



# DORNOCH GUTS IT OUT IN SCRATCH-DEPLETED FOUNTAIN OF YOUTH

When entries were taken Feb. 24, the \$400,000 GII Coolmore Fountain of Youth S. looked a tantalizing race in prospect, given the presence of 'TDN Rising Star' Locked (Gun Runner)--the GI Claiborne Breeders' Futurity hero and GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile third--and the resurgent GII Remsen S. winner Dornoch (Good Magic), not to mention a pair of clearly talented and unexposed rivals in the form of big-figure maiden winner Speak Easy (Constitution) and Victory Avenue (Arrogate), a close second that afternoon.

By mid-morning Saturday, Locked and Victory Avenue had been scratched, and Speak Easy--at the time around 6-5 second favorite--got loose behind the gate and was also withdrawn prior to the start. When the dust had settled, Dornoch was the 1-5 mortal against just four apparently overmatched rivals to pick up the 50 Kentucky Derby points on offer to the winner, and the full-brother to 2023 GI Kentucky Derby winner Mage duly obliged, albeit in workmanlike fashion.

Drawn the rail, **Le Dom Bro** (Mucho Macho Man), beaten 30-plus lengths in the Remsen and runner-up to **Frankie's Empire** (Classic Empire) in the Feb. 3 Swale S., was hard sent for the lead, but Luis Saez was equally positive aboard Dornoch, who made the front after a furlong and a half. **Cont. p3** 

#### DETERMINISTIC FIRES FRESH IN GOTHAM

**Deterministic** (Liam's Map), tabbed as a 'TDN Rising Star' in a visually impressive, come-from-behind debut score after a slow start going seven furlongs at Saratoga Aug. 12, fired fresh off the bench to capture Saturday's GIII Gotham S. at a rain-soaked Aqueduct.

Working up a storm for trainer Christophe Clement this winter at Payson Park in Florida, including a five-furlong bullet in 1:01 4/5 (1/8) Feb. 17, Deterministic was well supported at odds of 7-2 here.

The \$625,000 KEESEP yearling purchase raced in an inside fifth over the sloppy going as longshot **Maximus Meridius** (Maximus Mischief) led the way through an opening quarter in :23.42. Ridden along by Joel Rosario in fourth rounding the far turn, narrow GIII Withers S. runner-up **El Grande O** (Take Charge Indy) began to turn the screws on the pacesetter as favored **Just a Touch** (Justify) began to wind up with a move of his own on the extreme outside. **Cont. p6**

He managed to set very manageable fractions of :24.39 and :48.14 while galloping along in the two path down the back.

Dornoch was fairly conservatively ridden into the turn, and

that allowed Le Dom Bro to hold his spot at the rail, right underneath the front-runner, though Dornoch still looked to have something up his sleeve. Le Dom Bro refused to lie down inside and Dornoch didn't do himself any favors by hanging on his incorrect lead for much of the run home, but he was always doing enough to secure his second consecutive win at the graded level.

"We didn't want to be on the lead but when [Speak Easy] scratched, he gets out there

and he kind of plays around," said winning trainer Danny Gargan, who trains for a partnership that includes former MLB star Jayson Werth and Randy Hill's R A Hill Stable, among others. "You can see him with his ears kind of goofing off. I told [jockey]

Luis [Saez], 'Just go ahead and go.' We had no choice. We really wanted to stalk today, it just didn't work out that way. He won fine enough. Surely it won't be his fastest race. We didn't expect to win today. It just kind of played out that way. I don't think he

> ran very hard. He was just kind of playing around out there."

Gargan said that either the GI Curlin Florida Derby or the GI Toyota Blue Grass could be the next stop for Dornoch.


A debut second sprinting through the Saratoga slop last July 29, Dornoch was runner-up as the favorite in the one-mile Sapling S. at Monmouth Aug. 26 before graduating impressively by 6 1/2 lengths at Keeneland seven weeks later. The 17-10 favorite in the Remsen contested over a rain-affected strip, Dornoch maintained a narrow lead

throughout, but looked destined for a runner-up effort when 'TDN Rising Star' Sierra Leone (Gun Runner) raced past at the eighth pole. But Dornoch fought back while racing hard against a golden rail and got his nose down first. Cont. p4



#### **Pedigree Notes:**

Donegal Racing paid \$90,000 for Puca at the 2013 Keeneland September sale, and they knew a little bit about the family, as the syndicate campaigned her half-brother Finnegans Wake (Powerscourt {GB}), who was third to Hansen (Tapit) in the 2012 GIII Gotham S., but was runner-up in that year's GI Secretariat S. and would go on to become a Grade I winner on the turf. Puca would finish second in the 2015 GII Gazelle S. and became a stakes winner in late 2017 before changing hands for \$275,000 at that year's Keeneland November sale.

Among the first mares bred to Gun Runner, Puca returned to KEENOV and fetched \$475,000 from Robert Clay's Grandview Equine in the fall of 2018. The resulting foal was a \$70,000 buyback at Keeneland September in 2020, but the filly Gunning has punched well above her weight, with a pair of stakesplacings and earnings approaching \$280,000, not to mention not the considerable pedigree updates that have since occurred.

A \$235,000 KEESEP yearling turned \$290,000 Fasig-Tipton Midlantic juvenile, Mage was fourth in last year's Fountain of Youth off his maiden win and runner-up in the GI Florida Derby before being draped with the blanket of roses at Churchill. Also runner-up in the GI Haskell S., Mage now holds court at Airdrie Stud.

The current 2-year-old out of Puca, a colt by McKinzie, was hammered down to Mayberry Farm for \$1.2 million at Keeneland September last fall, and a few months later, John Stewart acquired the mare privately carrying a full-sibling to Mage and Dornoch for \$2.9 million at Keeneland November. As disclosed in the Resolute Farm mating plans feature, Puca is slated to visit Into Mischief this season.

Stewart's recent Fasig-Tipton February Digital sales-topper Pounce (Lookin At Lucky) won Saturday's GIII Herecomesthebride S. at Gulfstream (see below).

Just a Touch, favored at 8-5 off a sharp debut score for Brad Cox in the Fair Grounds slop Jan. 27, leveled off late and was up for second. El Grande O was third. Maximus Meridius tired to fourth.

"He was very impressive," said Miguel Clement, assistant to his father and winning trainer Christophe Clement. "He confirmed what we believed all along that he's top class. His works have been top class, as well as his win at Saratoga. He validated it all today."

As for what's next, he continued, "Let's enjoy this for a few days and come up with a plan. I thought he was very impressive today. I don't think the distance is an issue with him whatsoever. We always thought he wanted to go long. The longer, the better."

Rosario added, "He felt great. He was more in the game today in his second time out and first time going long. He did everything really well and so we're excited for him and where he'll take us."

Deterministic was the second new graded winner on the afternoon for Liam's Map, his 11th graded winner overall, and is a 24th worldwide stakes winner. Deterministic's hammer price of \$625,000 was the most expensive of the 58 (75 through the ring) of his sire's progeny reported as sold in 2022. Most of the action in Deterministic's pedigree is in the third dam, the stakes-winning Amelia. A half-sister to the talented European sprinter Bertolini (Danzig) and SW Alchemilla (Deputy Minister), she is the dam of seven winners, among them five full black-type scorers, including GSW & GISP Kindergarden Kid (Dynaformer); MGSW & GISP Rainha da Bateria (Broken Vow); Japanese group winners Rabbit Run (Tapit) and Asakusa Genki (Stormy Atlantic); GSW Assateague (Stormy Atlantic); and GI Breeders' Cup

Juvenile runner-up He's Had Enough (Tapit). Amelia's dam Aquilegia (Alydar) was a full-sister to champion Althea. Giulio's Jewel, a half-sister to the GII Lake Placid S. runner-up Duff One (Harlan's Holiday), passed away after foaling a Frosted filly in 2022.

## FIONA'S MAGIC WIRES DAVONA DALE AT 9-1; CHAMPION JUST F Y I SCRATCHED WITH

**FEVER** by Jill Williams

Stonehedge LLC's homebred **Fiona's Magic** (f, 3, St Patrick's Day--Mollie's Magic, by Factum) was catapulted into the spotlight on a Saturday reeling from several pre-race scratches of major players in significant graded events. Gulfstream Park's GII Davona Dale S. presented by FanDuel TV, a Road to the Kentucky Oaks race worth \$200,000 as well as points on a 50-25-15-10-5 scale, was not immune as Eclipse champion and GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies winner **Just F Y I** (**Justify**) developed a fever Saturday morning after shipping to Gulfstream from Payson Park. She was scratched just hours before what was to be her much-anticipated 3-year-old debut by her Hall of Fame trainer, Bill Mott.

"She was fine, but she spiked a fever and her temperature has just kept going up," said Mott.

Undefeated **'TDN Rising Star'** and former \$1.15-million Keeneland September yearling **Leslie's Rose** (Into Mischief), who had been expected to mount the most serious challenge in the field to Just F Y I, inherited the mantle of heavy favoritism in the Davona Dale, but it was an under-the-radar Fiona's Magic at 9-1 who prevailed.

A winner of two straight late last year while sprinting over this surface, Fiona's Magic made her sophomore debut with a runner-up finish in the Feb. 3 GIII Forward Gal S. at seven furlongs after relinquishing the lead at the top of the stretch to R Harper Rose (Khozan).

With expectations weighing on Leslie's Rose in the Davona Dale, Fiona's Magic popped out of the gate on top as 'TDN Rising Star' and Glitter Woman S. winner Into Champagne (Into Mischief) took a right turn before recovering to pressure from third as Cash Run S. runner-up Queen's Martini (Mucho Macho Man) tracked and Leslie's Rose found a sweet spot in the clear in fourth. Fiona's Magic was left alone for the :24.59 first quarter and was still running easily without a threat by the time the half was clocked in :47.47.

Tyler Gaffalione on the winner still rode confidently rounding the turn and began pumping his mount with gusto into the stretch as Leslie's Rose advanced and tried to find a seam to their inside. Irad Ortiz, Jr. couldn't quite get through on the favorite and shifted out, but Leslie's Rose was left with too much to do and could only muster third behind a driving Fiona's Magic and Into Champagne, who briefly looked a winner but couldn't match the determination of Fiona's Magic and settled for second by a half-length. Fiona's Magic covered the one-turn mile in 1:37.16.

Winning trainer Michael Yates also upset this race last year at 46-1 with Dorth Vader (Girvin), whose best finish to eventual divisional champion Pretty Mischievous (Into Mischief) in three tries as the season unfolded was a second in the GI Acorn S.

"I didn't give Tyler any instructions [Saturday]," said Yates. "I said, 'Ride the race how it comes up.'"

Yates did not have a plan for Fiona's Magic immediately following the race.

"[We'll] enjoy today and talk about the rest tomorrow. I thought she was very capable of it. She's been coming along steadily."

#### **Pedigree Notes:**

Fiona's Magic becomes the first stakes winner for St Patrick's Day, a full-brother to Triple Crown winner American Pharoah. She's a member of the first crop of the Journeyman Stallions-based sire, as well as just the second black-type winner for Factum as a broodmare sire. The latter's other stakes winner is Fiona's Magic's half-brother Cajun's Magic (Cajun Breeze).

The unraced Mollie's Magic has a 2-year-old colt named Blazing Hot (Khozan) and a yearling full-brother to Cajun's Magic. She was barren for 2024.

Steal Sunshine was able to turn the tables on Tumbarumba Saturday and just get his nose down on the wire first to take the GII Gulfstream Park Mile S. Third beaten just three-quarters of a length last out to that rival in the GIII Fred Hooper S., the son of Constitution was able to upend things as the 3-2 favorite.

Having raced nearly his entire 3-year-old season over the local surface, Steal Sunshine contested 2022's GI Curlin Florida Derby, finishing sixth behind future GI Breeders' Cup Classic winner White Abarrio (Race Day). That season also saw him earn back-to-back stakes wins in the Carry Back S. and the Runhappy Ellis Park Derby.

As a quick pace battle developed on the lead between the trio of II Miracolo, Tumbarumba and Gilmore (Twirling Candy), Steal Sunshine was content to sit last of the five-horse field and watch that group tear through a half in :45.81. Gliding through the field into the far turn as only a very game Tumbarumba and II Miracolo hung around, the chalk tipped out, took dead aim on

his rival and needed the entire length of the stretch to get by as the pair bobbed heads to the line.

"I'm so excited, for me, for my team, for the owners," said winning trainer Bobby DiBona. "It's a big opportunity. [Co-owner] Carrie [Brogden]'s been great for me. She's one of the top breeders in the country. Having her on the team and Mike [lavarone] coming in, it's great for me. You work hard for these opportunities. My barn is small so we're just really excited."

The top bid during the 2024 Fasig-Tipton February Digital Sale was made by John Stewart's Resolute Bloodstock, who parted with \$370,000 for Pounce, a maiden winner at first asking for Quintessential Racing Florida LLC and Hat Creek Racing and this trainer on the dirt at Churchill Nov. 19, an even sixth from a difficult high draw in a one-mile allowance over the Turfway synthetic Dec. 13 and the front-running winner of her turf debut from an equally awkward draw Feb. 11. Returning just 11 days after changing hands digitally Feb. 11, the bay validated the outlay with a late-on-the-scene victory in the GIII Herecomesthebride S.

With no luck at the draw yet again, Pounce was wisely taken hold of by Javier Castellano and angled over to the inside to caboose the field--led by Mystic Lake (Mo Town)--into the first turn. Content to trail down the back, Pounce was quietly ridden through the middle furlongs as market leaders Life's an Audible and Ozara raced handier to the speed.

Pounce began to thread the needle three furlongs out, splitting horses on a couple of occasions before angling out for the drive under a full head of steam. Life's an Audible also kicked nicely as Ozara failed to go on, but Pounce sprinted slightly the better of the two and was home narrowly best.

"Last time she broke good and I sent her to the lead, wire-to-wire," Castellano said. "It was a different ballgame today the way I handicapped the race. I was way outside with a lot of speed in the race. My goal was to save ground on the first turn but he didn't break good out of the gate and I used my best judgment to drop in and save all the ground I could on the first turn because in my mind I'd have to lose ground turning for home. It was a beautiful trip. [Life's an Audible] came out a little bit and my horse hesitated a little bit to go past, but I encouraged her and she responded really well."

Evidently a fan of a moisture-filled surface, Super Chow waged a war through the slop and collected his second graded stakes trophy in a row at a thoroughly soaked Big A on Saturday.

The 4-year-old, who has not missed hitting the board in his last seven attempts, has posted solid speed figures in his last pair of races. He was second against optional claimers at Gulfstream Park on Christmas Eve with a 96 Beyer, and then returned with a 95 Beyer when he went gate to wire over a muddy Aqueduct strip in the GIII Toboggan S. Feb. 3.

Serving as the 5-2 second choice, the dark bay showed dogged determination to secure the front, but Rotknee (Runhappy) had the same idea. The pair dueled into the far turn and entering the stretch it looked as though the battle would last all the way to the wire. However, Super Chow found another gear, fought the urge to drift too much past the eighth pole and outlasted his rivals.

"It was a really good performance," said trainer Jorge Delgado. "I give all the credit to the jockey Madison Olver. She rode the horse the way that she wanted, I think in the end that was the best decision. I was a little scared when I saw him go 22 on this kind of racetrack, but she figured it out I guess, and she felt comfortable doing that and won. I give all of the praise to her, she's been galloping the horse every day since he got to New York. She got really close to the horse and they're doing pretty well.

"I'm going to check the condition book and see what they have before May 15. Then he will head to Monmouth. He's in really good condition right now and I'm trying to take advantage of his form."

That got Emmanuel fired up some for a few strides, but he came back nicely to his rider and settled one out and one back entering the backstretch.

Settled on the back of longshot Napoleonic War (War Front) passing the half-mile marker, Emmanuel was eased out into the three path and tugged his way towards the lead without being asked to do so. Up to collar Saratoga Flash outside the eighth pole, Emmanuel dug in gamely and was able to withstand flying finishes from Siege of Boston and Ice Chocolat for the victory.

A slow-starting seventh in last year's GI Maker's Mark Mile at Keeneland Apr. 14, Emmanuel was a game third in the GIII Dinner Party S. at Pimlico May 20 and prevailing by a hard-fought neck in the GIII Poker S. at Belmont June 10 before proving no real threat in the Fourstardave.

A \$350,000 Keeneland September graduate, Emmanuel is one of two winners out of an unraced daughter of MSP Trensa, the dam of G1 Coral-Eclipse S. and G1 Longines Dubai Sheema Classic winner Hawkbill (Kitten's Joy), GI Claiborne Breeders' Futurity hero Free Drop Billy (Union Rags) and of the dam of Depiction (More Than Ready), third in this track's Dania Beach S. this past January. The GI Ballerina H.-winning third dam Serape bred three-time graded stakes winner Batique (Storm Cat).

Hard Cloth, also responsible for Emmanuel's 3-year-old full-brother Causeway's Jewel, was purchased by Gainesway Farm for \$550,000 at the 2022 Keeneland November Sale. The aforementioned Trensa was knocked down to Larkin Armstrong for \$270,000 in foal to Hard Spun at the same auction. Hard Cloth produced a colt by Mendelssohn in 2023 and--not surprisingly--was bred to Tapit for her 2024 produce.

He may be a ways from Hall of Famer Bill Mott's record of eight, but trainer Chad Brown made it three years in a row in Gulfstream's GIII Honey Fox S. when Chili Flag (Fr) crossed the wire first Saturday. Her win also marked Brown's fourth in the \$150,000 event in the last six years.

The 11 fillies or mares lined up for the Honey Fox broke in an even line before Time Passage (Tunwoo) and For the Flag (Uncle Mo) emerged from the early fray. Lost in battle, the two pulled away by daylight while throwing down early fractions of :23.31 and :45.53. Far back and third-last early, Chili Flag geared up for an assault on the turn. With massive strides while extremely wide, she mowed down the field as the frontrunners raised the white flag. Walkathon, winner of the GIII Endeavor S. a month ago, chased her home, also from far back, while Ancient Peace, who had been prominent in the second flight throughout, held her position and saved third. Final time for the mile on the grass was 1:32.78.

Jockey Irad Ortiz, Jr., aboard Chili Flag, won his fifth race on the Gulfstream card, which included the GIII Canadian Turf S. with Emmanuel (More Than Ready) for trainer Todd Pletcher one race earlier. **Cont. p14**

A former Maurizio Guarnieri trainee, Chili Flag was second in the 2021 Prix Saraca before selling for €140 000 to Mandore International Agency at Arqana's 2022 Arc sale. Her current connections got her going in early 2023 for a campaign that netted two wins last year, including in Aqueduct's Forever Together S. in November. That first black-type win earned her a shot in the Jan. 27 GII Pegasus World Cup Filly and Mare Turf Invitational S., where she finished off the board behind Didia (Arg) (Orpen). The Honey Fox was her first start since the Pegasus F/M Turf.

R Calli Kim saved her best for last, exploding through the final furlong for a comfortable victory in Saturday's GIII The Very One S. at Gulfstream Park.

The 6-5 chalk broke a bit outward from the outside gate, but that was all of little concern to Tyler Gaffalione, who settled her towards the back of the field as California raider Angel Nadeshiko (Carpe Diem) opened a long lead passing the stands for the first time. Switched off nicely through the middle stages of the 11-furlong contest, R Calli Kim traveled three to four lanes off the inside and with cover on the back of Anatolian as they raced into the last of the three turns. Building momentum with every stride, R Calli Kim had no choice but to circle five wide into the lane, but she jumped out of the ground passing the eighth pole and put the race to bed within a matter of strides.

R Calli Kim, a half-sister to the multiple graded stakes-winning turf distaffer Temple City Terror (Temple City), had made 12 of her 14 career appearances on the grass, but broke her maiden for \$16,000 on the dirt on debut back in 2020. A four-race winning streak that begam with a 1 1/4-length tally against \$32,000 claimers at Saratoga last July 23 was capped by a 2 1/2-length success in the Nov. 12 GIII Long Island S., a race won by her half-sister in 2022. The 7-year-old was looking to atone for a runner-up effort in this track's GIII La Prevoyante S. Jan. 27.

R Calli Kim is the only graded stakes winner left behind by Revolutionary.

#### LOCKED, VICTORY AVENUE SCRATCH FROM **FOUNTAIN OF YOUTH**

'TDN Rising Star' and GI Breeders' Futurity winner Locked (Gun Runner) has scratched from Saturday's GII Coolmore Fountain of Youth S. along with **Victory Avenue** (Arrogate) according to social media posts from each horses' respective connections along with a release from Gulfstream Park Saturday morning. Locked was 5-2 on the morning line while Victory Avenue was 4-1.

Eclipse Thoroughbred Partners noted on X that, "Locked will scratch from today's Fountain of Youth...but still has his eye on the prize. We'll regroup and come up with a game plan."

"He's [Victory Avenue] a high energy horse and he didn't eat his food and is mouse quiet today," Ramiro Restrepo told Gulfstream media. "That's totally uncharacteristic."



#### ESKENDEREYA PASSES AWAY IN JAPAN

Eskendereya (Giant's Causeway--Aldebaran Light, by Seattle Slew), whose son Mitole was the leading freshman sire of 2023 by winners and progeny earnings, died of heart failure Mar. 2 at Shichinohe Stallion Station in Japan, where he had been standing since 2016. He was 17 years of age.

Bred in Kentucky by Sanford Robertson, Eskendereya was purchased by Zayat Stables for \$250,000 at the 2008 Keeneland September sale. Turned over to Todd Pletcher, the chestnut broke his maiden in a rained-off renewal of the 2009 Pilgrim S. and switched to the synthetic for that year's GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile, finishing ninth. He was perfect in three starts at three, including romping scores in the GII Fountain of Youth S. and GI Wood Memorial S., but he suffered a leg injury leading up to the 2010 GI Kentucky Derby and entered stud at Taylor Made Stallions the following year. He retired with a record of 4-1-0 from six starts for earnings of \$725,700.

From his six American-foaled crops, Eskendereya was responsible for 22 black-type winners, including GI Met Mile winner Mor Spirit as well as Mitole. America's champion sprinter of 2019, the Bill and Corinne Heiligbrodt runner amassed four Grade I wins that season, including the Met Mile and GI Breeders' Cup Sprint.

Eskendereva entered stud at Shizunai Stallion Station on the island of Hokkaido and has sired for 109 individual winners from 167 starters. All totaled, Eskendereya has been represented by 365 winners which have earned nearly \$42.1 million.

## NEW SYNTHETIC TAPETA TRAINING TRACK OPENS AT SANTA ANITA



New Tapeta track at Santa Anita | Benoit

#### Edited Press Release

Santa Anita Park has opened its all-new synthetic Tapeta inner training track manufactured by Maryland-based Tapeta Footings, Inc., effective Saturday morning.

Following the Breeders' Cup, the 'Great Race Place' embarked upon an \$8 million project to provide horsemen with a state-of-the-art all-weather surface that will complement its one-mile natural dirt main track and serve as a safe and viable component in the conditioning of Thoroughbreds on a year-round basis.

"At Tapeta, our aim is to maintain the surface so that we have a soft cushion below and a slightly firmer finish on top," said Joan Wakefield, of Tapeta Footings. "This helps to reduce kickback and provide stability without as much impact on the horse. For the training track at Santa Anita, we have used a high temperature wax specially blended to suit the California climate."

Santa Anita's original training track, "Anita Chiquita," was eliminated in the early 1970s when construction began on what is now The Shops at Santa Anita Mall which adjoins the racetrack off of Baldwin Ave. Subsequently, Santa Anita's current inner training track was constructed at that time. At 4,200 feet, it is just shy of 6 1/2 furlongs in circumference.

"We are delighted to have finished construction on this very important project and I know our horsemen are anxious to begin utilizing it," said Santa Anita Senior Vice President and General Manager Nate Newby. "It's been a major undertaking and we are so fortunate to have the project headed up by Dennis and Rob Moore along with Jesse Martinez."

#### C Z ROCKET RETIRED TO OLD FRIENDS

Kentucky's Thoroughbred retirement home Old Friends welcomed the recently-retired MGSW/MGISP C Z Rocket (City Zip). The 10-year-old gelding arrived Feb. 29 to the farm and was welcomed by founder Michael Blowen and current Old Friends CEO John Nicholson.

"CZ Rocket has captured the affections of countless race fans throughout his many years on the track," said Nicholson. "After such a successful career, this special gelding has earned the right to enjoy being pampered and celebrated here at Old Friends. We are grateful to his connections for seeking such a well-deserved happy retirement for him."

""We are very grateful to Peter Miller and Tom Kagele for donating C Z Rocket to Old Friends," added Blowen.

C Z Rocket last raced at Oaklawn Park Feb. 19, finishing sixth against a starter allowance field.

"Tom [Kagele] and I talked to each other after the race and we both agreed," Miller told the Paulick Report after the race. "We said, 'It's time, he's done enough. He's sound, healthy, and happy. Let's not push the envelope."

The gelding retired with a record of 46-13-9-7 and earnings of over \$2.1m.

Jody's Pride opened her 2024 with style here as she outgamed Carmelina to claim her first stakes win of the season in the Busher S.

A dirt horse by accident after her maiden turf dash debut Aug. 9 at Saratoga was brought off the grass and she dominated by 10 1/2 lengths, it was a similar story for the Matron S. in her second start Oct. 8 when that six-panel sprint also came off the turf and again sent Jody's Pride to the winner's enclosure. Intentionally entered in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies going long on the main track at Santa Anita Park, she continued her improvement to come a neck short of catching champion MGISW Just F Y I (Justify) at 17-1 odds.

Returning at a one-turn mile, and greeting a rainy New York day, the 4-5 favorite stalked Carmelina as she rolled through :23.62 and :46.81 early splits. Making a bid entering the bend, Jody's Pride had come on even terms with that leader from the six path as they swung into the upper stretch. The fillies locked horns to the final sixteenth before the eventual winner finally managed to move clear by 2 1/4 lengths. Gin Gin came on from the back to close the trifecta. With the score here, Jody's Pride secured 50 Kentucky Oaks points in addition to the 15 she earned from the runner-up effort at the Breeders' Cup.

"We gave her 30 days [after the Breeders' Cup] and then we brought her back to Palm Meadows; she was doing everything great," said trainer Jorge Abreu. "She was working pretty good and we had her pointed for the Davona Dale, and at the last minute, [co-owner] Mr. Weston decided to run her over here. So I said, 'OK, let's go.'"

When asked whether his stable star might next be seen in the GIII Gazelle S., a 100-point qualifier to the Kentucky Oaks Apr. 6, Abreu said, "I'm going to see how she comes out of it and probably [come back] here in the Gazelle, and then the Kentucky Oaks. She ran two turns already and my concern was if she was going to perform as well as she did as a 2-year-old. She did, and I think she wants to go longer than that even."

Co-owner Steve Weston of Parkland Thoroughbreds, too, is looking ahead to Kentucky. "We made it [to the Kentucky Oaks] once before with Venti Valentine and we actually won this race for the third time today. We won it twice with Final Furlong, with Venti Valentine and Espesso Shot. I'm not saying we have the best horse for the Oaks of the 14, but at least we have a chance."

The second foal for Jody's Song, a half-sister to MSW & GISP Make Mischief (Into Mischief), Jody's Pride is the most accomplished for her dam. She has a 2-year-old full-brother Moreperfectunion as well as a yearling full-brother already named Jody's Legacy. The mare is due to Epicenter for 2024. 





Winless since taking out Round 1 of the G2 Al Maktoum Challenge going this track's 1600 metres way back in January 2021 and second in this race the year prior, **Military Law (Ire)** (g, 9, Dubawi {Ire}--Marine Bleue {Ire}, by Desert Prince {Ire}) led home a 1-2 finish for his legendary sire in Saturday's G2 Al Maktoum Classic, besting a valiant **Walk of Stars (Ire)** by a length on the wire.

Content on taking a chasing role as **Aldous Huxley (Ire)** (Dubawi {Ire}) was hard-ridden to set fast early sections in advance of **Quip** (Distorted Humor), Military Law settled in fourth position, with Walk of Stars just ahead of him and to his inside in the run down the back of the track. Aldous Huxley had run his race with the better part of 800 metres left to travel, and Military Law was first to make a move, as Oscar Chavez decisively sent him to the front at the far corner of the track. So as not to get trapped down inside of a rallying **Clapton** (Brethren), Tadhg O'Shea angled Walk of Stars off the inside and into the three path, with Military Law the target as the field turned into the straight. Mystic Guide (Ghostzapper).



The least-fancied of a trio of Godolphin runners, graded winner BOLD ACT (IRE) (g, 4, New Approach {Ire}--Dancing Sands (Ire), by Dubawi (Ire)) produced the strongest late surge to take the AED1,400,000 G2 Dubai City Of Gold Sponsored by



Emirates Airline over 2410 metres on Saturday. He outfooted fellow Charlie Appleby runner Warren Point (GB) (Dubawi {Ire}) by two lengths for the victory, with G1 Deutsches Derby hero Sisfahan (Fr) (Isfahan (Ger)) breaking up the Godolphin trio 4 3/4 lengths behind.

Moyglare Studs **Trevaunance** (Ire) (Muhaarar {GB}) cut out the running for the majority of this test, but began to wilt with 400 metres remaining. Bold Act, meanwhile, had raced in fifth in a well-spread out field. Switched on by Mickael Barzalona at the quarter-pole, he edged past Castle Way (GB) (Siyouni {Fr}) and took command. Warren Point ran into all sorts of traffic closer to the fence yet eventually got free to make a race of it, but could not match the winner.

"I had a lovely race, the pace was nice and regular," said winning jockey Mickael Barzalona. "I came to the front very easy, but when he was there he did the minimum, so this was an easy win for him."

Kept busy in 2023 with eight starts, the gelding won the Listed Prix Nureyev in August, but managed only fifth at the same level at Saint-Cloud a month later. He earned a career high and his first graded/group badge with a grinding victory in the GIII Sycamore S. at Keeneland on Oct. 13, the last time he was seen in action. Cont. p5

## JUDDMONTE'S LAUREL RIVER THRASHES FOES IN GODOLPHIN MILE PREP by Alan Carasso

Juddmonte Farms' **Laurel River** (h, 6, Into Mischief--Calm Water, by Empire Maker), favored for the 2022 GI Breeders' Cup Dirt Mile before being ruled out on the eve of the race, flashed some of the form that saw him win the 2022 GII Pat O'Brien S. with a towering, front-running victory in Saturday's G3 Burj Nahaar at Meydan Racecourse, the course-and-distance prep for the G2 Godolphin Mile on Mar. 30.

The result represented a complete turnaround from his local debut Jan. 26 when he was an early factor in the G3 Al Shindagha Sprint over 1200 metres, but faded tamely from 2 1/2 furlongs out and finished a distant seventh behind Mouheeb (Flatter).

Drawn wide in 14 for this contest over the mile, the homebred was well into stride and was restrained a bit through the opening exchanges before being allowed to stride into the lead by Tadhg O'Shea after the first 400 metres. Full of run at every stage of the race thereafter, Laurel River had amassed an imposing advantage turning them in and kept on very nicely to take it by eight lengths in good time.

Previously trained by Bob Baffert, the bay won four of his seven starts in the U.S., capped by his 3 3/4-length success in the seven-furlong Pat O'Brien at Del Mar in August 2022. Trainer Bhupat Seemar served as a Baffert assistant for some time.

"He's a high-class horse and, to be fair to him, he hadn't run in 18 months when we ran him over six furlongs," said O'Shea. "We weren't disappointed the last time, but they're racehorses and not computers; sometimes they just need a run to get back on their A-Game.

"Hats off to Bhupat and the team and to Juddmonte for keeping the faith with him."

#### **Pedigree Notes**

A predominantly breed-to-race operation, Juddmonte purchased Laurel River's second dam Soothing Touch for \$550,000 at the 2005 Keeneland September sale, and while she didn't work out as a racemare, she's excelled in the breeding shed.

The mare is the dam of six winners from 10 to race, including her first foal Emollient (Empire Maker), victorious in the 2013 GI Central Bank Ashland S. and the Juddmonte-sponsored GI Spinster, and her four winners as a broodmare include G2 Prix de Malleret winner Raclette (GB) (Frankel {GB}) and French listed winner Ardent (Frankel {GB}). Soothing Touch has also accounted for Hofburg (Tapit), a stakes winner and third in the GI Belmont S; and stakes winner Courtier (Tapit).

The second foal from Soothing Touch, Laurel River has a 2-year-old half-sister by Constitution, a yearling half-brother by the Tapit son and is due to foal a full-sibling to Laurel River this term.

The cross of Into Mischief over Empire Maker mares has resulted in 29 winners from 43 starters and six stakes winners, including GI Kentucky Derby hero Mandaloun, the Grade II winners Occult and Center Aisle and Juddmonte's sadly departed multiple stakes-winning 'TDN Rising Star' Taraz. When extending the cross to Unbridled-line mares, offspring include multiple Grade I winning champion Covfeve, Grade I winner Gina Romantica and the additional graded scorers Largent and Maximus Mischief.



Saturday marked a return to form for Alain Jathiere's FORT PAYNE (FR) (Rio De La Plata--Lady Verde {Fr}, by Meshaheer), who eked out a neck victory in the AED1,400,000 G3 Ras Al Khor Sponsored By Emirates Airline at Meydan. Tamborrada (GB) (Dubawi {Ire}) was second, a length ahead of Echo Point (Ire) (Dubawi {Ire}) in a fairly bunched finish in the 1400-metre grass affair.

Launched in the middle of the full field, Fort Payne was able to find cover as **Changing Colours (GB)** (Dubawi {Ire}) cut out the early running and anchored the field into the bend. Drawing closer by half-way, he sat three deep a few lengths off the vanguard. Waiting for his run inside the final 400 metres, he inched up to even terms with new leader **Noble Dynasty (GB)** (Dubawi {Ire}) 200 metres out. Those two traded blows for a few strides, with Fort Payne besting that rival, and he had just enough left in the tank to hold off the fast-finishing Tamborrada to his outside.

"I was pushed wide and saw too much daylight at Abu Dhabi last time," said Adrie de Vries of Fort Payne's second in the Listed President's Cup. "Today he was in top form, they did a great job with him."

Trainer Nicolas Caullery added, "I'm not sure what we will do with him [Fort Payne] next. We will have a little celebration and then think about it."

A winner of the G3 Prix du Palais-Royal in May, the 6-year-old entire made his Meydan debut several starts later, running ninth in the G3 Firebreak S. on Jan. 26. His form was on an upward trend leading into this contest, as he reported home second in the Listed HH The President Cup in the middle of last month.

Even with the likes of 2022 G1 Dubai Golden Shaheen hero and 2023 runner-up Switzerland (Speightstown) and the classy multiple group winner Tuz (Oxbow) back in the barn, Seemar fielded a team of three for Saturday's G3 Mahab al Shimaal, and duly filled the top three slots, as Leading Spirit (Ire) (Exceed and Excel {Aus}) capitalized on a perfect trip to punch his ticket to World Cup night. Freedom Fighter was doing the slightly better work and ultimately managed to shrug off Meshakel on the pointy end, but Cosgrave simply steered out Leading Spirit in upper stretch and easily raced past for the victory. **Morning** (Munnings) closed off with good energy to complete the Seemar sweep.

"He's fantastic and we've been very lucky with him this season," said Mike Kaye, founder of owners Touch Gold Racing. "He's stayed sound and been very easy to deal with. We took the blinkers off, too, which seemed to work.

"This is our biggest win. We've won a Group 3 before but never on Super Saturday."

Legend Of Time already found the front before Buick encouraged him with hands and heels and was a facile winner despite Musical Act finding more and briefly looking for a battle until Legend Of Time kicked clear by 4 3/4 lengths. Like the winner, Musical Act is a Godolphin homebred trained by

Appleby. Athan held for third as none of the others factored at the finish. The final time for the 1800 metres was 1:49.83.

Legend Of Time has been steadily building his CV, having won his debut at Haydock last fall. Off the board when trying the G3 Tattersalls S. at Newmarket three weeks later, he was put away before reemerging in Dubai to win conditions events Jan. 5 and Feb. 2, going 1400 meters and 1600 meters, respectively.

"He's won the series now and probably 1800 metres is more to his liking," said Buick. "He's an exciting horse for the rest of the season. The American Turf Derby series over there might suit him."

Appleby's exacta in the Jumeirah Classic mirrored his success in the race in 2023, when he sent Naval Power (GB) (Teofilo {Ire}), One Nation (GB) (Dubawi {Ire}), and Highbank (Ire) (Kingman {GB}) to fill out the trifecta. He only had the two entrants this year.

Legend Of Time is the 117th black-type winner worldwide for Gilltown Stud's all-conquering Sea The Stars (Ire). With the Jumeirah Classic winner, the remarkable sire of 70 group winners now has two stakes winners out of daughters of Danehill Dancer and an additional two out of daughters of that one's sire, Danehill. The late Danehill Dancer has 168 stakes winners as a broodmare sire.

Kissable (Ire), dam of Legend Of Time and herself a listed American stakes winner who also placed in the G1 Moyglare Stud S., is the dam of G1 Qatar Prix de Royallieu winner Loving Dream (GB) (Gleneagles {Ire}) and additional American stakes winner and Grade I stakes-placed Amandine (GB) (Shamardal). Her 2022 Pinatubo (Ire) colt died as a yearling and she produced a Night Of Thunder (Ire) filly last year. Cont. p11

#### **CINDERELLA'S DREAM REMAINS** UNDEFEATED DESPITE TACK DRAMA IN JUMEIRAH 1000 GUINEAS by Heather Anderson

CINDERELLA'S DREAM (GB) (f, 3, Shamardal--Espadrille {GB}, by Dubawi (Ire) ran out a 5 1/2-length winner of the 1600metre AED800,000 Listed Jumeirah 1000 Guineas, despite having her saddle slip approaching the far turn. Jockey William Buick kicked free of his irons and rode the rest of the race in what he described as a "bit of a rodeo show", with the duo keeping straight and true to the line, despite being at least four wide off the fence. Godolphin claimed this contest last year when it was only a conditions race with subsequent G1 1000 Guineas heroine Mawj (Ire) (Exceed And Excel (Aus)). Eclipse Thoroughbred Partners' Geologist (GB) (Territories {Ire}) was second, 1 1/2 lengths ahead of Yamamah (Ire) (Masar {Ire}). The final time for the race over good turf was 1:37.62.

From the bell, the eventual winner, and 169th stakes winner for her late sire, appeared a touch keen, but raced just off the leaders as Nadalia (Fr) (Spanish Moon) led. However, when the field entered the turn, the filly's saddle slipped, not once but twice, and the quick-thinking Buick steered her to the outside of her rivals just past half-way. Drawing even by the 700-metre mark, the dark bay responded to Buick's direction despite the unconventional tactics and they motored home to win as they pleased.

"She took a hold early and because she's quite slight my saddle slipped up her neck when I took a pull," said the jockey. "I was getting a bit unbalanced, so the safest thing to do was to take my feet out. It was a bit of a rodeo show, but we got the job done."

Appleby added, "She's four-from-four now and doing little wrong. The filly who won this last year went on to win the Guineas and while I'm not saying she's good enough to win one, she's certainly earning the right to run in one."

Already a winner at both Lingfield on debut in May and Thirsk in September, Cinderella's Dream defeated Charlie Appleby stablemate Beautiful Love (Ire) (Siyouni (Fr)) in the Jumeirah Fillies' Classic on Feb. 2.

Out of the dual winner Espadrille, Cinderella's Dream has a 2year-old Farhh (GB) half-sister. Her second dam is the G3 St. Simon S. winner High Heeled (Ire) (High Chaparral {Ire}), who was third in both the 2009 G1 Oaks and 2010 G1 Coronation Cup. This is also the extended family of crack distaffer Just The Judge (Ire) (Lawman {Fr}), who won a brace of top-level races including the 2013 G1 Irish 1000 Guineas.

#### SIZE RUNNERS DOMINATE MARKET FOR HONG KONG CLASSIC CUP by Alan Carasso

Trainer John Size has won the Hong Kong Classic Cup, the second leg of the 4-year-old Triple Crown, no fewer than four times and he'll saddle two of the top fancies as he looks for his first victory in the race since Sun Jewellery (Aus) (Snitzel {Aus}) in 2011 Sunday afternoon at Sha Tin Racecourse.

Helios Express (Aus) (Toronado {Ire}) is the lone member of the 14-strong field rated in triple figures (102), has won six of his eight lifetime starts and three of his last four. Drawn neatly in gate two Sunday, the bay was impressive in defeating Class 2 rivals over a mile Jan. 7 and backed up the performance with a 1 3/4-length defeat of Helene Feeling (Ire) (Sioux Nation) and a running-on **Star Mac (Aus)** (Heroic Valour {Aus}) in a slowly run renewal of the Hong Kong Classic Mile four weeks back. The 1800 metres of Sunday's test is as far as he's been, and he'll need to switch off better if he is to see it out, his connections admit.

Size said: "We're trying to adapt to a distance and to a tempo, which always is an issue for the jockeys who manage the horse through the race, so it depends on the circumstances on the day and what sections they run during the race. So far, he's been okay."

Size's second entry, **Ensued** (Lemon Drop Kid), will look to become the first US-bred to take the Classic Cup since Zaidan (Street Cry {Ire}) back in 2012. Placed twice from three overseas runs for James Fanshawe, the bay gelding broke his maiden on local debut over 1800 metres last October and-equally unusually--already owns two victories over the BMW Hong Kong Derby trip of 2000 metres. A horse that grinds it out, he just missed in Class 2 over the metric 10 furlongs, but tries restricted company for the first time in Hong Kong.

"He's been quite unusual the way he came into Hong Kong and won immediately at a distance, that doesn't happen too often so he's sort of stamped himself as one who has adapted to Hong Kong quite quickly," Size said. "[Being] just a little bit one-paced is probably the chink in his armour, he just doesn't have enough acceleration. But, with that, as long as he's running in a forward position and running freely, that's okay."

Two other American-breds are rough chances, Chancheng **Glory** (Mor Spirit) and **Unbelievable** (Justify).

**Chill Chibi (NZ)** (Wrote {Ire}) posted four straight wins over the course of last season and this season at Happy Valley before having the streak snapped by subsequent G3 January Cup H. hero Happy Together (Ire) (Dragon Pulse (Ire)) Dec. 20. Having missed the Classic Mile via a minor setback, he makes his Sha Tin debut Sunday.

#### **QUINELLA FOR YULONG AS SOUTHPORT** TYCOON WALTZES TO GUINEAS SUCCESS

The G1 Australian Guineas was kept in local hands by Southport Tycoon (Aus) (Written Tycoon (Aus)) on Saturday. It was the Ciaron Maher-trained 3-year-old colt who emerged for a decisive victory in the stallion-making race, leading home fellow Victorian Veight (Aus) (Grunt {NZ}) by 1.3l. After a less-than-fortuitous run, the pre-race favourite from Chris Waller's stable, Riff Rocket (Aus) (American Pharoah) had to settle for third.

Runner-up by a small margin on each of his previous two starts, the G2 Autumn S. and G2 Australia S., Southport Tycoon was an outsider ahead of Flemington's feature on Saturday, and provided his syndicate ownership, Bennett Racing, with a huge day out, and they might only just be getting started...

"The scary thing is he's so raw still," commented winning jockey Jamie Kah, who was following up on her 10th Group 1 notched only last weekend.

A \$300,000 purchase for Bennett Racing at the 2022 Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale from the draft of Daandine Stud, Syndicate chief Nathan Bennett was left visibly moved in the wake of Southport Tycoon's achievement.

"It's just huge for Bennett Racing and what we've been trying to build for the last five/six years," he said. "We've been there abouts but we just kept getting nailed... but wow, he's a pretty good colt too."

Whilst plans are yet to be confirmed, the Australian Guineas winner earns a place in The All-Star Mile, a target his trainer didn't rule out.

"... being a 3-year-old colt, maybe it's worth considering a little bit more," Maher said. Cont. p16

He said, "Now he's got that Group 1 on the board, it's a more realistic option, but I'm sure they'll enjoy it tonight and we'll have some good, healthy conversations about it tomorrow."

Thirteen individual Group 1 winners now stand in the shadow of Yulong Stud's Written Tycoon. Heading into the final 100 metres, the Victorian-based stud looked assured of a dream result, as Southport Tycoon drew alongside Veight, a son of their second-season sire Grunt (NZ).

Whether Southport Tycoon becomes the fourth son of Written Tycoon to stand at stud remains to be seen (Yulong has yet to stand one themselves), but his pedigree certainly positions him as a strong candidate.

#### WAR HORSE SALUTES IN VERRY ELLEEGANT

Formerly run as the G1 Chipping Norton S., there was no fairytale result for Chris Waller in the race's first renewal as the G1 Verry Ellegant S., only a few weeks after the passing of the champion mare.

Instead, it was a relatively processionary affair for Kerry Parker's **Think It Over (Aus)** (So You Think {NZ}), who seems to flourish at this time of year, as the 8-year-old gelding added a third Group 1 trophy to his cabinet.

Two fully white bridles synonymous with Verry Elleegant's (NZ) (Zed {NZ}) former trainer chased with typical tenacity, and it was a mighty effort for the favoured **Fangirl (Aus)** (Sebring {Aus}) to finish 0.9l away in second after making up so much ground from the rear of the field. **Cont. p17** 

#### **G1 Verry Ellegant S. Cont.**

Waller's other runner, last year's G1 Rosehill Guineas winner Lindermann (Aus) (Lonhro {Aus}), had to settle for third a further 1.6l away, but was far from disgraced in a classy field.

After handing Nash Rawiller his 69th Group 1 success, the winning jockey paid tribute to the trainer.

"If he was with Gai [Waterhouse] or Chris [Waller] he'd probably be rated the second-best horse in the country," he said.

"He's a horse that just flies under the radar a bit for being trained at Kembla, but they go the extra yard to have him turn up at the races in good order."

A delighted Kerry Parker confirmed post-race that a return to Randwick for the G1 Queen Elizabeth S. on April 13 remains the target, adding that Think It Over will likely step up to 2000 metres for the G1 Ranvet S. in between.

#### **Pedigree Notes**

One of the 56 stakes winners (and 11 Group 1 winners) for his Coolmore Stud-based star sire, Think It Over is a homebred for Bylong Park out of the unraced Personal Service (Aus) (Zabeel {NZ}) who has produced another three winners.

A half-sister to the Group 1 gallopers Universal Prince (Aus) and Universal Queen (Aus) (Scenic {Ire}), Personal Service sadly died in 2022 with her final foal being the yet-to-race Denis Pagan trained 4-year-old Normie No Show (Aus) (Exosphere {Aus}).

Able to count amongst his relations the big-race winners Blevic (Aus) and Krone (Aus) (Eurozone {Aus}), Think It Over is line-bred to the wonderful mares Special (Forli {Arg}), Lalun (Djeddah {Fr}) and Perfume II (GB) (Badruddin {Fr})--and he is a descendant of the latter's influential third dam Marchetta (GB) (Marco {GB}).

#### TROPICAL SHOWS TENACITY

First-up against plenty of race-fit opposition, **Tropical Squall** (Aus) (Prized Icon {Aus}) produced a mighty effort to grind out her second Group 1 victory in Saturday's Surround S., an often history-defining race for the 3-year-old fillies.

Pressed all the way to the line by **Stefi Magnetica (Aus)** (All Too Hard {Aus}), who was last seen running fourth in the G2 Light Fingers S., Tropical Squall held on to a 0.2l advantage at the line, with G1 Flight S. placegetter **Tutta La Vita (Aus)** (The Autumn Sun {Aus}) 1.6l away in third. Coolmore's Learning To Fly (Aus) (Justify), second in the Light Fingers, was edged out into fourth place.

Tropical Squall has been the headline horse for Kooringal Stud's second-season sire Prized Icon. After marking his first winner (in style) at Canterbury last June, she became his first Group 1 winner in the Flight S. this spring. Not bad for a filly that cost just A\$16,000 at the 2021 Magic Millions Gold Coast National Weanling Sale, sold from the draft of Bhima Thoroughbreds to Gooree Park Stud. That she's a homebred for Kooringal will make her success all the sweeter, and there may be more to come. Cont. p18

#### **G1** Surround S. Cont.

Although it wasn't upgraded to a Group 1 event until 2018, Gai Waterhouse's previous Surround S. victory in 2010 was a notable one. A champion the following season, it was More Joyous (NZ) (More Than Ready) who kicked off her Group 1 tally in the Flight S. before following up in the Surround, just like Tropical Squall, whose up-and-coming sire is a son of the same breed-shaping More Than Ready.

The now established partnership of Gai Waterhouse and Adrian Bott have been enjoying their best season since they joined forces in 2016. Striking at 21.5% winners to runners, this latest elite success puts them on five Group 1 winners for the season, matching 2021/22, whilst their prize-money haul has tipped over A\$20 million for the first time.

It's also been a defining season so far for winning jockey Adam Hyeronimus, who was winning his third Group 1 for the term.

"After winning the Flight S. we tried to go to the Oaks and that can be very difficult for 3-year-old fillies," he said. "... she came back and she really took some time to find her feet this preparation but her improvement... was very good.

"I wasn't happy with the conditions today [Saturday] but it just shows how good she is and what she had to overcome."

## SAVABEEL ORCHESTRATES HISTORIC SUCCESS WITH GROUP 1 WINNER #33

On a sensational Saturday in New Zealand, Waikato Stud's eight-time Champion Sire Savabeel (Aus) enjoyed remarkable success as he grabbed his 33rd individual Group 1 winner. Cont. p19

#### **G1 NZ Derby Cont.**

Savabeel sired his first G1 New Zealand Derby winner as his exceptional daughter **Orchestral (NZ)**, trained by Roger James and Robert Wellwood, dominated the field at Ellerslie to claim her maiden Group 1 victory. She became the first filly to win a New Zealand Derby since Silent Achiever (NZ) (O'Reilly {NZ}), who was also trained by Roger James, and triumphed in 2012. Orchestral, a recent winner of the G2 Avondale Guineas by a considerable margin, had previously claimed the R. Listed Karaka Millions 3YO Classic.

#### **Pedigree Notes**

She is the second foal from the O'Reilly (NZ) mare Symphonic (NZ), who placed in the G2 Cuddle S. Symphonic's Savabeel colt fetched NZ\$310,000 at the 2024 New Zealand Bloodstock National Yearling Sale at Karaka, purchased by the Hong Kong Jockey Club.

Orchestral herself was a NZ\$625,000 acquisition by her trainers from the draft of Haunui Farm at the 2022 New Zealand Bloodstock National Yearling Sale.

Earlier in the Ellerslie program, Savabeel celebrated his 141st stakes winner as the Mark Walker and Sam Bergerson-trained Certainly (NZ) claimed victory in the G3 Mufhasa S., donning the Waikato Stud colours.

One of the 141 stakes winners--and the 33rd Group 1 winner--for her Waikato Stud-based sire, she is the first live foal for her Group 3-placed, four-times-winning dam Symphonic (NZ) (O'Reilly {NZ}) who foaled another Savabeel filly last spring -again served by him.

Symphonic is out of a half-sister to the G1 Ellerslie Sires' Produce S. winner Good Faith (NZ) (Straight Strike), dam of the stakes winners Tully Dane (Aus) and Mygoodgrace (Aus) (Royal Academy).

Symphonic's dam is also the granddam of last weekend's G3 Matamata Slipper winner Savaglee (NZ) (Savabeel {Aus}).

Other members of this prolific family include the Group 1 gallopers Aegon (NZ) (Sacred Falls {NZ}), Daffodil (NZ) (No Excuse Needed {GB}) and Atishu (NZ) (Savabeel {Aus}) who won the G2 Blamey S. at Flemington later in the day.
