BEYOND DERBY ASPIRATIONS, PLETCHER DUO BLOSSOMS

The Week in Review by T. D. Thornton

Getting a 3-year-old to peak precisely on the first Saturday of May is an over-arching goal in our sport. But even for the very upper crust of colts, a brush with GI Kentucky Derby aspirations ends up being nothing more than an early diversion on a much longer development arc.

It's always intriguing to watch how one-time Derby hopefuls progress over months and even years, and two of them from Todd Pletcher's barn signaled Saturday that they might be A-level factors in the second half of this season.

Within the span of 15 minutes June 4, 'TDN Rising Star' Emmanuel (More Than Ready) and Dynamic One (Union Rags) each posted one-length victories, respectively, in the GII Pennine Ridge S. at Belmont Park and in the Listed Blame S. at Churchill Downs.

Emmanuel had been brought up to the cusp of this year's Derby, but after running a no-impact third in the GI Toyota Blue Grass S. over a drying-out track that he might not have cared for, Pletcher said the \$350,000 KEESEP colt would be freshened for nearly two months and then resurface on grass in the Pennine Ridge against fellow sophomores.

GOLDEN GLIDER WORKS FOR BELMONT

Golden Glider (Ghostzapper), most recently second in the GIII Peter Pan S., tuned up for Saturday's GI Belmont S. with a four-furlong work in :49.90 (33/84) at Belmont Park Sunday. NYRA clockers caught the colt, with exercise rider Kylie Wellington up, through a quarter-mile in :26.20 and a gallop-out in 1:02.80.

"I thought he worked really well. He settled early, which is what you want out of a Belmont horse, and flew home," trainer Mark Casse said.

Casse won the 2019 Belmont with Sir Winston (Awesome Again), who also finished second in the Peter Pan heading into the Test of the Champion. The Hall of Fame trainer expects Golden Glider will have no trouble with the Belmont's 1 1/2-mile distance.

GAM'S MISSION WINS MINT JULEP

Gam's Mission (Noble Mission {GB}) earned her second graded race at Churchill Downs with a late-charging victory in the GIII Mint Julep S. Sunday.

KLESARIS FILES APPEAL OF VOIDED CLAIM

Trainer Robert Klesaris has filed an appeal of a voided claim at Belmont Park last week, citing errors by the New York State Gaming Commission.

The switch yielded immediate-gratification results, and Emmanuel could now be targeting a bigger lawn party, the GI Belmont Derby Invitational S. July 9.

Debuting last Dec. 11, Emmanuel won his first two dirt starts at Gulfstream Park and Tampa Bay Downs by a combined 10 1/4 lengths while on the front end at every call. In the GII Fasig-Tipton Fountain of Youth S., this robust pacemaker was favored until the final flash, then got knocked off his game by failing to attain the lead and enduring a tour-of-the-track trip that hooked him four and five wide on the turns.

After that, Pletcher was on the fence between running back in the GI Florida Derby or shipping for the Blue Grass. Since he had fellow 'Rising Star' Charge It (Tapit) primed for the Gulfstream spot, Emmanuel had to take his show on the road to Keeneland.

Charge It ended up running second in a Florida Derby that featured a three-way pace meltdown, while Emmanuel was no match for blunt-force closer Zandon (Upstart), who would end up going off as the second fave and running third in the Derby.

Pletcher, who also trained Emmanuel's sire in the early 2000s, said as far back as January that Emmanuel was "a bigger, scopier colt" than most of More Than Ready's progeny. He likened Emmanuel to his trainee Verrazano, "a big, physical, strong imposing colt" who won the 2013 GI Haskell Invitational S.

Emmanuel dispatched with his Pennine Ridge foes like an in-control 19-10 favorite who relished being on the lead, practically walking through the first six of nine furlongs, but

igniting to life when roused for run in both upper and deep stretch. Like we saw in his first two dirt starts, Emmanuel was never fully extended.

And while his 88 Beyer Speed Figure appears at first glance to be on the soft side (matching his Blue Grass number on dirt), it's also an artifact of the dawdling internal fractions, and offset by a final furlong timed in an eye-catching :11.89 for the "about" distance.

Better late than never...

Dynamic One has taken a bit longer to figure things out. Now four, he ran the worst of four Pletcher entrants in the 2021 Derby, getting pinballed at the break and checking hard the first time past the sixteenth pole. He was never in it to win it, turning for home last at the quarter pole and gaining only one position by passing an eased-up entrant.

After an 0-for-3 start in the winter of 2020-21, Pletcher hadn't sugarcoated that he expected better out of this \$725,000 KEESEP colt. But he also explained how Dynamic One was hindered by shorter distances and outer gate draws before breaking his maiden by 5 1/4 lengths in start number four when stretched out to nine furlongs. In a bid to accrue last-chance Derby qualifying points, Dynamic One earned respect with a wide-on-both bends effort in the GII Wood Memorial S. at 15-1 odds, losing the race only on the final head bob.

Despite a top-side pedigree anchored by the 2012 GI Belmont S. winner and a female family that resonates with Phipps-homebred stayers, Dynamic One was in way over his head when taking the seemingly obligatory shot in the Derby. He rebounded by winning the Listed Curlin S. at Saratoga last summer, ran seventh in the GI Runhappy Travers S., then was shelved until this spring, when he ran third in the GIII Challenger S. at Tampa and second in the GIII Ben Ali S. at Keeneland.

But Dynamic One's trip-troubled go in the Ben Ali was far better than it appeared on paper. Committed to the rail, he was rated back "on hold" for a good portion of his backstretch run, then got shuffled to last to regroup. He blitzed through a wall of traffic off the turn with his head cocked out toward the stands, and was getting to the tiring repeat winner, Scalding (Nyquist), in the final stages.

On Saturday in the nine-furlong Blame, bettors let Dynamic One drift up to 6-1 behind second-favored Scalding and another Pletcher entrant, the 11-10 chalk American revolution (Constitution).

A five-way speed scrimmage broke out on the first turn, then percolated down the backstretch, playing right into Dynamic One's off-pace tactics.

Cued to quicken three-eighths out, he methodically picked off speed-sapped leaders, and being spun out to the six path turning for home was no worry given the head of steam Dynamic One had built over the course of his prolonged, quarter-mile bid.

Despite his name, this is not the type of colt who will wow you with one spectacular flourish. But slow and steady still wins a few races here in speed-centric North America, and when five horses lined up at the eighth pole, all with a chance to win it, it was clear that Dynamic One had built the best momentum.

Off a career-best 99 Beyer, Dynamic One is a candidate for either the GII Stephen Foster S. at Churchill July 2 or the GII Suburban S. at Belmont July 9.

That latter option could set up both Emmanuel and Dynamic One for important 10-furlong tries on the same afternoon in two different races.

Not exactly the 1 1/4-mile test those Pletcher stablemates were initially aimed for at earlier points in their careers--but not bad consolation prizes, either.

"I'm not worried about the mile and a half, it's just how long it's going to take him," said Casse, with a laugh. "He's a one-paced type of horse, so I'm hoping he'll have a similar trip like Sir Winston. In his previous races, Sir Winston used to come from the clouds, but in the Belmont, Joel Rosario kept him close enough and I could see the same thing happening Saturday with Dylan [Davis]."

Also working Sunday ahead of Saturday's stakes-packed card at Belmont, **Speaker's Corner** (Street Sense) went four furlongs in :48.01 (5/117) over the training track ahead of an engagement in the GI Hill 'n' Dale Metropolitan H.

"I let him pick it up a little more," trainer Bill Mott said. "He shaded :24 coming home today. He was off nice and I had him in :47 3/5. The gallop out was just normal. We let him finish up to the wire."

Speaker's Corner, a Godolphin homebred, won the GIII Fred Hooper S. at Gulfstream in January, the GII Gulfstream Park Mile in March and is coming off a win in the Apr. 9 GI Carter H.

"We've had a nice schedule. We've got a good foundation and plenty of time to be fresh for this race, so hopefully it works out," Mott said. "He seems to be doing well and we got all our works in and been fortunate enough that we haven't missed anything. We did what we wanted to do."

Trainer Chad Brown sent out GI Resorts World Casino Manhattan S. hopeful **Rockemperor (Ire)** (Holy Roman Emperor (Ire)) to work five furlongs in 1:01.80 (1/3) over the inner turf course at Belmont Sunday.

"He worked really good," Brown said. "He likes Belmont quite a bit and the key with him is firm turf. If the turf is firm on Saturday, he will run."

Rockemperor won the GI Joe Hirsch Turf Classic S. over the Belmont lawn last year.

Also working for the Manhattan, **Gufo** (Declaration of War) worked four furlongs in company in :49.60 (9/19) over the inner turf course at Belmont Sunday.

"Gufo worked great and is ready for the Manhattan," trainer Christophe Clement said. "He tried very hard and ran very well in the Man o' War."

Third in last year's Manhattan, Gufo is coming off a runner-up effort in the May 14 GI Man o'War S.

Unhurried out of the gate, the filly was allowed to settle near the back of the pack as Dalika charged out to the early lead. Making her first start of the season, Dalika bowled along through fractions of :24.22 and :48.68.

The field began reeling in the pacesetter on the far turn, with Gam's Mission widest of all into the stretch. The pacesetter looked determined on the front end, but Gam's Mission closed relentlessly to win going away.

"She's a war horse," said winning rider Adam Beschizza. "She's very tough, but this filly is all heart. She probably prefers a little cut in the ground and it was pretty fast today. She was able to overcome that and win very nicely. We thought she'd be sitting on a big run today and was doing well with just a couple of easy gallops into today's race."

Winning trainer Cherie DeVaux added, "Adam did a great job with her getting to settle from off the pace. She was a little bit farther back than normal but that was just sort of how the race unfolded today with [Dalika] on the front end. I'm really pleased with her effort to close that strongly."

Gam's Mission won the GIII Regret S. over the Churchill lawn last May. She was fourth in the GI Belmont Oaks Invitational in July and fifth in the GIII Saratoga Oaks Invitational in August before concluding the season with a fourth-place effort in the Nov. 14 Winter Memories S. She returned from a four-month freshening to be second in the Tom Benson Memorial S. at Fair Grounds Mar. 26 and was second again in a Keeneland allowance last time out Apr. 23.

Pedigree Notes:

Auntie Martha produced a colt by Dads Caps in 2021 and was bred back to Bodexpress. The mare is a daughter of Auntie Mame, winner of the 1998 GI Flower Bowl Invitational S. Gam's Mission's third dam, Lady Vixen, produced GI Acorn S. winner Star de Lady Ann (Star de Naskra).

Richard Barton purchased Auntie Martha, in foal to Tonalist, for \$11,000 at the 2018 Keeneland November sale. Her Cat Burglar filly sold for \$5,000 at last year's Fasig-Tipton California Yearling Sale.

KLESARIS FILES APPEAL OF VOIDED CLAIM

Trainer Robert Klesaris and his lawyer Drew Mollica have filed an appeal of the voided claim of Battalion (Tiznow) following the fourth race at Belmont Park May 28 with the New York State Gaming Commission. Mollica has filed a brief on behalf of Klesaris and owner Mike DeBella and the matter will be heard June 7 by Peter Moschetti.

Battalion finished seventh in the May 28 race and, when he received no notification of any claim, Klesaris said he had the horse returned to his barn. Once notified that trainer Rob Atras and owner Sanford Goldfarb had actually won a shake for the 5-year-old gelding, Klesaris had the horse sent to the testing barn, where he arrived shortly after 2:49 p.m., according to the filing. At 3:14 p.m., Klesaris was notified by Steward Brooke Hawkins that the claim had been voided because the horse was not at the testing barn. The void was later confirmed by New York Gaming Commission Steward Braulio Baeza.

In the filing, Klesaris seeks to have the commission vacate the voiding of the claim and transfer ownership of Battalion to Atras and Goldfarb.

"Our position is clear and unmitigated," said Mollica. "There was no reason the claim should have been voided. Mr. Klesaris followed every rule and every order of the Gaming Commission. The horse was returned to the test barn in a timely manner as soon as he was notified. The horse should have been transferred at that point. There was no reason or rule that the claim should have been voided. The ruling against Frank Gabriel is a smokescreen for the wrongful voiding of this claim."

In response to a *TDN* request for comment on the filing, the Gaming Commission's Brad Maione said, "This matter is the subject of an appeal. It would be inappropriate to comment on a pending adjudication."

There are thousands of people at the smaller tracks that get up and go to work, just like those in the upper tier of our industry. Everyone has the same dream, to get their hands on a great horse. Before this crisis is over, everyone will be tested. A great many will go under. Right now, less than 2% of the world's population gets to do what we do...we are blessed to work in this industry.

Let's take this wonderful sport, often call the Sport of Kings, and make it the sport of the people. We are the selected few, all with one common goal. We have people making the rules for our industry that do not know what they cost. We are running races at our best tracks, with five-horse fields. Cut it out and get real. We stand together, or we all go down.

Still under easy handling nearing the stretch as her pursuers were driven, Dreaming of Drew burst away into the final furlong despite staying on her left lead and had it to herself from there. Il Malocchio, who chased throughout, held for the place.

"I've been on her two or three times in the morning and she's eager, always running strong," said winning rider Kazushi Kimura. "On the backstretch, I was so comfortable with her. I 100% knew she was going to run at the top of the stretch."

The victress's dam, a Grade III winner in her racing career, was sold for \$15,000 at Keeneland November in 2019. She is responsible for a juvenile Midnight Storm colt named Midnight Dreaming who breezed a half-mile Saturday at Churchill in :50 1/5 (95/124) for Tom Amoss. Vadeni dazzles in French Derby | ScoopDyga

One hundred years on from the late Aga Khan III's initial foray into European racing, the internationally-renowned and respected operation were celebrating a momentous Classic victory as the Jean-Claude Rouget-trained Vadeni (Fr) (Churchill {Ire}--Vaderana {Fr}, by Monsun {Ger}) dominated Chantilly's G1 Qatar Prix du Jockey Club. Always travelling easily in the slipstream of the leaders from his favourable inside draw, the May 10 G3 Prix de Guiche winner pounced on the G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains hero Modern Games (Ire) (Dubawi {Ire}) with 300 metres remaining and a furlong later Christophe Soumillon was already saluting the crowd with the race in safe keeping. At the line, there was a five-length margin back to El Bodegon (Ire) (Kodiac {GB}), the only runner with a lower stall than the winner in one, with the wide-drawn Modern Games an honourable third a short neck behind. The Aga Khan IV now has eight Prix du Jockey Club successes, with this being only the second since the distance was shortened in 2005. "I am delighted to win for His Highness, as it has been a few years since we made it at the highest level and these prestigious races are so important for his breeding operation," Soumillon said after steering his fourth winner of the 10 1/2-furlong Classic. "I feel sorry that he and Princess Zahra could not make it to the races today and my first thoughts were for them--I owe them so much and they have been so important in my career." Cont. p2

PURPLEPAY OUTPOINTS SANDRINGHAM RIVALS

Lael Stable's **Purplepay (Fr)** (Zarak {Fr}) garnered a bumper pot when running away with the Haras de Bouquetot Criterium Arqana on ParisLongchamp's Arc Saturday card and closed last term under the stewardship of Cedric Rossi with a third in Saint-Cloud's Oct. 23 G1 Criterium International. Making her debut for new connections in last month's G1 Irish 1000 Guineas at The Curragh, having been knocked down for €2-million at last year's Arqana December sale, she finished sixth there and rebounded in style to salute in Sunday's G2 Prix de Sandringham going one mile at Chantilly. The eventual winner was swiftly into stride and found a smooth rhythm in second as **Hot Queen (Fr)** (Recorder {GB}) established a clear lead through halfway. Taking closer order in the straight, the 6-5 choice gained a narrow advantage on the bridle with 300 metres remaining and surged clear under a late drive to earn a career high with plenty to spare. **Cont. p5**


as the 2-5 favourite behind El Bodegon in the nine-furlong G3 Prix de Conde on his final juvenile start, the bay returned with a staying-on fifth in the G3 Prix de Fontainebleau at a mile at ParisLongchamp Apr. 17 before it all slotted into place in the Prix de Guiche back here last time.

After the earlier G3 Prix de Royaumont win of the Stud's Baiykara (Fr) (Zarak {Fr}), there was a feeling in the air that this

meeting would form some sort of crowning moment for the breeding operation which has its roots in Aga Khan III's 1922 Queen Mary S. success. Even the draw had been kind, twice, with Vadeni faring well the first time the balls were pulled out of the bowl and better at the second attempt. As is often the case in this race, it became a race of the haves and the havenots in that respect with Soumillon able to cruise and draft with minimal effort and William Buick's hand forced by stall 13. He had to use up fuel

on Modern Games to get the 21-10 favourite into the front line, but he made the right call as after the opening two furlongs, the eventual first, second and third were occupying three of the front five positions.

TDN Rising Stars Onesto (Ire) (Frankel {GB}) and Lassaut (Fr) (Almanzor {Ire}) and the similarly well-fancied Al Hakeem (GB) (Siyouni {Fr}) were far adrift as the trailing trio at that stage and the die was already cast for them. Soon into the straight it was clear that those in the rearguard had little chance of getting to the leaders and one glance at the emerald green was enough to predict the outcome. Hard as Modern Games tried, he was losing steam on the rain-softened ground and while his compatriot El Bodegon was wearing him down, by the time they had grafted to a furlong and a half out the race had already slipped out of their grip. It is rare that a jockey is able to begin celebrations so far from the line and only time will tell how Vadeni ranks alongside Desert Crown (GB) (Nathaniel {Ire}), but the fact is that France has a new star and that can only be a good thing where the diversity of the racing game is concerned.

For Rouget, the performance was a clear peak of his grand total of five. "He is the easiest of my Jockey Club winners--he's very good," he said. I will probably give him a break now and I'll speak to the owner and see what he wants to do. If he wants to go for the Arc, I would suggest running him in the Irish Champion S. first and if not, he could still come back in the Irish Champion and head to the Champion Stakes at Ascot as Almanzor did." Charlie Appleby is looking to the States now for Modern Games.

"I think in the end he didn't quite see out the trip," he said.

"The winner was quite impressive and you could spot him from a long way out. I think on faster ground Modern Games can stay nine or ten and the Belmont Derby or Saratoga Derby are options for him now in America." James Ferguson said of El Bodegon, "It's so great to see him back on track and I've never been so happy to be second—the winner is a fantastic horse and all credit to him. My horse has beaten everyone else. He wears his heart on his sleeve and tried all the way to the line."

Vadawina is kin to the fellow Saint-Alary heroine Vazira (Fr) (Sea the Stars {Ire}) and the stakes-producing, dual group 3 winner Vadapolina (Fr) (Trempolino), while their dam Vadaza (Fr) (Zafonic) is in turn a half-sister to the G1 Queen Anne S. and G1 Prix d'Ispahan hero Valixir (Ire) (Trempolino) and the listed-winning Celebre Vadala (Fr) (Peintre Celebre) who threw the G1 Prix du Moulin-winning sire Vadamos (Fr) from a mating with Monsun. Also connected

to the GI Breeders' Cup Mile hero Val Royal (Fr) (Royal Academy), Vaderana has the unraced 2-year-old colt by Camelot (GB) named Vazirpour (GB).

Working his way back to the level of his success in last year's G1 Prix Ganay, Gestut Schlenderhan's Mare Australis (Ire) (Australia {GB}) was steered to a cosy win in Sunday's G2 Grand Prix de Chantilly in what amounted to one of Olivier Peslier's masterclasses. Always comfortable on the front end kept company by the pacemaker Soho (Ger) (Mastercraftsman {Ire}), the 3-1 shot took command at the top of the straight and had the energy to shy at the advertising boards en route to a two-length verdict over Bubble Gift (Fr) (Nathaniel {Ire}), with Glycon (Fr) (Le Havre {GB}) a further length away in third.

Lightly-campaigned for his age and raced only twice since his career highlight at ParisLongchamp last May, Mare Australis had posted a respectable return when third behind Skalleti (Fr) (Kendargent {Fr}) and Sealiway (Fr) (Galiway {GB}) back at that venue Apr. 10 before finishing fourth in the latest edition of the Ganay there at the start of last month. Trainer Andre Fabre is keen to go where the underfoot conditions suit. "This horse had been away a long time and he needed his two starts this year to reach his top condition," he explained. "Softer ground today was also a help. If the ground is suitable and the weather not too dry, he might take his chance in the Grand Prix de Saint Cloud. If not we will wait for the autumn to race him again."

May 6 before taking the Listed Sole Power Sprint S. over this five-furlong trip at Naas May 15, the 3-year-old continued her progression tackling the habitual front-runner Air de Valse (Fr) (Mesnil des Aigles (Fr)). Hard at work a long way out as that G1 Prix de l'Abbaye runner-up enjoyed the rail and a marginal lead, the travails of the 17-5 second favourite paid off a furlong from home as she overhauled that rival who is twice her age and earned a 3/4-of-a-length success. Dylan Browne McMonagle, who was riding in France for the first time, said, "She has stepped forward loads from two to three and has loads of speed and a great attitude--she wears her heart on her sleeve."

BAIYKARA SETS THE TONE IN THE ROYAUMONT

The sole maiden in the line-up for Sunday's G3 Prix de Royaumont at Chantilly, **Baiykara (Fr)** (Zarak {Fr}) exited stage right as the leading lady following a four-length success to kickstart a memorable treble for His Highness The Aga Khan. Sent off at only 3-1 second favourite moving up to a mile and a half for the first time, the Francis-Henri Graffard-trained homebred was kept wide early by Christophe Soumillon tracking the pace. Sent to the front with two furlongs remaining, the bay was green in the clear but always in control as she relished the extra trip to put daylight between her and **Manisha** (Ire) (Lope de Vega {Ire}).

Third at ParisLongchamp Apr. 10 and runner-up here a month later, Baiykara was surprising nobody here and with the 4-5 favourite **Hidden Dimples (Ire)** (Frankel {GB}) running below-par in fourth, had a realtively straightforward task. "It is certainly unusual to go for a group three with a maiden, but she had run a great race last time and had improved a great deal since," trainer Francis-Henri Graffard explained. "It's nice to break the maiden like that and, even though she didn't have the best trip on the outer without cover, she relaxed well and quickened well. I imagine that the next logical step will be the G2 Prix de Malleret [at Saint-Cloud]."

Baiykara, who becomes the third group winner and fifth stakes winner for her second-crop sire, is out of Balankiyla (Fr) (Montjeu {Ire}) who is kin to the GI Secretariat S. and G2 Prix Eugene Adam winner Bayrir (Fr) (Medicean {GB}). WAGNIS A DEUTSCHES DERBY POSSIBLE AFTER DIANA TRIAL SUCCESS

Gestut Rottgen's homebred 3-year-old filly Wagnis (Ger) (Adlerflug {Ger}) graduated over one mile at Baden-Baden in September and came back this term to finish second upped to 10 1/2 furlongs at Mulheim in her only other prior outing last term. She was sent postward as the 23-10 favourite for Sunday's G3 Diana Trial at Hoppegarten and duly delivered in the Berlin feature. The February-foaled dark bay was trapped wide after breaking from the outside gate before cutting across to race along the hedge with just two behind after the early exchanges. Nudged along approaching the quarter-mile marker, she found the necessary opening with 300 metres remaining and lengthened clear of toiling rivals in the closing stages to secure a career high by daylight. Wagnis hit the line with five lengths to spare from Nastaria (GB) (Outstrip {GB}), herself 3/4-of-a-length ahead of last month's Listed Henkel-Stutenpreis victrix Toskana Belle (Fr) (Shamalgan (Fr)) in third.

"It wasn't easy breaking from stall nine as everyone wanted to go to the hedge and nobody wanted to give up their position," winning rider Andrash Starke told *GaloppOnline*. "We were forced to race in rear and bide our time. We then had to wait long enough for a gap to appear and, when it opened up, she went straight through and picked up immediately." Trainer Markus Klug indicated a tilt at next month's G1 Deutsches Derby in an option for the winner.

SONGLINE HEADS SUNDAY RACING'S 1-2 FINISH IN YASUDA KINEN



Songline winning the Yasuda Kinen | JRA

Sunday Racing Co. Ltd.'s 4-year-old filly Songline (Jpn) (Kizuna {Jpn}) bested **Schnell Meister (Ger)** (Kingman {GB}), also owned by Sunday Racing, by a neck to win the G1 Yasuda Kinen at Tokyo Racecourse Sunday. With his victory, Songline earned an automatic berth, including fees paid, to the \$2-million GI FanDuel Breeders' Cup Mile. Facing 17 others, Songline settled behind Salios (Jpn) (Heart's Cry {Jpn}) while stationed ahead of Schnell Meister in midpack as the field cruised down the backstretch. Making headway while shifting to the outside before the final turn, the 7-1 chance picked up the tempo, caught Salios in deep stretch before fending off Schnell Meister by a neck at the wire. In their previous meeting, the filly finished a nose behind Schnell Meister in last season's G1 NHK Mile Cup at Tokyo. "I'm just relieved and happy that I was able to live up to the team's expectations," said winning rider Kenichi Ikezoe. "It was a tight schedule for the filly, but the staff at the stables prepared her remarkably. She broke well and I decided to settle her behind Salios, who rushed up in front of us. Trying not to make the same mistake as last time, we made an early bid before the last corner and she responded well and stretched all the way for a strong finish."

In her two previous starts this year, Songline won the G3 1351 Turf Sprint at King Abdulaziz Racetrack in Saudi Arabia Feb. 26, before closing late to finish fifth in the May 15 G1 Victoria Mile, a Breeders' Cup Challenge Series race for the GI Maker's Mark Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Turf.

Already the sire of 18 stakes winners with his oldest foals just 5-year-olds, Kizuna has 11 group winners, including G1 Queen Elizabeth II Cup heroine Akai Ito (Jpn), who is also out of a Symboli Kris S mare. Songline, who is the second Group 1 scorer for her young sire, is the first foal out of her four-time winning dam who specialized at 1200-1400 metres. Her dam, a half-sister to dual Japanese group winner Jeune Ecole (Jpn) (Kurofune), did not produce a foal to the cover of Real Steel (Jpn) in 2020. Luminous Parade has a yearling colt by Real Impact (Jpn) and visited Songline's sire Kizuna in 2021.

Under the unraced third dam are group winners Renforcer (Jpn) (Symboli Kris S), Northern River (Jpn) (Agnes Tachyon {Jpn}) and the G1 Shuka Sho/G1 Nassau S. heroine Deirdre (Jpn) (Harbinger {GB}). The Classic-winning French champion 3-yearold filly Sonic Lady (Nureyev) is the fourth dam and boasts the Classic-placed Furner's Green (Ire) (Dylan Thomas (Ire)) and Lady Lupus (Ire) (High Chaparral (Ire)), both group winners.
