Sheikh Abdullah Almalek Alsbah's battle-hardened **Haatem (Ire)** (Phoenix Of Spain {Ire}--Hard Walnut {Ire}, by Cape Cross {Ire}) had twice chased home City Of Troy (**Justify**) in juvenile Pattern races last term and, while tipping his hat to that old foe, threw down a Classic marker of his own with a hugely impressive 3 1/2-length triumph in Thursday's one-mile G3 bet365 Craven S. at Newmarket.

CHALDEAN TO SHUTTLE TO CAMBRIDGE STUD THIS YEAR

Classic winner **Chaldean (GB)** (**Frankel (GB)**), who is standing his first season at Banstead Manor Stud in the UK, will shuttle to Cambridge Stud in New Zealand for the Southern Hemisphere breeding season, Juddmonte announced Thursday. His fee will be NZ\$35,000 + GST and his book will be limited to 120 mares.

One of only nine horses to complete the G1 Dewhurst S./G1 2000 Guineas double, **Chaldean** stands alongside his sire, the multiple champion sire **Frankel**, who completed the double in 2010/2011. The duo are the only father-son pair to complete that achievement. **Chaldean** also won the G2 Champagne S. and G3 Acomb S. during his racing days.

Simon Mockridge, general manager UK, Juddmonte, said "The exceptionally talented, good-looking **Chaldean** has been immensely popular during his first season at Banstead Manor Stud. With the ongoing support for **Frankel** and his incomparable statistics as they stand, Cambridge Stud have given us the perfect opportunity to send **Chaldean** to the Southern Hemisphere where we feel his precociousness and physical type will appeal. The Richard Hannon trainee broke on the front end and was restrained to accept a tow in an overall third before inching into second passing halfway. Thundering forward to seize control approaching the quarter-mile marker, the 17-2 chance surged clear in taking fashion up the hill to easily outpoint G1 Dewhurst S. third **Eben Shaddad (Calyx {GB})** by daylight.

Jane Chapple-Hyam's once-raced trainee **Sons And Lovers (GB)** (Study Of Man {Ire}) ran on well in the closing stages and finished 2 1/4 lengths adrift in third. Baron Eduoard de Rothschild's G3 Prix Thomas Bryon victor and G1 Criterium International runner-up **Alcantor (Fr)** (New Bay {GB}) raced too freely through the early fractions, making little impression at the business end, and crossed the line in sixth.

Haatem had already made three visits to the track before

running fifth in Royal Ascot's G2 Coventry S. and was City Of Troy's closest pursuer when a 6 1/2-length second in July's G2 Superlative S. at Newmarket. Back on song for Goodwood's G2 Vintage S. next time, he ran unplaced in two subsequent Group 2 contests and closed out a nine-race freshman campaign with a fifth behind City Of Troy, once more, and Eben Shaddad in October's G1 Dewhurst S. over the final seven furlongs of this Rowley Mile last time.

"The way he did it has surprised me and you can't say that was a fluke," reflected trainer Richard Hannon after notching a third win in the contest, halfway to Richard senior's haul of six. "He's obviously improved a lot physically and he's a big, strong, impressive horse. He's a good horse and he's just won a Craven by three-and-a-half lengths. He won a Vintage, with the subsequent Champagne winner [Iberian] behind him, and he was fifth in a Dewhurst." [Cont. p4](#)

"I thought he'd get the trip well and it seems the horses who have been making the running all week have been hard to peg back," Hannon added. "I know he didn't make the running, but I don't think you can say that is an average performance, he was pretty good there. This is the racecourse, this is where it matters and, on what he has done today, the 25-1 on offer for the 2000 Guineas looks generous to me.

"We've made no secret about how good we think Rosallion is, but this horse has surprised me in the manner in which he did it. Rosallion is a horse that contains an awful lot of speed, whereas this horse gets the trip extremely well. Rosallion will get the mile and they will both probably run [in the G1 2000 Guineas]. It's nice to have two very good milers on our hands and two with very good chances in the Guineas. One with an exceptional chance and one with a better chance than he had before.

"Haatem's also in the [G2] German [2000] Guineas and [G1] Irish [2000] Guineas and I think he will be a force to be reckoned with wherever he goes. I'm delighted and the owners are delighted. They deserve it."

Haatem is the fifth of six foals and one of three scorers out of a

dual-winning half-sister to G3 Premio Carlo Vittadini and G3 Premio del Giubileo runner-up Father Frost (Ire) (Rip Van Winkle {Ire}) and Listed Prix Pelleas, Listed Doncaster Mile and Listed Foundation S. placegetter Born To Be Alive (Ire) (Born To Sea {Ire}). His second dam Yaria (Ire) (Danehill), herself a daughter of G1 Phoenix S. runner-up Yara (Ire) (Sri Pekan), is a winning sibling of dual stakes scorer Emirates Gold (Ire) (Royal Applause {GB}), Listed Prix Melisande victrix Yarastar (GB) (Cape Cross {Ire}) and the stakes-placed Yario (Ire) (Danehill Dancer {Ire}). Haatem, half-brother to a yearling filly by Inns Of Court (Ire), hails from the family of G1SW sires Homme De Loi (Ire) (Law Society) and Mister Majestic (Ire) (Tumble Wind).

WASHINGTON HEIGHTS SPRINGS A SURPRISE IN THE ABERNANT

Reserving his best for 2024, Hambleton Racing's **Washington Heights (GB)** (Washington DC {Ire}) kicked off his campaign with a shock win at 33-1 in Thursday's G3 Abernant S. at Newmarket.

Signing off with a decisive first black-type win in the Listed Bro Park Sprint Championship in September, Kevin Ryan's gelding who had contested the competitive 3-year-old sprint handicaps last term only to run into the winning machine Quinault (Ger) (**Oasis Dream {GB}**) on three occasions was towing the dominant centre group along under Tom Eaves. Able to sustain his effort to the line, he had 3/4 of a length to spare over **Mill Stream (Ire)** (**Gleneagles {Ire}**) there, with a short head back to the solid yardstick **Spycatcher (Ire)** (Vadamos {Fr}) in third.

Kevin's son and assistant Adam Ryan said, "The good thing about him is he is very consistent and he deserved to get his head in front in Sweden. This year was always going to be about if he could take the next step up and he has certainly done that. He's such a genuine horse and if you had 100 like him it would be an easy game. He's always going to give you 110% and once his head is in front he is always going to be hard to pass. The Duke Of York or the Greenlands S. in Ireland could be the next port of call and he's an exciting horse to look forward to."

Pedigree Notes

The unraced dam Epping Rose (Ire) (Kodiac {GB}), who also has the 3-year-old filly Smokeintheair (GB) (Aclaim {Ire}) and a yearling colt by Dream Ahead, is a half to the G1 St Leger runner-up The Last Drop (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) and to the dam of the G2 Avondale Cup winner and G1 Zabeel Classic-placed Aquacade (NZ) (Dundeel {NZ}). The family of the Irish 1000 Guineas and Irish Oaks heroines Sarah Siddons (Fr) (Le Levanstell {GB}) and Princess Pati (Ire) (Top Ville {Ire}) respectively mostly consists of middle-distance performers and stayers such as the G2 Prix de Royallieu scorer Sea Of Heartbreak (Ire) (Rock Of Gibraltar {Ire}).

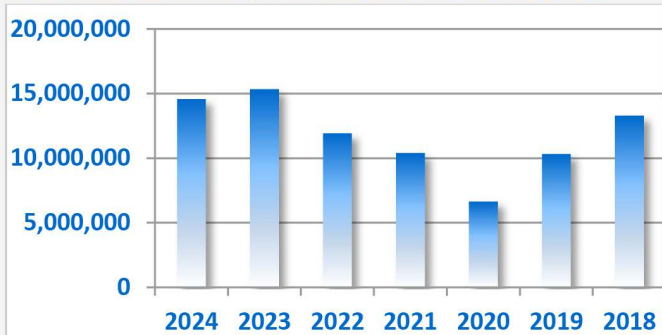

FRANCE GALOP TO OFFER INCENTIVES FOR PRIX DU GROS-CHENE

A new incentive programme for the G2 Prix du Gros-Chene was launched by France Galop this spring.

In danger of being downgraded from Group 2 to Group 3 status next year, the race now has a quintet of lead-up sprint-race qualifiers where the winner will be automatically entered in the June 2 1000-metre sprint and the €1,200 entry fee will be waived. Two of the five qualifying races have already taken place, the Prix Cor de Chasse at Deauville on Apr. 9, won by Vicious Harry (Fr) (Harry Angel {Ire}), and the G3 Prix Sigy at Chantilly, which was claimed by Sajir (Ire) (Make Believe {GB}) on Apr. 15. The remaining qualifiers for the event are as follows:

- Prix Servanne over 1200 metres at Chantilly on May 2
- Prix de Saint-Georges over 1000 metres at ParisLongchamp on May 12
- G3 Prix Texanita going 1200 metres at Chantilly on May 17

In Italy, the €640,200 G2 Derby Italiano over 2200 metres will be held on Sunday, May 19. Open to colts and fillies, the Capannelle showpiece is one of the most lucrative Group 2 races in Europe. A generous travel incentive is being offered for prospective entrants, with entries closing on Monday, Apr. 29 at 10:30 a.m. local time. The entry fee is €1,455. Supplemental entries will be accepted until 10:30 a.m. on May 16 for a cost of €48,200. Declarations, at a fee of €2,910, are due by 8:30 a.m. on May 17.

HALF-SISTER TO NAVAL CROWN DEBUTS IN "ESWARAH MAIDEN"

MAGIC DREAM (IRE) (**Shamardal**) is an eye-catching debutante for Godolphin and Charlie Appleby in this race which saw the future Oaks winner Eswarah (GB) (**Unfuwain**) and Irish Oaks heroine Star Catcher (GB) (**Sea The Stars {Ire}**) break their maidens. A half-sister to the stable's G1 Platinum Jubilee S. hero Naval Crown (GB) (**Dubawi {Ire}**), she encounters a clutch of potential Oaks fillies in a fascinating affair.

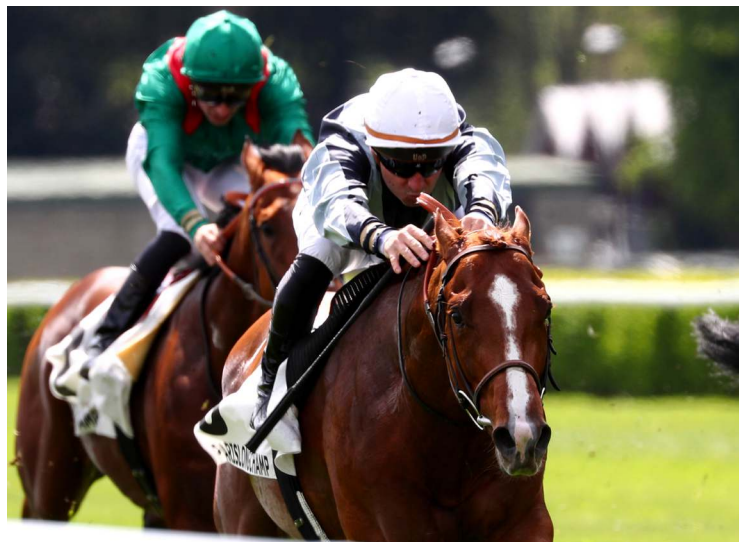

NYQUIST COLT LEADS MEASURED OBS SESSION THURSDAY

OCALA, FL - Without a breakout horse and numerous outs, the Ocala Breeders' Sales Company's Spring Sale of 2-Year-Olds in Training dutifully marched through its paces Thursday, with a colt by **Nyquist** attracting the session's highest price of \$550,000 late in the day. Bloodstock agent Donato Lanni, bidding on behalf of Zedan Racing Stable, signed the ticket on the session topper for the third straight day.

From a catalogue of 302 horses, just 187 went through the ring Thursday and the session, which started at 10:30 a.m., proceeded at a brisk pace and was over before 4 p.m. For the session, 143 horses sold for \$14,877,000. The session average was \$104,035 and the median was \$70,000.

"We had a high number of outs today," said OBS Director of Sales Tod Wojciechowski. "It was certainly the softest day of the sale we've had so far. But we still have tomorrow. Hopefully, we will be able to rebound and have a better day tomorrow."

Through three of four sessions, 472 horses have grossed \$61,608,500. The cumulative average of \$130,526 is nearly identical to last year's figure at the same point, while the median of \$75,000 is up 15.4% from a year ago.

"The market is obviously very spotty," said Ciaran Dunne, whose Wavertree Stables consigned the session topper. **Cont. p3**

ZEDAN VOWS APPEAL AFTER JUDGE DENIES DERBY INJUNCTION

Amr Zedan's incorporated racing stable is planning an immediate appeal to a Thursday decision by a Kentucky judge who denied an injunction request that would have overturned Churchill Downs, Inc. (CDI)'s ongoing ban against Bob Baffert. Zedan had initiated an **Apr. 3 lawsuit** in an effort to get his Baffert-trained 'TDN Rising Star' Muth (**Good Magic**) eligible for the GI Kentucky Derby.

But Judge Mitchell Perry of Jefferson Circuit Court also denied CDI's request to dismiss the case in his Apr. 18 order.

This means that barring a successful appeal with eight days now remaining until entry time for the Derby, the underlying lawsuit could linger for months after the Derby itself has been run if Zedan decides to pursue it that far.

"The Plaintiff makes a compelling argument that failure to grant this injunction will result in its horse being barred from running in the Kentucky Derby," Perry wrote in his order. **Cont. p9**

“The traffic has probably been down from years past. The attendance today was pretty sparse. A lot of people got out of town. I am sure they can bid by phone and internet, but it's different when people are in attendance. They get caught up in the moment, maybe, whereas they can be more objective when they are away from the heat of the battle. We've had a decent day. It's very reminiscent of our March sale. It has been good, but it hasn't been great.”

Of the scarcity of buyers actually on the ground in Ocala Thursday, Wojciechowski said, “We always like to have people on site. Certainly, on-line bidding was more prevalent today it seemed.”

More than half the horses catalogued for Thursday's session worked during last Friday's session of the under-tack show, which was conducted a day after heavy rain hit the area and featured a head wind.

The conditions and resulting slower times were unlikely to influence buyers, according to Lanni.

“I know it was a slow day,” he said. “The track was definitely a little bit slower and there was a headwind, but there were some nice horses that worked that day. Every day here is different. I think people kind of know and adjust and handicap every day when horses work. I think that's something that comes into play and they know. Even though they went somewhat slower, I don't think it means a whole lot.”

The OBS Spring sale's final session begins Friday at 10:30 a.m.

He was joined on the top-price list by another late in the day hip when a colt by **Army Mule (hip 886)**, who also **worked his eighth in :10**, went for \$350,000 to Lael Stable after having been purchased for \$190,000 at Keeneland September last year. The pair of colts were two of five six-figure sales for Grassroots during Thursday's session. Their top filly, an Arizona-bred daughter of **Spun to Run (hip 625)**, sold for \$120,000 after **working in :9.4**. @SGrimmTDN

Woodford Buys Bolt d'Oro Filly

The day's highest-priced filly (**hip 643**) went the way of Woodford Thoroughbreds for \$450,000 early in Thursday's third session of OBSAPR. By Bolt d'Oro, who also had an \$800,000 colt sell during Wednesday's session, the filly **worked her furlong in :10**.

"I liked the stallion and I think he's held his own in a very competitive Kentucky stallion market," said Will Walden. "And I'd say his fillies probably more than his colts have turned out to have been his more predominant runners. Physically, she's a long, scopey, racy-type filly that I think will stretch out and get two turns. She had a lot of quality. Every time I went back to the barn, she was the ultimate professional and I just fell in love with her."

It was the filly's fourth time through the sales ring after she failed to meet her reserve as a yearling at both Fasig-Tipton's October and July yearling sales. But Walden noted that the filly could have value for Woodford well beyond her racing career.

"We'll see how her [racing] career goes. Her pedigree is a little light right now but she's got a sister that's racing at Oaklawn and Bolt d'Oro has been, by far, the best stallion the dam has visited so there should be more in the pipeline." **Cont.**

Walden added: "But she's beautiful and I'd like to think that, in the future, she'd have beautiful babies."

Hip 643 was one of two fillies going home to Woodford after they went for an Omaha Beach filly (hip 127) during Tuesday's opening session.

Walden continued: "We bought a [Omaha Beach filly] for \$390,000 early in the week. We came to buy that Caracaro filly that Donato Lanni got [hip 199] for the Three Amigos and didn't even get a hand up so it's been competitive. Seems like the market has fluctuated. Tuesday started off soft, Wednesday was strong, Thursday was a little soft so hopefully the pattern holds and tomorrow's a strong day." @SGrimmTDN

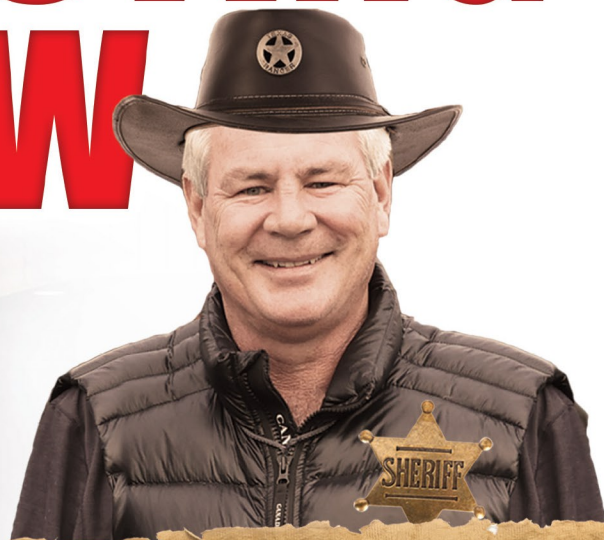

"However, the Defendants are correct that the Plaintiff has transferred its horses to a different trainer and those horses have been eligible to run in the Derby the previous two years," Perry continued.

"For the 2024 racing season, the Plaintiff voluntarily made the decision to not transfer its horses to a new trainer," Perry wrote. "The Plaintiff knew as early as July 2023 that Mr. Baffert was a suspended trainer and that to be eligible to run in the 2024 Kentucky Derby, horses had to be transferred to a non-suspended trainer by January 29, 2024. Nonetheless, the Plaintiff nominated its horses with Mr. Baffert as their trainer.

"The Court appreciates the once in-a-horse's-lifetime nature of the Kentucky Derby, but the other aspects at play prevent this factor from weighing fully in favor of the Plaintiff and injunctive relief," Perry wrote.

A spokesperson for Zedan and his legal team emailed the following statement to *TDN*, which read, in part:

"We are disappointed in the court's decision on our request for temporary relief, as we believe the court did not recognize the significant investment Zedan Racing has made, based on statements by Churchill Downs that if this trainer had no additional violations, Zedan Racing's horses would be able to compete. We will appeal this ruling on an emergency basis as soon as possible. The goal of our effort remains to ensure our horse Muth will have a once-in-a-lifetime opportunity to compete in the 150th Run for the Roses on May 4.

"The court's rejection of the defendant's motion to dismiss affirms our view that [CDI's motion to dismiss] was nothing more than a transparent delay tactic aimed at ensuring its unjust ban remained in place for the 150th Kentucky Derby," Zedan's statement continued. **Cont.**

Zedan vows appeal, cont.

Tonya Abeln, CDI's vice president of communications, emailed a statement in response to a *TDN* query for comment that underscored the gaming corporation's appreciation for the ruling--but also couldn't resist a glib portrayal of Zedan's legal efforts.

"We are pleased with the Court's decision today and believe Mr. Zedan may suffer from a case of 'Derby Fever,' which is known to spread with exposure to horses and is contagious this time of year," CDI stated.

"Symptoms can contribute to questionable judgement and in extreme cases can result in litigious behavior," the CDI statement continued. "There is no known cure. Nevertheless, we have communicated clearly about the rules of entry, which are the same for everyone and are non-negotiable.

Contenders cannot sue their way into the Kentucky Derby. We wish Mr. Zedan well in the

future and appreciate both his passion for the sport and his desire to see his horses compete on the First Saturday in May."

CDI had banished Baffert from its properties shortly after the 2021 Derby, which the now-disqualified Zedan-owned and Baffert-trained Medina Spirit won while testing positive for betamethasone.

The ban was initially just supposed to last for two Derbies. But in July 2023 CDI extended the penalty through 2024.

Zedan had claimed in his civil suit that he spent millions in buying horses at auction prior to the extension of the ban because he understood that Baffert would be allowed to train those horses for the 150th Derby in 2024.

On the issue of requirements for constitutional standing, Perry wrote, "The Plaintiff arguably meets the requirements for constitutional standing. It has suffered a business injury with its horses being barred from competing in the upcoming Kentucky Derby. This harm was caused by Churchill Downs's ban on the Plaintiff's trainer, Bob Baffert. And finally, if this Court were to rule in the Plaintiff's favor the harm would be cured, satisfying redressability."

But, Perry added, "The Court has more serious doubts concerning the Plaintiff's third-party standing to essentially challenge Churchill Down's ban on behalf of Mr. Baffert."

On Zedan's claim of "irreparable harm," Perry wrote, "This

factor is neutral at best. The Plaintiff makes a compelling argument that failure to grant this injunction will result in its horse being barred from running in the Kentucky Derby. This is an event that a horse is only eligible for once in its lifetime. However, the Defendants are correct that the Plaintiff has transferred its horses to a different trainer and those horses have been eligible to run in the Derby the previous two years."

Regarding the balance of equities, Perry wrote that this factor

"requires courts to consider the public interest, harm to the defendant, and preservation of the status quo. This factor weighs strongly against granting injunctive relief.

"The Defendant here will be severely prejudiced by the granting of injunctive relief. Churchill Downs, as the host of one of the most preeminent sporting events in the world, has a duty to ensure that the rules and regulations put in place to guarantee an even playing field are upheld and followed.

"Public trust and confidence in

the integrity of the races run at Churchill Downs are essential to its business. It is also in the public interest to ensure that all those who attend or watch races at Churchill Downs can be confident in the fairness and integrity of the sport.

"The Court is also deeply concerned about the innocent third parties who will have their horses removed from the Derby field to make room for the Plaintiff's horse should the Court grant injunctive relief. These are entities who have done nothing wrong, have followed the rules, and worked hard only to be denied the opportunity to compete at the last moment," Perry wrote.

"The Court further notes the concerns raised in the amicus brief of other horse owners who have retained Bob Baffert," Perry wrote. "If the Court were to rule in favor of the Plaintiff, the door would potentially be opened to an uncertain number of Baffert-trained horses dislodging multiple horses from the Derby field. The Court declines to open that door here."

Baffert was not a party in Zedan's lawsuit. He had already been denied a Derby-eligibility injunction at the federal court level in 2023.

FLASHY DEBUT WINNER VLAHOS, NOW WITH DOUG O'NEILL, TARGETING PAT DAY MILE FOR NEW CONNECTIONS

Vlahos (r, 3, **Kantharos**--Must Be Dreaming, by Run Away and Hide), a razor sharp debut winner for owner Dan Northrup and trainer Luis Mendez with a 98 Beyer Speed Figure at Santa Anita Mar. 9, has been purchased privately by Ty Leatherman and Todd Cady and transferred to Doug O'Neill. The sale price was not disclosed.

The chestnut, a steal for \$35,000 as a Keeneland September yearling, is aiming to make his next start in the \$600,000 GII Pat Day Mile S. on the Kentucky Derby undercard. He has posted three workouts since joining the O'Neill barn, most recently stopping the clock for five furlongs in 1:02.20 (33/45) in Arcadia Apr. 13.

The news was first reported by *Daily Racing Form's* Steve Andersen.

"He came over to us in great shape with an eye-popping debut," O'Neill said. "Sometimes when you get a horse like that your expectations are so high that they never live up to them. But so far, he's a beast. He's a big, good-looking colt with a great mind. His one stride is an average horse's stride and a half--he covers a lot of ground. We're just super excited and optimistic."

Cady, Leatherman and O'Neill recently teamed up to win the G2 Godolphin Mile with Two Rivers Over (Tamarkuz) on the Dubai World Cup undercard at Meydan. Cady and Leatherman claimed Two Rivers Over for just \$30,000 out of a maiden claimer at Ellis Park last June.

"Both great guys," O'Neill said. "I've trained for Ty for, geez, 15-20 years maybe. We got lucky and won the Japan Cup Dirt with a horse named Fleetstreet Dancer back in 2003. He took a

little hiatus from the business and came back bigger than ever a few years back. I was so grateful that he called me to reunite. He's been great."

O'Neill continued, "Todd Cady I've trained for the past couple of years. He's awesome. The great thing with Ty and Todd, they both know the sport really well and they're both successful businessmen. They've got a good approach and a good sense of being patient and doing the right thing. Both great guys to train for and we've been lucky so far."

The two-time Kentucky Derby-winning trainer and the aforementioned duo have had success buying off Mendez and Northrup before. Like Vlahos, last year's GI Cotillion S. Ceiling Crusher (Mr. Big) was acquired privately by a group including Cady and Leatherman and transferred to O'Neill following a debut score for Mendez and Northrup at Santa Anita.

Mendez was also the original trainer of the talented sprinter and young Taylor Made stallion **Dr. Schivel (Violence)**, who was purchased privately and moved to trainer Mark Glatt for his 3-year-old season.

"We're all pretty friendly with Luis Mendez and (his business partner and bloodstock agent) John Brocklebank, two really sharp horsemen," O'Neill said.

"After his debut we had heard that they were willing to take on a couple of partners if anyone would be interested. We reached out to John and Luis and got a deal done. Two of the gentlemen that were in on him in the debut are still in--Dan Northrup and Greg Pappas. It's four good guys and most importantly a really good horse."

Overlooked at 13-1 in his unveiling, the blinkered Vlahos was hustled to the front by Edwin Maldonado from his rail draw and sped through fractions of :21.47 and :43.69 in the 6 1/2-furlong affair. **Cont.**

He began to give them the slip on the far turn, switched over to his right lead as they straightened for home and kept on motoring down the stretch to win impressively by 4 1/2 lengths.

Vlahos's form was further flattered when the third-place finisher that day Ball Don't Lie (**Blame**) returned to graduate with a 97 Beyer Speed Figure for Glatt at Santa Anita Apr. 6.

Vlahos's sire **Kantharos** is responsible for nine graded/group winners worldwide. Vlahos, bred in Kentucky by John Bates, Ron Kirk and Greg McDonald, is the first to the races for the two-time winner Must Be Dreaming, a full-sister to Canadian champion Are You Kidding Me. The 10-year-old mare Must Be Dreaming was purchased by Denali Stud for \$40,000 while in foal to **Tiz the Law** at the 2023 Keeneland January Sale. Must Be Dreaming produced a colt by **Tiz the Law** last year and was bred to **Charlatan** for 2024.

"There's no buyer's remorse at this point," O'Neill concluded. "We're excited. We're definitely throwing him into the deep end. But he just acts like that horse that is more mature than his race record would say."

PRETTY MISCHIEVOUS TO MAKE 4-YEAR-OLD DEBUT IN LA TROIENNE STAKES

Champion filly **Pretty Mischievous** (Into Mischief) will return to the scene of her greatest triumph when she kicks off her 4-year-old campaign in the May 3 GI La Troienne S. at Churchill Downs. Pretty Mischievous won last year's GI Kentucky Oaks, a win that went a long way toward her earning an Eclipse Award as the nation's outstanding 3-year-old filly.

"She's been doing great and working very well," trainer Brendan Walsh said. "We're very happy with the way she has progressed from three to four. We won't know until we actually get her on the racetrack, but we've been very pleased with the way she's been working. She seems as enthusiastic as ever and is working as well as she ever has. We're looking forward to getting her back."

Pretty Mischievous was being pointed for last year's GI Breeders' Cup Distaff and made the trip to Santa Anita. But Walsh pulled her out of the race because he wasn't happy with the way she was doing.

"We brought her out there and she didn't travel well," he said. "She got a little colicky when we got her out there and she was acting dull. It was coming to the end of the year and she wasn't giving us the right vibes. We didn't want to risk having no horse this year. We thought we'd do the smart thing and take her out. Hopefully, she can make up for it this year."

After the Breeders' Cup, she was sent to Godolphin's Kentucky farm and was given a couple of months off. Walsh said the filly arrived at his barn at Palm Meadows in Florida around the first of the year. She had her first recorded workout Feb. 22 and followed that up with seven more works. The most recent was a five-furlong breeze at Keeneland Apr. 13 in which she went in 1:01. Walsh said the filly will be moved to Churchill Downs next week to prepare for her 2024 debut in the La Troienne.

"You always look forward to getting a horse like this back," he said. "It's exciting to have a horse of her caliber, a champion filly. It will be exciting to see how it goes. If she improves at all she should be very tough in that division this year. She worked really well here last week. She looks as good, if not better, than she ever has."

So far as future plans, Walsh said he has not mapped out a schedule, but will point for this year's Distaff.

"We'll start with this race and see how it goes," he said. "Obviously, the Breeders' Cup at the end of the year is a goal. If she maintains her form we'll point her to all of the top races."

In addition to the Oaks, Pretty Mischievous won last year's GI Rachel Alexandra S, the GI Acorn S. and the GI Test S.

MOTT CLASSIC CONTENDERS RESILIENCE, JUST F Y I RETURN TO THE WORK TAB

Trainer Bill Mott's barn sent out a pair of Classic aspirants Thursday morning, including Emily Bushnell and Ric Waldman's GII Wood Memorial winner **Resilience** (Into Mischief) along with George Krikorian's GI Ashland S. runner-up **Just F Y I** (**Justify**). The two returned to the work tab to continue their preparations for the GI Kentucky Derby and GI Kentucky Oaks, respectively.

The duo began their work together at 7:30 a.m. ET after galloping about one mile. The defending champion juvenile filly Just F Y I worked to the outside of Resilience and began one-length behind. By the quarter-pole, Just F Y I moved about a length in front of Resilience but, by the wire, the duo finished together. Resilience, who covered four furlongs in :50.2, finished his five-furlong gallop out in 1:02.80 while Just F Y I went four panels in :50 flat, galloping out in 1:03.40, according to Churchill Downs Clocker John Nichols.

"I thought [Resilience] had a great trip in the Wood Memorial," Mott said. "I thought Johnny [Velazquez] rode him great. He might have gotten a little jammed up on the first turn but got clear down the backside. When he asked him, he responded and he finished up well. The best part is he looked good visually.

Resilience is out of Meadowsweet (Smart Strike), a daughter of MGISW Tranquility Lake (Rahy) and a half-sister to Grade I scorers Courageous Cat (Storm Cat) and After Market (Storm Cat).

"The entire family of this horse has been very accomplished on the racetrack. Part of the family is Courageous Cat, who I trained for a Grade I win [in the Shoemaker Mile]. The owners have been in the breeding business a long time and Resilience is just the result of their program."

Resilience was bred in Kentucky by Pam and the late Marty Wygod, the parents of Bushnell. This would be the first starter in

the Kentucky Derby for the Wygod family along with Waldman, a longtime partner of the Wygods.

Resilience and Just F Y I are stabled in Mott's Barn 19.

SEVEN EQUINE FATALITIES IN MARCH RAISES CAUTION, BUT NOT ALARM, FROM CHRB

In the wake of news that seven racehorses at properties under the jurisdiction of the California Horse Racing Board (CHRB) died in March, several commissioners and staffers at Thursday's monthly board meeting raised the verbal equivalent of a yellow flag with the goal of preventing future fatalities that would equate to a spike into red-alert territory.

"Our injury rate, death rate, is creeping up," chairman Gregory Ferraro, DVM, said after CHRB equine medical director Jeff Blea gave the statistics in his report. "Do you have any solutions, reasons, comments about that?" he asked.

"Solutions, no. Reasons, each one is unique," Blea replied.

"For example, in March, there were two tibias, one shoulder in a Quarter Horse, and two fetlocks," Blea said, describing the underlying fatality reasons and settings in four musculoskeletal injuries that occurred in training and one in racing.

Blea said the other two deaths were "medical-condition fatalities unrelated to exercise."

Blea continued: "When I look at the necropsy reports and when I'm involved in the post-mortems, each one is unique. Solutions, I think what we need to continue doing is what we've been doing. We need to continue the educational point of the welfare, the racing and safety program that the CHRB established, trainer [continuing education]. We need to continue the education through the post-mortem examination reviews. And we need to continue to get that message out.

"We need to continue to remind our stakeholders not to get complacent," Blea said. "It's easy to get complacent. Right now is a difficult time for not only the industry but specifically in California. I think the horsemen feel it, management feels it, everyone feels it. So I think it's [important] to continue to do what we've been doing, and continue to do it better than we've been doing it.

"There's been some discussion in some circles about penalties for fatalities," Blea said. "I think that is recirculated conversation from a few years ago. That is going to take quite a bit of in-depth discussion and understanding as to how that sort of process would work.

"In other words, if you have more than one fatality, two fatalities, three fatalities [you'd face penalization]," Blea said.

"Some folks have brought that notion back up, but I think horsemen are keenly aware that the last thing they want is a fatality. But I think in order to help reduce those numbers, we just have to keep our foot on the pedal."

Ferraro then wanted to know how many trainers might have had more than one musculoskeletal fatality in their stables over a 12-month period.

Scott Chaney, the CHRB's executive director, didn't have the exact figures in front of him, but off the top of his head, he said that based on the last annual report the CHRB put out, he believed that of around 66 fatalities statewide, "in the neighborhood of 10 trainers that had more than one."

Chaney clarified that, "So the vast majority obviously have [just] one. And then I think there was maybe one trainer with four, one with three, and a handful with two."

CHRB vice chair Oscar Gonzales said it was important for the board to remain vigilant about keeping an eye on horses training and racing off of extended layoffs, and he added that he knows that oversight in general can be difficult at a time when the industry is short on veterinarians.

Chaney agreed that the layoff horses deserve the extra scrutiny they get from the CHRB.

"Those [injuries] are particularly troublesome, because they are preventable," Chaney said, noting the CHRB's required extra examinations for horses coming off a layoff.

Widening the lens further, Chaney added, "The sudden death ones, I still think we're still trying to get our arms around. But large-bone injuries we can prevent."

Gonzales summed up the discussion by reminding stakeholders, "The last thing we need are more rules and regs, or even for the state legislature to act in the instance where they feel not enough has been done." **Cont.**

HORSES LEFT BEHIND GATE AT BOTH EVANGELINE AND INDY

Races at Evangeline Downs and Horseshoe Indianapolis both went off without all horses being loaded into the starting gate on Wednesday.

The fourth race at Evangeline Apr. 17, a mile route for \$4,000 claimers, was declared a "no contest" by the stewards because multiple horses were involved. The \$54,453 in mutuels for the race had to either be refunded or paid out as part of "all" combinations for that leg in multi-race exotics.

Several hours earlier, the sixth race at Indy, a 5 1/2-furlong sprint for Indiana-bred maiden special weights, ended up with the stewards declaring the outermost-drawn entrant, Tremor (Unbridled Express), a non-starter whose bets were subject to refund.

The announcers at both tracks quickly informed the public in their calls that not all horses had loaded before the start and to expect an inquiry.

The Equibase chart described the chaos in the Evangeline race like this: "Paynt Battle (Paynter) unprepared start, rider left without irons, made a mild bid and faded...Gottatakehimto (Speighter Man) had an awkward start and was never close. Callinginthenight (Nownownow) unprepared start and was quickly pulled up. Smoky Topaz (Congrats) unprepared at the start and lost rider. Turn On the Magic (Khozan) not loaded in gates."

Updates on the riderless and pulled-up horses involved in the Evangeline "no contest" were not available at the time this story was posted. The jockeys on those mounts all rode later on the card.

The Evangeline incident was the second "no contest" at that track in as many racing dates because of an issue involving the starting gate.

On the previous day Evangeline raced, Apr. 13, the second race, a starter/optional claimer at one mile on the turf, had \$68,005 in wagers refunded when the starting gate could not be moved out of the homestretch.

Despite the barrier being stuck across the homestretch about four paths off the rail, the race was not called off in progress, and the nine jockeys had to shoot a narrow gap between the gate and the inside rail to finish.

WEEKLY STEWARDS AND COMMISSIONS RULINGS, APR. 10-17

Every week, the TDN posts a roundup of the relevant Horseracing Integrity and Safety Act (HISA)-related rulings from around the country.

Among this week's rulings, the focus once again has been on intra-articular injections before workouts.

As it stands, HISA imposes a seven-day prohibition of any inter-articular injection of any joint prior to a timed workout, and a 14-day ban prior to a race. Proposed rules currently before the Federal Trade Commission (FTC) would add additional wrinkles to this rule.

These proposed rules would bar a horse treated with any corticosteroid intra-articular injection of the metacarpophalangeal or metatarsophalangeal joints--in other words, the front and hind fetlock joints--from working for 14 days and racing for 30 days following treatment.

Six separate trainers were this past week sanctioned for breaching the current joint injection rule before workouts, each issued a \$3,000 fine. One new trainer has an additional case pending.

The filly's dam Cintra (Ire) (Camacho {GB}), an unraced daughter of European Broodmare of the Year Bordighera (Alysheba), was purchased by James Wigan's London Thoroughbred Services for 420,000gns (\$570,730) on behalf of Erdenheim at the 2019 Tattersalls December Mare Sale and she produced a **Kingman (GB)** filly the following spring, visiting this outstanding stallion prior to her export. The listed-placed Bordighera was the dam of nine winners from 11 to race, including the globetrotting three-time Group 1 winner Grandera (Grand Lodge)--also placed at the highest level in France and Australia--as well as multiple champion George Washington (Ire) (Danehill), whose four Group 1 victories included the 2006 G1 Stan James (English) 2000 Guineas; and SW Sun Central (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}).
