CATCHING FREEDOM LAST-TO-FIRST WITH LOUISIANA DERBY WIN

Eyeballing the quarter pole in Saturday's GII Louisiana Derby, it may have seemed that the Albaugh Family's Catching Freedom (Constitution) had far too much to do to even get a piece of it. However, what seemed like a foregone conclusion to some proved nothing more than an fleeting illusion as the colt closed by leaps and bounds to get up just in time to win by a length, earning 100 Kentucky Derby points and moving him into first on the Derby leaderboard with 125 points.

Breaking from the 12 hole, GIII Lecomte S. scorer Track Phantom (Quality Road) was ushered to the front as **Common Defense** (Karakontie {Jpn}) prompted him through opening splits of :23.49 and :48.33 as Catching Freedom lingered at the back under first-time pilot Flavien Prat. Starting to gain ground while several paths wide approaching the final turn, he was fanned out no less than seven paths wide as the field constricted up front. Closing with purpose down the center of the track, he put his head in front in the stages before drawing clear to put himself squarely in the Kentucky Derby picture. Last season's GII Kentucky Jockey Club victor Honor Marie (Honor Code) got up for second while **Tuscan Gold** (Medaglia d'Oro) completed the trifecta. The 2-1 favorite Track Phantom finished fourth. TARIFA CONTINUES MARCH TO LOUISVILLE WITH FAIR GROUNDS OAKS WIN

Godolphin's Tarifa (Bernardini) extended her win streak to three with a professional score in Saturday's GII Fair Grounds Oaks. Installed the 3-2 choice ahead of GII Golden Rod S. victress Intricate (Gun Runner), the Godolphin homebred broke well and wrestled her rider Flavien Prat into contention as 4-1 Our Pretty Woman (Medaglia d'Oro) led the way through a :23.84 quarter. Continuing to fight for her head through a half in :47.93, she was finally given some rein and duly responded, closing on the frontrunner turning for home. Taking over turning for home, the filly drifted out under a left handed encouragement down the lane but had enough to hold on to 3/4-length win over Our Pretty Woman. V V's Dream (Mitole) was a clear third over Accommodate Eva (Munnings). Second choice Intricate came home a well-beaten fifth as the 2-1 second choice. **Cont. p5**





"I didn't know what to make of it early on, being so far back and with not much pace, but Flavien did a great job of letting him inch up," said winning trainer Brad Cox, who also won the Fair Grounds Oaks with Tarifa. "He needed pretty much the entire stretch to get there. I am very proud of the effort. We'll make sure he is happy and healthy. We'll ship him up to Churchill; he broke his maiden there, so he knows the place. Hopefully, he can have a great six weeks and a big run the first Saturday in May."


Starting things off the right way, the \$575,000 Keeneland September buy came from off the pace to triumph by 1 3/4 lengths going a mile at Churchill Downs in October before returning to finish fourth while adding a sixteenth at that venue Nov. 9. Favored to regain the winning thread next time in the Jan. 1 Smart Jones S., the bay obliged with a 2 1/2-length win over Just Steel. Let go at 5-1 in a sloppy edition of the GII Risen Star S. Feb. 17, he finished third behind Sierra Leone (Gun Runner) and Track Phantom.

Pedigree Notes:

Catching Freedom is the 31st graded winner for WinStar's Constitution, whose 64 black-type winners worldwide in just five crops have repeatedly kept him at or near the top of his contemporaries on the sire lists. The son of Tapit finished 2023 as the leading fifth-crop sire by stakes winners and went into the Louisiana Derby ranked in the current year's top dozen North American-based sires--regardless of number of crops--by earnings.

While Catching Freedom is Constitution's second stakes winner out a Pioneerof the Nile mare, Constitution has an additional two stakes winners--both graded--out of mares by Pioneerof the Nile's sire, Empire Maker, and a number of others out of daughters of at least two other sons of Unbridled. The late Pioneerof the Nile, who also stood at WinStar, has 13 black-type winners out of his daughters.

Catch My Drift, a stakes winner at Saratoga who finished third in the 2015 GI Beldame S. at Belmont Park, was a \$400,000 purchase by WinStar at the 2015 Fasig-Tipton November sale. The mare produced two stakes performers prior to Catching Freedom: last year's GIII Peter Pan S. and GIII Ohio Derby runner-up Bishops Bay (Uncle Mo), also a 'TDN Rising Star', and MSP Strava (Into Mischief), who was an \$825,000 Keeneland November weanling. She has a juvenile filly by Improbable named Indeed, who sold to Centennial Farms at Fasig-Tipton Saratoga for \$385,000, and a yearling filly by Not This Time.

"She showed some early speed but once we got to the first turn, she was very keen," explained Prat. "Then she relaxed well when we got to the backside and she made a nice run down the lane. It will be a different deal when there a re a lot of horses around her."

Unveiled at seven panels last October, the filly ran a similarly headstrong race early before running away with authority to post a six-length TDN Rising Star-earning performance at Keeneland. Fourth when favored next time while extending to a mile in a Churchill optional claimer Nov. 25, the dark bay bounced back to post a narrow score at the Fair Grounds Jan. 20. Sent off second choice to Intricate last time in the Rachel Alexandra, she proved best again on the day, defeating that rival by 2 3/4 lengths.

"I would like to tell you she is settling down and relaxing, but that didn't work out well in the first turn," said Brad Cox. "Still she was able to overcome it. She needs to learn to relax in the race, and obviously next time we will be facing an older field. She needs to learn to chill out and relax. She is still learning and I am proud of what she has accomplished this far. She is not a real big filly but she has handled everything we've asked from her and hopefully she steps forward."

Pedigree Notes:

The winner has an unraced juvenile full-sister named Josie's Girl in addition to a yearling brother by Knicks Go. Her dam was bred back to Lexitonian. Godolphin acquired Tarifa's second dam Tizdubai (Cee's Tizzy) for \$950,000 at Keeneland November shortly after her full-brother Tiznow recorded the second of his two consecutive wins in the 2001 Breeders' Cup Classic. She is also a full-sister to MGSW and Classic runner-up Budroyale.







Already an earner of over \$1.2 million, Red Route One padded his account further with a come-from-behind victory in Saturday's GII New Orleans Classic. Unhurried in the early going of the nine-furlong content, the 4-year-old settled near the back as Touchuponastar and Best Actor (Flatter) led through opening fractions of :23.16 and :46.87. Carving his way up along the inside under Joel Rosario through three quarters in 1:11.17, the Winchell hombred cut the corner in fourth turning for home, was taken to the outside to close on the weakening pacesetters midstretch and took over late en route to a two-length victory over Touchuponastar with Money Supply getting up for third.

Grade I placed at two, the chestnut won last season's GIII West Virginia Derby and Bath House Row S., in addition to finishing runner up in the GII Rebel S., GIII South West S. and GIII Oklahoma Derby. At the Fair Grounds, he kicked off 2024 with a second in the GIII Louisiana S. Jan. 20 before coming home fourth last time in a sloppy renewal of the GIII Mineshaft S. Feb. 17.

After knocking on the door with a career trio of runner-up finishes in graded events, including the GI Pegasus World Cup Turf Invitational S. last out, 'TDN Rising Star' I'm Very Busy hit one out of the park to capture a graded win of his own in the GII Muniz Memorial Classic S. at Fair Grounds. Stakes veteran and last summer's GII Secretariat S. winner Gigante held second, while GSW & MGISP Webslinger--who finished a few spots behind I'm Very Busy in the Pegasus--closed late for third.

Loading last and breaking from the outside 13th stall, I'm Very Busy immediately ducked to the inside to sit comfortably midpack as Strong Quality (Quality Road) showed the way up front through :22.80 and :47.33 early fractions. Eventual runner-up Gigante dogged Strong Quality from the inside before tipping out coming off the final turn and briefly looked to have the race sewn up, but I'm Very Busy made a monster move of his own as he launched an extremely wide assault. He flew down the middle of the course, perhaps looking a bit green as he swapped to his wrong lead and drifted in, but his momentum was so strong that jockey Irad Ortiz, Jr. was able to gear him down late and still finish 3 3/4-lengths to the best.

"It was hard with the post position," said Ortiz. "But we got lucky, saved some ground in the first turn. We wanted to be a little closer, but the horse made it look easy.

"He's always been nice. This year he's probably doing better since he has more experience. Chad [Brown] has loved this horse since day one, to be honest. He always told me to ride this horse because he is so nice, and he was right."

I'm Very Busy, picked up out of the 2022 OBS March sale by agent Lauren Carlisle for \$135,000 after he breezed a furlong in :10.2, got the 'TDN Rising Star' tag on debut at Saratoga and placed in the GII Pilgrim S. in his second start, only to lose his way in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf.

Off for eight months, he's slowly improved in each start since his return, getting his sole win as a sophomore in a Belmont at Aqueduct allowance last fall, then registering back-to-back runner-up finishes in the GII Hill Prince S. in November and the Pegasus Turf in January. His Pegasus also marked the first triple-digit Beyer Speed Figure (100) of his career.



After standing at Spendthrift in Kentucky during his initial years as a stallion, Cloud Computing transferred to Pennsylvania's Pin Oak Lane Farm for the 2024 season. Winner of the 2017 GI Preakness S., the son of Maclean's Music is responsible for six black-type winners split between the U.S and South America and two graded/group winners. I'm Very Busy, also one of 13 stakes winners out of a daughter of Kissin Kris, is Cloud Computing's first graded winner in North America.



Endlessly continued his near-perfect roll with an emphatic four-length victory in Turfway's GIII Jeff Ruby Steaks Saturday. The win gave the Amerman Racing homebred 100 points, good enough to place him in second behind GII Louisiana Derby scorer Catching Freedom on the Kentucky Derby leaderboard.

Lucky Jeremy (Lookin At Lucky) went to the front early, leading the field into the first turn through an initial quarter in :23.33. Meanwhile, Endlessly took up position toward the back under Umberto Rispoli, several lengths off the lead. Exiting the far turn, Lucky Jeremy continued to show the way as Northern Flame pushed the issue to his outside as West Saratoga mounted a three-wide move. Rispoli continued to bide his time while remaining in the clear, but his mount began to crank up the tempo noticeably approaching the home turn. Several paths wide straightening for home, Endlessly's momentum carried him past his rivals with ease and propelled him to a four-length victory over West Saratoga. Seize the Grey was third.



The winner of his first three career starts, including the GIII Del Mar Juvenile Turf and GIII Zuma Beach S., Endlessly closed out the year with an eighth in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf at Santa Anita. Making his synthetic bow at Golden Gate, he came home a 1 1/4-length winner in the Feb. 10 El Camino Real Derby.

"I just remained patient with the face pace in front of me," Rispoli said. "This was his second start on the Tapeta and I think he handled it much better today [than in the El Camino Real

Derby]. He was able to get into a much better rhythm. In the stretch he was just so powerful and continued to go strongly through the wire."

And while his performance thrust him squarely into the Derby mix with the 100 points earned for the win, trainer Michael McCarthy confirmed that the colt would likely run on Derby Day, but not in the Run For The Roses, but in the \$600,000 GII American Turf instead.

"This was a really solid effort but I think his best days down the road are on turf," McCarthy said. "I thought he sat a great trip today being just off a fast pace. He's a very nice colt and mentally has handled everything in stride. I think he has a very bright future ahead of him and he's already very accomplished in his young career."

The winner's dam Dream Fuhrever, who is out of French

import and SW Society Dream, is a half to the dam of the Amerman's GISW Coffee Clique (Medaglia d'Oro) and MGSW Admission Office (Point of Entry). With a dominating performance down the lane, 'TDN Rising Star' First Mission gained access to the special winner's enclosure reserved for stakes horses in Hot Springs when he took home the GIII Essex H. at Oaklawn Park on Saturday.

The Godolphin homebred earned his 'Rising Star' badge at second asking when he won by 6 3/4 lengths at Fair Grounds just over a year ago.

After collecting his first graded stakes victory in the GIII Lexingon S. a month later at Keeneland, the colt was off the Derby Trail and did not return to the races until the following October when he won facing optional claimers over the same surface. Missing by a nose in the GII Clark S. at Churchill Downs in late November, the dark bay last time out was well-beaten in the GI Pegasus World Cup Jan. 27.

Supported by the public as the even-money choice here, First Mission was forwardly-placed into the first turn as longshot Great Escape (Midnight Storm) tried to don the invisibility cloak. The 4-year-old, guided expertly by Florent Geroux, knew exactly where his mark was and what he had in reserve. Around the far turn, the homebred was ready for his big reveal. Striding confidently and switching leads like a professional past the eighth pole, the Brad Cox trainee trucked home a no-doubt winner.

Cellist got back in the winner's circle for the first time since 2022 and picked up his first graded-stakes score Saturday, taking the GIII Kentucky Cup Classic S. at Turfway Park. Successful on grass throughout his career, the son of Big Blue Kitten and Calumet homebred only recently tried the Tapeta, placing in both attempts over the local course including a narrow second two starts back behind MGSW Woflie's Dynaghost (Ghostzapper) in the Prairie Bayou S. Dec. 16. Swapped back to the turf last out, he came home third at 8-1 odds in Gulfstream's GIII William L. McKnight S. Jan. 27.

The 6-1 shot broke with the field and flashed a bit of early speed but was outrun by rivals on both sides and found himself fourth on the run into the first turn. Well positioned just off the rail, Cellist tipped out up the backstretch and began to inch up past a half in :48.59. Four across the track into the far turn, Luis Saez had his mount full of run and, once straightened up, Cellist produced a strong late kick to win going away in a strong effort.

Pedigree Note:

One of two stakes winners for Eclipse champion Big Blue Kitten, Cellist is out of a full-sister to MGSW/MGISP Optimizer (English Channel) and a half to MGSP Lady Zuzu (Dynaformer). That mare, a \$3.25m FTKNOV broodmare buy in 2016 for Wertheimer & Frere, would go on to produce G1 Hong Kong Vase winner Junko (GB) (Intello (Ger)). Cello has produced four winners from five to race but has not reported a foal since her now 4-year-old Thedutchess (Producer {GB}).



Missed the Cut made it two graded wins from two tries in 2024 with a facile victory Saturday in Santa Anita's GIII San Luis Rey S. as the even-money favorite. Chasing in third early on the inside as GSW Balladeer (Distorted Humor) showed the way through: 24.45 and: 48.66 fractions, Missed the Cut advanced to track from second with a mile left to go. As the field bunched up on the final turn, the eventual winner found himself shuffled back to fourth. Rider Antonio Fresu sat chilly and confidently as he guided his mount through traffic to the outside, gave him one right-handed tap, overhauled the leaders, and hand rode the rest of the way to the wire for a 1 1/4-length win.

MGSW Planetario (Brz)--also a MG1SW in his native Brazil--and MGSW Offlee Naughty finished second and third, respectively.

"I was really happy when I got the mount," said Fresu. "He was a big favorite and I didn't miss it. He's a very cool horse to ride, the pace wasn't really strong, so I was just trying to just switch him off behind the leader. When the others kicked, [trainer] John [Sadler] told me to just wait for the last call. When I pulled him out, I thought he won pretty easy."

Missed the Cut kicked off his career in England, where won a listed stakes for trainer George Boughey, and competed in both France and Saudi Arabia before shipping to Sadler's barn last spring. Sadler hasn't shied from top competition and the bay has rewarded connections with graded wins on both dirt and turf at Santa Anita. He was last seen winning the GIIII San Marcos S. Feb. 10 at 10 furlongs on the grass, but also captured the 12-furlong GIII Tokyo City Cup S. on the dirt last October. The San Luis Rey marked his second career start--and win--at 1 1/2 miles.

Pedigree Notes:

Missed the Cut is one of 81 black-type winners--39 graded--for Quality Road, a Lane's End sire. He's the only Quality Road stakes winner out of a mare by Sea The Stars (Ire), who has 35 black-type winners out of his daughters, but Quality Road does have an additional two stakes winners and two other stakes performers out of daughters of Sea The Stars's mighty half-brother, Galileo (Ire). All of them are group/graded.

The San Luis Rey winner's dam, out of 2005 GIII Wilshire H. and GIII Yerba Buena H. winner Pickle (GB), has a 2-year-old filly by No Nay Never named Orange Sky (Ire) and a yearling colt by Camelot (GB). The juvenile sold in Book 1 of last year's Tattersalls October yearling sale for 330,000gns to the same Boughey who originally trained Missed the Cut in the UK.

FIERCENESS DRAWS POST 10 FOR FLORIDA DERBY

During Saturday's post-position draw at Gulfstream, Repole Stable's **Fierceness** (City of Light) was installed the 8-5 favorite on the morning line for next weekend's GI Curlin Florida Derby at Gulfstream Park. Drawing post 10 in the field off 11, the colt will try to give his trainer Todd Pletcher a record eighth win in the Classic prep. Pletcher won the nine-furlong test with defending 2-year-old champion Forte (Violence) last year.

"Normally I'd be afraid of the outside post, but Forte won from the 11 last year, so you can overcome that," Pletcher said. "Everybody knows Gulfstream two-turn races are very tricky and I think that's why the start is so important, getting away cleanly. I think what happens in a lot of these two-turn races is the jockeys are so conscious of having to get to the first turn in good position that it can get a little rough leaving the gate sometimes."

Victorious in last fall's GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile en route to a juvenile championship, the colt kicked off his sophomore campaign with a third in the GIII Holy Bull S. Feb. 3.

MYSTIK DAN READIES FOR ARKANSAS DERBY

Lance Gasaway, 4G Racing and Daniel Hamby III's Mystik Dan (Goldencents) worked five furlongs in 1:01.80 (20/34) over a fast track at the Fair Grounds Saturday morning. Trained by Ken McPeek, the winner of the Feb. 3 GIII Southwest S. is expected to ship to Oaklawn Wednesday in advance of a tilt at the \$1.5-million GI Arkansas Derby Mar. 30. McPeek opted to train Mystik Dan up to the Arkansas Derby, which could award as many as 200 qualifying points to its top five eligible finishers (100-50-25-15-10, respectively) for Kentucky Derby.

"About three weeks ago, I was down there and he looked great," said Gasaway of the homebred. "He's been working lights out. Last week, he worked five furlongs in 1:00 and galloped out [six furlongs] in 1:12 and change. That was the plan--take him back there after the Southwest. Scared of the weather and missing work time. We had to work around some rain and one day we did have to work in the mud."

Also expected for the nine-furlong race, Siena Farm and WinStar's **Timberlake** (Into Mischief), winner of the Feb. 24 GII Rebel S., worked five furlongs in 1:00.40 (5/34) at Fair Grounds Saturday. His trainer brad Cox will attempt to win his third consecutive renewal of the race following victories in 2022 with Cyberknife and Angel of Empire last year.

DORNOCH HEADS TO BLUE GRASS

West Paces Racing, R.A. Hill Stable, Belmar Racing and Breeding, Two Eight Racing and Pine Racing Stables' **Dornoch** (Good Magic), winner of the Mar. 2 GII Fountain of Youth S. at Gulfstream, is expected to make his next start in Keeneland's GI Blue Grass S. Apr. 6, trainer Danny Gargan told DRF.

"It's been my plan since December. All our owners want to run in the Blue Grass, if he wins it makes him more valuable as a stallion. He won over the track, it's one ship, and three days after the race I'll be at Churchill," Gargan told DRF.

Runner up in his first two career starts, including last summer's Sapling S., the full-brother to Kentucky Derby winner Mage won his next three starts, including a muddy renewal of the GII Remsen S. at the Big A in December. Second that day was Sierra Leone (Gun Runner), who is also expected to run in Keeneland's Classic prep. Sierra Leone won the GII Risen Star S. at Fair Grounds Feb. 17. According to Gargan, the colt will breeze once more in Florida before shipping to Lexington.



Everland, claimed for \$30,000 out of a maiden victory here Dec. 30, continued her rise through the ranks with a spirited rail rally to capture the Bourbonette Oaks. Since the claim by trainer Eric Foster for a partnership that includes his Foster Family Racing, she easily won a Feb. 10 starter allowance here over one mile and finished fourth in the Cincinnati Trophy S. Mar. 1, her stakes debut.

Facing nine rivals including Alpine Princess, winner of the Untapable S. at Fair Grounds, and the undefeated Pink Polkadots (Candy Ride {Arg}), sent off the 2-1 favorite following two facile front-running romps on the Fair Grounds turf course, Everland bided her time in sixth behind Maxisuperfly (Optimizer)'s contested pace set in :23.90, :47.98 and 1:12.70 over Turfway's Tapeta surface. With jockey Abel Cedillo poised to strike, the 11-1 longshot found a gap along the rail in the stretch and surged past Winnable to prevail.

Her dam, campaigned by trainer Jonathan Thomas for owner-

breeder George Strawbridge, the connections from which Everland was claimed, won a maiden race over one mile on the Colonial Downs turf. Everland is her first known foal. She has a 2-year-old Caravaggio colt named Chagall, a yearling American Pharoah filly and was bred to Oscar Performance, whose colt Endlessly won the featured GIII Jeff Ruby Steaks S. in the following race. Okiro became his sire's first stakes winner Saturday with a come-from-behind effort in Turfway's Animal Kingdom S. Having spent much of his 2-year-old season on the Tapeta at Gulfstream, the 8-1 shot shipped outside of Florida for the first time and got back on the all-weather after a pair of races on the grass, including an eighth in the Colonel Liam S. last out when stretched to a mile Mar. 2. Back sprinting, Okiro was in no hurry early and raced in the back half of the field as Joe Sheisty (Air Force Blue) went loose on the lead through opening fractions of :21.82 and :44.74. Needing to swing out wide off the turn for

room, Okiro found his best gear inside the final furlong and easily swept past to win going away over a pair of rivals who hit the line together to dead heat for second. From his sire's debut crop, the Jose Garoffalo trainee is out of a daughter of Canada's champion older mare Bear Now (Tiznow). 

Humility goes by the household name of humble and you will be hard pressed to find a more humble couple than Donna Cowens and Nicky Souza de Oliveira of DNA Equine.

WATERHOUSE/BOTT'S LADY OF CAMELOT WINS THE SLIPPER

The powerhouse combination of Gai Waterhouse and Adrian Bott teamed up for their first joint Slipper winner just four years ago with Farnan, and such is their dominance in racing's juvenile features that they fielded no fewer than six of Saturday's field. That tipped Waterhouse well over a half century of lifetime Slipper runners - more than enough experience for the master trainer to know that it doesn't always go to plan.

It's fair to say that the pre-race talk had concentrated on the stable's favourite, Storm Boy (Justify {USA}), but it was their sole filly in the race, Lady Of Camelot (Written Tycoon), who emerged from the pack late under Blake Shinn to deny Coleman (Pierata) by 0.2l, with Storm Boy far from disgraced a further 1.3l back in third having missed the kick early on.

The significance of training a Slipper winner for Sir Owen Glenn, who bred and races Lady Of Camelot under his Go Bloodstock banner (one of just three homebreds in the field), was not lost on Bott.

"I owe so much to my training partner in Gai Waterhouse," he said. "I can't tell you how special it is to do it alongside her."

The Tamayuz (Ire) filly had been bought for a song the previous winter.

Identified by Cowens as a potentially nice type to go breezing and get the DNA consignment up and running, the native of Northumberland shelled out just €10,000 for the filly from Ringfort Stud at the Goffs Autumn Sale 2022.

Mantra more than held up her part of the bargain by breezing like a rocket, resulting in that massive return on investment for the young couple, but you won't find any gloating here. Instead, Cowens and Souza de Oliveira described that dream debut as "beginner's luck" and are fully concentrating on building on that result this spring.

"I don't think that sale ever settled in, really," Cowens reflected. "We didn't get a chance to sit back and take it in--you

just keep your head down and keep on going in this game, don't you?"

She added, "But it definitely made the decision to go out on our own a lot easier. If we didn't take the plunge after that, well then we probably never would have. We owe that filly a lot. She gave us the springboard that we needed."

Cowens, 34, and Souza de Oliveira, 39, are graduates of Willie Browne's famous Mocklershill Stables. After the success with Mantra, the pair decided to go out fully on their own, and have rented a yard on the Curragh.


With 10 horses for the upcoming breeze-up sales and eight more in pre-training, you could say this fledgling operation is finding its stride.

Cowens said, "We have rented a yard on the Maddenstown side of the Curragh and have 18 horses in at the moment--10 are for breezing and the rest is made up of horses in pretraining. We moved here last September."

She added, "We've got three for Doncaster--a nice Earthlight (Ire) colt for the Guineas Sale and a lovely Sottsass (Fr) colt for Arqana. That's rather exciting because he is the only Sottsass colt catalogued for France.

"The rest of the horses will be split up between Tattersalls Ireland and then we have a few for the July Sale in France as well. Obviously it was very difficult to get horses into the breeze-up sales this year so we will be taking a few to France in July as well."

It seems to be a common complaint among the breeze-up handlers this year. It was in these pages last month when Harry Fowler of Goffs and Tattersalls Ireland boss Simon Kerins explained how entries for the breeze-up sales were at an all-time high. **Cont.**



Invariably, some consignors were going to be left disappointed, as there simply weren't enough slots to go around.

However, in DNA's case, they are happy to roll the big dice with a certain Sands Of Mali (Fr) filly on the racetrack, with Souza de Oliveira saying that he is convinced she is up to winning a maiden.

"I already have a name picked out for her," he explained. "I am from Rio in Brazil and, with her being by Sands Of Mali, I was thinking Copacabana Sands would be a nice name. I think she could be up to winning a maiden so we don't mind being brave."

And Souza de Oliveira would know. Still a major cog in Browne's Mocklershill wheel, Souza de Oliveira has ridden countless high-class horses at home and at the breeze-up sales. Not only that, but the couple are taking heart in the result fellow Brazilian native and prominent breeze-up rider Manoel Marques enjoyed with Buyin Buyin (Ire) (Bungle Inthejungle {GB}) this time 12 months ago.

Cowens explained, "We've worked her a couple of times and she goes particularly well. Obviously she will be for sale but we're happy to race her ourselves if we have to. She will go to Diego Dias and hopefully, if she shows on the track what she has been showing us at home, we can get her sold. With a filly like that, you don't want to be waiting until July."

"She will be ready to run in four to six weeks and, while we don't want to get into the habit of keeping horses, we're happy to take a chance with a filly like her."

She added, "Diego is very good friends with Nicky. He has sat on her and is actually the one who said to us, 'this filly is good guys, I think you need to be brave.' Hopefully it ends up being a similar story to Buyin Buyin last year." **Cont**.



"He wasn't accepted into a breeze-up sale but was obviously ready to run early. Manoel rolled the dice and ran him and the rest is history. Nicky rode Buyin Buyin a good bit at home at Willie's so he knows what's needed to win a maiden.

"Nicky still works very closely with Willie and will be riding for him at the breeze-ups as well. If we didn't take the plunge to go out on our own, Willie is a man I would have happily worked for for the rest of my life. He has always been there for help and advice. The knowledge he has on the game is amazing. When we were leaving, he said, 'I'm not happy that ye are leaving, but I wish ye the best of luck."

And finally, what's behind the name? Not only do DNA have the horses to make their second year in business a success but they are also the proud owners of one of the catchiest consignment names in the game.

Cowens laughed, "Everyone asks us this! Basically, it's all about the DNA of the racehorse, isn't it? When you are buying potential racehorses, you are looking at bloodlines and pedigrees, so we said we'd use DNA. The logo actually came first. Everyone thinks the D and the N is for Donna and Nicky and they ask us what the A is for. We always say it's for associates. So, anyone who wants to associate with us, it can be Donna, Nicky and associates."

There will be few nicer people to be associated with.

This British Flat Turf season opener was a smart race for its type, with two former TDN Rising Stars and a colt who was placed in two of the country's boutique races at three. In the event, the cream rose to the top with the G1 St James's Palace S. and Sussex S. third Charyn running out a decisive winner on ground more testing than usual for the Lincoln card.

Covered up early by the returning Silvestre De Sousa, the grey whose signature win had come in the 2022 G2 Criterium de Maisons-Laffitte showed no signs of rustiness as he moved through the gears on his first run since finishing third in the G2 Celebration Mile at Goodwood in August.

In front approaching the furlong pole, he was rampant from there and it took his rider some time to pull up passing the line.

"Last year, he put up some really good efforts in the Irish Guineas, St James's Palace Stakes and Sussex Stakes against some top opposition," trainer Roger Varian said. "He looks to have done well through the winter, he's a stronger horse this year and we were always keen to come here just to try and get a win on the board and build him back up again. I'd like to go to Sandown for the group two (Sandown Mile) and then the Lockinge."

Charyn, whose 2-year-old full-sister Shinara (Ire) was a 850,000gns purchase by his owners at Tatts Book 1 in October, is also a full-brother to the G2 Mill Reef S. and G3 Sirenia S. winner Wings Of War. The dam, who was placed at this level on three occasions, hails from the family of another Mill Reef winner in Galeota (Ire) (Mujadil) and the Sirenia-winning half-siblings Burnt Sugar (Ire) (Lope De Vega {Ire}) and Brown Sugar (Ire) (Tamayuz {GB}). Having visited solely Dark Angel so far, she also has a yearling filly to follow.

Upping his game when winning the competitive Coral Sprint Trophy at York in October, Montassib returned to mark his black-type debut with a breakthrough win to promise a bright campaign ahead. "To be entrusted with a valuable filly like this (by Sir Owen) at the start of my career in the partnership and to win another Slipper alongside Gai...it's been fantastic."

A Slipper victory is a feather in the cap of Sir Owen's Fastnet Rock mare Miss Debutante. With Lady Of Camelot just her third named foal, the first is the tough G3 Widden S. winner Queen Of The Ball (I Am Invincible) whilst the second was another top juvenile for Waterhouse and Bott in their G3 Gimcrack S. winner and G2 Silver Slipper S. runner-up Platinum Jubilee (Zoustar).

Pedigree Note

It was a race in which so much of the pre-race hype centred on the boys but it would a filly to find the line - Lady Of Camelot (Written Tycoon) the sixth G1 Golden Slipper S. winner of her gender in the last ten years. After running such a great race in the G1 Blue Diamond S. in which Coleman (Pierata) - second to her today - was so favoured - Lady Of Camelot was able to go right on with it at just her fourth start.

One of the 62 stakes winners - and the 15th Group 1 winner (and second Golden Slipper winner, Capitalist the other) - for her in-form Yulong based Champion Sire Lady Of Camelot is one of the three stakes winners (from her first three foals) for the Listed Denise's Joy S. winner Miss Debutante (Fastnet Rock). A home-bred for Go Bloodstock, Lady Of Camelot is a half-sister to the four times Group 3 winner Queen Of The Ball (I Am Invincible) and the G3 Gimcrack S. winner Platinum Jubilee (Zoustar). Cont.

Those two also raced today, both out of the placings in feature events at Moonee Valley.

A daughter of the G3 Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies Turf S. winner More Than Real (USA) (More Than Ready {USA}), Miss Debutante missed last spring by Zoustar having foaled an I Am Invincible filly. Her 2022 foal is a colt by Flying Artie. More Than Real is out of the five times Listed winner Miss Seffens (USA) (Dehere {USA}) whose dam Noise Enough (Can) (Bold Ruckus {USA}) was also a stakes winner...that's a remarkable five generations of female black-type! Lady Of Camelot is one of the 28 Written Tycoon winners (from 34 runners) out of mares by Fastnet Rock and another four of those are stakes winners.

VEIGHT GOES VROOM IN RYDER

Classy 3-year-old colt Veight (Grunt {NZ}) defeated a gun field to claim his maiden and much-deserved Group 1 success in Saturday's George Ryder S. at Rosehill.

Trained by the Ballarat-based father and son duo, Tony and Calvin McEvoy, and ridden by Damian Lane, the son of Grunt (NZ) lapped up the 1500-metre feature and held off the last-start Group 1 winner Lady Laguna (Overshare), while another star 3-year-old in Militarize (NZ) (Dundeel {NZ}) flew into third.

Last year's The Everest winner Think About It (So You Think {NZ}) was slightly underwhelming, finishing out of the placings for the first time in his career.

Speaking to 7HorseRacing, co-trainer Tony McEvoy said, "It was so deserved. I'm so proud of Veight and my entire team." "I'm thrilled for Wayne Mitchell, who has been my biggest supporter and owns most of this horse (Veight). It's just fabulous."

Veight has been a standout performer and is the first Group 1 winner for Yulong's Grunt. He is also the first 3-year-old to secure success in the George Ryder since Pierro saluted in 2013.

Pedigree Note

So tough taking on the older horses, Veight (Grunt {NZ}) was deserving of his first win at the elite level having won three times in Group company and finishing runner-up in the G1 Australian Guineas and the G1 Caulfield GUineas. Bred by Yulong Stud (home to his G1 Australian Guineas and G1 Makybe Diva S. winning sire), he was sold by them to Sledmere Stud/Cangon Pty Ltd for \$100,000 at the 2021 Magic Millions Gold Coast National Weanling Sale.

Sledmere then sold him onto McEvoy Mitchell Racing/Belmont Bloodstock for \$220,000 at the 2022 Inglis Classic Yearling Sale.

Hailing from his sire's debut crop (one which also produced the Listed winner Miraval Rose), Veight is a son of the dual Group 3 winner Neena Rock (Fastnet Rock) whose dam is a half-sister to the Group 1 winning stallion Quiet American (USA).

The daughter of I Am Invincible, trained by Mark Walker, was gallant, finishing second to Cylinder (Exceed And Excel) in the G1 Newmarket H. at Flemington, carrying 58kg compared to the colt's 51.5kg.

As reported by Racing Victoria stewards, Imperatriz sustained EIPH (equine-induced pulmonary haemorrhage) in the Newmarket H. and was cleared by Racing Victoria veterinary

staff earlier in the week to contest the William Reid.

Imperatriz, ridden by her regular rider Opie Bosson, held off a game Johnny Rocker (Jukebox), while I Am Me (I Am Invincible) was third.

Walker told Racing.com, "It was great for her to win. Opie (Bosson) got into a nice spot, and what a great comeback from the Newmarket.

"Impertartiz is extremely good, and we're just thankful she's stable. Credit to all our team; they work so hard."

It was Group 1 number ten for the wonderful mare Imperatriz (I Am Invincible) who joined The Night Patrol, Heros (Heroic), Flying Halo, Golden Doubles (Avalanche {GB}), All Shot (NZ) (Idomeneo {GB}), Manikato (Manihi), Apache Cat (Lion Cavern {USA}) and Black Caviar (Bel Esprit) as multiple winners of this Moonee Valley feature.

The most prolific stakes winner for her Yarraman Park based reigning Australian Champion Sire (whose stakes winner total sits at 105), Imperatriz was bred by Raffles Dancers and purchased by David Ellis for \$360,000 from the Bhima Thoroughbreds draft at the 2020 Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale.

Imperatriz is the second foal and first winner for Berimbau (Shamardal {USA}) who earned her black-type with a G3 Moonee Valley Fillies Classic third to Lumosty (Fastnet Rock). Also dam of the multiple city winner Cabaca (Fastnet Rock), Berimbau produced a full brother to Imperatriz last August, subsequently served by Pierata. Her 2-year-old is a Capitalist colt, a \$200,000 Magic Millions purchase for Lofth Thoroughbreds and AGR Racing.

Hulking 6-year-old mare Via Sistina (Ire) (Fastnet Rock) made an immediate impact on Australian soil when the now Chris Waller-trained mare, ridden by James McDonald, coasted to success in the G1 Ranvet S.

Via Sistina, carrying the Yulong silks, showed her class to defeat the fellow colour-bearer Place Du Carrousel (Ire) (Lope De Vega {Ire}), while Buckaroo (GB) (Fastnet Rock) denied Think It Over (So You Think {NZ}) for third place.

The daughter of Coolmore Stud's extraordinary Fastnet Rock is the best runner produced from the unraced Galileo (Ire) mare Nigh (Ire). Via Sistina won five races in Europe, including the G1 Pretty Polly S. at the Curragh and the G2 Dahlia S. at Newmarket.

In addition, Via Sistina was placed in the G1 Champion S. at Ascot and the G1 Prix Jean Romanet at Deauville before she was sold for 2.7-million gns (AU\$5.2 million) to Evergreen Equine at the 2023 Tattersalls December Mares Sale.

Via Sistina was originally a 5000gns (AU\$9700) purchase by Stephen Hillen Bloodstock at the 2019 Tattersalls October Yearling Sale.

Waller was eager to praise Via Sistina's previous trainer, George Boughey, and the investment made by Yuesheng Zhang's Yulong. "I am a small cog in the wheel; that's all I am. Via Sistina is a very good horse, which came to us well-trained, lightly raced, and smartly purchased by Yulong," he told 7HorseRacing.

"Her class is different from what we usually see, and my team and I are just privileged to play a small part in this mare's success today (Saturday)."

Waller shared his first thoughts on Via Sistina and where the daughter of Fastnet Rock would likely head: "She had been prepared in England by James Ferguson and previously trained by George Boughey, who provided plenty of insight.

"Via Sistina came to us very fit, and we haven't done anything with her; we just kept her ticking over. She'll head to the Queen Elizabeth S."

Pedigree Note

Part of a great day for Yulong - home to the G1 Golden Slipper winner's sire Written Tycoon and the G1 George Ryder S. winner's sire Grunt (NZ) - the Ranvet saw imported mares racing in their bottle green colours finish one two, Via Sistina (Ire) (Fastnet Rock) game defeat Place Du Carrousel (Ire) (Lope de Vega {Ire}).

Having her first Australian start off consistent form in UK and European Group 1 company - winning the G1 Pretty Polly S. last July - Via Sistina is one of her Australian bred, Coolmore Stud based sire's 193 stakes winners.

Bred by Laundry Cottage Stud Farm, she was purchased by Evergreen Equine for 2.7 million gns at last year's Tattersalls December Mares Sale. Her dam is the unraced Nigh (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) whose half-brother Kingsgate Native (Ire) (Mujadil {USA}) earned the title of GB Champion 3YO Sprinter with his two wins at the elite level - the G1 Golden Jubilee S. and the G1 Nunthorpe S.
