION** (Quality Road) debuts for Shug McGaughey. Out of 2016 Gl Del Mar Oaks heroine Harmonize (Scat Daddy), who was campaigned and bred by Larkin Armstrong, this 3-year-old colt hails from a deep, extended female family which includes MGSWs like Al Khali (Medaglia d'Oro), Cappuchino (Capote) and Hungry Island (More Than Ready), plus Gl Diana S. heroine and MGSW Somali Lemonade (Lemon Drop Kid) and MGISW Verrazano (More Than Ready). **TJCIS PPs**

5th-SAR, \$136K, Msw, 2yo, 7f, 3:20 p.m.

Heading to Upstate New York, a trio of 2-year-old colts who will be kicking off their juvenile careers. From the inside, Eliminate (Curlin) is a \$525,000 Ylg KEESEP chestnut owned by Spendthrift Farm and Repole Stable out of GSW I'm A Looker (Henny Hughes) whose second dam's half-sister produced MGISW Dortmund (Big Brown). Deeper still on the female side, the Todd Pletcher trainee's fourth dam, champion 2-year-old filly Lakeville Miss (Rainy Lake) is responsible for GISW and GSW Mogambo (Mr. Prospector). The yearling Quality Road cold out of I'm a Looker topped the opening session of the Fasig-Tipton Saratoga Sale on Amo Racing's bid of \$1.1 million.

Just to his outside is another son of Curlin--Chaperone--who fetched \$950,000 at last year's Saratoga sale. Owned by Gus King and trained by Ron Moquett, the chestnut is out of GI Cotillion S. heroine and GI Alabama S. runner-up It Tiz Well

"He reminded me of all the good things about the Curlins that you would like to see," said trainer Ron Moquett. "He's a good-sized horse and had a certain sense of class about him. We thought there was a possibility that he would get well over a million and it worked out in our favor. You'd always rather have a horse with expectations and, as a trainer, it's your job to manage the expectations until you get him where he needs to be."

Breaking from gate five, **Deterministic** (Liam's Map) is a \$625,0000 Ylg KEESEP buy for trainer Christophe Clement. The dark bay's second dam is a half-sister to a pair of successful group winners in Japan, namely Asakusa Genki (Stormy Atlantic) and Rabbit Run (Tapit), and also to MGSW Rainha Da Bateria (Broken Vow). This colt's well-regarded family under the fourth dam Aquilegia (Alydar) also includes her full-sister and champion 2-year-old filly Althea and her unraced daughter's offspring, Gl Breeders' Cup Classic hero Bayern (Offlee Wild). **TJCIS PPs**

While all eyes were on the comebacking GISW Americanrevolution (Constitution), it was the good doctor who stole the show when Dr Ardito pounced in the lane to secure his second career black-type score in the Evan Shipman H. Winner of Aqueduct's state-bred Haynesfield S. back in February to take his winning streak to six before having it broken on his step up in company to contest the GIII Westchester S., Dr Ardito made up ground to claim fourth last out in the Commentator S.

Three wide and chasing from fifth after the jump, the Browntrainee floated another path out before being returned to his previous spot as the group approached a half-mile from the wire. Inching forward through the final bend and coming fast from the outside, he dug in relentlessly as a leg-weary Americanrevolution herded him out to the five path. Tipped back in to challenge longtime leader Sheriff Bianco, Dr Ardito nailed that one seventy yards out and edged clear.

"Two trips in a row this horse doesn't want to be inside and we all know that, but that is just the way the trips worked out--no fault of Manny's [Franco]," said Brown after the race. "I really didn't look beyond this race. I was very frustrated with his last couple trips, just wanted to get him here. I wanted to see him at this distance, getting outside and seeing what he could do. I'm very relieved to see he ran to his works and is back on track again."

Added Franco: "The main thing was to break well and let the race develop and try to get him to the outside and that's what I did. As soon as we broke, I let those three horses go and I went outside and [followed] the one [Americanrevolution] that stumbled and was outside of me. I've ridden this horse since his debut, so he's special to me. He knows where the wire is and he tries every time he runs. I'm just grateful to be on him."

The winner hails from a half-sister to a host of accomplished runners, namely Canadian champion 2-year-old filly GSW Delightful Mary (Limehouse); multiple track record-setter MGSW Delightful Kiss (Kissin Kris); GSP Honour the Deputy (Honour and Glory); and who is also related to the dam of MSW Wilson Tesoro (Jpn) (Kitisan Black {Jpn}). 

THE CURRAGH: 'HOPEFULLY WE CAN GET REVENGE.' UNQUESTIONABLE SET FOR PHOENIX REMATCH

The Curragh stages Europe's first Group 1 contest for the current crop of 2-year-olds on Saturday and it is fair to say that a Keeneland Phoenix S. without the anticipated presence of River Tiber (Ire) (Wootton Bassett {GB}) is up for grabs. While Aidan O'Brien and the Coolmore contingent opted to send the G2 Coventry S.-winning 'TDN Rising Star' to Deauville for the Prix Morny, the way is clear for another 'TDN Rising Star' son of that sire to step into his place. Unquestionable (Fr) has the obstacle of yet another Wootton Bassett colt in Bucanero Fuerte (GB) to overcome and he couldn't quite manage that in the course-and-distance G2 Railway S. last month, but this is the Phoenix and O'Brien that we are talking about.

Ballydoyle's commander-in-chief has almost made this race his private property since 1998, with a sequence of 17 winners. Remarkably, the gap between Sioux Nation in 2017 and Little Big Bear (Ire) last term was the only time in that period that he had gone more than a year without collecting and the Railway has always been a race to sharpen his prospective Phoenix colt.

AZURE BLUE VERSUS HIGHFIELD PRINCESS IN NUNTHORPE

Azure Blue (Ire) (El Kabeir), who bested Highfield Princess (Fr) (Night Of Thunder {Ire}) in the G2 Duke Of York S. in May, will square off again with that multiple Group 1 winner in York's G1 Nunthorpe S. on Aug. 25, trainer Michael Dods confirmed on Friday.

A listed winner last October, the 4-year-old claimed the Listed Ellen Chaloner S. at Newmarket at the beginning of May before her group heroics. She was sixth in the G1 July Cup S. at Newmarket, but is reportedly doing well.

"At the moment we're thinking of going to York and the Nunthorpe," said Dods, who has won the Knavesmire feature three times with Mecca's Angel (Ire) (Dark Angel {Ire}) in 2015/2016 and Mabs Cross (GB) (Dutch Art {GB}) in 2018.

Ryan Moore has enjoyed even more success than usual on the stable's big guns in Ireland in 2023 and he said on his betfair blog, "This lacks a stand-out. Only a short-head separated Bucanero Fuerte and Unquestionable in the Railway and hopefully we can get revenge after our colt had to miss Goodwood because of the worsening ground."

Other than Bucanero Fuerte, Royal Ascot's Coventry also featured **Givemethebeatboys** (Ire) (Bungle Inthejungle {GB}) who was just 3/4 of a length behind having been sent for home some way out. Bronsan Racing and Theresa Marnane's G3 Marble Hill S. winner has been given a freshener since then and trainer Jessica Harrington issued a positive update on the £1.1million Goffs London sensation. "Hopefully he'll run a good race and we don't get too much rain between now and then so we have a bit of nice ground on the day. He's won on soft, but I'd prefer better ground as he's a good-moving horse," she said.

No filly has won this since La Collina (Ire) (Strategic Prince (GB) in 2011, but the unbeaten **Porta Fortuna (Ire)** (Caravaggio) had some smart fillies behind when capturing the G3 Albany S. for the Fowler-Medallion Racing-Weston-Reeves collective and there is no definitive marker as to how the two sexes stand up. "She was in control the whole way in the Albany and did everything you'd like, so you'd have to respect the form and she seems quite versatile," jockey Oisin Murphy said.

Sweet Solera Up For Grabs

While Ascot stages its longstanding Shergar Cup with its alternative appeal, Newmarket quietly gets on with the business of helping to sort the 2-year-old pecking order. Like the Phoenix, the G3 Molson Coors Sweet Solera S. also lacks a standout candidate but Godolphin's four-length course-and-distance winner Wild Goddess (GB) (Camelot {GB}) fits the bill with her connections and pedigree as she tackles the Listed Star S. second and third Fallen Angel (GB) (Too Darn Hot {GB}) and **Soprano (Ire)** (Starspangledbanner {Aus}). The latter is back on more suitable ground, having been third behind Porta Fortuna in the Albany and we'll know more what that form means by late afternoon on Saturday.

At Haydock, there is an intriguing blend of youth and old talent in the 10-furlong G3 Rose Of Lancaster S. with the impressive Listed Lyric Fillies' S. winner Midnight Mile (Ire) (No Nay Never) taking on Shadwell's unpredictable Al Aasy (Ire) (Sea The Stars {Ire}) with weight-for-age on her side.

Inspiral Confirmed For Marois Defence

John and Thady Gosden have given the green light for Inspiral (GB) (Frankel {GB}) to attempt back-to-back successes in Sunday's G1 Prix du Haras de Fresnay-le-Buffard Jacques le Marois at Deauville following her last-of-five effort in the G1 Sussex S. She will encounter her G1 Queen Anne S. conqueror Triple Time (Ire) (Frankel (GB)) and also Yeguada Centurion SL's G1 Prix du Jockey Club runner-up Big Rock (Fr) (Rock Of Gibraltar (Ire)), as well as the G1 Prix Jean Prat-winning course specialist Good Guess (GB) (Kodiac {GB}) in a competitive 11runner affair.

"We're pulling her back a furlong and it will be very competitive if the 2-year-olds come in and also Highfield Princess was so impressive at Goodwood.

"We had had a run and Highfield had not when we met before and she's obviously come on a lot from then. But it is the obvious race and at the moment the plan is to go there."

The five-furlong Group 1 is new territory for the filly, who has raced at six furlongs or farther in every other start to date.

"We're travelling into the unknown," Dods acknowledged. "They will go a hard gallop and hopefully she will be fine. We're looking forward to it and at the minute it is all systems go."

SHELAKA (IRE) (f, 2, Lope De Vega {Ire}--Shelina {Ire}, by Dalakhani (Ire)), a 16-1 shot on this tough debut, was settled in mid-division early. Delivered wide on the turn into the straight, the homebred reeled in Ballydoyle's 8-11 favourite Andromeda (Ire) (Galileo (Ire)) inside the last half a furlong en route to a commanding success by 3/4 of a length. "I was impressed the way she picked up," jockey Chris Hayes said. "She ran a little bit green the last 100 yards but ran through the line. She handled the ground well and has the potential to be a stakes filly."
