# NEWLY CROWNED CHAMP TAKES THE STAGE AT LANE'S END by Katie Petrunyak

Owner Jon Ebbert was adamant that **Arcangelo** (Arrogate) was not for sale after the 3-year-old put in a hard-fought victory in the GIII Peter Pan S. The story didn't waver as the striking gray reeled off wins in the GI Belmont S. and GI Travers S. and it still didn't change when Ebbert was selecting a stallion farm for the star of his Blue Rose Farm.

At Lane's End, Ebbert found a team that was experienced with and even enthusiastic about his desire to be involved in the next chapter of the dual Grade I winner's career.

"John had a tremendous experience with the horse and really the ride of a lifetime, as he's said, but the fact that he wants to keep the whole horse and stay involved to that degree is pretty rare," said Lane's End Farm's Bill Farish. "You don't see people doing that very much anymore and it's great to see. The last horse that we had that was kind of similar was Curlin, but there have been others over the years where the owner has stayed in. It's fun to work with him. He's involved in the mares we've selected and he just loves the horse. He wants to give him every chance at stud."

Newly crowned as the 2023 Eclipse Champion 3-Year-Old Male, Arcangelo has fully recovered from a surgery to repair a condylar fracture and all systems are go ahead of the 2024 breeding season. **Cont.**, **p6**

Hall of Fame jockey Braulio Baeza won his first of three victories in 1969 aboard Funny Fellow and took home his last Donn with Foolish Pleasure in 1976.

One of the greats, Forego, captured the 1974 race. There was Deputy Minister in 1983. The legendary Cigar grabbed back-to-back races starting in 1995 for a trainer with the last name of Mott, who is still collecting accolades and giving sound speeches without notes.

And who could forget the haul by Todd Pletcher with his first Donn win in 2003 which was authored by Harlan's Holiday.

Speaking of sires, futures breeding shed stars like Medaglia d'Oro, Quality Road and Constitution, all got their picture taken after winning the Donn.

As we know, the race was renamed and its history placed on a dusty shelf. Instead of drawing from the near and visceral past, it was time to extract strength from a famous mythological winged horse slaying a dragon. Second in size stateside to only the Statue of Liberty, the completed 2014 edifice ominously guards the entrance of Gulfstream, presides over the Donn's demise and welcomes those attending Pegasus World Cup Day.


On Saturday, another edition arrives as the GI Pegasus World Cup Invitational S. anchors a card which sports six other graded events. Looking to join the likes of Arrogate (who won the first Pegasus), Gun Runner and Life Is Good, are a dozen suitors and an also-eligible.

Out of these, **National Treasure** (Quality Road) is the clear class leader. The Bob Baffert trainee won last year's GI Preakness S. and ended his 3-year-old campaign as the runner-up in the GI Big Ass Fans Breeders' Cup Dirt Mile to newly-minted Horse of the Year Cody's Wish (Curlin).

One of National Treasure's primary rivals, who is drawn right next to him, is Godolphin homebred GSW **First Mission** (Street Sense). **Cont.**

Trained by Brad Cox, the dark bay missed last year's Triple Crown, but he has the potential to be a major player within the 2024 Classic division.

"It couldn't have gone better so far," said Cox assistant Trace Messina. "He shipped in here early Tuesday morning and had a good gallop over the track Wednesday and another good gallop Thursday."

First Mission was second in the GII Clark S. at Churchill Downs

last November. Both the winner of that race, **Trademark** (Upstart), and the third-place finisher, **II Miracolo** (Gun Runner), also received a Pegasus invite.


Il Miracolo's trainer Antonio Sano said, "The horse has been doing very well after the [last] race. Right now, the horse is very excited and in good condition. He worked two times with [jockey Javier] Castellano and I hope to run well. I think there are four horses that show speed in the race. I hope we can find room behind the speed for the horse to close."

As for the rest of the field, it includes Mineshaft's own GISW Hoist the Gold and MGSW Senor Buscador (who ran first and second in the GI Cigar Mile), plus the lavarone's MGSW O'Connor (Chi) (Boboman) and that 7-year-old's Saffie Joseph stablemate MGSW Skippylongstocking (Exaggerator).

#### The Undercard Takes to the Turf

The rest of the Gulfstream slate has an intriguing lineup. In the GI Pegasus World Cup Turf Invitational S., trainer Aidan O'Brien sends GI Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Turf runner-up **Warm Heart** (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) back to America. Since missing by a neck to newly-crowned champion female turf horse Inspiral (GB) (Frankel {GB}), the filly was third in the G1 Hong Kong Vase at Sha Tin in mid-December.


Last year's winner, **Atone** (Into Mischief) returns, along with the undefeated MGSW **Integration** (Quality Road), who picks up rider Tyler Gaffallione for Kendrick Carmouche.

West Point Thoroughbreds executive vice president Tom Bellhouse said about Integration's development, "He's as exciting a horse as we've had. He's just a super exciting horse. It took him a while to really get rolling and find his stride. If you look back, he had a lot of works and a lot of base. Shug [McGaughey] was always, 'I like this horse.' He's rewarded all the confidence Shug had in him. To win the race at Colonial [Downs] first time out and to come back a little less than four weeks later and win the Virginia Derby the way he did, it was spectacular. I was lucky enough to be at Aqueduct for the Hill Prince S. and it was one of those races that was never in doubt. It was really an amazing performance."

A trio of graded turf races help to round out the Pegasus Day card. First among them is the Pegasus World Cup Filly & Mare Turf, which moved up a spot to become a Grade II race. **Star Fortress (Ire)** (Sea The Stars {Ire}), the market leader at 5-2 here, made her U.S. debut a winning one by 10 lengths for trainer Cherie DeVaux in the GIII Cardinal S. at Churchill Downs last November. Chief among her rivals will be veteran 6-year-olds like GISW **Queen Goddess** (Empire Maker), MGSW/MGISP **Fluffy Socks** (Slumber {GB}) and MGSW/GISP **Didia** (**Arg**) (Orpen).

As an ode to the Donn's origins, also on the docket are a pair of grass distance tests at 12 furlongs—the GIII La Prevoyante S. and the GIII W.L. McKnight S.

Graded dirt races do make an appearance with the GII Inside Information S. for older females at seven furlongs, which is led by local favorite GSW/GISP **Maryquitecontrary** (First Dude). Also, older males traveling a mile in the GIII Fred Hopper S. will look to challenge morning-line favorite **Hejazi** (Bernardini), who was the runner-up in the GI Malibu S. **Cont.**


On the racetrack, Arcangelo made history for trainer Jena Antonucci. Now as a stallion, he looks to do the same for his late sire Arrogate, who has produced five Grade I winners from just three crops. Three of those top-class performers were fillies and the other was Cave Rock, who passed away from laminitis, and while the ill-fated stallion's final crop has only just turned three, for now it appears as though Arcangelo may provide the only opportunity for breeders to access a Grade I-winning son of champion Arrogate.

"[Arcangelo] being a son of Arrogate is pretty exciting for us," said Farish. "There's no telling how good of a sire he would have been and he's certainly showing through this horse and others how good he could have been. So a son of his out of this female family--it just doesn't get much better than that."

Arcangelo's dam Modeling (Tapit), a \$2.85 million purchase for Don Alberto Corporation, is a half-sister to GISW Streaming (Smart Strike) and SWs Treasuring (Smart Strike) and Cascading (A. P. Indy). Another generation back in the family shows broodmare of the year Better Than Honour, whose produce records features Belmont-winning siblings Rags to Riches and Jazil.

Lane's End's bloodstock agent David Ingordo explained just how influential he believes this pedigree to be.

"It's one of the best families in the stud book," he said. "It's one of those pedigrees that if you're in the breeding business, you want to have access to it. There are so many matriarchs in there. You can do a lot of creative things in breeding with him and because Arrogate is gone now, where are you going to find another one? We are so lucky to have him here."

Ingordo said he considers Arcangelo to be a better version of his sire physically. "I'm a balance person and he's exceptionally well-balanced. He's got great proportions and a lovely shoulder. When you see him standing from the side, he's got all these great qualities and is even improved on what his sire had. When you look at his hip and how his hind leg sits, he's an improvement on his sire."


Both Farish and Ingordo made a point of noting that based on the requests coming in from breeders, Arcangelo's first book is shaping up to include some intriguing matings.

"Arcangelo's book of mares includes a lot of the bestproducing mares that went to Arrogate himself because those mares probably would have been bred back to Arrogate had he been here," explained Ingordo. "So we're getting a lot of graded stakes winners and producers, including some mares that have horses on the upswing on the Derby trail."

"I think he represents a very interesting mating for people because he's pure dirt and that appeals to a lot of people," added Farish. "The fact that he had the speed and precocity that he did and then the ability to carry it a distance also is really appealing to a lot of breeders."

With a stud fee set at \$35,000, Arcangelo joins Up to the Mark (Not This Time), who also brought home an Eclipse Award as champion turf male and is profiled by Chris McGrath here, as the newcomers to the Lane's End stud barn for 2024.

"I think Arcangelo could end up with a pretty tight, nice book



of mares when this is all over because of the quality he's getting at the price point that he's at," said Ingordo.

"We think we stood him very reasonably and breeders are sending mares that would go to a horse double his stud fee. All of the right people are breeding to him and that's so important when you're trying to curate these stallion books. The right people bring the right mares and then do the right job with those offspring. That's what helps these horses make it as stallions."

Tipsy Tammy brings \$600,000 as a KEESEP yearling | Keeneland

Sporting a pair of bullet breezes on her worktab, the Rigney Racing colorbearer wasn't much of a secret and was off as the 4-5 favorite in the six-furlong affair.

Tipsy Tammy jumped well from post three and battled for command from an outside second with Impel in hot pursuit in third through an opening quarter in a sharp :21.89. Tipsy Tammy poked her head in front as Impel began to wind up with a flashy sweep on the far turn.

Tipsy Tammy fought on gamely along the rail as they straightened for home, but couldn't match strides with the Brad Cox-trained Juddmonte homebred down the lane. Impel crossed the wire 3 1/4 lengths to the good and it was another 10 3/4 lengths back to the distant third-place finisher.

Tipsy Tammy earned a 77 Beyer Speed Figure for the effort. "Really thought she ran really well," Bauer said. "Progression and maturity, she should move forward, hopefully."

He continued, "It was as advertised. Obviously, when you spend that kind of money, you hope they turn out to be something special. She indicated that to us in the mornings and everybody was on to her as well. I think that was the reason for the short price.

Brad (Cox)'s horse shipped in from Kentucky, so maybe a little bit of camouflage there. No shame in running second to something like that. Visually, I thought they both ran winning efforts. They just got the better of us."

Tipsy Tammy will look to go one better in her second career start in a six-furlong, \$57,000 maiden special weight at Fair Grounds next Thursday. With a five-furlong bullet in 1:00 4/5 (1/12) under her belt in the interim, the 8-5 morning-line favorite has drawn widest of all in post seven. Mitchell Murrill will be at the controls once again.

"Who knows? Sometimes it's beneficial to get two starts in the maiden ranks and try and get some more seasoning before you take on winners," Bauer said.

"She's put together really well and a very efficient mover. Obviously, you always hope that they'll stretch out a little bit in distance, which I think she will based on her training. We thought coming back in a three-quarter event would be the right move to try and get the maiden broke, then probably point towards something at Keeneland."

Bred in Kentucky by Sierra Farm, Tipsy Tammy hails from the third and final crop of the much-missed Arrogate, who is already responsible for five Grade I winners, led by the recently crowned champion 3-year-old Arcangelo. She was the highest-priced yearling filly by Arrogate to sell in 2022 and the third most expensive overall of 61 yearlings by the late Hall of Famer to change hands that year.

The half-sister to MSW Doc Boy (Into Mischief) was produced by Peggy May, an unraced daughter of champion grass mare Perfect Sting (Red Ransom). The Adena Springs-bred Peggy May brought \$170,000 from breeder Sierra Farm while in foal to Awesome Again at the 2014 Keeneland November sale.







The inside four horses, all first-time starters, headline Pegasus World Cup day at Gulfstream Park Saturday. **BATTEN DOWN** (Tapit) kicks things off for Bill Mott who looks to capitalize on a huge Eclipse Awards night with this Juddmonte homebred. A son of champion older mare Close Hatches, this colt is out of a full-sister to MGISP Lockdown, herself the dam of newly-crowned champion 3-year-old filly Idiomatic (Curlin). He is also a full-brother to MGSW/MGISP Tacitus and from the family of G1 Tattersalls Irish Two Thousands Guineas winner Siskin (First Defence).

Corporate Power (Curlin) brought \$925,000 as a yearling at KEENOV in 2022 for Courtlandt Farms and trainer Shug McGaughey. Out of GSW Road to Victory, herself a \$1.45m Stonestreet buy at FTKNOV 2019, the colt counts Japanese G1SW Moanin (Henny Hughes) as an extended family member.



# KABIRKHAN UP TO THE CHALLENGE AT MEYDAN

**Kabirkhan** (California Chrome) continued a most improbable fairy-tale run at the Dubai Racing Carnival, as he raced prominently following a bit of a sluggish dispatch and powered home late to easily take out Friday's US\$1-million G1 Al Maktoum Challenge at Meydan.

The chestnut with a big white blaze--eerily reminiscent of his G1 Dubai World Cup-winning sire--was returning just a fortnight after annexing a 2000-metre handicap, and for all intents and purposes forced the hand of trainer Doug Watson. After racing for next to no prize-money while winning eight of nine starts in Kazakhstan and Russia--he picked up about \$20,000 for running second to now barnmate Hero Mo (Mo Town) in last year's Russian Derby--it made sense to wheel back on the short rest, the significantly stiffer competition and sub-optimal spacing notwithstanding.

Favoured on the international markets, the \$12,000 Keeneland September bargain raced ahead of midfield in about fifth position as **First Constitution (Chi)** (Constitution) burned plenty of fuel and took over from **Walk of Stars (Ire)** (Dubawi {Ire}) to inject some pace into his race for the commonly owned GIII Lukas Classic winner **Clapton** (Brethren). Three wide and right there to pounce for the run around the turn, Kabirkhan went for home three off the inside in upper stretch. **Cont. p3** 

# MEASURED TIME BRINGS UP GODOLPHIN GROUP HAT TRICK IN JEBEL HATTA

Fresh off seeing his Inspiral (GB) named the 2023 Eclipse Champion Turf Female, the success keeps coming for Juddmonte's Frankel (GB), as his MEASURED TIME (GB) (c, 4, out of Minidress {GB}, by Street Cry {Ire}) surged to a goodlooking victory in the AED1.85-million G1 Jebel Hatta Presented by Longines at Meydan Racecourse on Friday. It was the 34th worldwide top-level winner for Frankel.

Godolphin and trainer Charlie Appleby were winning their third group race of the evening after half-siblings Mysterious Night (Ire) (Dark Angel {Ire}) and Star Of Mystery (GB) (Kodiac {GB}) won the G2 Al Fahidi Fort and G2 Blue Point Sprint, respectively, earlier on the card. In the nightcap, Siskany (GB) (Dubawi {Ire}) would take the Listed Al Khail Trophy to bring up four winners on the day for Appleby and the Godolphin blue.

The pick of William Buick despite the presence of three other Godolphin runners including G1 1000 Guineas heroine **Mawj** (Ire) (Exceed And Excel {Aus}), the 4-year-old perched just one off and one back of that rival's shoulder for much of the Jebel Hatta's 1800-metre trip. Cont. p4

He took over a furlong and a half from home and had four lengths on Franz Strauss (GB) (Golden Horn {GB}) on the wire in a solid clocking for the 1900 metres.

Trainer Chad Summers indicated pre-race that they would be content to race Clapton wide so as not to be trapped inside as they were when finishing down the field in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic when last seen. Five deep on the circle, Clapton plugged on gamely for Antonio Fresu and managed to cling on for third.

Kabirkhan is the first Northern Hemisphere Group 1 winner for the expatriated California Chrome and the first Thoroughbred Grade I winner in the distinguished career of trainer Doug Watson.

"He might be the best mile and a quarter horse I've ever trained," said Watson. "We'll see what the owners want to do next, but I'm glad he's in our yard. I'm delighted for our team, [jockey] Pat [Dobbs] and of course everybody in Kazakhstan."

Added the winning jockey, also ringing up his first top-level Thoroughbred success: "This is massive for everyone, especially Doug. He's such a good mover, he [Kabirkhan] doesn't feel like he's doing the times he is. Doug has a smile on his face whenever he sees him."



#### **Pedigree Notes**

There were roughly 200 horses left to sell during the 11th and final session of the 2021 Keeneland September sale when Nadir Khassanov paid \$12,000 for the California Chrome colt from the Mulholland Springs consignment.

Kehner Thoroughbreds' Kyle Kehner acquired Kabirkhan's stakes-winning dam for \$85,000 in foal to Fort Larned at the 2014 Keeneland November Sale and Kabirkhan is one of three



winners from as many to the races for the mare. The dam of a 3year-old colt by Yoshida (Jpn), Little Emily's 2-year-old colt by Global Campaign has been exported to Kazakhstan, but she failed to produce a foal in 2023 after selling for the upset price of \$1,000 to Jacob Sherman at Keeneland January last winter. She had been bred to Omaha Beach on a late cover, but was listed as not pregnant in the catalogue. Little Emily is due to Lookin At Lucky this season.

The duo tracked fellow Godolphin runner Highland Avenue (Ire) (Dubawi (Ire)) for the duration, who at one point had as many as eight lengths on the field. Buick gave Measured Time his cue in upper stretch, and he soon reeled in Highland Avenue, before striding out a 1 3/4-length winner. The fourth Godolphin runner in the nine-strong field, U.S. graded winner Ottoman Fleet (GB) (Sea The Stars {Ire}) unleashed a strong late burst to take second, three-quarters of a length in front of G2 Zabeel Mile winner San Donato (Ire) (Lope De Vega (Ire)) in third. Mawj received a check near the furlong pole and dropped out of the race to finish tailed off. A post-race veterinary exam did not reveal any abnormalities, according to the stewards' report.

"I'm delighted, obviously," said the Godolphin trainer after his first Group 1 win of 2024. "We knew it was a big step up with Mawj in there--a Classic winner and a filly we hold close to our hearts. He'll likely go straight to the Dubai Turf now."

A winner of his first three starts last year, the first pair over the Kempton all-weather going a mile and the third a 1 1/4-mile race over the Newmarket turf, Measured Time ran second in the Listed Floodlit S. back on synthetic at Kempton in November. He broke his stakes duck with a 3 1/4-length victory in the G2 Al Rashidiya going this trip at Meydan on Dec. 22.

#### **Pedigree Notes**

The undefeated Frankel is arguably proving an even better sire than he was a racehorse, with his 136 stakes winners including a staggering 92 group/graded winners. A two-time champion sire, the bay is now responsible for two Jebel Hatta winners, as he is also the father of Godolphin's 2019 winner Dream Castle (GB).

Measured Time is a half-brother to GI Breeders' Cup Turf winner Rebel's Romance (Ire) (Dubawi {Ire}) and the stakesplaced Petticoat (GB) (Cape Cross {Ire}). His dam was second in the Listed Height Of Fashion S., and her latest foal is a yearling by Dubawi. Cont. p5



Just two races after her half-brother Mysterious Night (Ire) (Dark Angel (Ire)) won the G2 Al Fahidi Fort, Godolphin's STAR OF MYSTERY (GB) (f, 3, Kodiac {GB}--Mistrusting {Ire}, by **Shamardal)** picked up strongly in the closing stages to take the AED850,000 G2 Blue Point Sprint Presented by Longines by 1 3/4 lengths. Ponntos (Ire) (Power {GB}) ran second, with Tajalla (Ire) (Kessaar {Ire}) a neck back in third. Cont. p6

The race was delayed for several minutes when both Tajalla and Thunder Of Niagara (Ire) (Night Of Thunder (Ire)) broke through the gate and had to be reloaded. Group winner Ponntos

was the first to receive a call, while Star Of Mystery was hunkered down near the tail of the field. Starting to make in roads toward the vanguard inside the final quarter mile, the filly hit the clear at the 250metre mark, but still had several lengths to make up on the freewheeling Ponntos. She bounded by all comers in a matter of strides with 50 metres to travel under Mickael Barzalona before dashing away to win by daylight.

"We went a fast gallop and I just had enough time to come from that far back," said

Barzalona. "For a 3-year-old filly against these older horses, she showed some class. She's still learning, so everything is going the right way."

Named a 'TDN Rising Star' on the back of an 11-length drubbing of a Haydock novice field at second asking, the halfsister to a pair of Grade I winners promptly won the Listed Empress Fillies S. last July. Tried later that month in the G2 Duchess Of Cambridge S., she was not disgraced when second. Sixth behind paternal half-sister Relief Rally (Ire) in the G2 Lowther S. at York in August, the bay was duly shelved. She won her 3-year-old bow going 1200 metres at this venue by a length and, based on Friday's heroics, has every chance to continue her progression later in the season.



Mysterious Night burst through a gap in the later stages of the Al Fahidi Fort to give William Buick and Charlie Appleby their first winner on the Fashion Friday card. It was the eighth edition of the race for Appleby and the fourth for Buick.

A winner of the G3 Prix Francois Boutin in France and the GI Summer S. in Canada as a juvenile, he first surfaced at Meydan after a mostly forgettable 3-year-old 2023 campaign with a fifth to Vafortino in the Listed Business Bay Challenge in December. He entered Friday's contest with a handicap victory over course and distance on Jan. 19.

Glued to the rail for much of this contest as stablemate Majestic Pride (GB) (Shamardal) set the pace, the gelding badly needed a gap to open once the field hit the straight, but none was forthcoming. Still lacking room with just 300 metres remaining, he finally found a hole between that foe and G1 Al Quoz Sprint winner Danyah just a half-furlong later. It took him until just before the 100-metre mark to secure an advantage and he eventually won a shade comfortably over old rival Vafortino, who had burst through up the fence in the closing stages. Danyah was third, with Majestic Pride hanging on for fourth.

He added, "We've got an invitation to Saudi for the 6 1/2furlong [1351 Turf Sprint] which will probably suit him but we could also stay here for the G3 Ras Al Khor [on Mar. 2nd]. Jim Crowley [on Danyah] was keeping him in, which he's entitled to do, but luckily we had the horse to get out of it."

#### **Pedigree Notes**

One of 101 stakes winners (58 group) for his 19-year-old sire who is based at Yeomanstown Stud, Mysterious Night is also part of a clutch of 15 scorers at the highest level. He is a fullbrother to dual American Grade I winner Althiga (GB), who also claimed the G2 Cape Verdi S. in this locale.

Few broodmare sires are missed as much as the late Shamardal. His daughters have excelled as producers, and have left 102 stakes winners--52 graded/group--to date. The son of Giant's Causeway also has 11 Grade/Group 1 winners to his credit.

Mistrusting won at the listed level in England, and Mysterious Night is one of three stakes winners for her so far.

Later on the Meydan card, her 2021 Kodiac (GB) filly Star Of Mystery (GB) won the G2 Blue Point Sprint. All five of her foals to race have won, and her latest is a juvenile colt by Dubawi (Ire).

#### MENDELSSOHN BAY PROVES TOO STRONG **IN UAE 2000 GUINEAS** by Alan Carasso

Mendelssohn Bay (Mendelssohn), whose sire won the 2018 G2 UAE Derby by an Arabian desert in track-record time and whose broodmare sire Curlin counts the G1 Dubai World Cup amongst his conquests, stalked a good pace and kept on gamely through the final 200 metres to win Friday's G3 UAE 2000

Guineas at Meydan Racecourse.

Ridden forward by Pat Cosgrave, the Bhupat Seemar stable's second string sat just outside of pacesetting Military Artist (Munnings), as that one took the Guineas field along at a decent tempo. Asked to come after the front-runner in the straight, Mendelssohn Bay surged past and continued to find to score comfortably in what is a prep for the Derby, contested over 1900 metres on the World Cup undercard Mar. 30. The winner's stablemate Killer Collect (Collected), the selection of number one stable jockey Tadhg O'Shea, spotted his rivals a few lengths at the break and was forced to expend a fair bit of energy to be prominent when push came to shove. Wide into the lane, he fought on bravely to be second ahead of Quartier (Uru) (Matterhorn), who was exiting a runner-up effort to the wellregarded Ma Yetal (Flameaway) in the 2000 Guineas Trial last time over the 1400 metres. Mendelssohn Bay was a slowstarting fourth in the same event, having won his maiden going seven furlongs over this surface Nov. 24.

"The further we go the better for this horse," said Cosgrave, for whom it was a first Meydan winner of the campaign. "He's a bit immature mentally, he's still learning, but when I asked him to quicken at the 300 [-metre marker] he put the race to bed quickly."

#### **Pedigree Notes**

Mendelssohn Bay is the eighth black-type winner and second graded winner for his sire. He is also the 21st stakes winner and eighth group/graded winner from a Curlin dam.

Joe and Debbie McCloskey's Cuyathy LLC purchased Reiki Baby for \$8,000 at the 2014 Keeneland September Sale, but didn't make the races until the middle of her 4-year-old season. She made the most of limited opportunities, graduating at first asking and adding a pair of allowance seconds before retiring after four starts. The McCloskeys bought out their partners, Firsthome Thoroughbreds, for \$40,000 at that year's Keeneland November Sale.

The majority of the black-type in the family occurs in the third dam, which features the likes of champion Escena (Strawberry Road (Aus)).

Reiki Baby's first foal, the 5-year-old Blame mare Lightheart, was unraced, while her second produce is the dual winner Reiquist (Nyquist). Behind Mendelssohn Bay is the juvenile filly Paprika Princess (Practical Joke) and with no foal reported for 2023, she is due to Omaha Beach this term.

Winner of the 2022 G1 Maktoum Challenge Round 3, Hypothetical had been beaten by a combined 80 1/2 lengths in his three most recent visits to the races dating back to the 2022 G1 Dubai World Cup, but returned to something resembling his best form with a pace-pressing victory in Friday's G3 Firebreak S. at Meydan, a race he also scooped two seasons ago.

Drawn gate five, Hypothetical was given his usual positive ride by his regular partner Mickael Barzalona and led the field down the chute before ceding the advantage to Southern Artist, who pushed through underneath to lead as they reached the round course. Positioned right at the front-runner's hind quarters leaving the 800-meter marker, Hypothetical was the magnet to Southern Artist's steel and was poised to pounce turning in. Southern Artist boxed on doggedly, but Hypothetical always looked to have his measure and inched away in the final 50 metres to return to winning ways. Quailty Humor won a photo with Royal Mews (Fr) (Siyouni {Fr}) for third.

"He's a top-class horse, a Group 1 winner over 10 furlongs [2000metres]," said Barzalona. "We didn't have much choice but to run him on turf last time and he ran just OK but it made him fit. He showed again his quality tonight."

A two-time stakes winner at Meydan, including the 2021 G3 UAE Guineas on this program, Mouheeb muscled his way through four off the inside with 250 metres to travel and was off and gone to impressively take out Friday's G3 Al Shindagha Sprint as the comebacking Laurel River (Into Mischief) proved disappointing.

Mouheeb left the machine without incident, but the pace was on and he was left at the tail of the field through the opening exchanges as Rawy set a pressured tempo from Freedom Fighter. Laurel River did not appear to jump all that well, but nevertheless sat up on the speed three deep. The leading trio continued to lock horse rounding the turn and into the straight, but all the while, Mouheeb was making sneaky inside progress to loom a threat. Laurel River could offer no more and was up and down at the 300 metres, but Mouheeb was deftly steered off heels by the visiting Tom Marquand--who had broken Mouheeb's maiden at first asking at Jebel Ali in 2020--and tore away for a dominating success. Laurel River weakened out to finish seventh, beaten just over 10 lengths, while first-up since winning the GII Pat O'Brien S. at Del Mar in August 2022.

A listed winner during last year's Carnival, Mouheeb was having his first start since finishing a well-beaten 13th behind Sibelius (Not This Time) in the G1 Dubai Golden Shaheen last March.

"It's a bit of a surprise," said winning trained Michael Costa.

"The whole game plan this year was to save him for the backend of the season and have him cherry ripe for then.

"I wasn't quite sure what we'd get tonight as we'd planned to be going a mile in a start's time so today was just about getting him to the races and wanting him to pull up well and go to his next race.

"The initial plan was the mile race on Super Saturday (G3 Burj Nahaar) before the big mile race (G2 Godolphin Mile) on Dubai World Cup night but that puts a little spanner in the works the way he was so dominant over six furlongs."

The globetrotting Siskany has won stakes in England, the U.S. and Meydan, and it was the last-named venue where he padded his resume with a last-gasp victory in the Al Khail S. on Friday. It was the fourth winner on the card for trainer Charlie Appleby and the third for William Buick.

Well back from the bell in this 2810-metre test, the 6-year-old gelding swooped up the centre of the course to just pip stretch leader Al Nayyir by a narrow margin in the final stride.

Already a winner of the G3 Nad Al Sheba Trophy last year, he took the GII Belmont Gold Cup in June, ran third in the G1 Preis von Europa in September and was a flat fifth in the GII Thoroughbred Aftercare Alliance S. on dirt in November.

# TIPPERARY GREEN LIGHT FOR €18 MILLION ALL-WEATHER DEVELOPMENT

The introduction of a second all-weather track in Ireland would appear to be imminent after An Bord Pleanála granted

permission for construction to get underway at Tipperary Racecourse.

Dundalk became Ireland's first and only all-weather track in 2007 but Horse Racing Ireland have been working hard behind the scenes in recent years for Tipperary to become the second.

Tipperary County Council had granted permission for the development in August 2022 but the project met a roadblock when the decision was appealed by residents close to the racecourse the following month.

The appeal process took almost 16 months and news broke on Friday afternoon that the green light had been given for what had been previously estimated to be an €18-million development.

Tipperary manager Andrew Hogan commented, "I was delighted to get that news today. It's very positive and is huge news for Irish racing. There is a big demand for a second all-weather track in Ireland. Not only that but, for all of the trainers and owners in the south, it will be a great benefit to them."

# RVC STUDY LINKS LOW COLLAGEN TO INCREASED FRACTURE RISK

The Royal Veterinary College (RVC) has published new research that shows that Thoroughbreds with lower levels of collagen type III have a higher risk of fracture.

The study will help to provide a greater understanding of how best to diagnose and manage horses at high risk of fractures, which is a leading cause of euthanasia within the breed. Currently in the UK, approximately 60 horses each year are put down on racecourses after sustaining such an injury.

#### **RVC Study Cont.**

The research team leader Dr Debbie Guest, Senior Research Fellow at the RVC, said, "Bone fractures are a major welfare concern in Thoroughbred racing. We know that there are many environmental risk factors for fracture and much has been done over the years to reduce these risks. Despite this effort, fractures sadly still occur, and we know that some horses are genetically more predisposed to fracture than others."

She continued, "The development of a polygenic risk score for fracture will allow us to identify horses that are at high genetic risk to allow the targeted use of diagnostic imaging and close monitoring of their bone health. This study has also demonstrated the power of using cell models to work out what differences exist in bone cells from high and low-risk horses and therefore why some horses are at high risk. This is vital to develop new interventions for high-risk horses in the future so that they are less likely to suffer from a catastrophic fracture."

The research, which was funded by the Horserace Betting Levy Board, the Anne Duchess of Westminster Charitable Trust and The Alborada Trust, found that collagen type III, a gene which is required for normal bone formation, is expressed at lower levels in bone cells from horses with a high genetic risk of fracture. This is because they have a change in their DNA sequence in the region which controls how much collagen III is produced.

Additional research is now being undertaken and further studies using this system and cell model will help to identify other genes and processes to better understand why some horses are more susceptible to fracture than others.
