GII Risen Star S. runner up Track Phantom (Quality Road) headlines the field for Saturday's GII TwinSpires.com Louisiana Derby at Fair Grounds. The race draw also named the GIII Lecomte S. winner, who will break widest of the field in gate 12, as the 3-1 morning-line favorite. Two of the runners, Triple Espresso (Omaha Beach) and 'TDN Rising Star' Agate Road (Quality Road), are also cross-entered into Saturday's GIII Jeff Ruby Steaks at Turfway Park.

NEWGATE FIRES BULLET FOR DUBAI WORLD CUP

Newgate (Into Mischief), recent winner of the GI Santa Anita H., was one of nine American horses to turn in breezes Saturday morning both domestically and abroad in advance of the Dubai World Cup meeting at Meydan Racecourse in two weeks' time.

An \$850,000 Keeneland September yearling, Newgate returned to the worktab for the first time since the Mar. 3 Big 'Cap, covering five furlongs in a bullet :58.20 (1/77) in the company of GIII Native Diver S. winner Mr Fisk (Arrogate) at Santa Anita. Frankie Dettori, who won his fourth World Cup aboard the Bob Baffert-trained Country Grammer (Tonalist) in 2022, has the riding assignment in the \$12-million feature.

Stablemate Hopkins (Quality Road) went five-eighths of a mile in :58.80 (2/77) and will have Luis Saez aboard for the G1 Dubai Golden Shaheen, a race in which he was beaten just one length into fourth in 2023.

"We had a great day breezing," trainer Bob Baffert told SF Racing's Tom Ryan, who added, "Two healthy and happy horses. We look forward to getting them to Dubai with Jimmy and Humberto "Beto" to acclimate them to the Meydan surface and surroundings. It's very exciting, and we are very grateful to have the caliber of horse to get invited to participate in such valuable and prestigious events." Cont. Pg. 3

Also turning in a work at Santa Anita was **Two Rivers Over** (Tamarkuz), who covered five furlongs in 1:00.40 (19/77) and is expected for the G2 Godolphin Mile, an event won by his sire in 2015. Trainer Doug O'Neill has tabbed Edwin Maldonado to ride.

Crupi (Curlin) will attempt to give trainer Todd Pletcher a maiden victory in the World Cup and the 4-year-old, third to National Treasure (Quality Road) and Senor Buscador (Mineshaft) when last seen in the GI Pegasus World Cup Invitational S. Jan. 27, went five furlongs in 1:00.91 (1/7) at Palm Beach Downs Saturday morning. Luis Saez, who guided Crupi to victory in Saratoga allowance company last summer, made the trip up to breeze Crupi and has the mount at Meydan.

Jose D'Angelo breezed his two big-night entries about 10 miles north of Palm Beach Downs at Palm Meadows. **Caramel Chip** (Midshipman), fourth to **Sibelius** (Not This Time) in the Feb. 10 Pelican S. at Tampa, was the fastest of 92 workers going a halfmile as he stopped the clock in :47.45. While he stretches out in distance for he Godolphin Mile, his Gulfstream Park Sprintwinning stablemate **Run Classic** (Runhappy) will take on defending champ Sibelius in the Golden Shaheen. The Tom Durant galloper went in :48.95 (22/92). D'Angelo reports that Cristian Demuro rides Caramel Chip, while Florent Geroux will hop aboard Run Classic.

Casa Creed (Jimmy Creed) has been doing the bulk of his training towards the G1 Al Quoz Sprint on the turf, but he turned in his final piece of work over the dirt course at Payson Park. The 8-year-old breezed a half-mile in :49.20 (11/63), with part-owner Lee Einsidler commenting, "He went great and he's doing fantastic."

A pair of U.S.-trained horses who made the short trip over to Dubai after placing in races on the Saudi Cup program were out over the Meydan main track Saturday morning. **Cont.**



Saudi Crown (Always Dreaming), third to Senor Buscador in the G1 Saudi Cup, went a half-mile under the lights in a reported :48.50. He takes on defending champion **Isolate** (Mark Valeski) in the Godolphin Mile. **Bold Journey** (Hard Spun) went a similar distance in a reported :48.46 after daybreak for trainer Bill Mott. The New York-bred faces a rematch with Japan's **Remake (Jpn)** (Lani) in the Golden Shaheen after closing nicely for third to that rival in the G3 Riyadh Dirt Sprint Feb. 24.

Pandagate (Arrogate), last-out winner of the Gander S. at Aqueduct works Sunday at Payson Park towards a potential appearance in the G2 UAE Derby, per assistant trainer Miguel Clement.

With its namesake looking on after leading the field to post, the GIII Whitmore S. lived up to its billing with a thrilling photo finish separating the top pair. Upset-minded '**TDN Rising Star**' Jaxon Traveler lasted in the last jump to the wire to hold off a charging **Tejano Twist**, awarding trainer Steve Asmussen his 111st Oaklawn stakes win.

Heading into his 6-year-old season off a significant layoff last year, Jaxon Traveler earned wins in two of his last three, even matching his career-best 97 Beyer Speed Figure in a 5 1/2length romp in the Zia Sprint S. to end 2023. Doing his best running on the lead, the 5-1 shot entered off a gate-to-wire win in the B Thomas Memorial S. Feb. 18 after coming up empty two back in the King Cotton S. over course and distance Feb. 3.

Breaking from the far outside facing four rivals, Jaxon Traveler broke in a line with two inner speed horses with all three runners immediately forming a calvary charge on the lead. Flavien Prat opted to take the 6-year-old back just a bit into the far turn, letting Ryvit and Suveillance (Constitution) go on with it through an opening quarter in :22.41. Still three across the track as they swung into the stretch, Jaxon Traveler edged up the widest of the three, turned back his two rivals to the inside and just lasted ahead of a charging Tejano Twist to earn his second graded-stakes win. **Cont.**

"Watching it live, obviously, I was hoping that he held on like he did," said Asmussen. "But definitely a big sigh of relief when [they] put his number up."

Pedigree Note:

A son of leading sprint sire Munnings, Jaxon Traveler is out of the stakes-placed dam Listen Boy who holds a 100% strike rate in foals to race and winners with six apiece. The most accomplished of his siblings, the Steve Asmussen trainee was a \$140,000 OBS April buy in 2020 and has rewarded owner West Point Thoroughbreds with career earnings over \$891,000. Listen Boy's last reported offspring is a 2-year-old Liam's Map colt but she was bred to a son of Munnings, Jack Christopher, for a 2024 foal.

To quote Frank Mirahmadi's race call, The Chosen Vron is simply "a legendary Cal-bred". The 6-year-old picked up his 16th win from 21 starts Saturday with an easy front-running victory in the GIII San Carlos S.

Making his first start back in graded company since have to settle for fifth in the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint last November, the 2-5 favorite returned to listed stakes and picked up back-to-back wins by clear margins facing state-breds in both the Cary Grant S. and the California Cup Sprint S. most recently Jan. 13.

Now racing in his fourth season, The Chosen Vron was a no surprise favorite and broke on top from the rail to establish a lead just inside of Elwood Blues who struggled to keep up in the opening furlongs. Under an easy hold into the far turn as the half went in a sharp :44.42, The Chosen Vron began to outrun his rivals and swept past the quarter marker alone. Only a game run from Ghost of Midnight along the fence kept the race from being a blowout as the winner hit the wire in a nice final time of 1:20.96.

"He's keeping me in the game, I'm in my 70's now and you start wondering when it would be a good time to throw it in but as long as he's around, I'm in," said winning trainer Eric Kruljac. "He just leaves us all in awe. In the barn and in the mornings, he is just all class. I never would have dreamed I would have a horse of his caliber that just keeps going. I've had some good, almost brilliant horses that lasted for a while but not like this."

Pedigree Note:

The Chosen Vron is one of 14 stakes winners for his sire Vronsky. Tiz Molly, a half-sister to the stakes-placed Modacious (Uncle Mo), has produced fillies by Clubhouse Ride in 2022-23. Modacious, in foal to Quality Road, sold for \$600,000 at the 2019 Keeneland November sale. The Chosen Vron's third dam, Deputy's Delight, produced multiple graded stakes winner Delightful Kiss (Kissin Kris), as well as Canadian champion Delightful Mary (Limehouse). Tiz Molly returned to Clubhouse Ride for 2024.

ENDLESSLY LEADS FIELD OF 12 IN JEFF RUBY STEAKS

MGSW **Endlessly** (Oscar Performance) will ship to Kentucky to take on 11 rivals in Saturday's GIII Jeff Ruby Steaks, a 100-point race on the Road to the Kentucky Derby. Named the 5-2 morning-line favorite, Endlessly last took the El Camino Real Derby to get back in the winner's circle off his only career defeat came in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf. Turfway Park's signature race drew 14 total entries for 12 spots including two runners who are cross-entered into the GII TwinSpires.com Louisiana Derby also on Saturday.

Other entries in the field include: Freedom Principle (Flameaway) (30-1), Dancing Groom (Vino Rosso) (15-1), Lucky Jeremy (Lookin At Lucky) (15-1), Noted (Cairo Prince) (15-1), 'TDN Rising Star' Agate Road (Quality Road) (4-1), Northern Flame (Flameaway) (5-1), Woodcourt (Ransom the Moon) (6-1), Otello (Curlin) (10-1), Seize the Grey (Arrogate) (6-1), Endlessly (Oscar Performance) (5-2), Baytown Chatterbox (Street Sense) (30-1) and West Saratoga (Exaggerator) (20-1). FOUNTAIN OF YOUTH RUNNER UP LE DOM BRO CONFIRMED FOR FLORIDA DERBY

Le Dom Bro (Mucho Macho Man) will train towards a start in the GI Curlin Florida Derby, his connections announced Saturday. The GII Coolmore Fountain of Youth S. runner up worked a half mile in :49 4/5 Saturday morning at Palm Meadows. "He went really well," said owner Vincente Stella. "We are looking at the Florida Derby 100 percent. He's a very happy horse. He's going really well."

The winner of the Fountain of Youth, **Dornoch** (Good Magic), also worked a half mile Saturday morning in :49 4/5 and will start next in either the Florida Derby or the GI Toyota Blue Grass S. for Danny Gargan.

MATANZAS CREEK EUTHANIZED FOLLOWING SANTA ANITA ALLOWANCE

Matanzas Creek, a 4-year-old son of Empire Maker, crossed the line first as the 4-5 favorite in a six-furlong allowance at Santa Anita Park Saturday afternoon, but fell about 50 yards past the wire and was later euthanized, the first equine fatality reported in a race at Santa Anita in nearly a year. Tom Ryan, representing part-owner SF Racing, confirmed the news in a tweet about an hour after the race.

Initial reports indicated that the colt walked onto the horse ambulance and was taken to the barn of trainer Tim Yakteen to be evaluated further. Frankie Dettori emerged from the incident with no serious injuries, but took off his mounts for the remainder of the afternoon. It was Santa Anita's first racing fatality in 363 days, the prior occurring Mar. 18, 2023.

"Matanzas Creek sustained irreparable injuries to his right front fetlock," read Ryan's tweet. "It's a heartbreaking decision to make, but he was euthanized on site. Our hearts go out to the horse and the people who adored and cared for him. Thankfully, Frankie walked away from this tragedy."

Bred in Kentucky by Betz, Burns, Kidder, Cole, D J Stables, CoCo and the Empire Maker Syndicate, Matanzas Creek won at second asking at Del Mar last November and was second in consecutive first-level allowance races at Santa Anita, going a mile Dec. 29 and 6 1/2 furlongs Feb. 15.

In addition to SF Racing, the other partners include Starlight Racing, Madaket Stables LLC, Robert E Masterson, Stonestreet Stables LLC, Jay A Schoenfarber, Waves Edge Capital LLC and Catherine Donovan. Share this story

LONGTIME NYRA EMPLOYEE MICHAEL PRUNETTI DIES AT 77

Michael F. Prunetti, a veteran NYRA employee, passed away March 15 at the age of 77. Remembered by some of his NYRA colleagues in a note released Saturday, Prunetti spent over 40 years as a racing official around New York tracks including time as the Assistant Racing Secretary.

"What a kind gentleman he was," recalled NYRA Stakes Coordinator Andrew Byrnes. "Mike took the time to teach me how to do things the right way. I learned a tremendous amount under him. He was one of the best. He was a jewel."

Prunetti retired to Florida where he continued to volunteer his time until his passing.

"Mike was also a genuinely nice guy, loved the game and loved people," said Peter McGivney, a fellow NYRA racing official. "Everybody thought the world of him."



On hold until the quarter pole, Stay Hot responded when asked and poked his head in front at the sixteenth marker. He was able to get up in the shadow of the wire.

"He's very versatile, he makes it really exciting. Antonio Fresu does ride an amazing race," said Eurton.

Cutting back a furlong after finishing runner-up in the Feb. 17 Ruthless S., the bay was away from stall one without incident, but was beaten for speed by Reconcile (War Front). Manny Franco elected to take a tug on Ghalia Princess, easing her back and into the two path to do the chasing through an opening quarter in :22.15. Content to race with that target ahead of her rounding the turn, Ghalia Princess began to pour on the pressure into the stretch, claimed the front-runner for good with about a furlong and a half to travel and was punched out hands and heels to take it by six lengths in a sharp clocking.

"They broke good and I thought it was the right call to let [Reconcile] go on," said Dustin Dugas, assistant to trainer Brad Cox. "I thought she [Ghalia Princess] ran on and let her big stride kind of unfold the way it does and [didn't] press her too much. It kind of went the way we thought. I didn't think she'd be quite as quick to keep up with these guys, but she could if she was pressed. I think Manny [Franco] made the right call by just letting the race unfold the way it did."

Oussama Aboughazale's International Equities Holdings acquired the winner's dam for \$600,000 as a weanling at the 2014 Keeneland November sale and she became a three-time winner at the races, including the 2017 Sunland Park Oaks. Ghalia is a daughter of Grade III winner Verdana Bold--also the dam of the multiple stakes-placed Copperplate (Curlin)--and is represented by a yearling colt by Constitution. CHELTENHAM WAS ALWAYS ABOUT THE HORSES AND BRITAIN HAS LOST GROUND

When I started covering the Cheltenham Festival in the late 1980s it was still a place of myth and legend: whiskey priests, all-night card schools, hopeful (but not expectant) Irish pilgrimages, farmers with chances of winning a race and wince-inducing whip-use up the hill.

It was a place chiefly for aficionados--the county set and jump racing hardcore, leavened with once-a-year urban tweedies who loved the racing and knew what it meant to watch Dawn Run win both a Champion Hurdle and Gold Cup.

A place, in other words, for disciples, with newsworthy battles between rails bookmakers and big hitters, which the outside world peered at excitedly but fleetingly. The Cheltenham Festival made the front pages because it was edgy, rooted, fragrant, intense and magical. It united the human and animal kingdoms like no other sport. The Grand National was a national ritual, but it didn't shine a light on our culture the way Cheltenham did. **Cont. p3**

HAYA ZARK CRUISES TO VICTORY IN SAINT-CLOUD FEATURE by Sean Cronin

Preceded by a trio of sophomore Listed contests on the card, Saturday's G3 Prix Exbury at Saint-Cloud went the way of last year's three-length winner **Haya Zark (Fr)** (Zarak {Fr}--Haya City {Fr}, by Elusive City), who handled bottomless conditions at the Paris track and cruised to an easy 1 1/2-length victory from 50-1 Polish raider **Gryphon (Ire)** (Vadamos {Fr}).

The 53-10 chance also bagged 2023's G3 Prix d'Hedouville and was dropped down to this 10-furlong trip for the first time since last term's heroics at this venue coming back off unplaced efforts in ParisLongchamp's G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe and G1 Prix Royal-Oak.

Haya Zark was positioned in a stalking second from flagfall and went wide with the six-strong field off the home turn. Launching his challenge on the bridle passing the quarter-mile marker, he swooped for control underneath the stands' side rail at the 300metre pole--with rider Christophe Soumillon sitting motionless in the plate--and toyed with long-time leader Gryphon inside the final furlong to easily assert superiority in untroubled fashion.

"I dreamt he could do it again after last year and he did," said owner-breeder Odette Fau. "He had his ground, he was fresh and he won very well." **Cont. p4**

We've come a long way since then. The modern Cheltenham is entertainment industry giant, mass market day out, commercial

behemoth, and these days, a place of plunder for Irish yards, principally that of Willie Mullins, who won nine of this year's 27 races, including the two defining events with State Man (Champion Hurdle) and Galopin Des Champs (Gold Cup).

More than ever, Cheltenham is subject to modern economic reality. On the track we see a concentration of power into a few hands and a switch to recruitment, scouting and academy-based success. This, aside from the training skill, is the foundation of Mullins'

our colleagues in Ireland, and in particular one yard.....

"However, the Irish domination of the Grade 1 races this week has illustrated that the issue is becoming more pronounced and more damaging for the sport on both sides of the Irish sea.

"Put simply, the rate of decline of Jump racing in Britain at the top end has outstripped the measures that have been put in place to tackle it. We must do more, more quickly, and in a more coordinated and decisive manner if we are going to restore British Jump racing to the standing at which it belongs."

> In other words--it's an emergency. Off the track meanwhile Cheltenham can no longer expect legions of revellers to arrive on autopilot. Like the Ryder Cup in golf, the Festival became drunk on the notion of infinite expansion and untouchable popularity. To the addicted, the last race on Friday triggers a kind of melancholia about the length of the wait for the next Festival to come around. But not even the imperishable charm of that great Cotswold playground can guarantee its survival as an

success--a pre-emptive odds-loading in his favour. An astonishing tally of 103 Festival winners suggests Mullins's networking has caught many of his rivals cold.

Ireland's latest training win over GB yards by 18-9 in the Prestbury Cup has caused alarm at the British Horseracing Authority, whose chief executive Julie Harrington said in a statement the morning after the Gold Cup...

"I have no doubt that the men and women who train horses here in Britain are more than a match for their Irish counterparts. However, they need the ammunition and at present the balance of power and the best horses are going to



annual must-go event.

First, the experience. Muddy and gridlocked car parks are not to the modern consumer's taste. Nor is a £7.50 pint you have to queue for 20 minutes to get. Nor is a lack of places to sit. Nor, you might argue, are small fields or the Mullins dominance. It's hard to disentangle anxiety about Cheltenham's importance as a shop window from wider worries about the health of National Hunt racing.

Cheltenham is not to blame for much of this. Climate change and £700 hotel room rates are not their fault. Sport's post-Covid spike is over. **Cont. p4**

The racecourse is promising to freeze ticket prices and stop car parks becoming swamps. They insist there is "no complacency."

Grumbles about the cost of food and drink can be heard across all British sports. And each pays a price for the shambles that our rail network has become. Cost of living pressures are not just Radio 4 news headlines. They force choices on people: what to stick with, what to give up.

In that context the drop in attendance at this year's Festival was relatively modest. Crowds were down 11,000 from 240,603 in 2023 to 229,370 this year. But if the lesson is that Cheltenham will have to sing for its supper like every other major sporting event then the signs of a downturn in public interest may turn out to be cathartic.

There is a deeply optimistic note in what we saw this year. For some, Cheltenham is about the gambling, drinking, eating and cavorting. For my money it was always about the horses. The romance end of the market survives. Fiona Needham winning the Foxhunters' with a \pounds 2,400 horse (Sine Nomine) 22 years after she won the race as a jockey was a throwback tale.

And for all the misgivings about Cheltenham becoming the Willie Mullins show, he sent some magnificent horses out for our entertainment: State Man, Ballyburn, Fact To File and above all Galopin Des Champs, whose victory in the hundredth anniversary Gold Cup was a thing of beauty. That's what Cheltenham is, right there.

Trainer Adrien Fouassier expanded, "He loves this extreme ground, and a left-handed course, and he had a dream trip with a lead. He can be keen between horses, but when he is in the clear, like today, he is much more relaxed. In the straight he quickened as if he were on fast ground and it was amazing. We made mistakes with him last year, running on fast ground and over too long a trip, but there will be no such mistakes this year. The weather will dictate where we run."

Ramadan backed up a Sept. 28 breakthrough win at Chantilly with a fourth over course and distance in October's G1 Criterium de Saint-Cloud and stepped forward to secure a career high on seasonal return here. Positioned second after racing on the lead through the early strides, he eased to the front hard on the steel soon after passing the quarter-mile marker and extended clear in effortless fashion to easily outpoint last term's G3 Prix Francois Boutin victor Grey Man by an unextended five lengths.

"I am not surprised to see him win so easily even though I was a bit nervous beforehand," admitted trainer Christopher Head. "He is among my best 3-year-old colts and, after being fourth in a Group 1 last year, it is very satisfactory to see him produce this performance. We might keep him over a mile for the time being or stretch out to nine furlongs. I will discuss the future with the owner and a decision will be made in time."

Ramadan is the sixth of seven foals and one of two scorers out of a winning full-sister to G1 Pretty Polly S. heroine Chinese White (Ire) (Dalakhani {Ire}) and G3 Royal Whip S. third Highly Toxic (Ire) (Dalakhani {Ire}). "Bright Picture's earlier performances can't be faulted, but the question mark today was the [very heavy] ground," said racing manager Pierre-Yves Bureau. "He won on good ground first time and his second win was on the all-weather surface. He is an uncomplicated horse but, being a gelding, he has fewer options. Nevertheless, if he comes out of this race well he will run in a Group 3 race next time."

MAURICE COLT LANDS FALCON STAKES

Danox, Inc.'s **Danon McKinley (Jpn)** (Maurice {Jpn}) rallied to win the G3 Chunichi Sports Sho Falcon S. at Chukyo on Saturday. It was the first stakes victory for the son of G1 1000 Guineas heroine Homecoming Queen (Ire) (Holy Roman Emperor {Ire}).

Fourth last through the early going as **Orchid Romance (Jpn)** (Roger Barows {Jpn}) led, the 12-1 shot was able to relax behind a rapid pace, with the first 1000 metres reached in :57 flat. He gathered himself on the turn and fanned out into the centre of the course at the 400-metre mark. Making up ground with every stride, Danon McKinley ground past the G2 Keio Hai Nisai S. third and won by a half-length. It was two lengths back to **Sonshi** (**Ire**) (Night Of Thunder {Ire}), who had enjoyed a stalking trip for much of this contest.

First in both a newcomer affair at Hanshin in September and in a Kyoto allowance in November, Danon McKinley was eighth to Jantar Mantar (Jpn) (Palace Malice) in the G1 Asahi Hai Futurity S. a month later. Wheeled back in the Jan. 27 Listed Crocus S., he improved to fifth over this trip in Tokyo.

Pedigree Notes

Danon McKinley is the 26th stakes winner worldwide (18th group) for Shadai Stallion Station's Maurice, who also shuttles to Arrowfield Stud in Australia. The 13-year-old son of Screen Hero (Jpn) was Japanese Horse of the Year, Champion Sprinter and Champion Miler in Japan in 2015. His quintet of top-level winners include Australian three-time Group 1 winner Hitotsu (Aus), while Jack D'Or (Jpn) won the G1 Osaka Hai, Mazu claimed the G1 Doomben 10,000 back in Oz, Geraldina (Jpn) struck in the G1 Queen Elizabeth II Cup and Pixie Knight (Jpn) prevailed in the G1 Sprinters S.

2012 G1 1000 Guineas heroine Homecoming Queen left five Galileo (Ire) foals in Ireland with a record of four winners from four runners and three stakes horses. The best of these was Shale (Ire), who won the G1 Moyglare Stud S. and Berkeley Square (Ire), who was third in the G2 Futurity S. Acquired privately by Japanese interests, Homecoming Queen foaled the 4-year-old winner Irish Pearl (Jpn) (Saxon Warrior {Jpn}). Next is the ¥220,000,000 JRHA Select yearling and Falcon S. hero, who has a juvenile half-sister by Kizuna (Jpn) and a yearling halfbrother by Epiphaneia (Jpn). In 2023, Homecoming Queen--a half-sister to Group 1 winners Dylan Thomas (Ire) (Danehill) and Queen's Logic (Ire) (Grand Lodge)--visited Japanese Triple Crown winner Contrail (Jpn).

DURAMENTE FILLY EARNS FLOWERS AT

The late Duramente (Jpn) continues to pad his stallion resume, and his **Mi Anhelo (Jpn)** claimed the spoils in the 1800-metre G3 Flower Cup at Nakayama on Saturday.

Sent off as the 5-2 second choice behind **Cantiamo (Jpn)** (Epiphaneia {Jpn}), the Silk Racing colourbearer found an ideal tracking position while glued to the fence, as **Elf Struck (Jpn)** (California Chrome) showed the way under mild pressure. Content to rate in midfield, Mi Anhelo began to wind up with 600 metres remaining while still saving every inch of real estate on the fence. Cued in upper stretch, she swung off the inside and burst past Elf Struck to take over inside the furlong pole. Strong to the line, she had built up enough cushion to repel the late charge of **Hohelied (Jpn)** (Rulership {Jpn}), with Cantiamo a neck back in third with the first six home tightly bunched.

Mi Anhelo donned cap and gown over this course and distance when unveiled in September, and closed to take fifth as the favourite in a blanket finish in the Nanohana Sho on Jan. 13, her 3-year-old bow.

Pedigree Notes

The much-lamented Duramente, posthumous champion sire in his native land last year, has his final crop of 3-year-olds this year. Mi Anhelo is his first stakes winner from that group, while he has 18 stakes winners worldwide (14 group) so far lifetime. Six of his progeny have landed Group 1 races, and Japanese Triple Tiara heroine Liberty Island (Jpn) is a leading fancy for the upcoming G1 Dubai Sheema Classic later this month.

The winner is a half to Frankel (GB) 'TDN Rising Star' Mi Suerte (Jpn) who won the G3 Fantasy S. in Japan. Originally a \$1.7million Keeneland November weanling, Mi Sueno won both the GIII Sorrento S. and GI Debutante S. as a juvenile. Since being purchased for \$1.9 million out of the Fasig-Tipton November Sale in 2013 by Katsumi Yoshida, Mi Sueno has produced eight foals in Japan, with six winners to show for it. Her latest runnerto-be is Shonan Xanadu (Jpn) (Kizuna {Jpn}), who just turned two, while she also has a Real Steel (Jpn) yearling colt and was covered by American Horse of the Year Bricks And Mortar last spring.

Second dam Madcap Escapade (Hennessy) claimed the GI Ashland S., four other graded races and ran third in the 2004 GI Kentucky Oaks. She, in turn, is a half-sister to GI Ballerina Breeders' Cup S. victress Dubai Escapade (Awesome Again).

Zougotcha (Aus) (Zoustar {Aus})'s second Group 1 win in the G1 Coolmore Classic at Rosehill on Saturday made it 90 Group 1 wins for jockey James McDonald as he took his first victory in the race. She tracked up the middle of the Rosehill course, digging deep to hold on to the lead by 0.4l from **Semana (Aus)** (Winning Rupert {Aus}), with **Kimochi (Aus)** (Brave Smash {Jpn}) the same distance away back in third.

Trainer Chris Waller admitted to making a mistake with the 4-year-old mare's campaign, telling *RSN* after the race, "I tried to make her sprint and got it wrong.

"She has won a (G1) Flight S., she's now won a Coolmore and I'm sure there's more to come," added Waller, who just a day previously had announced that another of his stable's star mares, Fangirl (Aus) (Sebring {Aus}), was ruled out of the Autumn Carnival through injury.

Winner of seven of her 14 starts with earnings over A\$1.7 million, Zougotcha had three starts in the spring over sprinting distances for a fourth and two sixth placings. **Cont. p11**

Widden Stud, also the co-breeders of Zougotcha with RMA Bloodstock Trust, remain in the partnership of owners led by Noel Greenhalgh and enjoyed a fruitful day all round as their first-season sire Zousain (Aus) earned his first stakes winner in the G3 Magic Night S. earlier in the day. They stand Zoustar, who now has 49 stakes winners.

She is one of three stakes winners for her dam, the stakes-placed, triple city winner Fast Talker (Aus) (Fastnet Rock {Aus}) whose dam is the Listed winner Crystal Wit (Aus) (Distorted Humor).

HISTORY WRITTEN IN NEW ZEALAND OAKS

Last-start G2 Lowland S. winner **Pulchritudinous (NZ)** made it look easy when winning the G1 New Zealand Oaks at Trentham on Saturday. Trained by Chad Ormsby and ridden by Warren Kennedy, Pulchritudinous became the first Group 1 winner for her sire Wrote (Ire), a GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf S.-winning son of High Chaparral (Ire).

Sold by Milan Park at the 2022 New Zealand Bloodstock National Yearling Sale for NZ\$32,500 to Ormsby's Riverrock Farm, Pulchritudinous was passed in at the 2022 New Zealand Bloodstock Ready to Run Sale 10 months later. Her first two dams are non-winners, while the third dam is 2-year-old winner Market Fair (Biscay), dam of G2 Silver Slipper winner Kenfair (NZ).

Once a Group 1-winning jockey himself, Orsmby now trains a small string and juggles that with his Riverrock Farm outfit, and even won a bull-riding competition on Saturday morning--a truly multi-talented rider!

"Things like a Group 1 win are what we strive for," Ormsby said. "I really can't thank my team enough. The people on the ground make it all possible. "We're only a small team, around five racehorses, but we bat above our weight and I'm so grateful to the people around us."

In case you were wondering, vocabulary.com defines Pulchritudinous as: "Even though it looks (and sounds) like it would describe a disease or a bad attitude, pulchritudinous actually describes a person of breathtaking, heartbreaking... beauty." **Cont. p12**

Pedigree Notes

Bred by Tony Rider, she is one of the three stakes winners-and the first Group 1 winner--for her Highview-based sire, a G1 Breeders Cup Juvenile Turf-winning son of High Chaparral (Ire).

Sold by Rider's Milan Park to Riverrock Farm for NZ\$32,500 at the 2022 New Zealand Bloodstock Karaka Yearling Sale (Book 2), Pulchritudinous was again offered at that year's Ready to Run where she was passed in with a reserve of NZ\$50,000.

Her dam, the unplaced Showus (NZ) (Pentire {GB}), has also produced the Happy Valley winner Double Show (NZ) (Showcasing {GB}). She is one of only two foals for the unplaced Perfect Pair (NZ) (Redoute's Choice {Aus}), a half-sister to the triple Group winner Kenfair (NZ).

Showus's city-winning granddam Market Fair (Aus) (Biscay {Aus}) is a full-sister to Marscay (Aus) and this is also the family of the Group 1 gallopers Subzero (Aus) (Kala Dancer {GB}) and Alacrity (NZ) (Grosvenor {NZ}).

Not served last spring, Showus foaled fillies by Ardrossan (Aus) at each of her previous three years at stud with the first of those being named Fillygizalook (NZ)--a recent trial winner retained by Tony Rider.

Pulchritudinous is the sixth stakes winner and third Group 1 winner (from 41 winners/61 runners) combining High Chaparral and Pentire (GB)--a cross which provides for the duplication of the terrific mares Lalun (Djeddah {Fr}) and Hardiemma (Ire) (Hardicanute {Ire}).
