

DORNOCH ULTRA GAME TO PICK UP DERBY POINTS IN REMSEN

While he still has a long ways to go to follow in his older brother's footsteps, **Dornoch** (**Good Magic**) proved he might just be up to the task with a game win in the GII Remsen S. to pick up 10 Kentucky Derby qualifying points.

The younger full-brother of this year's GI Kentucky Derby winner and **recently-retired stallion Mage**, Dornoch took three tries to break his maiden but did so impressively at Keeneland in a gate-to-wire 6 1/2-length romp Oct. 14. Already stakes placed before even breaking his maiden, the Danny Gargan trainee went off favored for his third-straight race at 8-5 for an ownership group that includes West Paces Racing LLC, R. A. Hill Stable, Belmar Racing and Breeding, LLC, Two Eight Racing, LLC and Pine Racing Stables.

Hustled from the gate, the bay secured a leading position into the first turn amidst a wall of challengers on both sides. Longshot **Private Desire** (**Constitution**), who was last from the gate, sped up alongside Dornoch to issue an early challenge as the colts hit a quarter in :23.09. The duo was joined by another longshot as **Billal** (**Street Sense**) moved between runners to make it three across the track up front past the half in :46.97.

OWNER WYCOFF SPLASHES HOME WITH TWO WINS ON RAIN-SOAKED CLAIMING CROWN CARD by T.D. Thornton

Owner Jordan Wycoff was victorious with his only two entrants on Saturday's Claiming Crown card, executing a similar strategy with both favored winners. Each had met their respective starter-allowance eligibility conditions by only once having raced at or below the required minimum claiming price. And both recently had been running against tough competition on the New York and Kentucky circuits before overpowering their fields at Fair Grounds in a rain-soaked renewal of the annual event nicknamed "the blue-collar Breeders' Cup."

One of Wycoff's wins Dec. 2 was delivered by **Money Supply** (**Practical Joke**), who was so keen to score in the featured \$200,000 Jewel at nine furlongs that the 2.8-1 shot broke through the gate prior to the start. **Cont. Pg. 4**

Relaxed under a loose rein from Luis Saez, Dornach spun for home seemingly ready to run away with it until **'TDN Rising Star' Sierra Leone (Gun Runner)** came charging from the back of the pack in an attempt to make it a graded double for his sire. The pair hit the furlong pole together and Sierra Leone had all the momentum, putting the favorite back to second against the fence. But Dornach was tenacious to the inside and re-rallied from what appeared to be a sure-beat to get up in the final strides past his rival.

"Kendrick [Carmouche] told me, 'Danny, if I had more time'," said Gargan. "When he saw the horse go by him, he said he gets to playing around, which he bounced off the rail today and when he gets out there by himself he loses focus. He said if he sees another horse, he's going to run back to him and today he proved it. It was something that was always said but never proven until today, but that was pretty impressive because I thought the other horse went way past him. For him to dig in and fight back like that, especially after the half mile in 46 [seconds], he ran the whole race."

"He's a pretty nice horse, but I feel like he's still learning," added Saez. "When he kind of feels a little alone, he was a little lost. As soon as the other one came to him, he saw him and he wanted to beat him. He wants to win the race."

Pedigree Note:

From the second crop of **Good Magic**, sire of now 16 stakes winners, Dornach continued the good fortunes for dam Puca. In addition to seeing Mage wear the roses in May, the graded-stakes placed daughter of Big Brown brought \$2.9m post-sale from John Stewart last month at Keeneland November carrying a full-sibling to both Mage and Dornach. Her first foal, Gunning (**Gun Runner**), placed in a pair of stakes herself. Puca is a half-sister to GISW Finnegan's Wake (Powerscourt {GB}). Her yearling, a colt by **McKinzie**, sold for \$1.2m in September at Keeneland to Mayberry Farm.

After being cleared to reload, the 4-year-old colt was a touch unsettled in the early stages. He got pelted with wet kickback while carving out an inside trip, brushed briefly when seeking room for a rally in mid-stretch, then opened up when cued to quicken between tiring leaders before extending fluidly under hand encouragement through the final sixteenth.

"He broke good and just kind of got shuffled back in there, but he was handling it well the whole time, and when we turned for home, I had a lot of horse," said jockey Jareth Loveberry after the 1:52.05 win over nine furlongs. **Cont.**

A \$400,000 KEESEP buy, Money Supply had never been in for a tag until previous connections Klaravich Stable and Chad Brown risked losing him for \$35,000 on Aug. 20 at Saratoga. Money Supply won his N2L condition the day he was claimed by trainer Joe Sharp on behalf of Wycoff, and three subsequent allowance and/or starter races after that yielded one narrow defeat at Saratoga and two victories at Churchill Downs.

Sharp said he and Wycoff had "an epiphany" after the first of those two wins Sept. 27 that reminded them that having run for a \$35,000 tag in 2022-23 meant that Money Supply was eligible for the Jewel.

"At that point, we started to target it," Sharp said.

The result was a 1 3/4-length, going-away win in the premier Claiming Crown race.

The Claiming Crown, which began in 1999 as a way to showcase and reward horses who compete in the types of races that form the backbone of day-to-day American racing, is a

partnership between the National Horsemen's Benevolent and Protective Association (NHBP) and the Thoroughbred Owners and Breeders Association.

After initially starting at Canterbury Park while occasionally

rotating among other tracks in its formative years, Gulfstream Park had evolved into the host track starting early in the 2010s decade.

But for 2022, the Claiming Crown switched sites to Churchill Downs, where a November snow wiped out last year's turf races. When the series got switched to the Fair Grounds (which last hosted in 2011) for the 2023 edition, Mother Nature followed with more nasty weather.

It rained so hard in New

Orleans prior to Saturday's first post that track management opted to cancel the days first two (non-Claiming Crown) races, and an abandonment of the grass races was necessary for the second year in a row. **Cont.**

Maintenance crews worked the track to remove standing water, and after an additional 45-minute pushback to post time, Fair Grounds commenced the card with Race 3, the first of eight consecutive Claiming Crown races. The main track was sealed and sloppy throughout according to Equibase charts, although Fair Grounds announced on its broadcast feed that the main track would be rated "good" for the Jewel.

Wycoff's other Claiming Crown winner was **Anatolian**, a 4-year-old filly by **Not This Time**. She emerged as the strongest in a wall of late bidders (on a day when speed was not holding) to win the \$150,000 Tiara for distaffers in a 1 1/16 miles off-the-turfer in 1:46.11.

Anatolian's win by 2 1/4 lengths as the 3-2 favorite was the 22nd lifetime Claiming Crown victory for trainer Mike Maker, who extended his record as the event's winningest conditioner. James Graham rode.

Anatolian met her \$25,000 starter condition by only starting once that low, for a \$16,000 tag when breaking her maiden back in 2022. Since then she has kept far higher company, and twice won off-the-turfers over 10 furlongs at Saratoga and Churchill as a lead-in to her Claiming Crown engagement.

Trainer Sharp also doubled on the program. The 5-1 Runway **Magic** (**Runhappy**) took the \$150,000 Emerald, a 1 1/16 miles off-the-turfer, for owner Baron Racing Stables.

The 5-year-old hounded the pacemaker, took over midway on the far turn, then uncorked a long, steady drive to hold off a fresh challenger late to win by 1 1/2 lengths under Jaime Torres in 1:44.71.

Runway Magic was a former stakes competitor at age three but had swapped stables via the claim box four times since.

Claimed for \$50,000 out of a 12th-place effort when previously trained by Sharp (but for a different owner) at Oaklawn Jan. 22, the gelding didn't resurface until nine months

later for a \$20,000 tag at Delta Downs. He ran sixth in that start, but Sharp, reclaiming with the backing of Baron Racing, gambled by taking Runway Magic back for the heavily discounted price.

That move paid off five weeks later with a next-start win in the Claiming Crown.

In the \$150,000 Canterbury Tom Metzen Memorial that got washed off the grass at 5 1/2 furlongs, **Mischievous Rogue** (Into Mischief) closed widest with a well-timed burst to win by 3 1/2 lengths as the 17-10 favorite in 1:04.20 for owner Southern Comfort Stables, trainer William "Doug" Cowans, and jockey Luan Machado.

A 5-year-old gelding, Mischievous Rogue had spent the bulk of career (14 of 17 starts) racing on either turf or synthetic surfaces, and had never before raced on a wet track prior to showing a huge affinity for it with Saturday's convincing tally.

In the \$100,000 Glass Slipper for fillies and mares at one mile, it was Chris Hartman trainees one-two across the wire with 5-year-old mare **Xylophone** (**Tonalist**) orchestrating a 3 3/4-length victory at 7-2 odds for owner Joseph Longtin and jockey Mitchell Murrill.

The 5-year-old mare circled the field and drove to the lead unopposed a furlong out, stopping the timer in 1:39.02.

Although a number of familiar names graced the Claiming Crown winner's circle in this year's renewal, the \$100,000 Rapid Transit at six furlongs represented a big, breakthrough score for some less-heralded connections shipping in from FanDuel (formerly Fairmount Park).

Richiesonaroll (Gone Astray) prevailed by a neck at 15-1 odds in 1:10.64, lighting up the tote board as the Claiming Crown's highest-odds winner this year. The 3-year-old, three-time-claimed, Illinois-bred races for owner/trainer Jose G. Rodriguez, who has only been a licensed conditioner for 13 months.

The jockey for Richiesonaroll was Emmanuel (Manny) Giles, who had been badly injured in a three-horse spill at Hawthorne Race Course during his rookie season in 2021. Giles had to undergo several surgeries to repair hip and back damage, and missed 14 months of riding before getting back in the saddle earlier this season.

In the \$75,000 Ready's Rocket Express at six furlongs, **Caramel Chip** (**Midshipman**) stalked from fourth and picked off the pacemakers with a three-wide swoop at top of lane to win by 3 1/2 lengths as the 2.3-1second choice in a 1:10.25 clocking.

Jose D'Angelo trains for Bianco Stable, with Florent Geroux riding.

It was the 10th lifetime victory for the 5-year-old horse, and his seventh on the season. Caramel Chip was claimed for \$8,000 out of a Jan. 8 win at Gulfstream. **Cont.**



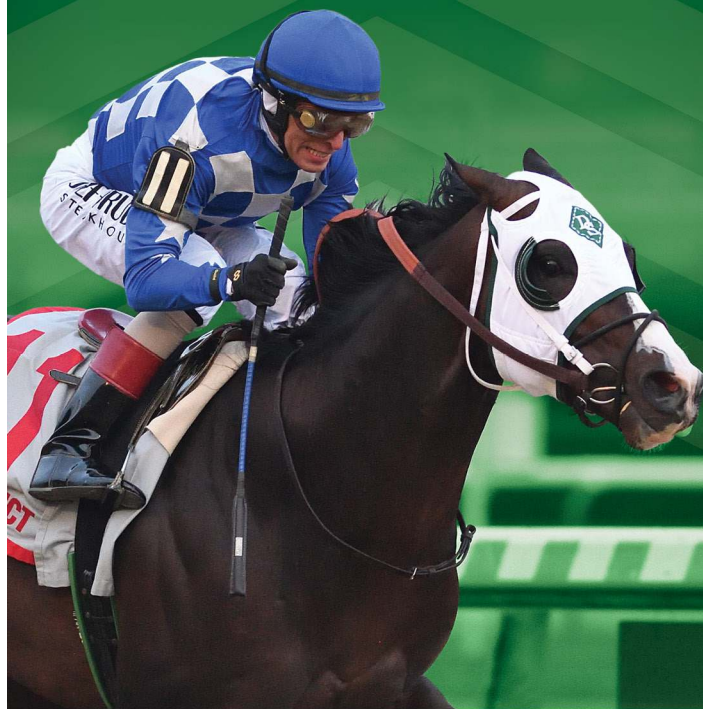

In the \$75,000 Iron Horse Kent Sterling Memorial at 1 1/16 miles, the 11-10 favorite **Time For Trouble** (English Channel) wrested control in the final hundred yards and prevailed by a head in 1:46.17.

The 6-year-old gelding had started for an \$8,000 claiming tag only once in his life, back in 2021. But that eligibility has enabled him to win back-to-back editions of the Iron Horse, both times over a sloppy surface.

Time For Trouble seemingly enjoyed a class edge on paper from running in Grade II and III stakes in Florida, Kentucky and New York earlier this season. Yet he made his connections, the partnership of Thorndale Stable and owner/trainer Jeff Hiles, sweat out a photo finish that was one of two wins on the day for jockey Graham.

"This is why we do what we do," said Hiles. "Three-sixteenths pole, we thought we didn't have a shot. And the emotions that you experience that last three-sixteenths of a race, that's exactly why we're in this...The adrenaline that kicks in, the emotions--you can't buy it."

PROGRAM TRADING GETS BACK ON TRACK WITH HOLLYWOOD DERBY WIN

Denied as the heavy favorite at Colonial Downs by the undefeated Integration (**Quality Road**) in the GIII New Kent County Virginia Derby last time out Sept. 9, **Program Trading (GB)** (Lope de Vega {Ire}) got back on track to take his fourth win in five starts in the GI Hollywood Derby. **Cont.**

A winner of his first three starts, the Chad Brown trainee reached the pinnacle two starts back with a narrow victory over **Webslinger** (**Constitution**) on a lucky on-the-turf weekend in Saratoga in the G1 Saratoga Derby Invitational Aug. 5. Given a rest after being run down late in that Virginia Derby, the Klaravich Stables entry shipped west to enjoy closing weekend at Del Mar and lined up opposite Webslinger once more as the 4-5 favorite.

From the far outer gate, Program Trading broke alongside his uncoupled stablemate **Redistricting** (GB) (**Kingman** {GB}) and the two Klaravich runners both took back off the early speed out of the chute as a trio of runners battled for first call. With just a single rival behind him, the favorite took his time through a :23.17 opening quarter as Charlie Appleby's Godolphin runner **Silver Knott** (GB) (Lope de Vega {Ire}) paced the group. A group of five runners raced bunched together up the backstretch while the pair of Saratoga Derby runners were several lengths off the speed but the pack began to come together into the far turn as the half went in :47.19.

Tipped out into the far turn, Program Trading picked it up under Flavien Prat as Redistricting blew the turn and was pulled up to his outside. Now suddenly with plenty of room to run, the bay quickly found himself third while three wide for the lead with a furlong to run. Webslinger fired a threatening shot close to home but Program Trading just held on to deny his rival once more by nearly the exact same margin.

"He was actually pretty relaxed before the race," said Prat. "We had a good trip; the pace was pretty fair. He relaxed well, he had a good turn of foot. Luckily there was a horse in front of me that bolted around the turn so I had a clear path. As soon as I asked him to make a run, he was there for me. I think he will still improve. He has run well every time."

With the win, trainer Chad Brown tied Charlie Whittingham

with a record four Hollywood Derbies while owner Klaravich Stable picked up a record third win in the closing-weekend feature.

Pedigree Note:

Program Trading is one of two winners from two to race out of a half-sister to G2 Park Hill S. winner and G1 QIPCO British Champions Fillies & Mares S. runner-up Silk Sari (GB) (Dalakhani {Ire}) and full-sister to Andrew Rosen's Fashion Fund (GB). His third dam was the 2002 champion 3-year-old filly in England, highlighted by a 4 1/2-length win in the G1 Irish 1000 Guineas. Dreamlike is the dam of the a 2-year-old filly by **Starspangledbanner** (Aus) and a yearling filly by Pinatubo (Ire) who sold for 260,000gns at Tattersalls October Yearling Sale and was exported to the United States. 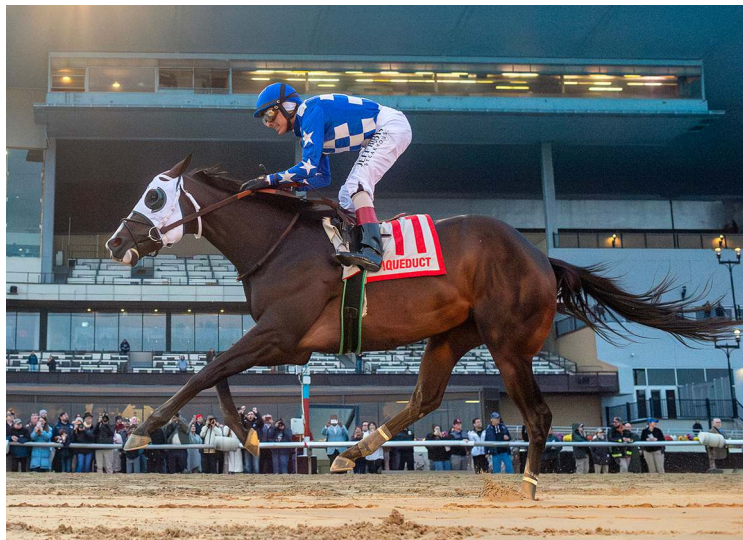

HOIST THE GOLD HOISTS THE TROPHY IN CIGAR

It may not have been a Grade I race this year, but the GII Cigar Mile H. came down to a horse with top-level class as **Hoist the Gold (Mineshaft)** sped gate-to-wire to hoist the trophy ahead of a talented, full field.

One of a pair of horses in the field coming back from last month's GI Breeders' Cup Sprint, Hoist the Gold took the GII Stoll Keenon Ogden Phoenix S. two starts back with a career-best 101 Beyer Speed Figure Oct. 6. Consistently raced throughout his career, the 4-year-old entered the gate Saturday for the 26th time with eight of his nine starts this year in graded-stakes races.

Slightly chilly on the board at 8-1, the Dream Team homebred broke from the outside but possessed all the early speed and quickly moved down to race between **Pipeline (Speightstown)** and the lightly-raced **Cascais** (Into Mischief). But as the field of 12 came out of the Aqueduct chute and onto the main track, Hoist the Gold was left alone on the lead under Hall of Fame jockey John Velazquez. Allowed to run free on the lead with only Pipeline keeping in touch, the colt zipped through fractions of :22.41 and :44.88 as the rest of the field struggled to keep the leader in their sights. Velazquez stayed motionless on his mount into the lane, not even drawing his stick until the furlong marker as Hoist the Gold drew away in hand with only a late-closing

Senor Buscador (**Mineshaft**) cutting into the winning margin late to make it a **Mineshaft**-sired exacta.

"What a race," said winning trainer Dallas Stewart. "Johnny [Velazquez] picked the right race for us. He told us at Breeders' Cup, the horse doesn't like dirt in his face. He said, 'just let me ride him the way I want--run him a mile at Aqueduct and he won't get beat.' He was 100 percent right. At the eighth pole, he kicked in another gear and got in front of them some more. He made that separation and that's the sign of a good horse. I just hate that they took the Grade I away, but he showed he's a good horse and we'll take the \$500,000 and head down the road."

Pedigree Note:

One of 61 stakes winner for the Lane's End stallion, Hoist the Gold is one of three winners from three runners out of the winning **Tapit** mare Tacit Approval, herself a \$320,000 2-year-old. Her other two winners were both fillies sired by Hill 'n' Dale's **Mucho Macho Man**. She foaled a Vekoma filly last year and reported another foal by **Mucho Macho Man**, this time a colt, earlier this year.

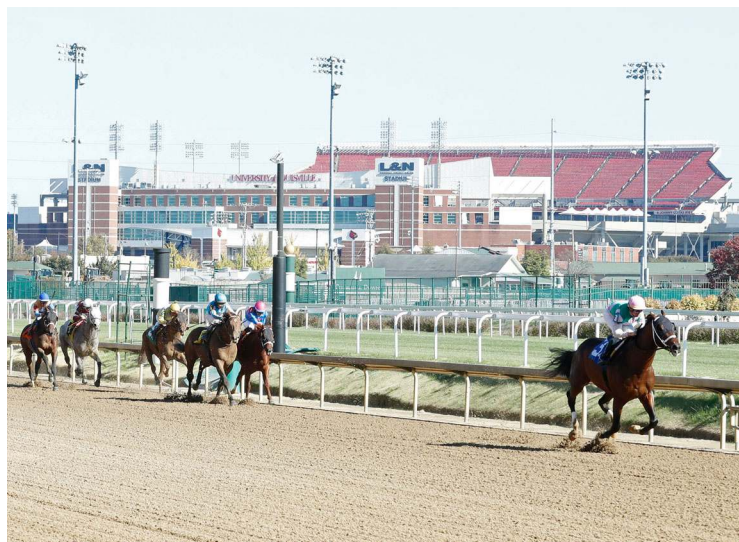

ONE IN A MULLION: FULL-BROTHER TO MANDALOUN 'LOOKS LIKE A CARTER-MET MILE TYPE OF HORSE'

With the team at Juddmonte still “floating on air” after a pair of wins on Breeders' Cup Saturday, the blue-blooded **Mullion** (c, 3, Into Mischief--Brooch, by Empire Maker) added to a banner weekend for the international operation with a '**TDN Rising Star**' performance at [Churchill Downs Nov. 5](#).

Sidelined for more than 14 months following a strong debut second--beaten just a nose--going six furlongs at Ellis Park in late August of his 2-year-old season, the full-brother to promoted GI Kentucky Derby winner and Juddmonte stallion **Mandaloun** proved well worth the wait with a jaw-dropping, 10-length maiden victory for trainer Brad Cox at second asking beneath the Twin Spires.

With nine breezes on the worktab for his comebacker, Mullion was favored at 3-5 while facing six rivals with first-time Lasix going a one-turn mile. He was bumped slightly from both sides at the start after exiting from post three. Unfazed by the minimal contact, he was keen in the early stages while hard held in second. Mullion tugged his way to the front as the half went up in :46.09 and traveled beautifully leaving the quarter pole. He put on a show from there down the stretch beneath a motionless Florent Geroux and stopped the timer in 1:34.69. He earned a 101 Beyer Speed Figure for the effort.

“As much time, patience and effort as we put into Mullion, we were expecting a big performance, but to do what he did was beyond our expectations off that kind of a layoff,” Juddmonte USA General Manager Garrett O'Rourke said. “It shows the talent that the horse has and hopefully he keeps it together now and can be a big player next year. He ran a 4 on the Ragozin Sheets, which is just off the charts.” **Cont.**

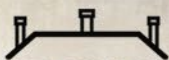

O'Rourke continued, "He injured himself after his first start--he had a soft-tissue injury, then he had a few other little issues--and we gave him all the time he needed. It was always something just holding him back after that--upper respiratory infection, sore shin, foot abscess, etc. I always felt like the talent was there and all the extra time was only going to be to his benefit. We knew how nice he was. He's a gorgeous-looking horse with the pedigree to match and Brad (Cox) had a very high opinion of him, even as a 2-year-old."

Mullion got back to business since earning his diploma with a four-furlong breeze in :48.80 (8/40) at Churchill Downs Nov. 26. He will winter at Fair Grounds, O'Rourke reports.

"All of the targets for him will be next year," O'Rourke said. "I just felt like we didn't need to be in a rush with him. Brad (Cox) agreed and he'll try and go through his conditions down at Fair Grounds, then we'll look about jumping him up in mid-to-late spring. He definitely looks like he could hopefully be a (Grade I) Carter-Met Mile type of horse."

Mullion was produced by the Empire Maker mare Brooch, a Juddmonte homebred and two-time group winner in Ireland. In addition to Mullion's aforementioned full-brother and fellow 'Rising Star' **Mandaloun**, the Into Mischief x Empire Maker cross is also responsible for Laurel River, who carried Juddmonte's famed green-and-pink silks to a win in the 2022 GII Pat O'Brien S. at Del Mar; and GSW & MGISP Occult.

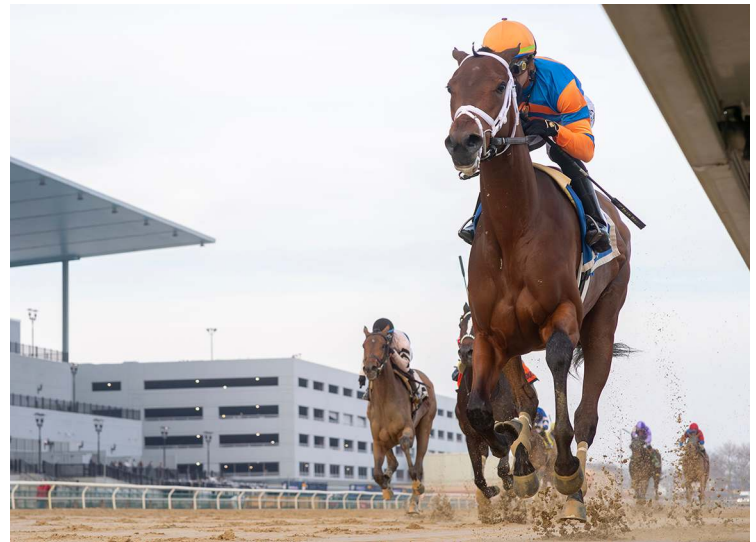

LIFE TALK ON THE ROAD TO THE OAKS WITH DEMOISELLE WIN

Dropping out of a pair of Grade I races, Repole Stables and Todd Pletcher's **Life Talk** (**Gun Runner**) earned 10 points on the Road to the Kentucky Oaks with an impressive win in the GII Demoiselle S.

Second by a head to future GISP Alys Beach (Omaha Beach) on debut, Life Talk came back with a 6 1/2-length win at second asking upstate in August. Unfortunately for daughter of **Gun Runner**, she then twice ran into likely 2-year-old filly champion Just F Y I (**Justify**) in both the GI Frizette S. (in which she finished third) and at last month's GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies where she was fourth.

Always bet like a winner Saturday, Life Talk broke at even money under Irad Ortiz, Jr. and enjoyed a rail-hugging trip as the field stacked up six wide to her outside into the first turn. **Most of All** (**Quality Road**) kept pace a half-length back as the fillies sorted themselves out but the field of eight remained tightly bunched as the favorite handled the tempo through a :24.10 opening quarter. Kept just off the rail over a main track listed as muddy, Life Talk cruised up front into the far turn, shook off Most of All passing the quarter pole and was left to contend

with a strong closing run from both **Shimmering Allure** (**Enticed**) and **Dolomite** (Unified) to her outside. Shimmering Allure got closest but Life Talk was up to the task and kicked away again into the final sixteenth, opening up to the wire to win in front-running fashion.

"Obviously, [the good break] was all Irad [Ortiz, Jr.] and Todd [Pletcher] coming up with a game plan," said Amelia Green, assistant to winning trainer Todd Pletcher. "With how the track's playing today, you need to get position and like Irad said, she warmed up good and he made the most of it. No one else wanted the lead, so he made the most of that situation. She seemed happy out there and did everything very professionally."

"It is great to see her back in this performance," added Irad Ortiz, Jr. "Because it was a great race [in the Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies], she ran so good to get beat last time. She got beat by three lengths and she come back maybe a little quick after that tough race, flies back all the way here but we have a great team, they all do a great job, the assistants and the trainer. She was one hundred percent."

Pedigree Note:

The 26th stakes winner and 19th graded winner for sire **Gun Runner**, Life Talk is out of a winning Bernardini mare who has produced two other winners from as many to race. As a broodmare sire, Darley's late stallion Bernardini has sired the dams of 82 stakes winner. The dam, a half-sister to GSW Indian Firewater (Indian Charlie), saw her yearling **Maclean's Music** filly bring \$140,000 in January's Keeneland Horses of All Ages Sale while her weaning Bolt d'Oro filly brought a final bid of \$250,000 last month at Keeneland November. Touchy Feely is due on a cover to Cyberknife in 2024.

Stop us if you've heard this a time or a thousand. Horses trained by Chad Brown figure tough in the GI Matriarch S. on closing day of the Bing Crosby Meet at Del Mar. Undisputable though that is--he has, after all, sent out the winner all but once since 2017--Harris Farms homebred **Closing Remarks** (Vronsky) will look to have the final say Sunday afternoon.

The chestnut has yet to strike in three tries at the top level, though she was runner-up in the 2021 Del Mar Oaks while finishing just ahead of one of the Brown representatives she'll be facing here. Closing Remarks is, however, a three-time graded winner over the one-mile distance of the Matriarch and has recorded two of her four victories at the graded level over

the Jimmy Durante turf course, including this year's GII Yellow Ribbon S. and GII John C. Mabee S. going slightly farther. Fourth in the GII Rodeo Drive S. over a 10-furlong journey that likely finds her out, she bounced back to defeat **Queen Goddess** (Empire Maker) and **Hamwood Flier (Ire)** (Kodiac {GB}) in Santa Anita's one-mile GII Goldikova S. Nov. 5. Juan Hernandez will need to work out a trip from the widest gate, but there is plenty of speed on paper and she should be coming at them late.

The Brown-trained **Fluffy Socks (Slumber {GB})** was third in that aforementioned Del Mar Oaks, having won the local GIII Jimmy Durante S. at two. The Head of Plains homebred won the GII Distaff Turf Mile at Churchill on seasonal debut May 6, but has since dropped three straight, including a third in the Listed Athenia S. at Aqueduct Oct. 27.

Whitebeam (GB) (Caravaggio) is the likely Matriarch favorite after downing stablemate In Italian (GB) (Dubawi {Ire}) in the GI Diana S. going nine furlongs July 15. The Juddmonte homebred has revenge on her mind, having finished an alibi-free fourth to stable companion Gina Romantica (Into Mischief) in the GI First Lady S. at Keeneland Oct. 7.

Sunday's co-featured GIII Cecil B. DeMille S. lacks a marquee horse, and its winner could also come from a high draw. Unplaced behind Mission Beach (**Curlin**) and Wine Me Up (Vino Rosso) in a pair of main-track sprints, **Stay Hot (Summer Front)** looked like a new horse when graduating first time turf and first time long at Santa Anita Oct. 7 and exits a 10th in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf. **Lord Bullington** (Lord Nelson) maps to have a sweet run behind what should be a generous tempo as he looks to add to his victory in the Qatar Gold Mile Nov. 4, while D J Stable's **Deadpan** (Distorted Humor) looks to build on a neck maiden victory over the Keeneland turf course Oct. 28.

Having debuted Apr. 22 in the maiden race which yielded one of Europe's top colts in River Tiber (Ire) (**Wootton Bassett {GB}**), the grey daughter of **Calyx** hit the board one more time in four starts in Ireland before moving from the Ken Condon yard to Philip D'Amato in the States. She won her US debut by a half-length Sept. 8 over this turf course before running sixth in Santa Anita's Oct. 8 GIII Surfer Girl S.

Breaking from what would've been a ground-losing trip, she quickly took command from the outside to clear rivals and set all the pace to the top of the final stretch. Roused for more as the closers inched closer, she responded well to the right-hand urging to hold off Lady de Berry and Yatta by a length.

"I think the turf course looks a little speedy today. This filly broke good and Juan (Hernandez) just took the initiative and that was the winning move," said D'Amato. "She had won impressively at Del Mar (this summer) then we took her to Santa Anita and ran her in a stake and she got wiped out, never had a free run. But today she got in the clear and ran very well."

Hailing from the family of G1 **Saxon Warrior** Coolmore Prix Saint Alary-placed Olendon (Fr) (Le Havre {Ire}), Zona Verde has a placed elder sibling as well as a yearling half-brother Cayman Tai (Ire) (Earthlight {Ire}) and a 2023 half-brother by Waldgeist (GB). She is the third black-type and Graded winner for her young sire from his first crop.

Twelve months ago, Dr B caught a rain-affected Aqueduct main track and led nine others on a merry chase to post her first career graded victory in the GIII Go For Wand S. While Irad Ortiz, Jr. was in the irons last year, the leading jockey opted for favored Good Sam (Good Samaritan), and it was a positive and aggressive ride from the front by Jose Lezcano that paved a way to a successful title defense Saturday afternoon.

Driven away from the inside stall, Dr B found her way to the front with a minimum of fuss and got the opening quarter-mile in :22.56 while racing inside of the more physically imposing Gerrymander (Into Mischief). The two continued to match strides through a half in :45.06, and while Gerrymander tried to pour the pressure into the front-runner leaving the three-eighths, she began to retreat, leaving Dr B with an imposing lead turning for home. She opened up on the lead in upper stretch and the result was never in doubt, as Tizzy in the Sky and Venti Valentine filled the minors.

Given a good rest after winning last year, Dr B was a well-beaten fourth behind champion Goodnight Olive (Ghostzapper) in the GII Bed O'Roses S. June 17 and ran into the buzzsaw named Echo Zulu (Gun Runner) when a distant second in Saratoga's GII Honorable Miss S. July 26. Fifth to that rival in the GI Ballerina S. in the Saratoga mud Aug. 26, the bay was a wide fourth against the boys in the Sept. 23 Parx Mile S.

"To hold her form that long, it's just great that she's still maintaining this level of competition to be able to compete at this level," said winning trainer Butch Reid, Jr. "She's just been an iron mare from the day we got her and has held that so far."

LONGTIME MARYLAND TRAINER RONALD CARTWRIGHT DIES AT 93

Ronald "Ronnie" C. Cartwright, a Maryland-based trainer who conditioned multiple graded-stakes winners throughout his career, passed away Nov. 11 at the age of 93.

A steeplechase jockey who then trained from the late 1960's through 2005, Cartwright won almost 700 races and his horses earned more than \$13 million. His graded-stakes winners included Mz. Zill Bear (Salutely), Castelets (King's Bishop), Miss Slewpy (Slewpy), Palliser Bay (Frosty the Snowman) and Mymet (Mehmet).

"I've been in this for 60 years and will miss it," Cartwright said soon after he retired in 2005. "It has been a great run. I've had a really good life and enjoyed this very much. I had a lot of nice horses and had a good time."

"Ronnie was a horsemen's horseman--very old school," said Maryland-based breeder/owner Jay Williamson. "He did it the right way, and he had the right owners. When horses need time off, they got time off. That's tough to do in today's environment. He was an all-around good person. Everybody like Ronnie."

A Celebration of Life for Cartwright will be held at Laurel Park on the first floor of the clubhouse Dec. 19 at 11:30 a.m.

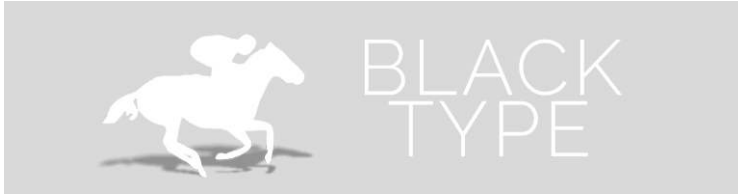

Looking for the fillies' series sweep, as was Bentornato in the colts' division, R Harper Rose was the odds-on pop and led her rivals through lively splits of :23.19 and :46.78. Asked to take up the chase at the three-furlong point, Honey Dijon began to zero in on R Harper Rose and drew even at the eighth pole, then kicked on nicely to win clear.

"I was really happy to see her be able to stretch out like that. ALMOST 30 MILLION GUINEAS SPENT ON FOALS AT TATTS BUT FIGURES TAKE A DIP

Tattersalls chairman Edmond Mahony acknowledged the weakness of the lower end of the market as the Tattersalls December Foal Sale concluded on Saturday with a 125,000gns Showcasing (GB) filly leading the way.

Almost 30 million gns was spent on foals this week at Tattersalls while Friday saw the most expensive foal sold so far this year--a **St Mark's Basilica (Fr)** filly--in Europe and North America at 575,000gns.

However, the aggregate of 29,842,902gns was down 15% on last year while the average dropped 6% to 44,608gns. The clearance rate was more or less the same, dropping 1% to 75%, while the median dropped 19% to 21,000gns.

Mahony commented, "Sustained demand for quality foals has been the feature of the four days of selling at Europe's premier foal sale. In addition to the highest price for a foal in Europe and North America this year there have been a record 29 foals sold for 200,000 guineas or more and a healthy diversity of buyers in all sectors of the market. The cream of the British and Irish foal crop has attracted buyers in abundance not only from Britain and Ireland but also from throughout Europe and the Gulf region as well as China, Japan and America. The overseas demand has had a significant impact on trade which, although not matching last year's record levels, has remained robust with the exception of the lower end of the market which we must all recognise has been challenging." They are also successful owners and breeders. Theresa Marnane's yellow-and-black silks have been carried by a number of good horses, including the G1 Racing Post Trophy winner Palace Episode and most recently the G3 Marble Hill S. winner Givemethebeatboys (Ire). She was the leading owner of two-year-olds in France on a number of occasions, with the victories invariably coming with inexpensively bought youngsters selected by Con and Amy Marnane.

It was the 2017 G3 Albany S. winner Different League (Fr) who sparked perhaps the most memorable celebrations when beating subsequent multiple Group 1 winner Alpha Centauri (Ire) at Royal Ascot.

Bought as a foal for €8,000, the daughter of Dabirsim (Fr) won her first three starts for the Marnanes and was then placed in both the G1 Prix Morny and G1 Cheveley Park S before being

sold for 1.5 million gns to Coolmore and Peter Brant.

Different League's Royal Ascot victory came four years after Theresa, a solicitor by trade, had undergone cancer treatment for the first time, and her success on racing's biggest stage was

enjoyed wildly, both on the day and with a huge party at the family's Tipperary home later that summer. The couple celebrated their 30th wedding anniversary in May, and they were rarely seen apart: Theresa's warm and ever-smiling presence perfectly complementing her husband's natural exuberance.

"I met Theresa 43 years ago at Danny O'Connell's, when she was riding out there," said Con Marnane on Saturday.

"We've just been overwhelmed by the support of everyone in the racing and breeding industry, the breeze-up consignors, the trainers, owners and jockeys. She was a very special person to so many people. Everyone loved her."

Conroy commented, "Let's hope she is a top lot next year! She is a lovely physical, I like the stallion--he is a very good sire of fillies. She is a really good individual, very balanced, a very good walker. She is a Book 1 individual, and from a young operation so good to see young breeders having a good result."

The sale capped off a solid day's trade for Daymark Stud with four foals selling for 263,000gns.

"It is a sigh of relief! It has been incredible, we are very lucky, we are a very small operation," the stud's Josh Cameron said. "I have done every hand walk with every single foal and some days I think 'Oh maybe I should get someone to help', but I do think it helps the foals in the end. I am not sure my girlfriend has loved living with me over the last eight weeks!"

"But we got there in the end and thanks to the little syndicate who own the mare Messalina for their support. Two mates bought her out of Archie Watson's yard and sent her to me, and just said, 'See how you get on!' Her first foal by Havana Grey (GB), who we sold here last year for 46,000 guineas, is going to Kevin Philippart De Foy and this year she has produced this amazing Showcasing filly, who has not missed a beat all week. She is a real athlete and for someone like Flash to buy her is unreal."

OVERPASS CONTINUES ASCOT

Eight months after shocking the Western Australian racing community with a brilliant front-running ride in The Quokka, **Overpass (Aus)** (Vancouver {Aus}) returned to Ascot to claim another sprinting feature.

Settling down outside the leader after beginning strongly, the 5-year-old gelding was given a daring steer by Josh Parr, hooking out to the middle part of the home straight to complete the 300-metres standing between him and the A\$1.5 million in prize-money on offer.

Bar a fleeting moment where **Oscar's Fortune (Aus)** (Rich Enuff {Aus}) emerged from the ruck to issue his challenge, it was apparent from a long way out that he was all but guaranteed Group 1 glory.

His incredible record in sprint races has amassed him over A\$5 million in prize-money, an astonishing effort for a horse that competed in a race for the 25th time on Saturday. The victory provides his Woodside Park-based stallion, Vancouver, with his maiden Group 1.

Overpass is not yet done with Western Australia, with connections announcing post-race he will be back for another run at The Quokka, now worth A\$5 million.

Pedigree Notes

One of 10 stakes winners for Vancouver, he was bred by Corumbene Stud.

Making his way through the sales ring on two occasions, Overpass was passed in for A\$140,000 at the Inglis Australian Easter Yearling Sale in 2020, and then sold to Darby Racing and William Johnson Bloodstock (FBAA) for A\$75,000 at Round 2 of that COVID changed sale.

He is one of five winners (from as many to race) for the two-time winner Walkway (Aus) (Exceed And Excel {Aus}) who hails from the family of one of the best horses Western Australia has produced--the mighty Northerly (Aus) (Serheed).

In mid-September foaling a full-sister to Overpass after missing to Shalaa (Ire) the previous season, Walkway has a yet-to-be named 2-year-old colt by Capitalist (Aus) whilst Gerald Ryan and Sterling Alexiou-trained 3-year-old Inca Trail (Aus) (Menari {Aus}) who won a Goulburn maiden in October. **Cont. p12**
