Having come out on the losing side of a couple of tight photos in graded-stakes company earlier this season, BBN Racing's **Trademark** (Upstart) was finally on the winning end of things Friday after dropping his nose down on the line just ahead of **'TDN Rising Star' First Mission** (Street Sense) in the GII Clark S. at Churchill Downs. The consistent **II Miracolo** (Gun Runner) was a distant third.

The 13-1 chance, drawn five in a field reduced to nine by the scratching of **Happy American** (Runhappy), Trademark broke cleanly and settled in an ideal spot from third, albeit a bit headstrong, as **Film Star** (Flatter) set the pace in the two path while First Mission held his spot at the fence while somewhat atypically disputing a moderate pace. **Cont. p3**

JUVENILES IN THE SPOTLIGHT AT CHURCHILL SATURDAY

Points towards the 2024 GI Kentucky Derby and GI Kentucky Oaks will be up for grabs with a pair of graded races for juveniles Saturday at Churchill Downs. Eight colts face off in the 1 1/16-mile GII Kentucky Jockey Club S. and an equal number of fillies head postward in the GII Golden Rod S. a race earlier on the card.

Winchell Thoroughbreds and Three Chimneys Farm's **Risk It** (**Gun Runner**), who already owns five Derby points thanks to his runner-up effort in the Sept. 16 GIII Iroquois S., is the 5-2 morning-line favorite in the Kentucky Jockey Club. Trained by Steve Asmussen, the colt was a debut winner at Saratoga Aug. 19.

West Point Thoroughbreds' **Stretch Ride** (Street Sense) brings a two-for-two record into his stakes debut Saturday. The colt graduated going six furlongs at Churchill Sept. 17 and romped by 5 3/4 lengths when stretched to 1 1/16 miles in an Oct. 14 Keeneland allowance for trainer Dale Romans.


While he has raced only twice, Stretch Ride has already logged plenty of frequent flyer miles. He was a bargain \$5,000 Fasig-Tipton October purchase last year, before selling for €100,000 at the Arqana Breeze-Up Sale in May.

The 6-5 chalk began to get the better of the battle up front rounding the second turn, but Fernando De La Cruz had a fistful of rein astride Trademark, just needing a way out as they hit the quarter pole. Accelerating sharply, Trademark zoomed past a weakening **Giant Game** (Giant's Causeway) to his outside and hooked up with First Mission passing the eighth pole.

The latter drifted outward as heads were up and down with time ticking away, and it was Trademark who was home by the slimmest margin.

"I thought at the sixteenth pole I had a big shot at winning," said De La Cruz, winning his second graded event of 2023 (Get Smokin, GII Kentucky Turf Cup). "He relaxed early and I saved ground, just waiting for the right opportunity to get him outside. He's always been a very nice horse. I've been on him a couple of times and knew he was pretty tactical in his races. He showed a big turn of foot in the stretch and fought all the way to the wire."

Trademark entered the Clark as something of a horse for the course, having made the rained-off Commonwealth Turf S. his first black-type score just short of a year ago. A sound third at longshot odds in the GIII Salvator Mile S. at Monmouth June 17, the bay won the July 8 Michael Schaefer Memorial S. at Horsehoe Indianapolis before falling a half-length shy in the GIII Philip H. Iselin S. back at the Jersey Shore Aug. 19. Tagged on the money in this track's GII Lukas Classic Sept. 30, Trademark beat just one home in the GII Fayette S. at Keeneland Oct. 28.





Pedigree Notes:

With his first three dams by Creative Cause, Mazel Trick and Northjet--hardly household names, but horses the late Brereton C. Jones was happy to take a chance on as stallions--Trademark is a living tribute to the former Kentucky governor's breeding operation at Airdrie Stud.

Out of an unraced half-sister to MGISW Include Me Out (Include), GISW Check The Label (Stormin Fever) and On the Menu (Canadian Frontier), Trademark descends from Lucy Sims, a homebred daughter of Northjet, who was imported by Jones to stand at Airdrie in the 1980s after winning the G1 Prix du Moulin and G1 Prix Jacques le Marois in France. Lucy Sims would go on to produce six winners from 12 to the races, including MSW & MGSP Tiffany Diamond (Tiffany Ice).

But it was Lucy Sims's other daughters that had the more lasting influence on the family, as Kittery Point (Include) produced GI La Brea S. winner Sam's Sister (Brother Derek) and SW Sensitive (Divine Park), while Another Vegetarian (Stalwart)-a winner of \$4,200 at the races--became the dam of GI QE II Challenge Cup winner Sweet Talker (Stormin Fever) and MGSW Silver Medallion (Badge of Silver). Lucy Sims's daughter Haddie (You and I) counted MSW Haddie Be Good (Silver Deputy) and Panamanian stakes-placed Sixpack of Kings (Belong to Me) among her five winners.

Trademark's 2-year-old full-sister There She Goes was unplaced on Hawthorne debut over the summer and his half-sister by newer Airdrie sire Complexity was hammered down to Meridian International for \$140,000 at this year's Keeneland September sale. The mare foaled a Beau Liam colt Mar. 8 and was bred back to Upstart, who is now the sire of five graded stakes winners. Trademark is bred on the same cross at Grade I winner and new Spendthrift stallion Zandon.



Despite Friday's GII Mrs. Revere S. being transferred to the Churchill main track, the connections of nine of the 12 entrants elected to remain in the race and Heavenly Sunday--a Grade II winner on turf, but bred beautifully to handle the dirt--asserted her superiority through the final furlong to prove a much-the-best winner.

Callie's Grit, a winner and second from two previous tries on the main, won the break and set sail for the lead from her outside draw, but Florent Geroux was intent on putting an equally positive ride on the 7-5 favorite and the duo tracked Callie's Gift from second. Going smoothly through the middle stages, Heavenly Sunday went calling for the lead outside the pacesetter nearing the stretch and she lengthened away to score with something in hand. Beach Walkn and Make the Boys Wink ran on late to round out the minor placings.

The front-running winner of the GII Edgewood S. one race prior to the running of the GI Kentucky Oaks back on May 5, Heavenly Sunday was run down in the shadow of the post by Thursday's GIII Falls City S. winner Xigera (Nyquist) in the relocated Tepin S. at Ellis Park July 1. Seventh after making the early running in the GII Lake Placid S. at Saratoga Aug. 19, the dark bay was exiting a second in Keeneland's GIII Valley View S. Oct. 27.

In receipt of a half-dozen pounds from top-weighted favorite Durante, Bold Journey did the better of the two in the final eighth of a mile to prove a clear-cut winner of the Black Friday feature at the Big A.

Void of any sort of early speed, Bold Journey was soon racing in a detach last of the five remaining runners as Durante took his other three closely grouped rivals through an opening couple of furlongs in :22.68. His backers were consigned to watching his chicklet at the bottom of the feed as they raced around the turn, but the New York-bred began to find his best stride as Win For Gold poured the pressure into Durante at the quarter pole. With his mouth flapping open and shut and going a bit awkwardly, Durante nevertheless carried the lead into the final furlong, but Bold Journey had his measure down the wide outside and went on to score comfortably.

Fall Highweight H. cont.

Bold Journey had been kept busy during his 4-year-old campaign and was making his ninth start of the season Friday to go with his eight trips postward--good for a single victory--last term. He had won three from eight this season, taking a Belmont turf sprint allowance June 9 before dropping to seventh back on the dirt at Saratoga July 29. The chestnut bounced back to be second after a stumbling start at the Spa Aug. 26 and he was up in the final jump to take an open second-level allowance here Oct. 12.

"The last couple times we've been sitting at the back and making one run and it worked out for me both times," said winning jockey Jose Ortiz. "The horse is doing very good. Mr. Mott has him in great form and I'm happy to win today."

Planetario | Benoit

Long-distance specialist Planetario has made four career starts at $1\,1/2$ miles or farther, resulting in a Group 1 victory in his native Brazil, a win and a second in Grade III events at Santa Anita earlier this year, and a win Friday in the GII Hollywood Turf Cup S.

After that Group 1 in Brazil--his second at the highest level in that country and his third consecutive stakes win--he left the barn of L. Esteves and shipped stateside to Richard Mandella during the first half of 2022. After only one start last year, he was freshened until this spring and kicked off his season nicely with a GIII San Luis Rey S. second and a GIII San Juan Capistrano S. win. With marathons in short supply, Planetario shortened up by a furlong or more for his next three starts and proceeded to finish off the board in all. Friday's Hollywood Turf Cup was his first start since his fourth Oct. 1 behind the re-opposing Balladeer (Distorted Humor) in the 1 1/4-mile GII John Henry Turf Championship S.

Hollywood Turf Cup cont.

In no hurry early, Planetario settled into the penultimate spot in Friday's Turf Cup while Balladeer, who set the pace in the Nov. 4 GI Longines Breeders' Cup Turf, led the way with :24.76 and :49 early fractions. Planetario had advanced just one spot on the inside by the 1:39.33 mile split while Balladeer continued to lead and the field bunched up. Planetario split horses down the lane, dodging through a seam that would surely have been intimidating for a horse less game, and hit the front with a head full of steam. It was a mad dash to the finish with the late-closing Chad Brown shipper Francesco Clemente and last-out Chilean Group 1 winner Lukka joining him for a three-way photo.

"Great ride by [Hector] Berrios," said winning Hall of Fame trainer Richard Mandella. "He didn't lose an inch of ground. He sat still on him and just rode him with a lot of confidence. [Going back to 1 1/2 miles] didn't hurt him. He carries a lot of weight but it doesn't take anything out of him."

Pedigree Notes:

Il Doge, Brazil's champion 2-year-old colt in 2014, is a son of Overbrook Farm homebred and 1998 GI Florida Derby winner Cape Town. Despite extremely small reported crops, he is the sire of two Brazilian Group 1 winners. Like his U.S.-winning son, he raced as a Red Rafa Stud homebred.

Planetario's female family has been in South America for several generations, but traces directly back to the wonderful Calumet Farm homebred Nellie Flag, who was sired by the Man o'War stallion American Flag and was Calumet's first-ever champion. The champion 2-year-old filly of 1934, Nellie Flag became a foundation mare for Calumet. In addition to producing champion Mar-Kell and Kentucky Oaks winner Nellie L., her descendants include three-time Horse of the Year Forego and Kentucky Derby winner Bold Forbes.

Gary and Mary West's homebred **West Sunset** (West Coast), 2-1 on the morning line, comes into the Golden Rod off a front-running 6 3/4-length victory over this same track and distance in the Oct. 29 Rags to Riches S.

Graded stakes action Saturday also includes the GII Seabiscuit H. over the lawn at Del Mar and the GIII Comely S. for 3-year-old fillies at Aqueduct.

XIGERA TAKES PLANNED BREAK AFTER FALLS CITY ROMP SAYS BAUER

Rigney Racing's **Xigera** (Nyquist), the 6 1/2-length GIII Falls City S. winner on Thanksgiving Day, will enjoy a planned break this winter before targeting next year's GI La Troienne S. on Kentucky Derby weekend, according to trainer Phillip Bauer.

The Kentucky-based conditioner won last year's Falls City with now-retired Played Hard (Into Mischief), who returned five months later to win the La Troienne by a neck over GI Longines Kentucky Oaks winner Secret Oath (Arrogate).

"We're going to take her to the sidelines for the winter and hopefully take the same course as we did last year with Played Hard and target the La Troienne," said Bauer. "Our year-end goal next year will be the Breeders' Cup. We got bit with the injury bug this year with Played Hard who we retired and never got to make it to the Breeders' Cup. Hopefully Xigera can fill Played Hard's shoes now that she's out of the barn."

The 3-year-old's victory in Falls City was her fifth win from six starts this year. Bauer successfully switched Xigera to the dirt three starts ago in the Seneca Overnight S. Sept. 23 before taking home the GII Mother Goose S. by 3 1/2 lengths during the Belmont at the Big A meet Oct. 28.

Xigera gave Rigney and Bauer three wins on the holiday card. The duo won race nine with veteran **Angkor** (Anchor Down) and race 12 with 2-year-old first time starter **Legadema** (Arrogate).

CATTLEYA STAKES KICKS OFF JAPAN ROAD TO THE KENTUCKY DERBY by Alan Carasso

A field of 16 horses--14 colts and a pair of 2-year-old fillies--will head to the gate for Saturday's \$206,819 Cattleya S., a 1600-meter allowance test going a single left-handed turn at Tokyo Racecourse that serves as the first of four legs on the Japan Road to the Kentucky Derby.

Trainer Tetsuya Kimura, who will tighten the girth around favored Equinox (Jpn) (Kitasan Black {Jpn}) in Sunday's G1 Japan Cup, sends out American-bred **Sonic Star** (Into Mischief). Bred in Kentucky by Nancy Shuford, the dark bay was a \$300,000 Keeneland September yearling acquisition and has one racetrack appearance under his belt, a 3 1/2-length victory in an 1800-meter event for newcomers at Hanshin back on Sept. 24 (video, SC 1). Back in third on that occasion was **Marcha Real (Jpn)** (Real Impact {Jpn}), a half-brother to GI Breeders' Cup Distaff heroine Marche Lorraine (Jpn) (Orfevre {Jpn}), who returned to break his maiden going nine furlongs over a sloppy strip at Kyoto Nov. 11. Sonic Star, to be ridden by the visiting William Buick, is the 5-1 third betting choice in ante-post wagering.

Into Mischief is also represented by **Bushin**, a full-brother to Horse of the Year Authentic, who was placed twice on the turf before breaking his maiden going 1000 meters on the dirt in July. The \$800,000 Keeneland September purchase was well-beaten in a local allowance over 1400 meters two weeks back.

Holding early favoritism is **Rata Forest (Jpn)** (Pyro), who will look to build on a seven-length victory over course and distance Oct. 21 (video, SC 9). It will be up to Mirai Iwata to work out a trip from gate 14.

Others attracting early support include **Amante Bianco (Jpn)** (Henny Hughes), a white colt from the family of multiple champion Sodashi (Jpn) (Kurofune); and **O K Birdie (Jpn)**, a daughter of top dirt sire Sinister Minister who thrashed a field of newcomers by 14 1/2 lengths on Fukushima debut Nov. 5 (video, SC 2).

The Cattleya S. offers Kentucky Derby points on a 10-5-3-2-1 scale to the first five home. The series continues with the Listed Zen-Nippon Nisai Yushun (1600m) at Kawasaki Dec. 13, the Listed Hyacinth S. (1600m) at Tokyo Feb. 18 and the Fukuryu S. (allowance) at Nakayama Mar. 23, with each race offering increased points. The horse that amasses the most points earns a guaranteed spot in the Kentucky Derby. If those connections decline, the offer is extended to each of the next four finishers, in order of points earned.







ALPINE STAR AND ALPHA CENTAURI SELL FOR €6M APIECE TO COOLMORE AT GOFFS



MV Magnier bought four mares from the Niarchos draft for \in 19m $_{Goffs}$

Coolmore Stud spent €19m and equalled its own record set for the highest price paid at public auction in Ireland 10 years ago for Chicquita (Ire) (Montjeu {Ire}) by flexing its buying power to secure half-sisters Alpine Star (Ire) (Sea The Moon {Ger}) and Alpha Centauri (Ire) (Mastercraftsman {Ire}) for €6m apiece from the Niarchos draft at the Goffs November Breeding Stock Sale on Friday.

Alpine Star, the brilliant G1 Coronation S. winner, and multiple Group 1 and Irish 1,000 Guineas heroine Alpha Centauri, carried the Niarchos family's colours with great distinction throughout their glittering careers for trainer Jessica Harrington.

Their former stablemate Albigna (Ire) (Zoffany {Ire}), winner of G1 Prix Marcel Boussac, also featured on Coolmore's shopping list along with That Which Is Not (Elusive Quality) (lot 1260), the dam of Irish Derby runner-up Piz Badile (Ire) (Ulysses {Ire}).

It was Albigna (lot 1212) who broke the million mark on the day but it didn't take long for Alpine Star (lot 1240) and Alpha Centauri (lot 1263), who rightly commanded star billing at arguably the most eagerly-anticipated Irish sale in recent times, to steal the show. Cont. p3

STRAVINSKY PASSES AT 27 IN JAPAN

Champion and pensioned stallion **Stravinsky** (Nureyev--Fire the Groom, by Blushing Groom {Fr}) passed away from the infirmities of old age at JBBA Shizunai Stallion Station in Japan earlier this week, *Net Keiba* reported on Friday. A notable broodmare sire, he was 27.

"We are truly saddened to lose him and are grateful for all the support from his fans over the years," Shigeki Yusa posted on X.

Bred by R. D. Hubbard, E. C. Allred and C. Sczesny in Kentucky, the \$625,000 Keeneland July yearling was purchased by Coolmore interests and raced for Michael Tabor and Sue Magnier. Trained by Aidan O'Brien, the colt was third in the G1 Dewhurst S. at two. During his 3-year-old season, he won the G1 July Cup and G1 Nuthorpe S., and retired to Coolmore Ashford with a mark of 8-3-1-1 and \$361,450 in earnings. He was named the Cartier Champion Sprinter of 1999. Cont. p9

Bidding from his usual spot to the right of the rostrum and under letter H, MV Magnier saw off Northern Farm for Alpha Centauri, with Yulong's Yuesheng Zhang involved in the running

for the 2018 Cartier Horse Of The Year up to €5m.

Alpha Centauri was sold in foal to Sea The Stars (Ire) while her half-sister Alpine Star was sold in foal to Frankel (GB) having given birth to a colt foal by the Juddmonte stallion earlier this year. Meanwhile, Alpha Centauri has had one runner to date--the twice placed Saturn (Ire) (Galileo {Ire})--and had a Circus Maximus (Ire) filly last year.

Coolmore hasn't built itself up to being one of the powerhouse breeding outfits in the world without having a plan and

Magnier revealed after signing for Alpine Star that their dual Derby winner Auguste Rodin (Ire) (Deep Impact {Jpn}) is already being touted for the Kiltinan Castle Stud-drafted Royal Ascot

winner.

He explained, "When the time comes, we'll probably send her to Auguste Rodin. When Auguste Rodin won the Derby, I'd say it was 30 seconds later when Dad [John] rang me and said, 'this is

the most important thing that has happened to Coolmore since Galileo (Ire) won the Derby.'

"That horse has absolutely everything--from Deep Impact to his mother being a champion, his grandmother being a champion, he's a Group 1-winning two-year-old and he's a dual Derby winner, Breeders' Cup Turf and Irish Champions Stakes winner as well. He's everything we're looking for and, when the time comes after next year, we're going to really get behind him."

Magnier continued, "She

[Alpine Star] was a very good race mare and it's an incredible family. Honestly, all our partners, everyone, we're just delighted to be able to buy these mares off Maria [Niarchos]. Cont. p4

"She has been a huge supporter of ours as long as I am alive--like, she is the Godmother to my brother. It just means a lot to us to be able to give back to Maria after all the support

she has given us for a very long time."

Harrington, who managed the careers of Alpine Star, Alpha Centauri and Albigna, the winners of 12 races, six of which were Group 1s and well over €2m in prize-money, was in attendance to see the three queens amass €15.7m in the ring.

As was Alan Cooper, who has been a part of the Niarchos outfit since the early 1980s, and oversaw Friday's draft in the role as racing manager to the world-famous racing family.

He commented, "It's been a great tribute to decades of building these bloodlines. The family would like to thank everybody who has contributed to the success of these families over the decades, from those involved with foaling, right through to training, racing and back to breeding. It's very much mixed emotions, but as we said from the start it's a restructuring.

"That's been accomplished in the sense that the bloodlines are spreading out. We've still got access to all of the bloodlines through our two- and three-year-old fillies, yearlings and foals. Even though we've separated from these great race mares, we still have the blood."

Cooper added, "It goes back many decades and it's become global. The Miesque line has been very successful in Japan with Loves Only Me winning at the Breeders' Cup and Real Steel. We had a look last week and descendants from Miesque

and her dam, Pasadoble, if I'm not mistaken, include 91 black-type winners."

Just how highly sought after these bloodlines are among some of the biggest breeding operations the world over was evident by the truly international turnout at Goffs on Friday. Juddmonte underbid Albigna, consigned by Baroda Stud, earlier in the session where the Japanese-based Northern Farm once again played a strong hand for much of the bidding war.

Magnier commented on €3.7m purchase Albigna, "She is a lovely mare. The whole Niarchos family, they have been very special friends of ours for a long time. We're just very happy that we can continue the relationship."

Albigna has already produced a Wootton Bassett (GB) colt which realised €460,000 as a yearling and had a Dubawi (Ire) filly foal this year. Along with that Group 1 triumph in 2019, Albigna landed the G2 Airlie Stud S. as a two-year-old in a brilliant nine-race career.

Magnier added, "These kinds of mares don't come on the market very often and, with this mare, we are lucky that we have very good partners who will support us to try and buy these mares. St Mark's Basilica has had some very good foals and, if she has a good colt by him, it would make it easy to go back."

Talking Points

- It's been a good week all round for Goffs, with the foal sale exceeding expectations, and the trade on Friday was strong again with 53 mares making six-figures or more. Of the 53, there were five who rocked into millionaire status.
- The Niarchos draft, split between Baroda Stud, Norelands and Kiltinan Castle Stud, did not disappoint and accounted for roughly €27m of the turnover on the day.

- In a normal year, the Aga Khan draft would be front and centre at this sale, not least the €410,000 Jill Lamb spent on behalf of Childwickbury Stud for Siyouni (Fr) mare Suwayra (Ire). A winner at two for trainer Dermot Weld, Suwayra (lot 1194) was sold in foal to Sea The Moon (Ger), and will form part of Paul and Sally Flatt's burgeoning broodmare band at Childwickbury Stud in England.
- It was interesting that the Aga Khan supported the Niarchos draft to the tune of €1.375m. Signing under Gilltown Stud, the Aga Khan bought Galileo (Ire) mares Malicieuse (Ire) (lot 1262) [who is in foal to Wootton Bassett (GB)] for €775,000 and Raja Ampat (Ire) (lot 1259) [in foal to Baaeed (GB)] for €450,000 as well as La Fiamma (War Front) (lot 1181) for €150,000.
- Kildare-based trainer Takashi Kodama might be best known in this part of the world for his handling of talented stayer Pop Rock (Jpn) (Helissio {Fr}) over a decade ago but he also lands one with a major order at the big mares sales every now and again. Kodama paid €625,000 for Dubawi (Ire) mare Forever Be (Ire) (lot

- 1184) in foal to Wootton Bassett (GB) on behalf of the Japanese-based Champions Farm from the Niarchos draft.
- Cheshire Oaks winner Thoughts Of June (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) (lot 1264), who raced in partnership between Moyglare Stud and Coolmore Stud, was bought out by the former for €2m. The classy filly was sold in foal to No Nay Never.
- There was a notable French presence at Kildare Paddocks and Sumbe got in on the action for unexposed mare Provocateuse (Ire) (Pride Of Dubai {Aus}) (lot 1238) from the Niarchos offering. Sold in foal to Kingman (GB), it wouldn't take Einstein to work out who Provocateuse is being lined up to visit next year, given the French farm signed as Sumbe Belbek.
- A sale like Friday's does not come around very often which was illustrated in the figures with a 153% rise in the aggregate to €39,507,500. The €203,647 average was up 166% on last year while the median climbed 5% to €44,000. Of the 240 mares offered on Friday, 194 were sold at a clearance rate of 81%.

ALL EYES ON EQUINOX IN THE JAPAN CUP

by Alan Carasso

Having given the race a pass in 2022 after taking a thrilling renewal of the G1 Tenno Sho (Autumn), Silk Racing Co. Ltd.'s world's top-rated racehorse **Equinox (Jpn)** (Kitasan Black {Jpn}) looks to complete that particular double--most recently accomplished by the syndicate's two-time Horse of the Year Almond Eye (Jpn) (Lord Kanaloa {Jpn}) in 2020--as the warm favourite in Sunday's G1 Japan Cup at Tokyo Racecourse.

It has been a meticulously managed preparation for the 4-year-old colt with the broad blaze, as his abilities were on display for all to see when thrashing some of the world's best 2400-metre gallopers in the G1 Longines Dubai Sheema Classic Mar. 29. How strong was the performance? The second, third and fourth home--Westover (GB) (Frankel {GB}), Zagrey (Fr) (Zarak {Fr}) and Mostahdaf (Ire) (Frankel {GB})--would all go on to plunder Group 1s in various parts of Europe, while the fifth-placed defending champion Shahryar (Jpn) returned to his best form with his recent third in the GI Longines Breeders' Cup Turf.

Rested until the G1 Takarazuka Kinen in June, Equinox--whose own sire took this in 2016--came from well back and held off future G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe fourth Through Seven Seas (Jpn) (Dream Journey {Jpn}), but sat handier to the pace in the Oct. 30 Tenno Sho to score by an easy 2 1/2 lengths in the time of 1:55.2 for the 2000 metres. He's been ticking over since and did his final piece of work on the bridle Nov. 22.

"It was a usual workout," said trainer Tetsuya Kimura. "He left the gate eagerly and was well-balanced under way. He was patient and waited for the rider's signal, then picked up the pace and ran solidly to the end. It was a good workout, as usual. I'm not going to make any empty promises, but we'll do our best over these last few days to get him to the gate in top condition." Indeed, Horse of the Year honours for 2023 are at stake

Sunday, as Triple Tiara heroine **Liberty Island (Jpn)** (Duramente {Jpn}) has claims with a victory. The Sunday Racing runner is also perfect in her three trips to the races this term, coming from a near-impossible position to win the G1 Oka Sho (Japanese 1000 Guineas) in April before stamping her authority on the G1 Yushun Himba (Japanese Oaks), scoring by six lengths over the Japan Cup course and trip May 21. Leaving nothing to chance in the Oct. 15 G1 Shuka Sho, Yuga Kawada kept her in the clear, went for her fairly early while wide and won by a comfortable length. Harper (Jpn) (Heart's Cry {Jpn}), second in the Oaks and third in the Shuka Sho, returned to be a close third in the G1 QE II Commemorative Cup against older females earlier this month. Liberty Island will get a 4kg pull under the weight-for-age conditions plus sex allowance.

"I think she's one level better than she was for the Shuka Sho," opined trainer Mitsumasa Nakauchida. "Her muscle tone is better, her mood is good. The Shuka Sho draw was difficult, but the jockey did a great job of guiding her. After seeing that race, I decided to come here. She is familiar with the venue and the Tokyo 2400 metres from her Japanese Oaks run, but she'll be up against older horses for the first time."

Titleholder (Jpn) (Duramente {Jpn}) was Japan's champion older horse of 2022, with scores in the G1 Tenno Sho (Spring) over two miles and in the Takarazuka Kinen ahead of an 11th to Alpinista (GB) (Frankel {GB}) in that rain-soaked Arc. Winner in Group 2 company this past March, he was pulled up and out of the Tenno Sho Spring, but bounced back with a runner-up effort in the G2 Sankei Sho All Comers Sept. 24, holding gamely after making the majority of the running. He's drawn low, but will surely have a fight on his hands up front with all-the-way G1 Saudi Cup hero Panthalassa (Jpn) (Lord Kanaloa {Jpn}). Cont. p15

Stars on Earth (Jpn) (Duramente {Jpn}) could prove the eachway play in this year's race. Desperately unlucky not to secure a Triple Tiara of her own in 2022, the dark bay--who carries the Shadai black-and-yellow--missed by a nose to pacesetting Jack d'Or (Jpn) (Maurice {Jpn}) in the G1 Osaka Hai Apr. 2 and was last seen charging home into third behind Songline (Jpn) (Kizuna {Jpn}) and Sodashi (Jpn) (Kurofune {Jpn}) in the G1 Victoria Mile at this venue in May. She is clearly at home at Tokyo and the distance should be much more to her liking.

Vela Azul (Jpn) (Eishin Flash {Jpn}) won last year's Cup under an audacious Ryan Moore steer, but with Moore having cut short his Japanese stint due to an injury suffered last weekend, Hollie Doyle is at the controls Sunday.

Following the withdrawal of G1 St Leger hero Continuous (Jpn) (Heart's Cry {Jpn}), Iresine (Fr) (Manduro {Ger}) is the lone European raider this year. The 6-year-old won the G1 Prix Ganay in yielding ground at ParisLongchamp in May, received a break over the summer and exits a strong-finishing score in the G2 Prix du Conseil de Paris on a sounder surface Oct. 15. He likes to be ridden quietly, conserving his energy for the straight, and the long run home over the Fuchu course should suit his style nicely.

Shooting the breeze well off the rail just behind the first flight, Al Nefud soon inched closer to the leaders with just over a half-mile to travel.
