## BUSY SATURDAY MORNING FOR KENTUCKY DERBY AND OAKS WORKERS

It was an action-packed Saturday morning at Churchill Downs for GI Kentucky Derby and GI Kentucky Oaks workers.

At 5:15 a.m., the Brad Cox-trained duo of GI Arkansas Derby winner **Cyberknife** (**Gun Runner**) and GII Twinspires.com Louisiana Derby runner-up and **'TDN Rising Star' Zozos** (**Munnings**) worked six furlongs together in 1:11.20 (1/4) and 1:11.40 (2/4), respectively. At 7:30 a.m., GIII Stonestreet Lexington S. winner **Tawny Port** (Pioneerof the Nile), with newly named jockey Ricardo Santana, Jr., worked five furlongs for Cox in 1:01.60 (30/57).

"There's a lot of excitement leading into these final Derby works," Cox said. "You start to get a little anxious as the days near closer to the Derby. Things went very smooth this morning."

The Kenny McPeek tandem of GI Toyota Blue Grass S. runner-up and 'TDN Rising Star' Smile Happy (Runhappy) and GIII Jeff Ruby Steaks S. winner Tiz the Bomb (Hit It a Bomb) worked a half-mile together in :48 (28/130).

"I like that this is a home game for us," McPeek said. "Both Brian [Hernandez, Jr.] and Corey [Lanerie] have been around this oval all their lives, and both are solid journeyman riders. Both Corey and Brian are due a signature horse, so maybe one of them's got it this week." **Cont. p3** 

#### **ACTING OUT TOPS KEENELAND APRIL SALE**

Acting Out (Blame), who most recently caused a 6-1 upset of the Carousel S. at Oaklawn Park Apr. 2 (video), was hammered down to Bill Farish, acting as agent for his parents Will and Sarah, to lead the way at Friday's Keeneland April Horses of Racing Age Sale held following the conclusion of the closing-day program at the racetrack a handful of steps up the hill.

Previously trained by Hall of Famer Jerry Hollendorfer for the ownership group of Sherman Racing Inc., Zivka Akin and Robert Hawkins, Acting Out won three of 10 starts in California and was placed in the Camila Urso S. sprinting on the turf at Golden Gate last year, but switched to the Arkansas oval this term and was a wire-to-wire allowance winner Mar. 11 before besting heavily favored 'TDN Rising Star' Frank's Rockette (Into Mischief) in the Carousel. Todd Pletcher breezed the trio of GII Wood Memorial S. winner Mo Donegal (Uncle Mo) (four furlongs in :48.60) (55/130); and GI Curlin Florida Derby runner-up and 'TDN Rising Star' Charge It (Tapit) and Louisiana Derby third Pioneer of Medina (Pioneerof the Nile), who worked a half-mile together in :47.40 (9/130).

"From here, we'll do the usual stuff--like visiting the gate and galloping. We'll be galloping up to the Derby," Pletcher said.

Other Derby horses on the worktab Saturday included: Arkansas Derby runner-up Barber Road (Race Day) (four furlongs in :48.80) (67/130); GII Lambholm South Tampa Bay Derby winner Classic Causeway (Giant's Causeway) (six furlongs in 1:13.20) (3/4); and GII Rebel S. winner **Un Ojo** (Laoban) (four furlongs in :47.60) (14/130). Happy Jack (Oxbow), a distant third in the GI Runhappy Santa Anita Derby, covered a mile in 1:39.60 (1/1) at Keeneland. Florida Derby winner White Abarrio (Race Day) breezed a half-mile in :48.28 between races during an impromptu workout on Saturday afternoon's program at Gulfstream Park. "Wow. That's all I can say is 'wow,'" trainer Saffie Joseph, Jr. said. "He worked super."

Four Kentucky Oaks candidates had their final works Saturday morning at Churchill Downs: Bourbonette Oaks heroine Candy Raid (Candy Ride {Arg}) (four furlongs in :48.80) (67/130); GI Central Bank Ashland S. runner-up and 'TDN Rising Star' Cocktail Moments (Uncle Mo) (five furlongs in 1:00.80) (15/57); unbeaten GII Gulfstream Park Oaks winner Kathleen O. (Upstart) (four furlongs in :47.80) (20/130); and GIII Gazelle S. heroine **Nostalgic** (Medaglia d'Oro) (four furlongs in :48.60) (55/130).

"She's not necessarily a strong morning worker," Hall of Fame trainer Shug McGaughey said of Kathleen O. "So, we're very pleased with what we saw today. I'm excited. We're excited. We got through today and we know she always shows up on race day. This morning was right up there with some of her best. We're glad to be back in Kentucky with her and we're thinking with her running style she'll appreciate the longer stretch here [at Churchill Downs]."

Desert Dawn (Cupid), upset winner of the GII Santa Anita Oaks, worked five furlongs in 1:00.60 (19/53) at Santa Anita Saturday.

She was consigned by Taylor Made Sales Agency as hip 23. "She is a six-furlong specialist, so she will [continue] sprinting and hopefully be back here to [race in] the [GII] Thoroughbred Club of America S. in the fall," said Farish. "We hope we can make some of the purchase price back [by racing her] before retiring her at the end of the year.

"When the catalog came out, she was one that just stood out in the catalog," Farish added. "When we saw her--she looked fabulous, a beautiful mare, really correct. She looks like one who would have nice babies. [Her pedigree] goes back to a Stuart Janney III family, and we hope to breed her one day."

Acting Out is out of a half-sister to Janney III's Grade III-winning turf mare Onus, also a daughter of Blame, and to the dam of the promising 3-year-old multiple graded-placed turf colt Limited Liability (Kitten's Joy), who flew home to win a grass allowance at Keeneland Apr. 16. The stakes-placed third dam Meghan's Joy (A.P. Indy) has left behind the likes of graded winners Ironicus (Distorted Humor), On Leave (War Front), Norumbega (Tiznow), Hunting (Coronado's Quest) and Quiet Harbor (Silver Deputy).

The ELiTE-consigned **Blue Devil** (Uncle Mo) was the most coveted of the male racing prospects, selling to Rocket Ship Racing LLC, agent/William Denzik for \$260,000. The 3-year-old was offered as hip 32 on behalf of his previous owners SF Racing, Starlight Racing, Madaket Stables, Siena Farm and Golconda Stable and trainer Rodolphe Brisset and made a favorable impression in his lone racetrack appearance to date, missing by a neck in a six-furlong maiden over the Turfway synthetic Apr. 2. The same connections were also represented by **Blackadder** (Quality Road) (hip 89), who was purchased by Claiborne Farm, agent, for \$250,000. Hailing from a Stone Farm family, the colt holds an entry for the GI Preakness S. by virtue

of his victory in the El Camino Real Derby Feb. 12.

Another Brisset trainee made his way down to the sales pavilion only hours after winning his maiden at the track a few hours earlier. Summer Anthem (Temple City) was offered by Gainesway, agent, as hip 104, and was snapped up by Kirk Wycoff's Three Diamonds Farm for \$150,000 to continue his career. The 3-year-old gelding proved a tenacious winner of Friday's fourth race in a meet-fastest clocking for the 8 1/2furlongs on turf.

Other offerings to have won during the meet and sold Friday were the I.C. Racing-consigned **Shannon** (Nyquist) (hip 100), who broke her maiden at 24-1 in an Apr. 22 turf sprint and was purchased for \$240,000 by Hidden Brook, agent; and Atras (Astern {Aus}) (hip 102), a 3-year-old gelding who graduated by 2 1/2 lengths in an Apr. 23 turf sprint and fetched \$150,000 from Clay Scherer.

As reported earlier, a share in Airdrie Stud's Upstart sold for \$450,000 as the final hip up for bidding.

For the single-session auction, a total of 58 horses were reported as sold for \$5,349,000, good for an average of \$92,224 and a median price of \$50,000. The 2021 event saw 37 horses sell for \$2,440,000 for an average of \$65,946 and a \$45,000 median.

"From start to finish of the sale, the energy was strong and the enthusiasm at every level was really encouraging," Keeneland Vice President of Sales Tony Lacy said. "Joining the race meet and sale and having them on one day really, really worked. The atmosphere was incredible with a real buzz. That's something we want to replicate and build on not just for the April Sale, but all sales moving forward."

Added Keeneland's Director of Sales Cormac Breathnach: "It's so important to us to have the brick-and-mortar event built around the race meet and have the support we got up front from so many consignors and owners with really good horses. That first group--the 73 horses that were initially entered--really turned heads. We are incredibly grateful to them. That feeds into the race meet, and people see a chance to cash in or a

chance to buy. And to be able to accommodate those horses that had run well during the meet in the sale showed our flexibility. To see it all come together is very rewarding."

Keeneland will welcome buyers and sellers back to Lexington for its benchmark September Yearling Sale Sept. 12-23.

## KEENELAND SPRING MEET CONCLUDES WITH RECORD HANDLE

Keeneland closed its 2022 Spring Meet Friday with all-sources handle in excess of \$219 million to establish an all-time meet wagering record for the track, and a third consecutive season of record handle. The Lexington oval offered record average daily purses of \$1.147 million, attracting an average of 9.1 starters per race.

"This Spring Meet was unmatched in many measures, most of all the fact that everyone seemed to revel in the energy of having fans back in full force on race days," said Keeneland President and CEO Shannon Arvin. "Keeneland is a special place because of the support we receive from the Central Kentucky community, our horsemen, handicappers, sponsors, fans and employees. This spring season sets the stage for a huge racing

year that continues with the Fall Meet in October and the return of the Breeders' Cup World Championships on Nov. 4-5."

All-sources wagering (not including whole-card simulcasting at Keeneland) for the Spring Meet totaled \$219,284,979, eclipsing the previous record of \$181,009,626 set during last year's 17-day Fall Meet. The total represents a 33.16% increase over last spring's record \$164,680,229. Average daily all-sources handle was \$14,618,999.

A number of individual handle records were also set during the Spring Meet. Record single-day all-sources handle of \$28,137,728 was set on GI Toyota Blue Grass Day, Saturday, Apr. 9, which featured 11 races including five graded stakes. Wagering on the 11-race card the following Saturday, Apr. 16, totaled \$27,304,001 to be the second-highest single-day handle in Keeneland history. Record Pick 4 and Pick 5 wagering also was realized on Apr. 16. The Pick 4 handled a record \$1,357,298, exceeding the previous mark of \$1,065,002 set on Blue Grass Day 2018. The Pick 5 handled a record \$1,539,098 to surpass the \$1,485,090 established on 2021's Blue Grass card.

On-track wagering this spring totaled \$16,190,832, up 75.52% from last spring's \$9,224,273 when COVID-19 limited attendance for the meet. Average daily on-track wagering this spring was \$1,079,389.

The Keeneland Turf Pick 3, a wager on the final three turf races each day that was inaugurated last fall, handled a total of \$1,543,399, for an average of \$128,617 per day.



fractions of :22.92 and :46.30 as the field of four bunched up. Heavily favored GI Santa Anita H. winner Express Train took a run at him at the top of the stretch, but Stilleto Boy had plenty left in the tank and won going away.

Winner of the 2021 Iowa Derby for trainer Doug Anderson, he brought \$420,000 later that month from Steve Moger at the Fasig-Tipton July Horses of Racing Age Sale. He hit the board in four Grade I races since, including third-place finishes in the GI Pegasus World Cup Invitational S. Jan. 29 and the Santa Anita H. Mar. 5. last time.

"I was looking for a horse and he had just won the lowa Derby," Moger said. "I liked the way he looked and I watched his races and I said, 'Let's take a shot.' I didn't even tell [brother and trainer] Ed [Moger] we got him until after the deal was done.

'By the way, I'm sending you a horse!' He ran great today and this puts him over a million dollars in earnings, so it's pretty exciting."

Ed Moger added, "He beat a good horse today. We've been thinking about the [GI] Hollywood Gold Cup [at Santa Anita May 30] as long as he ran good here."

#### **Pedigree Notes:**

The wildly popular Shackleford, a flashy big-blazed chestnut and the 2011 GI Preakness S. winner, got the eighth American graded stakes winner of his career here. The Forestry stallion has a total of 19 black-type winners. His first foals hit the ground in 2014 from his time at Darby Dan in Kentucky. Shackleford was sold to the Korea Racing Authority in 2020 prior to the breeding season.

Remarkably, like Stilleto Boy, Shackleford's Promises Fulfilled, winner of the GI H. Allen Jerkens and four other graded stakes, is out of a Marquetry mare. The late Marquetry is the broodmare sire of 50 stakes winners, two of them out of Stilleto Boy's dam, Rosie's Ransom. Marquetry, who passed away in 2013 at Old Friends, originally stood at Central Kentucky's Vinery, then owned by Ben P. Walden, Jr. and his wife, Elaine, as did Rosie's Ransom's damsire, Red Ransom. The two stallions-one a chrome-splashed chestnut and the other a mostly plain

bay with just a little white on his face--had paddocks located near each other.

Rosie's Ransom has produced nine winners from as many starters. All of her runners have made starts in the double digits, with four of them in the 42- to 54-start range. Her only foal to live since Stilleto Boy is a yearling colt by Gormley named Irish Ransom. Stilleto Boy's bottom line traces directly to the great matriarch Myrtlewood, herself a granddaughter of foundation mare Frizette, through Myrtlewood's Durazna branch.

Blue Stripe (Arg), a four-time winner in her native country, led by a win in the G1 Criadores last May, made up for a no-show seventh while making her U.S. debut in the GI Breeders' Cup Distaff with a good-looking win here.

A ground-saving fourth heading into the clubhouse turn here, Blue Stripe sat in a perfect spot just behind the leaders down the backstretch. Under a ride passing the three-eighths pole, she was guided out widest of all as they turned for home and came charging down the center to get the money.

"When the filly came to me last year, six months before the Breeders' Cup, I kept in contact with the trainer, so the trainer kind of gave me all the updates on her so it was easy," winning trainer Marcelo Polanco said. "Plus, she's so easy, she's amazing." He added, "It's a dream for everybody, winning these kinds of races at Santa Anita, it's amazing."

#### **Pedigree Notes:**

The Argentinean farm Haras Abolengo has made quite a splash in U.S. racing. Probably best known stateside for breeding impactful Lane's End sire Candy Ride (Arg), they also bred and stand Equal Stripes (Arg), sire of Blue Stripe (Arg). Equal Stripes is by Candy Stripes, damsire of Candy Ride and also sire of U.S. Horse of the Year Invasor (Arg) and U.S. champion Leroidesanimaux (Brz), in turn sire of U.S. Classic winner Animal Kingdom, as well as others who won at the highest levels of American racing.

Equal Stripes has been in the top 10 on the Argentinean sires list since 2010. While records may not be complete, he has sired at least 58 stakes winners and 47 graded winners in both hemispheres combined.

In a rare twist, Americans may be even more familiar with Blue Stripe's dam than with her sire. Four years before she produced Blue Stripe, Blues for Sale (Arg) produced Blue Prize (Arg) (Pure Prize), a MG1SW in Argentina who came stateside to win the GI Breeders' Cup Distaff, two editions of the GI Juddmonte Spinster S., and a number of other graded races. She sold for a sale-topping \$5 million to Larry Best at the 2019 Fasig-Tipton November sale. Blue Prize now lives at Taylor Made, where she produced a now-yearling filly by Into Mischief and an Instagrand colt this year. Blues for Sale's most recent foal is a 2-year-old filly named Blue Coast (Arg) (Suggestive Boy {Arg}).



Broodmare sire Not For Sale (Arg), a Caro (Ire)-line stallion, has 15 stakes winners out of his daughters, not only in the U.S. and Argentina, but also in places like Japan, where Danon Fantasy (Jpn) (Deep Impact {Jpn}) was champion 2-year-old filly in 2018.

The popular Cal-bred Brickyard Ride, a well-beaten second as the heavy favorite in this race last year, made it four wins in a row in dominating fashion. The 2021 GII San Carlos S. winner entered off three straight stakes wins versus state-breds, including runaway scores going a mile in the Tiznow Feb. 21 and 6 1/2 furlongs in the grassy Sensational Star S. last time Mar. 20. The 2-5 favorite quickly established command over his three rivals, was traveling nicely approaching the quarter pole and never gave them a chance in the stretch en route to a facile victory.

"He just keeps getting better and better," winning trainer Craig Lewis said. "We're going race to race, but our long-range plan is to be at Keeneland in November [for the Breeders' Cup]. He's been showing so much versatility though, we don't know if he

should go in the Sprint, the Turf Sprint or the Mile. A lot of options, we just hope he stays as good as he is now."

#### **Pedigree Notes:**

One might think, with just 80 lifetime starters from four small crops to race, that MGSW & MGISP Clubhouse Ride might have a career-topping runner with a MGSW like Brickyard Ride. While that may eventually be the case, the honor at present goes to Warren's Showtime, who is not only a MGSW, but is also GISP, and has won or placed in 21 black-type events compared to Brickyard Ride's eight. The graded-winning pair are two of the Candy Ride (Arg) sire's three stakes winners and additional four stakes horses. Clubhouse Ride stands in California at Legacy Ranch.

Also standing in California, approximately a three-hour drive from Clubhouse Ride, is Gray's Farm's Southern Image, who has a few hundred more foals in his 13 racing crops and has exactly one North American stakes winner out of any of his daughters: Brickyard Ride. The winner's dam has a 2-year-old filly named Annie's Conquest (Conquest Farenheit) and a yearling full-sister to Brickyard Ride. She was bred back to Clubhouse Ride for 2022.



The filly was far back in her first two starts over conventional dirt at Churchill Downs before breaking her maiden Dec. 10 over the synthetic at Turfway Park to conclude her juvenile season. The chestnut began her year with a close runner-up effort Jan. 8 at the venue on first-time Lasix and finished third in a stacked rendition of the Valdale S. Feb. 12 and most recently overcame a bump at the start of a local allowance Apr. 16 to draw clear by four lengths.

Allowed to settle after the break here, the 7-2 third choice tracked from last early and quickly made up ground from that rail spot coming into the lane. Under right-hand urging from Emma-Jayne Wilson, Beautiful Empire kicked into high gear in the final furlong to clear rivals and win by 1 1/2 lengths over Aubrieta. Diabolic rounded out the Casse trifecta. The time for the six-furlongs was only just off the track record set by the venerable Pink Lloyd (Old Forester).

"I was actually angling to go to the outside, and the rail kind of opened up," said Wilson post race. "Good horses, when you ask them, they run. And that's exactly what happened. She's been running lights out the whole winter. She was primed for a big effort. It was a big effort last time and she stepped up again today."

The victress is her dam's first black-type earner and second winner from three to race. She has a 2-year-old half-brother by American Pharoah. Humor Me Colonel is expecting a foal by Munnings this season. She is also the fourth stakes winner for her young sire (by Pioneerof the Nile). #### **COROEBUS IS THE ANSWER**

A Godolphin-Charlie Appleby one-two in Saturday's G1 QIPCO 2000 Guineas at Newmarket seemed highly plausible, but as the dust settled on the sun-blessed Rowley Mile it was Coroebus (Ire) (Dubawi (Ire)) and not Native Trail (GB) (Oasis Dream (GB)) who held the Moulton Paddocks bragging rights.

Despite arriving here in his stablemate's shadow, the G3 Autumn S. winner received due respect and support at 5-1 attempting to navigate from the one draw on the far side. As the 5-4 favourite charged down the other wing with William Buick animated, Coroebus was just gliding under James Doyle and no sooner had he been delivered to lead approaching the furlong pole was the result settled. Hard as Native Trail tried to bridge the gap, it was 3/4 of a length at the line as Ballydoyle's Luxembourg (Ire) (Camelot {GB}) put up an ideal Derby trial, 1 1/2 lengths away in third.

"At halfway, I thought 'this is all going pretty well' and I just had to keep patient," the winning rider said. "It was no surprise to see William there at the finish--I had thought of saying to him going down 'I'll be seeing you at the other end' and that was how it happened. He travelled incredibly strong throughout and there's no reason he won't improve from today, as he was quite exuberant through the race." Cont. p2

#### **ALL TO PLAY FOR**

After the decision to avoid the stress of a G1 QIPCO 1000 Guineas examination for Inspiral (GB) (Frankel {GB}), the latest renewal of the Newmarket Classic has become open season for up-and-comers in the miling division. Very few of the 14 left in the race can be safely discounted and with a filly unproven beyond six furlongs at the head of the market, it is fair to say that anything can happen in this one. There were shades of Ravinella (Mr. Prospector) in the way Ballydoyle's number one and 'TDN Rising Star' Tenebrism (Caravaggio) went through the G1 Cheveley Park S. here in September, but there is a definite question mark over the mile for her and the performance of Flotus (Ire) (Starspangledbanner (Aus)) here on Saturday was an untimely blow to that form. "She is unproven beyond six furlongs and maybe some have pegged her as a sprinter, but there is only one way to find out and that is on Sunday," Ryan Moore said. "In terms of raw ability, we are happy with where she sits in the pecking order." Cont. p6



#### G1 QIPCO 2000 Guineas Cont. from p1

What had looked beforehand a vintage renewal may well turn out that way, with the only one of the "big four" out of the frame being the forwardly-ridden **Point Lonsdale (Ire)** (Australia {GB}) who had been interfered with by Native Trail as that rival veered right running down into the dip. Coroebus, who had so dramatically gone too early when worn down by **Royal Patronage (Fr)** (Wootton Bassett {GB}) in the G2 Royal Lodge S., was not for stopping this time as he showed all the benefit of a winter's strengthening. Still a physical specimen in need of time, the winner faced a deficit in terms of form figures entering this but put it all together to emerge best of a strong bunch.

As Coroebus remained trapped wide without cover for the early part of the contest, Native Trail had the same dilemma towards the stands but as expected their racing styles were in marked contrast throughout. There was no surprise to see Buick niggling some way out to engage his long-striding mount and, equally, nothing unusual in the manner Doyle was able to employ minimal encouragement to send the slick-travelling second-string forward heading to the downhill slope. Native Trail lost minor momentum there as he lugged into Point Lonsdale, but his finish was typically strong enough to win out had Coroebus fallen into a hole as he had in the Royal Lodge. Seven months on, the son of Dubawi was a more dynamic proposition at the death and that was the telling factor. Intriguingly, he becomes the latest superstar to emerge from the August Newmarket mile novice--formerly a maiden--won by Motivator (GB), Frankel (GB) and Roaring Lion.

"Ryan [Moore] joined me quite quick and so I just asked him a couple of questions going into the dip and he responded incredibly--I think had Ryan not forced my hand to go early I

could have afforded to be even cheekier and he would have won even more impressively," explained Doyle, the latest in a long line of riders to sport the old "lucky" white cap for the operation in a prestige event. "It is just amazing how hard it is to win this race. I've ridden some very good horses, including Kingman (GB) and Barney Roy (GB)--I hate to mention them, but they both fell short through no fault of their own and were victims of circumstance. It is testament to Charlie and the belief he has in us guys. For a jockey go out in a big race with a free rein to change things up is an incredible feeling."

Interestingly, immediately after Coroebus's Autumn success on a Future Champions Day which belonged to the stable, Appleby had seemed to favour him over Native Trail. He said at the time, "It's a long way off, but I do like Coroebus. He's a supreme traveller and although you cannot fault what Native Trail has done, you've got to be able to travel in a Guineas and what Coroebus does have is a high cruising speed. You'll never take him off the bridle before the two-pole."

Reflecting on Saturday's performance, he said, "I could see James was travelling for fun and that's what this horse doesthey can't go quick enough for him. He's a seven-furlong horse who could potentially get a bit further than a mile in time, I think." Cont. p3

"I'd like to think I know the Dubawis by now," Appleby added. "We've had enough of them through our hands and he's shown us all the right signs. This horse has always shown, like any good horse, natural pace and when they have that natural pace in the physique he has you can't do anything apart from get excited about it. He gained a lot of confidence in the Autumn S. and you have to just keep filling him up as he has an electric turn of foot. Dare I say it, he'll progress throughout the season and I think we'll potentially try to keep them apart."

"It would be a shame for them to keep butting heads with one another and on the evidence of what we've seen today they are the best two 3-year-old colts around to date," their trainer concluded. "We can probably say Native Trail will go to Ireland for the G1 Irish 2000 Guineas where we have seen him be impressive before and Coroebus can go straight to the G1 St James's Palace [S. at Royal Ascot]. Native Trail has gone down on his sword, but to be fair to him he's not actually built like a Newmarket runner and his class gets him through it. He's built to meet a nice rising track and Ascot would suit him perfectly. He's been beaten by an exceptional horse and is still a class animal."

Already replete with Derby prospects, Aidan O'Brien can approach the Epsom Classic with even greater bullishness after Luxembourg put in a perfect preparatory effort. There were shades of Australia (GB), who also filled the third spot in 2014, in his performance as he stayed on to chase the pacier duo up ahead.

"We knew he was a middle-distance horse and we were happy with where he was coming into this, so we were delighted with that run," he said. Cont. p4

O'Brien added, "Everything went perfect over the winter and Ryan was delighted, he said he just stepped half a length slow out of the stalls and it just lost him a length or two but he was full of praise and Ryan did everything perfect. Point Lonsdale might not have been as forward as the other horse, so we hope there's going to be more to come from him. He's a horse that's going to be happy stepping up to a mile and a quarter and a mile and a half as well."

Seemingly treading water over six furlongs, **Khaadem (Ire)** (Dark Angel {Ire}) took his record to two wins from four starts since being dropped to five in Saturday's G3 Betfair Palace House S. at Newmarket.

Jim and Fitri Hay's acquisition had excelled under William Buick on his first try over Britain's minimum trip when capturing Doncaster's Listed Scarbrough S. in September, but had failed to build on that in Meydan following a gelding operation and his exit from the Shadwell ranks.

Reunited with Buick here, the 7-1 shot stayed away from the rest towards the far rail and had burnt his way to a clear lead at halfway much as the rider's mount Noble Truth (Fr) (Kingman {GB}) had on this track the previous day. Seeing it out up the rising ground despite tiring, he held on to prevail by a neck from Existent (GB) (Kingman {GB}).

"He's got plenty of class and on those quick five-furlong tracks like here he's good," Buick said. "He's got some amazing mid-race pace and especially here you're able to nurse him into the dip and come out the other end. He's a very talented horse."

Khaadem had taken the 2019 Listed Carnarvon S. and Stewards' Cup and been fourth in the following year's G1 July Cup and G1 Diamond Jubilee S. and he showed here there is mileage still for further pattern-race exploits.

"We only bought the horse at the end of last year off Shadwell and he ran well on his first run in Dubai and then got drawn badly," the Hays' Racing Manager Alex Cole said. "He loves the fast ground and seems to get on with the jockey well. I'd think he'd have to go to Ascot now and stay over five furlongs, seeing as he's won a group three here."

#### Will Danehill's Record Fall?

Aidan O'Brien tends to win mile Classics with stouter-bred individuals, which brings in **Tuesday (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) but there is a feeling that the reality of winning a 1000 Guineas will be too much too soon as she builds experience ahead of an Oaks tilt. The Naas maiden winner shaped as the better filly when second to **Discoveries (Ire)** (Mastercraftsman {Ire}) on her sole juvenile start and if she has made the leap she will be providing Galileo with the world record of stakes winners. This would be a stage fitting for such a landmark, and Ballydoyle's go-to rider Frankie Dettori only adds to the equation. "We are happy with where she is, as we didn't think we would be in this position with her four weeks ago," the Ballydoyle handler admitted recently.

#### **Setting The Scene**

In an edition dominated by Irish and French-trained fillies, it looks a tall order for the home team to arrest the overseas momentum. The top-rated quartet among them are the quartet who chased home Inspiral in the course-and-distance G1 Fillies' Mile in October, and while Prosperous Voyage (Ire) (Zoffany {Ire}), 'TDN Rising Star' Cachet (Ire) (Aclaim {Ire}), Mise En Scene (GB) (Siyouni {Fr}) and Wild Beauty (GB) (Frankel {GB}) are all solid proposals here they all have something to find. Mise En Scene provides James Ferguson with a first Classic runner and he is understandably hopeful that the Qatar Racing and Racehorse Club-owned G3 Prestige S. winner could be at least a

bit player in this play. "I honestly think it is the most open 1000 Guineas I can remember," he said. "It is wonderful to have a filly this good and she deserves to be the shortest-priced British runner. The fact she has got stamina in her pedigree will help her."

#### **Guineas Set For Frexit?**

This is a big year for Francis-Henri Graffard, who has been handed the golden opportunity of taking over the famous Aiglemont stables, and in Everest Racing, Barbara Keller and David Redvers's Malavath (Ire) (Mehmas {Ire}) he has a strong chance of making waves in this important monument. Building slowly to a crescendo last term, she went from a soft-ground win in the six-furlong G2 Criterium de Maisons-Laffitte at Chantilly in October to a barnstorming finish when second in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies Turf on a firm surface over this trip at Del Mar the following month. She put her compatriot Zellie (Fr) (Wootton Bassett {GB}) in her place in the Apr. 7 G3 Prix Imprudence at Deauville, which during the 1980s was the launchpad used by Criquette Head for her Guineas heroines Ma Biche and Ravinella and by François Boutin for the great Miesque. "I couldn't have her in better form," Graffard said. "She came on a lot from her seasonal debut and she's very well. When it comes to the ground, she's a very versatile filly and hopefully she is good enough for a race like this."

#### The Supporting Cast

There is abundant intrigue away from the Guineas, with ParisLongchamp staging the G1 Prix Ganay where the G2 Prix d'Harcourt one-two-three **Skalleti (Fr)** (Kendargent {Fr}), **Sealiway (Fr)** (Galiway {GB}) and **Mare Australis (Ire)** (Australia {GB}) re-oppose. **Cont. p7**

Umm Kulthum, who annexed 2020's G3 Firth of Clyde S. and ran third in this venue's G1 Cheveley Park S., lined up for this event--switched from Nottingham--coming back from almost one year off, having finished eighth in last term's G3 Fred Darling S. and third in May's G2 Sandy Lane S. at Haydock. The lightly-raced 4-year-old tracked the leaders in third early, but slipped to sixth at halfway in this comeback. Coming under pressure to close soon after passing the quarter-mile marker, she quickened to launch her bid at the furlong pole and was driven out up the hill to deny the forward-running Tenaya Canyon for a second black-type success.

"She just had a small issue after she ran in the Sandy Lane, which I thought she ran a good race in, and I just ran out of time to run her last year," explained trainer Richard Fahey. "She had been working well at home, but when they have a little problem you are always minding them and it was only in the last couple of weeks she has come to herself. She is in the York race [G2 Duke of York S.] and the Ascot race [G1 Platinum Jubilee S.] and that is where we will try and head with her. I thought the Haydock form was very good and I thought if she ran near that she would have a big chance, which she has shown she has. The plan was to get a run into her before York, but I just hope she will be alright now. She was very unlucky at Haydock and she should have won that day as she got stopped a couple of times. She is not a bad filly and this is a great race for fillies over six furlongs early in the season."

Umm Kulthum, half-sister to the unraced 2-year-old filly Minka (Ire) (Kodiac {GB}) and a yearling filly by Galileo Gold (GB), is the first of four foals and lone representative of Queen's Code (Ire) (Shamardal), herself kin to multiple winners Barbarous (Ire) (Lope de Vega (Ire)) and Juthoor (Ire) (Lope de Vega (Ire)). # DEEP IMPACT FILLY TAKES TOP PRIZE

A brilliant, rail-hugging ride by Daniel Moor paved the way for **Glint Of Hope (Jpn)** (Deep Impact {Jpn}) to play a starring role in Saturday's G1 Grand Syndicates Australasian Oaks at Morphettville.

The Victorian filly arrived in Adelaide as a winner and six-time placegetter from an eight-start career, performing with admirable consistency right up to a second placing in the G3 Ethereal S. in the spring. Her only time further back than third was a seventh, 4.3l from the winner, in the G1 VRC Oaks.

That consistency may have been overshadowed by more impressive winning form in the lead-up to Saturday's fillies' feature, and Glint Of Hope started at double-figure odds in a field dominated by the high-flying favourite **My Whisper** (Frankel {GB}).

But after following My Whisper everywhere she went through the majority of the 2000-metre feature, Moor stuck to the inside at the home turn and scythed through along the fence, quickly moving up alongside **Barb Raider** (Rebel Raider) and My Whisper as they lodged their bids. That trio fought an enthralling battle to the line, which Glint Of Hope won by 0.2l.

#### **Pedigree Notes**

Bred by Raffles Dancers and purchased by Asrun Japan for \$250,000 at the 2020 Inglis Easter Yearling Sale, she is the 185th stakes winner for her late sire--and his fifth on Australian soil. Her dam is the unplaced Sacred Sight (GB) (Fastnet Rock), daughter of the German Group 3 winner Give Me Five (Ger) (Monsun {Ger}) who also produced the G1 Royal Ascot Gold Cup winner Colour Vision (Fr) (Rainbow Quest {USA}). Hailing from a classy German family, Glint Of Hope is the sixth Group 1 winner bred on a Deep Impact (Jpn) (Sunday Silence {USA})/Danehill (USA) (Danzig {USA}) cross, one which provides for duplications of the outstanding mares Natalma (USA) (Native Dancer {USA}) and Almahmoud (USA) (Mahmoud {Fr})--Halo (USA) (Hail To Reason {USA}), Northern Dancer (Can) (Nearctic {Can}) and Danehill all hailing from this prolific family.
