The Breeders' Cup returns for a record 11th time at Santa Anita

ARCADIA, CA – Forty looks good on you, Breeders' Cup. With defending winners **Caravel** (Mizzen Mast) (Turf Sprint), **Cody's Wish** (Curlin) (Dirt Mile), **Elite Power** (Curlin) (Sprint) and **Goodnight Olive** (Ghostzapper) (F/M Sprint) all back to defend their titles, the two-day Championships--consisting of 14 races with purses and awards totaling more than \$31 million--gets underway for a record 11th time at Santa Anita Friday.

Sunny skies and temperatures in the 80s--welcome back to Southern California!--will be on the menu as the weekend kicks off with a 10-race, 'Future Stars Friday' program.

"This is what it's all about," Santa Anita track announcer Frank Mirahmadi said. "The Breeders' Cup at Santa Anita, there is nothing that's bigger than that in our game."

All eyes will be on Spendthrift Farm's unbeaten 'Rising Star'
Tamara (Bolt d'Oro) as she looks to emulate her larger-than-lifedam Beholder (Henny Hughes) with a win in the GI Breeders'
Cup Juvenile Fillies.

A terrific field has been assembled for the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile, led by last-out GISWs and 'Rising Stars' Locked (Gun Runner), Timberlake (Into Mischief), and the Bob Baffert-trained duo of Muth (Good Magic) and Prince of Monaco (Speightstown).



Some of the headliners for the trio of wide-open 2-year-old turf races include: Royal Ascot G2 Coventry S. winner River Tiber (Ire) (Wootton Bassett {GB}) (Juvenile Turf); GI Natalma S. heroine She Feels Pretty (Karakontie {Jpn}) (Juvenile Fillies Turf); and returning G2 Queen Mary S. winner Crimson Advocate (Nyquist) (Juvenile Turf Sprint).

Baffert will very likely be favored to secure a fifth win in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic with 'Rising Star' Arabian Knight (Uncle Mo) following the late defection and subsequent retirement of GI Belmont S. winner Arcangelo (Arrogate). The \$6-million feature also includes G1 Dubai World Cup winner Ushba Tesoro (Jpn) (Orfevre {Jpn}) and GI Whitney S. winner White Abarrio (Race Day).


The GI Breeders' Cup Turf could arguably be the best race of the weekend. European heavyweights Auguste Rodin (Ire) (Deep Impact {Jpn}), Mostahdaf (Ire) (Frankel {GB}) and King of Steel (Wootton Bassett {GB}) will take on the best from these shores, led by Up to the Mark (Not This Time) in the 1 1/2-mile event.

Other high-profile runners in action this weekend include: Inspiral (GB) (Frankel {GB}) and Warm Heart (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) (F/M Turf); Mawj (Ire) (Exceed And Excel {Aus}) and Songline (Jpn) (Kizuna {Jpn}) (Mile); and Idiomatic (Curlin) and Pretty Mischievous (Into Mischief) (Distaff).

The Breeders' Cup World Championships will be televised live by NBC, Peacock, USA Network, and FanDuel TV.

It's impossible to count how many people each individual horse touches, whether it's someone like Vicky Van Camp at Darley who sneaks Midshipman apple slices or Price Bell at Mill

Ridge who shared how much a winner inspired a tour guest from his childhood cancer hospital bed or Larry McGinnis at WinStar whose affection for Tiznow is palpable or Veronica Reed at Three Chimneys who so eloquently said Gun Runner "reminds us that this industry is about the horse."

What became clear throughout this project is it's not just the public faces associated with these horses when they win the Breeders' Cup who are impacted. It's all the people ever associated

with a Breeders' Cup winner, from the foaling person who helps pull them out of their dam to the exercise rider on the racetrack to the grooms and handlers and watchmen and administrative staff who care for them today and even their fans.

Often we have fixed images in our minds of these horses during their racing days, when they're at peak fitness, in racing

shape, and young and fiery. But as the years pass, the stallions fill out, the broodmares get permanent bellies, the grays become white, and quiet time on the farm often mellows even the fiercest of competitors.

Knowing nothing but a lifetime of top care, these horses positively glow with good health, the assurance of having every need met, and the confidence they are champions.

What struck us as we saw each horse and spoke with their connections is the love and adoration each one has inspired.

It is often said that 'a rising tide lifts all boats.' That's what these Breeders' Cup-winning horses are, an unstoppable swell that elevates everyone around them. *Cont.*

It was a very different scene ahead of last year's Championships as the 67-year-old put the finishing touches on the once-in-a-lifetime Flightline (Tapit), who concluded his

brilliant career unbeaten from six starts with a performance for the ages in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic at Keeneland.

How's life after Flightline treating you these days John Sadler?

"He's one of the greatest horses to ever run, so it's a little different," he replied. "I've been doing this a long time, so I know the ebb and flow of it. Even though you may not have another one like that, you're gonna sure be looking for one. Everybody goes, well, is it easier this year?"

"I'll take last year any day," Sadler said with a big laugh.
Located directly below Santa Anita's signature facade in the
grandstand breezeway, a spectacular mural depicting Flightline's

jaw-dropping 11 1/2-length victory in the 2021 GI Runhappy Malibu S. was unveiled on opening day at the Great Race Place last winter.

There are plenty of reminders of the big horse scattered

around the facility.

"It's great to see," Sadler said while seated just a few feet away from a cardboard cutout of the 2022 Horse of the Year, who covered 152 mares during his first season at stud at Lane's End this year.

"What's gonna be fun is that he's gonna set the market next week at Keeneland (and Fasig-Tipton)--some of those mares will sell in foal to him and next year he'll have foals on the ground. His saga is still being written."


The fun will begin for Sadler

this weekend with \$240,000 OBS April graduate **Slider** (Jimmy Creed) in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf Sprint on Friday.

The stretch-running Kirstenbosch (Midnight Lute) figures to get a nice set up in Saturday's speed-laden GI Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Sprint. The Keith Abrahams homebred, given a 10-1 shot on the morning-line, was a come-from-behind, last-out winner of the local prep GIII Chillingworth S. Sept. 29.

Missed the Cut (Quality Road), meanwhile, will be one of the longest shots on the board as Sadler goes for a third win in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic. The dominating 1 1/2-mile GIII Tokyo

City Cup S. Oct. 1 winner, a \$400,000 KEENOV weanling and 40,000gns TATFEB graduate, is campaigned in partnership by Bee Zee, Lanes End Racing, St. Elias Stables, Edward P. Babington, Edward J. Hudson, Jr. and Lynne Hudson.

"It's one of the things that I'm proudest of that we end up in the Breeders' Cup a lot of these years," Sadler said. "We're going over there with horses that may not be the favorite, but they all have chances. When you get at this level, you have to realize that everybody you're running against is top class. They're good, tough races, but that's the way it should be."



ARCADIA, CA – The imposing Bill Mott-trained duo of **Just F Y I** (**Justify**) (Juvenile Fillies) and champion **Elite Power** (**Curlin**) (Sprint) immediately caught the eye as the curtain was lifted at Santa Anita with a spectacular sunrise beneath the San Gabriel mountains on Breeders' Cup eve.

Japanese superstar **Songline** (**Jpn**) (Kizuna {Jpn}), the 5-2 morning-line favorite for the Mile, began her marathon training session, while the horse to catch in the Dirt equivalent **'Rising Star' Zozos** (Munnings) left the pony raring to go.

John Gosden, represented by potential race favorites for the Filly & Mare Turf and Turf with the brilliant duo of **Inspiral (GB)** (Frankel {GB}) and **Mostahdaf (Ire)** (Frankel {GB}), made his way

through the less-congested apron as the lively 'Breakfast at the Breeders' Cup' crowd packed into the legendary Clockers' Corner viewing area at the top of the stretch.

Aidan O'Brien, also in town from the other side of the pond, will be loaded for the Championships as well.
Standouts from his arsenal include: River Tiber (Ire)
(Wootton Bassett {GB}) and Unquestionable (Fr) (Wootton Bassett {GB}) for the Juvenile Turf; Warm Heart (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) in the F/M Turf; and, of course, the G1 Epsom Derby winner Auguste Rodin (Ire) (Deep Impact {Jpn}) in the Turf.

Royal Ascot last out G2 Queen Mary S. heroine **Crimson Advocate** (Nyquist), one of three entered for former Wayne

Lukas assistant George Weaver in the Juvenile Turf Sprint, made a nice impression while sporting a white bridle as she gets ready to face off versus the boys from her rail draw. *Cont.*

Speaking of white bridles and former Lukas assistants, the Todd Pletcher-trained 'Rising Star' Locked (Gun Runner) has also

stood out in the mornings during training hours this week. The blaze-faced chestnut is the 7-2 morning-line favorite for a fantastic renewal of Friday's Juvenile. Co-owner Eclipse Thoroughbred Partners will also be well-represented by unbeaten Candied (Candy Ride {Arg}) in the Juvenile Fillies.

After assembling a highlight reel of morning breezes since his game win in this summer's GI Pacific Classic--do yourself a favor and head to XBTV's fantastic website if you haven't already done so yet--Classic

horse to beat 'Rising Star' Arabian Knight (Uncle Mo) was feeling mighty good during a light gallop while giving his exercise rider a workout of his own just two days out from the \$6-million main event.



SERVIS BEGINS HIS SENTENCE AT "CUSHY"

PRISON by Bill Finley

Home for Jason Servis for the next four years will be Federal Prison Camp Pensacola.

Sentenced to four years in prison after pleading guilty to using banned, performance-enhancing drugs on his horses, Servis reported to the Florida prison Wednesday. The prison is 175 miles west of Tallahassee, opened in 1988 and has a population of about 460 inmates. Notable residents included disgraced former NBA referee Tim Donaghy, Congressman Chris Collins and Billy Walters, a professional sports gambler convicted of insider trading.

But FPC Pensacola, a minimum-security facility, is, perhaps, best known for being for one the country's "cushiest" prisons. In 2009, Forbes rated the nation's prisons and listed Pensacola second on its list of "America's 10 Cushiest Prisons."

"If you've got to do time, you may as well do it off the Gulf of Mexico," Forbes wrote. "Pensacola's prisoners also tend to have better jobs and recreational choices due to the proximity of a large naval base."


Prominent defense attorney Allan Ellis, who annually publishes a "Federal Prison Guidebook," told the *Buffalo News*, "These federal prison camps are much better to be at than other federal prisons."

In a 2016 blog posted by former Pensacola inmate Kenneth Flaska, Flaska described his day, which included making coffee, watching CNN, reading, doing Soduko puzzles, checking his email, reading the *Wall Street Journal*, talking to his wife on the phone and exercising. Flaska wrote that the meals were "not bad by prison standards."

Pensacola's recreation department offers intramural sports programs, weight training and fitness, racquetball, bocce ball, horseshoes and hobbies and crafts. *Cont.*

The rec department also sponsors a movie program, with a new film being shown once a week.

Inmates are required to have a job. Depending on that position, they are paid between 12 and 40 cents per hour.

Servis will be served three meals a day, breakfast at 5 a.m, lunch from 10:45 to 11:45 and dinner from 4:30 to 5:30. 'Lights out' is at 10:30 p.m. Visitors are allowed on Saturdays, Sundays and on Federal holidays.

He was sentenced on July 26 by judge Mary Kay Vyskocil in U.S. District Court in Manhattan. Four years was the maximum sentence that Vyskocil could have levied against Servis for the guilty pleas on two counts, one a felony, one a misdemeanor.

The former trainer has a home in Jupiter, Florida.

We filled the vacancies (thanks to Dr. Michael Osborne's enormous help) with guys from Ireland, France, England and

Wales. I can only imagine how shocking this all was to those four great Black guys upon the arrival of this European invasion! All stud grooms had four stallions to care for. As I recall, Buster had Pretense, Sham, Cornish Prince and Bold Hour. Without a doubt, Sham was Buster's favorite. Whenever Sham had a mare booked for that session, upon entering the breeding shed Buster would shout out, "WHO'S YOUR GROOM, SHAM?!" He was so proud of the gleaming coat Sham always had due entirely to the immaculate grooming Buster gave him to showcase his work with his favorite horse.

"One day Penny Tweedy was scheduled to visit the stallion barn. I told Buster about the visit from the owner of Sham's nemesis, and asked him to have Sham in top show shape. When Penny arrived, I asked if she would mind having her picture taken with Buster and Sham. She happily agreed, and Buster led Sham out to the center of the Nashua Motel. I asked Penny to stand at Sham's shoulder as Buster proudly held the horse. I told Penny that I had promised Sham and Buster that I would make sure Sham finally had a head and neck in front of HER! Buster burst out with his signature belly laugh, and we all joined in on the fun.

"There are many good memories of those exciting days in the late 70's and early 80's at Spendthrift. Buster Gordon certainly contributed to them."

Padraig Campion submitted the following tribute:

A Tribute to Walter "Buster" Gordon

"I first met Buster Gordon at the Spendthrift stallion barn in 1979. I was straight off the boat and was described by John Williams as 'all hair and zits.' My first job at Spendthrift was as swing groom at the stallion barn, basically to cover the strings of whoever was off that day.

"My favorite string to do was Buster's. All his horses were well-behaved, and easy to groom and handle. Buster taught me and all the guys that worked in the stallion barn in the seventies, eighties, and the nineties the tricks of the trade. These alumni

are successful horsemen not only in the U.S., but in Ireland, England, France, Australia, and New Zealand. He showed me how to put a chain in Raise A Native's shark-like mouth (quickly).

He showed me how to put a stallion ring on Slew (gently). Many times I used Buster's methods to clean up a dirty horse for a last-minute breeding session or show. Buster was always called into service when the legendary photographer Tony Leonard came to shoot his flawless conformation shots. Buster could get the toughest horse to stand up in a perfect pose.

"Another lesson Buster gave me was how to stop Exclusive Native from bolting when turning him out. He was always on the lookout for the Irish lads on the morning after St. Patrick's Day, knowing that we

were all a bit seedy.

"Don't get me wrong: it wasn't all work advice. He knew where the best pork chops were available for lunch (the IGA supermarket on North Broadway). The best beer was a cold Stroh's by a long shot and he even had me smoking Kool cigarettes (I stopped smoking the next year).

"Buster was devoted to his beloved Sham. One morning, Sham was breeding a grey mare named Alert Princess. During the deed, Alert Princess decided to reverse and continued this maneuver from the front of the shed to the back of the shed. Sham, being a gentleman, stayed to his task and backed his hind end into the tiny bucket room, where Buster was standing. There was barely enough space for one in there, so it was very overcrowded with three. Sham and the mare completed their mission, and all concern was for Buster. However, he was not to be seen. Buster appeared at the breeding shed door unscathed having jumped through the small half-open window. He was not a small man and the mystery of how he got through that narrow opening remains.

"In the early eighties, John and blacksmith Beach Faulkner designed a steel cooker equipped with propane tanks. Buster started cooking his mash (a secret recipe) each morning, stirring throughout the day and by feed time the stallions were squealing, whinnying and hollering for their mash.

"The Spendthrift stallions shone in all seasons and never wore blankets. *Cont.*

RETIRED JOCKEY KEN SHINO SENTENCED TO SIX YEARS FOR HIT-AND-RUN by Bill Finley

Jockey Ken Shino, who won 2,542 races during a career that began in 1987, has been sentenced to six years in prison after a jury found that he struck and injured a pedestrian in Hot Springs, Arkansas in 2021 and then left the scene of the accident.

According to the Hot Springs Sentinel-Record, the jury deliberated for about an hour before finding Shino, 56, who listed Des Moines, Iowa as his address, guilty of leaving the scene of an accident involving personal injury or death, and deliberated for another hour before recommending the maximum sentence of six years in prison and a \$10,000 fine.

The incident took place on Feb. 14, 2021. Shino turned himself in to Hot Springs police on Dec. 7, 2021 after a warrant had been issued for his arrest. He was released later that same day on a \$10,000 bond and pleaded not guilty to the charge on April 18,

According to the Sentinel-Record, Shino's attorney filed a motion to dismiss, arguing the victim "was intoxicated with a blood alcohol level of .30 and a presumptive positive test for cannabinoids upon drug testing performed at the hospital." The motion also noted another vehicle was possibly the one that hit the victim based on one of the 911 calls.

Deputy Prosecutor Brock Price told the paper that Shino never made any statement to police after his arrest and did not testify at trial. Price said that his defense was basically that "while it's his truck in the video and he was driving, he did not hit the victim, but the video made it clear he did."

Police later found a vehicle matching the one caught on video showing the accident in a public parking lot. Shino was identified as the owner of the truck and detectives were also able to determine from the video that he was the person driving the truck at the time of the accident.

As far as the victim's condition, Price told the Sentinel-Record,

"He's good; he had skull and facial fractures, intracranial hemorrhaging, and some contusions and abrasions, but he healed up. He says he still has some lingering pain and back spasms, though."

Shino last rode in 2016. In 2000, he set a record-winning seven straight races on a card at Fonner Park. He had eight wins total on the day. In 2020, he was inducted into the Nebraska Thoroughbred Racing Hall of fame.

"I had three generations, so its kind of the breeder's ultimate reward. Their owner--Eric Kronfeld, who has passed away--over the years we became very fast friends. We formed such a very close human relationship that became obviously closer and closer over Zenyatta's career. He was a great friend. I still miss him.

"My family has been three or four generations in the Thoroughbred business. I don't think we ever could have thought we'd have the good fortune to be such an integral part of such a magnificent horse like Zenyatta. I feel she's the best horse of our lifetimes. I'll leave that to others to decide, but no matter who I run into, people tell me that they feel she's the best horse they've ever heard of or seen. It's heartwarming; it's rewarding; it's all the superlatives.

"The three generations of her family that I had started with For the Flag [Zenyatta's granddam], whom Eric very carefully bred to the Roberto line to get Vertigineux [Zenyatta's dam]. He was so taken with Street Cry that he bred Vertigineux to her and got Zenyatta. I never knew she'd be that kind of horse; you just never know.

"I'd raised all of Vertigineux's foals. It was a really neat family. Balance [Zenyatta's half-sister by Thunder Gulch] was totally precocious. She felt like a quick 2-year-old, so fast and so hot. She was quite remarkable. She'd get away from you. Zenyatta had much more cool; she was a bit more level headed.

"Of course, everyone knows the infamous story about Zenyatta at the [2005 Keeneland September] sale: Street Cry wasn't particularly well received and she was immature. She had a Street Cry hind leg; there was no precocity to her at all.

"There were really just two people interested in her at all and I think David Ingordo had a little bit of a leg up because Balance was really impressive and he was either in the same barn or next to the barn of Balance.

"Zenyatta looked like a project to many people. She didn't grab them. We thought more of her, but we got her on the ground and raised her well, I hope.

"But the best thing that ever happened was that David purchased her for Jerry Moss, who was one of the more patient owners. He and [trainer] John Shirreffs just really had a sense of Thoroughbreds and giving them time. What a great team. They left the horses alone if they needed it and gave them the time they needed to mature.

"I think that time was really essential for Zenyatta. So much of the key is giving them the time they need.

"My friend Eric Kronfeld said, 'I never could have done that; I would been impatient.' Most people would, but she was in the right hands."

Robinson also talked about Zenyatta's three Breeders' Cup appearances. She won the 2008 Ladies' Classic, briefly rebranded as that name from the Distaff; the 2009 Classic against the boys as the only filly or mare to win the Breeders' Cup's signature race; and then closed out her career with her only official loss in 20 starts in the 2010 Classic.

"My favorite race, what I thought was her crown," said Robinson, "was her Distaff. She went off--for her--at a fairly long price and was discounted some because she had remained in California, except for the Apple Blossom in Arkansas. She just annihilated the field. That race was, 'Oh my goodness; she's the real deal.' She just performed like no other horse. She was pretty unusual. And then she kept improving.

"When I went to her Distaff, I had not seen Zenyatta since I'd raised her. I was kind of leaning around the wall in the saddling paddock when she made a pass by. She went past me, stopped, and turned her head completely around. She took her time, looked straight at me. *Cont.*

"There was no question she sensed me. It was like she was saying, 'Where have you been?' She had such a presence. It really gave me the chills. She singled me out, no question. Isn't that remarkable? She was just an incredibly unusual horse. She was so intelligent.

"Everyone loves the Classic she won, but I think her best race was the one at Churchill she lost in her last start. There was silence afterward. But I came away thinking, 'That was the most sensational race.'

"She was absolutely out of contact with the field. Floundering. For her to get up and just miss that wire by a head.... I've never seen a horse on dirt make up that kind of ground. It was the best.

"Sometimes I go to YouTube and look up Zenyatta. All her starts are there. You almost end up on the floor, it's so sensational to see her break patiently, get up, and measure the wire. You end up breathless.

"I'm 75 years old and the experience with her has been extraordinary.

"Now, years later, I still sort of pinch myself to think I had a horse like that on this land.

"To have raised her and to have that sort of extraordinary

performance and career and presence and just everything... I can't imagine a greater experience in this industry, but hope springs eternal." -- Jill Williams



In this continuing series, Alan Carasso takes a look ahead at US-bred and/or conceived runners entered for the upcoming weekend at the tracks on the Japan Racing Association circuit, with a focus on pedigree and/or performance in the sales ring. Here are the horses of interest for this Saturday running at Kyoto and Tokyo Racecourses. Group 1 racing takes the week off in Japan, giving leading riders Christophe Lemaire and Yuga Kawada an opportunity to make the trans-Pacific trip to the Breeders' Cup, but plenty of action to be witnessed all the same:



ARCADIA, USA — In case you're wondering, Aidan O'Brien had scrambled eggs for breakfast. That was just after he had watched his squad of ten take a stronger turn around Santa Anita's dirt track and before he had a chance to consider a second course at the lavish buffet by politely stepping outside to answer questions from a few annoying hacks, this one included.

Ryan Moore has been aboard Friday's GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf Sprint contender Cherry Blossom (Ire) (No Nay Never) these last two mornings. "Is that a tip," we enquired. "No, someone asked me that already. I'll show you," replied O'Brien, digging his phone from his pocket and flicking past his selfies (just kidding) to find a photo of said filly throwing shapes worthy of the rodeo.

"She's not for kids," said the trainer with a grin. "You need a parachute to ride her."

Moore, evoking thoughts of the Man from Snowy River, never shifted in his seat, his kid gloves deployed with aplomb to ensure that there were no repeat antics from Cherry Blossom. She whipped them in as the dependable Broome (Ire) (Australia {GB}) led them all around the cambered turn of the main track, pretty much in age-descending order. Cont. p3

DARLEY FEES RELEASED AS DUBAWI AND NIGHT OF THUNDER REMAIN UNCHANGED

As has become customary, **Dubawi (Ire)** heads the list at Darley's Dalham Hall Stud, where his fee will remain unchanged in 2024 at £350,000, making him the most expensive stallion in Europe. The champion sire covered 137 mares this spring, in a year in which he was represented by nine Group/Grade 1 wins on the track.

One of those came in the Lockinge S., won by his son **Modern Games (Ire)**, who joins him at stud in Newmarket at a fee of £30,000 after notching a total of five top-level wins, including in the Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf in 2021 and last year's Breeders' Cup Mile.

Another of Darley's sons, **Night Of Thunder (Ire)**, remains at the head of the Kildangan Stud roster and his fee is also unchanged at €100,000. **Cont. p5**

O'Brien Breeders' Cup Brigade Cont. from p1

As ever, the Ballydoyle horses on tour have been one of the highlights of a morning at the track. No other visitors have as many to go out together, and horses trained at Santa Anita tend

to appear for exercise solo or in pairs. It is an arresting sight then, with the sun fully up as if to light the group to full effect, to witness this spectacle of almost synchronised breezing.

"They might have got a bit of a shock this morning," said O'Brien referring to the kickback for those in behind Broome, which included his fellow Longines

Breeders' Cup Turf runners Bolshoi Ballet (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) and Auguste Rodin (Jpn) (Deep Impact {Jpn}). "We didn't want to go on the grass today as it's plenty quick and [the dirt] opens up their mind anyway."

Five of the pack, the youngsters at the back, will face the starter on Friday; the other half take their chances come Saturday.

With Cherry Blossom finding what O'Brien believes could be her optimum conditions in the Turf Sprint, she reverts to five furlongs for the first time since her debut, and is the first of the team to jump into action, hopefully not literally.

"She's a fast filly and wasn't really getting six at home, and this flat track should suit her, as well as the ground," he said.

Content (Ire) is out of a fast filly in Mecca's Angel (Ire) but as her sire is Galileo (Ire), the mile of the Juvenile Fillies Turf seems more her go.

"She'll definitely get the trip, the fast ground will suit her better and she has a nice draw," the trainer added. Tick, tick, tick for the last-start winner of the G3 Staffordstown Stud S. "Ryan

will probably take his time on her and ride her for a little bit of luck. She needs to relax a little bit early and then she should run well."

Of River Tiber, O'Brien said, "We think he's come right since Newmarket and he's rated 3lbs below the other horse but he was always a very classy horse. He should get a mile around here; it's a nice draw and a flat track and I'm looking forward to seeing what he does."

There's something for everyone in Saturday's team. The three-year-old Aesop's Fables (Ire) (No Nay Never), who was just a length off Highfield Princess (Fr) when third in the Prix de l'Abbaye, is perhaps a little overlooked in the Turf Sprint, especially since the defection of Bradsell on Wednesday evening.

"Ryan felt in France that if he had challenged the winner a little earlier he might have been even closer but it was a huge run from him," said his trainer.

Before that there's the intriguing puzzle of Cheveley Park Stud's Inspiral (GB) (Frankel {GB}) stepping up in trip while O'Brien's Warm Heart (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) comes back in distance for the Filly & Mare Turf after her victories in the Yorkshire Oaks and Prix Vermeille.

And it must be said, having been lucky to see her at close quarters over the last few days, it's hard not to fall in love with Warm Heart. Her demure demeanour clearly masks her warrior instincts, however, as O'Brien said of the three-year-old, "She doesn't lie down, she does fight. She has a nice draw and I imagine that Ryan will probably go forward on her. She has tactical speed and will get the trip very well."

There's no doubting that the race most of the huge European contingent now camped out at Santa Anita is looking forward to the most is the Breeders' Cup Turf.

Shadwell's stud plans for Mostahdaf (GB) (Frankel {GB}) were confirmed on Thursday morning, while we already know that

Onesto (Ire), also by Frankel, is joining Haras d'Etreham and King Of Steel (Wootton Bassett {GB}) will remain in training next year. What then for Auguste Rodin? If he knows, O'Brien ain't telling, but it is a safe bet that plans are to an extent contingent on what happens this weekend.

Would American breeders appreciate another chance at the sire-line of the Kentucky Derby and Breeders' Cup Classic winner who got away, Sunday Silence? Or is Ireland the natural home for a dual Derby and Irish Champion S. winner? Could we even see Auguste Rodin race on next year? Time will tell, maybe as soon as Saturday night, but in the meantime, there is the prospect of an almighty tussle between four of the best horses in Europe and some smart Japanese and American runners.

"Obviously we'd love to have him but it will be whatever the boss decides," said O'Brien, ever the diplomat, on the subject of Auguste Rodin's post-Breeders' Cup future.

Of the immediate matter in hand, he said, "Rachel [Richardson] rode him this morning and was very happy with him. He cruised around on the dirt; he's a lovely long-striding horse. The plan was always for him to go to Leopardstown and then to come here. This is what we've been looking forward to all year. He's won two Derbys and a Champion Stakes and he's only a three-year-old. He really has done well since Leopardstown."

O'Brien added, "Did you see him on the dirt this morning? He looks like a dirt horse. If you look at Sunday Silence and look at him they are almost identical."

It certainly was a sight to behold, as Auguste Rodin stretched out over the track where Sunday Silence was trained more than 30 years ago. The colt, who can appear on the small side in the company of burlier sprinters, looks an entirely different animal unleashed at full stretch. Cont. p5

The image of him extending past King Of Steel down the hill at Epsom is still vivid in the mind but there have been good days and head-scratching days since then in the career of Auguste Rodin.

With no disrespect to his stable-mates and competitors Bolshoi Ballet and Broome, he's the one on whose near-black shoulders the hopes are resting. Maybe we'll get the chance to see if Auguste Rodin really is a dirt horse in next year's Classic, but for now his sole aim is to emulate another Ballydoyle star, High Chaparral (Ire), in taking the Derby, Irish Derby and Breeders' Cup Turf in the same season. Of Darley's other new stallions for 2024, **Triple Time (GB)**, the Group 1-winning son of Frankel (GB) is introduced at £10,000, while the former European champion 2-year-old and Irish 2,000 Guineas winner **Native Trail (GB)** will stand in Ireland at €17.500.

Cracksman (GB) was responsible for the top-rated horse in Europe this year in the unbeaten Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe winner Ace Impact (Fr), and his fee is unchanged at £17,500, while **Teofilo (Ire)**, represented by Group 1 winners in Australia, Canada and Germany in 2023, is also unchanged at \in 30,000.

Blue Point (Ire), who is set to be the champion first-season sire of 2023, has sired 41 individual winners to date, including G1 Prix Jean-Luc Lagardere winner Rosallion (Ire). Another of his sons, the G2 Flying Childers winner Big Evs (Ire), is favourite for Friday's GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf Sprint. Blue Point's fee has risen from €35,000 to €60,000 after covering 190 mares this year.

Too Darn Hot (GB) has also had a fee increase, from £40,000 to £65,000, with his first-crop runners having included seven black-type performers, headed by G1 Moyglare Stud S. winner Fallen Angel (GB). Too Darn Hot was sent 157 mares this year.

MOSTAHDAF BOUND FOR BEECH HOUSE STUD IN 2024 AS SHADWELL UK ROSTER RELOCATES

Shadwell homebred **Mostahdaf (Ire)** (Frankel {GB}--Handassa {GB}, by Dubawi {Ire}), a dual Group 1 winner, will stand at Beech House Stud next season after a final start in the GI Breeders' Cup Turf on Saturday, the operation announced on Thursday. He will join the Shadwell UK roster which is relocating permanently to Newmarket.

Trained by John and Thady Gosden, the dark bay won five of his first six starts at three, including the G3 Darley S. At four, both the G3 Gordon Richards S. and G3 September S. went his way, and he also ran second twice more--in the G3 Brigadier Gerard S. and in Royal Ascot's G2 Hardwicke S.

It was as a 5-year-old that the son of Handassa really shone, taking the G2 Neom Turf Cup in Saudi Arabia in February, before a close fourth in the G1 Dubai Sheema Classic in Dubai a month later. His final two starts were won by a combined five lengths, with the G1 Prince Of Wales's S. going his way at Royal Ascot, and then he secured the G1 Juddmonte International at York in August. His current record features 10 wins in 16 starts with earnings of \$3,000,193.

Stephen Collins, European bloodstock manager for Shadwell, said, "Shadwell are delighted that Mostahdaf will retire to the newly refurbished Beech House stallion complex in Newmarket. He has all the attributes to become a successful stallion." Cont. p7

He added, "Mostahdaf was an outstanding winner of both the Group 1 Prince of Wales's S., the highest-rated winner of the race since Dubai Millennium in 2000, and the Group 1 Juddmonte International S. at York in the same year. A truly remarkable historic double achieved by only two horses in the last 50 years.

"He possesses a pedigree packed with natural speed being closely related to two champion Group 1 winning sprinters. Mostahdaf demonstrated his incredible turn of foot by winning over seven-furlongs on debut and winning three races at a mile at three before being stepped up in trip.

"A quality, well balanced, imposing individual, with an athletic walk, he should prove very popular with breeders."

Out of the listed winner Handassa, Mostahdaf is a half-brother to the high-class Nazeef (GB) (Invincible Spirit {Ire}), who won the Sun Chariot S. and Falmouth S., both Group 1 races. Under his third dam are the pair of Group 1-winning sprinters and sires Pastoral Pursuits (GB) (Bahamian Bounty {GB}) and Goodricke (GB) (Bahamian Bounty {GB}).

Angus Gold, racing manager for Shadwell, said, "Mostahdaf has been a top-class horse for the last three seasons, from showing his speed when winning five of his six races as a 3-year-old between seven furlongs and a mile; he then displayed his clear versatility and ability over further.

"Mostahdaf never missed a day's training and was a thorough professional throughout his career; his enthusiasm for his work, together with his outstanding physique and speed, should make him a very attractive prospect for breeders."

John Gosden said of the 128-rated 5-year-old, "Mostahdaf has always been a pleasure to train. Sound and always positive and generous in his work. His action is superb and fluent with a high cruising speed and electric acceleration. A horse who has been very consistent throughout his career."

A fee for Mostahdaf and the rest of the UK roster will be announced in due course. Formerly Shadwell's UK stallion base, Nunnery Stud will remain a private base for the foaling of all of Shadwell's mares vising UK-based stallions.

LOCKINGE HERO CREACHADOIR DEAD AT 19

Group 1 winner **Creachadoir (Ire)** (King's Best--Sadima {Ire}, by Sadler's Wells) died at Haras de la Tricoliere due to a suspected cardiac event after the 2023 breeding season, *Jour De Galop* reported on Thursday.

Bred by Frank Dunne, the bay was an €83,000 Tattersalls Ireland September Sale grad when picked up by his first trainer Jim Bolger. He raced in the colours of Bolger's wife and John Corcoran through his first nine starts at two and three which

resulted in a pair of Group 3 victories and placings in both the G1 Irish 2000 Guineas and the French equivalent. Purchased by Godolphin, he made his first start for the Saeed bin Suroor barn a winning one in the G3 Joel S. at Newmarket in October of 2007. Second later that year in the G1 Hong Kong Mile at Sha Tin, he resumed at four with a victory in the G1 Lockinge S. in May of 2008.

Eventually retired with a mark of 15-4-3-2 and \$1,161,141 in earnings, Creachadoir stood at several French farms throughout his career. He moved to Haras de la Tricoliere this year. Utilised as a sire under both codes, he left stakes winner What About Carlo (Fr) on the Flat. His best NH horse was Footpad (Fr), who won a guartet of Grade 1 races.

He is a half-brother to dual Group 1 winner and sire Youmzain (Ire) (Sinndar {Ire}), as well as group winner Shreyas (Ire) (Dalakhani {Ire}). Noted runner Pilsudski (Ire) (Polish Precedent), who took top-level races in five countries, is under the third dam.

Tin Horse (Ire) (Sakhee), who has six stakes winners over jumps, will stand at Haras de la Tricoliere for €2,500 next year.

IRISH CLASSIC WINNER WESTOVER TO YUSHUN STALLION STATION IN JAPAN

Multiple Group 1 winner and Classic winner **Westover (GB)** (Frankel {GB}--Mirabilis, by Lear Fan) has been sold and will stand at Yushun Stallion Station in Japan next year, his owner/breeder Juddmonte announced on Thursday. The Irish Derby hero will be syndicated and a fee will be announced later.

Trained by Ralph Beckett, Westover won on debut at Sandown in August of 2021 and was listed-placed later that year. At three, he won the G3 Bet365 Classic Trial and was a good third in the G1 Derby prior to running off with the Irish Derby by seven lengths. Kept in training at four, he was second to the current Longines World's Best Racehorse Equinox (Jpn) (Kitasan Black {Jpn}) in the G1 Dubai Sheema Classic this March, and ran second in the G1 Coronation Cup in June. Back in the winner's

circle in the G1 Grand Prix de Saint Cloud in July, he would finish his career with a narrow second in the G1 King George VI And Queen Elizabeth S. and fill the same position in the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe. An injury sustained in the latter race resulted in his retirement in October. His record stands at 13-4-6-1 and \$4,064,813 in earnings.

"Given his tremendously consistent race record, along with his beautiful conformation and pedigree, he is sure to make a successful contribution to the Japanese breeding industry," Juddmonte said in a statement.

A full-brother to G3 Darley Club S. winner Monarchs Glen (GB) (Frankel {GB}), Westover is out of GIII Churchill Distaff Turf Mile S. heroine Mirabilis, who also won at stakes level in France, was second in the G3 Prix Miesque and G3 Prix du Pin and took third in the G1 Prix de la Foret. Second dam Media Nox (GB) (Lycius) claimed a pair of grade/group stakes in California and France, and then threw dual Group 1 winner Nebraska Tornado to the cover of Storm Cat.

DERBY WINNER ADAYAR JOINS HUKUM AT DARLEY JAPAN NEXT YEAR

Godolphin's G1 Derby winner **Adayar (Ire)** (Frankel {GB}--Anna Salai, by Dubawi {Ire}) will join **Hukum (Ire)** (Sea The Stars {Ire}) at Darley Japan for stallion duty in 2024, Darley announced on Thursday. Fees for the G1 King George-winning duo will be revealed later.

The first horse to win the Derby and the King George in the same year since his paternal grandsire Galileo (Ire), Adayar was retired in July.

The bay broke his maiden by nine lengths at Nottingham at second asking at two for Charlie Appleby, and was group-placed prior to winning the 2021 Derby at Epsom and adding the King George in his next start. **Cont. p15**

In two starts at four, he was second in the G1 Champion S., and resumed this term with a victory in the G3 Gordon Richards S. in May. After a third-placed run in the G1 Prince Of Wales's S. at Royal Ascot, he concluded his career with a second in the G2 Princess Of Wales's S. at Newbury in July. Overall, he earned \$2,553,575 and boasts a record of 13-5-4-1.

A full-brother to the stakes winner Military Order (Ire) (Frankel {GB}), Adayar is out of G3 Prix de la Grotte winner Anna Salai, who also ran second in the G1 Irish 1000 Guineas. His dam is a half-sister to stakes winners Iguazu Falls (Pivotal {GB}) and Advice (GB) (Seeking The Gold), who both placed at group level. He is also kin to G1 Prix Jean-Luc Lagardere winner National Defense (GB) (Invincible Spirit {Ire}), among others.

Hukum, a full-brother to the brilliant miler Baaeed (GB) (Sea The Stars {Ire}) won nine stakes races for his owner/breeder Shadwell, including the 2023 King George and the G1 Coronation Cup at Epsom. His female family features Shadwell blue hen Height Of Fashion (Fr) (Bustino {GB}).

Harry Sweeney, president of Darley in Japan said, "We are really excited to be able to stand two brilliant stallions in Japan, Derby winner Adayar by Europe's leading stallion Frankel, and King George winner Hukum by Sea The Stars. We hope that these excellent bloodlines will not only succeed in Japan, but also spread to Europe and the rest of the world. We look forward to welcoming you to view these stallions."

SOTTSASS FULL-BROTHER, ARQANA TOPPER SHIN EMPEROR UNVEILED AT TOKYO

Shin Emperor (Fr) (Siyouni {Fr}), the full-brother to G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe winner Sottsass (Fr) and €2.1-million topper at the 2022 Arqana August Sale, will make his much-anticipated career debut in an 1800-metre newcomers' event Saturday afternoon at Tokyo Racecourse. Bred by Ecurie des Monceaux, the chestnut carries the colours of prominent and big-spending owner Susumu Fujita and is under the care of trainer Yoshito Yahagi. Takeshi Yokoyama will be in the saddle.

An Apr. 30 foal, Shin Emperor is related to six winners from as many to race from Starlet's Sister (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}), whose produce includes the American champion turf female and GI Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Turf heroine Sistercharlie (Ire) (Myboycharlie {Ire}), who was a Group 3 winner in France and second in the 2017 G1 Prix de Diane; as well as My Sister Nat (Ire) (Acclamation {GB}), also a winner at Group 3 level in France before annexing a pair of Grade III races in the U.S. while finishing runner-up in the 2021 Filly & Mare Turf, ironically behind the Yahagi-conditioned Loves Only You (Jpn) (Deep Impact {Jpn}).

"I will take him to Japan and I hope he will win the Japanese Derby, then I hope to bring him back to France later," Yahagi told *TDN*'s Emma Berry and Brian Sheerin following his purchase.

Sistercharlie and My Sister Nat each raced for Peter Brant in the States, and it was on behalf of the art connoisseur's White Birch Farm that Michel Zerolo's Oceanic Bloodstock paid €340,000 for Sottsass (Fr) at Arqana August in 2017. Cont. p16

Turned over to Jean-Claude Rouget, Sottsass won his maiden at second asking as a juvenile and blossomed at three, with his major victory in the G1 Prix du Jockey Club, before closing the season with a gallant third behind Waldgeist (GB) (Galileo {Ire}) and three-peat seeking Enable (GB) (Nathaniel (Ire)) in that year's Arc. His second elite-level success was achieved in the G1 Prix Ganay in June 2020 and he proved a nails-tough winner of the Arc that October, defying testing underfoot conditions to score by a neck.

Sottsass's first yearlings were well-received at Argana this summer, including a colt that was purchased by top Japanese trainer Mitsu Nakauchida for €525,000.
