

SIERRA LEONE, CATCHING FREEDOM, TARIFA LEAD DERBY, OAKS WORKERS

With less than two weeks to the first weekend in May, a gaggle of contenders for the GI Kentucky Derby and GI Kentucky Oaks took to racetracks across the country for some critical breezes Saturday morning.

'**TDN Rising Star**' Sierra Leone (Gun Runner) has remained at Keeneland since his slashing victory in the Apr. 6 GI Toyota Blue Grass S. and returned to the worktab for the first time on a chilly morning, breezing a half-mile in the company inside of recent Keeneland maiden winner White Palomino (Kitten's Joy) in :48.80 (19/127) ([video](#)).

The \$2.3-million topper from the 2022 Fasig-Tipton Saratoga Sale was caught in even splits of :12.40, :24.20 and :36.80 before galloping out a strong five furlongs in 1:01.20 and three-quarters in 1:15.60. Exercise rider Kriss Bon--apparently optimistic that Joel Embiid would be suiting up for Game 1 of the Philadelphia 76ers first-round NBA playoff appearance against the New York Knicks--in the stirrups.

"I've always worked him in company in the mornings," said trainer Chad Brown. "He's always been a decent workhorse, just needs a little focus. Obviously, we've added blinkers this year, which have helped. But a little competition so he just feels a horse next to him just keeps him in the bridle nicely.

KINGSBARN'S WINS BEN ALI WITH AUTHORITY by J. N. Campbell

Looking strong as an oak in the GIII Ben Ali S. at Keeneland, Kingsbarn's (Uncle Mo) cleared professionally down the lane to take home his second graded stakes trophy for Spendthrift's case on Saturday afternoon.

The 2023 GII Louisiana Derby winner finished 14th behind Mage (Good Magic) in the GI Kentucky Derby before completing his 3-year-old year when he was beaten only a neck as the heavy favorite in the Pegasus S. at Monmouth June 17.

After a nine-month hiatus, Kingsbarn's returned to Gulfstream Park Mar. 2 for the first time since breaking his maiden early in 2023. Though he lagged in sixth for the first half of the race, the 4-year-old showed his class by motoring home in the final jumps to win by a half-length in the prep for this spot.

Tabbed as the 8-5 choice here, Kingsbarn's exited the gate with what looked like a recreation of his Louisiana Derby trip, but jockey Luis Saez took him back into the first turn and the pair settled to the outside in the second flight. **Cont. p9**

“He’s a good-feeling horse—a nice horse to work around,” he continued. “He’s a very alpha horse. He’s definitely in charge of what’s going on everywhere, and we give him his space and we let him be him. He’s a very rare horse to have in your shedrow.”

Sierra Leone heads to Churchill Sunday and is tentatively scheduled to have his final breeze Apr. 27, weather permitting.

Brown's second Derby hopeful, Gill Lambholm South Tampa Bay Derby winner **Domestic Product** (**Practical Joke**), went a half-mile in:48.40 at Payson Park Saturday morning and ships to Kentucky on Monday, with the commonly owned Oaks contender and **'TDN Rising Star'** **Ways and Means** (**Practical Joke**). The latter drilled five panels in 1:00.60 at Payson Park Saturday.

Catching Freedom Goes Early at Churchill

With the majority of the pre-Derby hype focused on **'TDN Rising Star'** Fierceness (**City of Light**) and Sierra Leone and to a lesser extent Forever Young (Jpn) (Real Steel {Jpn}), **Catching Freedom** (**Constitution**) is arguably the most-accomplished horse getting the least amount of attention two weeks out.

The GII Louisiana Derby winner was one of the first to visit the Churchill main track Saturday morning at 5:15 and covered five furlongs in 1:00.80, breaking off slowly through fractions of :25.40 and three-eighths in :37.80 before galloping out six furlongs in an energetic 1:13.20 and seven in 1:26.20, per clocker John Nichols. Trainer Brad Cox sent out stablemate **Just a Touch** (**Justify**), a latest second in the Blue Grass, for a half-mile breeze that was timed in :48.20 (:24.20, 1:01.20).

'**TDN Rising Star**' **Tarifa** (Bernardini), in many eyes the Oaks favorite, was out soon after to breeze five furlongs in the company of fellow Oaks hopeful **Gin Gin** (Hightail). The duo stopped the clock in 1:00.80 in fractional times of :13 and :37.20, with a six-furlong gallop out in 1:14.20.

Just Steel (**Justify**) breezed an eventful six furlongs in 1:13.80 (:13.40, :37.20, :49.40). After beginning his move by himself, he was joined by a stablemate to his inside and the duo was confronted by a pair of Norm Casse workers at the half-mile pole. But by the time they reached the stretch, the Wayne Lukas trainees had separated themselves and completed the work in tandem.

The Lukas-trained **Lemon Muffin** (**Collected**), who earned her way into the Oaks with an upset in the GIII Honeybee S., breezed five furlongs in 1:02.20.

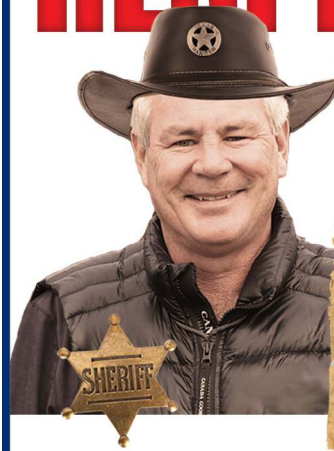
Gargan, McPeek Each Breeze A Pair

New York-based trainer Danny Gargan will have two runners in this year's Run for the Roses, and that team eyeballed one another through a half-mile breeze in :48.20 (16/123) Saturday in Louisville.

Dornoch (**Good Magic**), the full-brother to 2023 Derby hero **Mage** who won the GII Coolmore Fountain of Youth S. Mar. 2, worked outside of stablemate **Society Man** (**Good Magic**), long-odds runner-up in the GII Wood Memorial S.

Mystik Dan (Goldencents), upset winner of the GIII Southwest S. and third in the GI Arkansas Derby, will carry the hopes of the Ken McPeek barn and earned the bullet for his five-furlong work Saturday that was timed in :59.40 (1/71) beneath the Twin Spires. '**TDN Rising Star**' **Thorpedo Anna** (Fast Anna) continues to thrive following her comebacking victory in the GIII Fantasy S. and went a five furlongs in 1:00.60 (14/71). **Cont. p5**

“She’s a super nice filly,” McPeck said. “I was very impressed with how easily she was able to win the Fantasy off the layoff and she’s run very well over this surface here at Churchill. They better bring a bear [in the Oaks] because I’m bringing a grizzly. I wouldn’t be afraid to run her against the colts.”

Stronghold Breezes A Bullet At Santa Anita

Stronghold (*Ghostzapper*), last-out winner of the GI Santa Anita Derby, worked a swift half-mile in :46.60 Saturday morning in Arcadia beneath jockey Antonio Fresu and under the watchful eye of trainer Phil D’Amato.

Coming onto the track just after 6:30 a.m., Stronghold broke off at the half-mile pole a few lengths behind a stablemate, drew even with a sixteenth of a mile to the finish and was narrowly in front at the wire. Crack California-bred sprinter The Chosen Vron (*Vronsky*) shared the bullet time for the half-mile.

“He did it so easy,” said Fresu. “I was actually expecting about :48 the way he was going,” he added. “The track was a little fast today. I didn’t ask him for anything.”

Per D’Amato, Stronghold will ship to Kentucky this coming Tuesday and will have his final Derby work next weekend.

The 5-year-old bounced well from gate 10 and showed his typical good early speed to sit just off the pace of his stable companion **County Final** (Oxbow)—ostensibly a 60-1 pacemaker—through an opening couple of furlongs in a strong :23.21. Positions were largely unchanged through the middle furlongs as the tempo became more steady, and as they raced into the final three-eighths of a mile, Skippylongstocking easily collared the pacesetter and began to open up as one of his chief market rivals, **Reincarnate** (*Good Magic*), began to back-pedal. Godolphin's rail-drawn **Highland Falls** (*Curlin*) split horses at the quarter pole and loomed the only real threat, but Skippylongstocking was always holding that one in the run to the line. **Red Route One** (*Gun Runner*) rallied from last to finish a non-threatening third.

Skippylongstocking led every step of the way to take out the \$1-million GII Charles Town Classic around that West Virginia bullring last August and gave an excellent account of himself in the GI Breeders' Cup Dirt Mile, finishing 3 3/4 lengths behind Horse of the Year **Cody's Wish** (*Curlin*) and National Treasure (*Quality Road*) in third. Pulled up and out of the GI Pegasus World Cup in January, the bay rebounded with a successful defense of his title in the GIII Challenger S. at Tampa Mar. 9.

Brushy Hill acquired the dam of Skippylongstocking for \$42,000 in foal to **Liam's Map** at the 2018 OBS Winter Mixed Sale and the in-utero foal became Moonlite Strike, a stakes winner and third in the 2021 GII Lambholm South Tampa Bay Derby. Skippylongstocking's year-younger half-sister Olivia Twist won the Trapeze S. at the back end of her 2-year-old season and was third in last year's GIII Fantasy S. Olivia Twist was most recently an allowance winner at Sunland Park Mar. 22.

A half-sister to a pair of black-type earners, Twinkling is also responsible for the 2-year-old filly Mia's Mom (**Maclean's Music**), a \$275,000 purchase by Bill Parcells's August Dawn Farm at last year's Fasig-Tipton Saratoga Sale and a yearling filly by Authentic. Trying a distance beyond nine furlongs for the first time in his career, Godolphin's Silver Knott got first run on his rivals entering the final three furlongs of Saturday's GII VisitLEX Elkhorn S. and kicked on nicely in the stretch to make a winning return to the races.

Drawn widest in a field scratched down to nine, Silver Knott was alertly into stride and was perhaps a touch keen through the early exchanges, but ultimately settled off the flank of 97-1 leader Wentru (**Tourist**) passing the stands for the first time. Settled better beneath Flavien Prat as they headed to the backstretch, the gelding held his spot from second, but behind him, things got a bit messy, as Dynadrive (Temple City) went for a middle move outside of horses, forcing the hands of both Missed the Cut to his immediate inside and a tugging Highland Chief (Ire) (**Gleneagles (Ire)**) in the three path.

In front for a stride or two approaching the half-mile pole, Silver Knott was back into second entering the turn, but was asked to claim Wentru with three-eighths of a mile to travel. Firmly in front turning for home, Silver Knott sprinted nicely and proved a comfortable winner as Missed the Cut gave vain chase. Odds-on Bold Act tugged hard against Frankie Dettori for much of the opening mile and stayed on at one pace for third.

“He was pretty forward going into the first turn, and after that it was just a matter of getting him to relax,” Prat said. “He was traveling actually a bit strong. But it worked out well. I was very pleased when we were going down the backside, and then horses came alongside of us so that made us go a little bit. But it gave him a chance to actually get a nice breather, and once I called on him, as you could tell he had a great turn of foot.”

A dual Group 3 winner at two in England, Silver Knott was beaten a nose into second on his first trip to North America in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf over this course, was 11th in last year's G1 English 2000 Guineas and spent the rest of the year on these shores. Though winless in five tries, he hit the board on four occasions, finishing third as the favorite in Belmont's GII Pennine Ridge S. over nine furlongs and in the GII Secretariat S. going a mile at Colonial. A sound second in the GII Twilight Derby on Breeders' Cup Saturday last November, the bay was making his first start since a third in the GI Hollywood Derby at Del Mar Dec. 2. **Cont. p9**

God Given is a half-sister to Postponed (Ire) (Dubawi {Ire}), himself a King George winner in addition to a G1 Dubai Sheema Classic, each over a mile and a half. The G1 Moyglare Stud S.-winning third dam Bianca Nera adds further luster to the pedigree.

God Given is also the dam of the 3-year-old colt King's Reign (Fr) (Dubawi {Ire}) and the 2-year-old colt Divine Legacy (GB) (Siyouni {Fr}). @EquinealTDN

Up front, it was **Laughing Boy** (Distorted Humor) who was attempting to run the field off their feet, but the orange and purple squared silks were instead focused on **War Campaign** (Declaration of War) up the backstretch.

As that 5-year-old began to gear up, Kingsbarns shadowed him into the far turn. With the pacesetter giving way, the pair locked in a duel through the eighth pole, but it was the 4-year-old colt who made the lead and put away his rival for good.

"This is a credit to (trainer) Todd (Pletcher's) management and the fact that Eric Gustavson (owner and President of Spendthrift Farm) made the decision to give him the time (off) that he needed," said Spendthrift General Manager Ned Toffey. "He needed some time after his 3-year-old campaign, he got it, and he's just done so well from 3 to 4 (years old). Hopefully he's going to reward us with a big year."

The pace was moderate at best, and Shiloh's Mistress--having her first start on the turf--bowed along at her leisure on the engine, but Medoro was also not having to do much work to match strides and the two were more or less on even terms nearing the stretch. Medoro was asked to kick and put a head in front with a furlong and a half to race, looking the more likely of the two, but Shiloh's Mistress refused to lie down and was just on the losing end of the bobber.

"I really like this filly, she's very tough," Fresu said. "Today wasn't an easy spot because she was going a little longer and there was not much speed in the race. I was just trying to get her relaxed and get her into a nice position.

"I was just waiting for the turn to home to ask her to go," Fresu continued. "She did it, but then she kind of wanted to stay with some company. The other horse was coming to me and she kept fighting to the end. She is just a good filly and she wants to win."

It was the third time in her four starts that Medoro had found herself in a battle to the finish. Up in the dying strides to graduate by a head in a five-furlong maiden at Del Mar Dec. 1, she was again forced to dig deep late when prevailing by a neck in the Dec. 29 Blue Norther S. Given a bit of a breather, the bay was exiting a 2 1/4-length 'romp' in the China Doll S. Mar. 10 and was being asked to stretch beyond a mile for the first time on Saturday.

Mr Fisk, winner of last November's GIII Native Diver S. at Del Mar, upset the heavily favored Judge Miller for his second career graded victory.

Given a 7-2 chance in this scratched-down field of four, Mr Fisk was kept within striking distance while trailing as the highly regarded Judge Miller, the recipient of a 105 Beyer Speed Figure in a runaway optional claiming win Feb. 24, had things his own way up front through fractions of :24.67 and :48.75.

Mr Fisk launched with a flashy move on the far turn, hit the front approaching the quarter pole and leveled off nicely in the stretch to take care of business.

Mr Fisk, a dead-heat winner of last year's Shared Belief S., was a punchless fifth in the GII San Pasqual S. last time Jan. 27.

"He is getting better," winning trainer Bob Baffert said. "I have a great team and we've been schooling him, he's tough. He can be really tough and aggressive, but I think we just freshened him up. The owners they let me freshen him up and get him right for this race. We are looking at down the road at the (GII Hollywood) Gold Cup, at a mile and a quarter (Monday, May 27). Being by Arrogate he is bred for this."

YUTTITHAM A FIRST JAPANESE STAKES

WINNER FOR JUSTIFY *by Alan Carasso*

Carrying the famed colors of Deep Impact (Jpn)'s owner Makoto Kaneko, **Yuttitham (Jpn)** became the first Japanese stakes winner for Coolmore America's Triple Crown winner **Justify** with a narrow victory in Saturday's \$298,147 Listed Oasis S. going a one-turn mile on the dirt track at Tokyo Racecourse.

The fourth betting choice at just over 5-1, the 4-year-old was one of the first to break the line from post position 16 and raced in a share of third while deep on the track down the back straight. Traveling well in hand three deep passing the 600-meter marker, Yuttitham was held together into the homestretch, but was asked to quicken when **Perriere (Jpn)** (Henny Hughes)--a two-time course-and-distance stakes winner--rolled up to his immediate outside with a menacing bid of his own.

But Yuttitham would have none of it, as he boxed on tenaciously from between horses to lead with a bit less than a furlong to race and managed to keep his head in front on the line ([video](#)). Third home was **Omega Guinness (Jpn)** (Logotype {Jpn}), the beaten favorite in the G1 February S. at headquarters two months back.

Shadai Farm acquired Yuttitham's dam, 2017 GI First Lady S. heroine Zipessa (City Zip), for \$1.25 million in foal to **Medaglia d'Oro** at the 2018 Keeneland November Sale, but this colt is the mare's first listed produce. Shadai immediately recouped their outlay when Yuttitham was knocked down to Kaneko for ¥200 million (\$1,815,520) at the 2021 JRHA Select Yearling Sale, and Kaneko went back to the well the following summer, purchasing Zipessa's colt by Isla Bonita (Jpn) for ¥76 million (\$558,835). Pakarang, a debut fifth to GI Kentucky Derby hopeful T O Password (Jpn) (Copano Rickey {Jpn}) in January, most recently broke his maiden at third asking at Hanshin Mar. 17.

Zipessa is also the dam of the 2-year-old filly Rapid Growth (Jpn) (Kizuna {Jpn}), a yearling filly by the outstanding Lord Kanaloa (Jpn) and was due to Orfevre (Jpn) for 2024.

Yuttitham is the 27th worldwide stakes winners for **Justify** and is one of his 14 Japanese winners, a number that also includes the 4-year-old filly Awesome Result, unbeaten in her five racetrack appearances to date. Yuttitham has a record of 4-1-1 from eight starts and earnings of about \$478,000.

CORRALES DISCHARGE FROM HOSPITAL AFTER FATAL ACCIDENT AT KEENELAND

During Friday's fifth race at Keeneland, February Son (Mizzen Mast) was removed from the track via equine ambulance and was later euthanized, according to a report from Keeneland.

"February Son sustained an injury and was attended to by an expert team of veterinarians led by KHRC Chief Veterinarian Dr. Nick Smith in consultation with Dr. Stuart Brown, Vice President of Equine Safety at Keeneland," said the report. "Given the extent of the injury, it was determined that humane euthanasia was in the best interest of the horse. Keeneland offers our heartfelt condolences to owner Captain Jack Racing Stable and trainer Anthony Granitz."

His rider Gerardo Corrales was taken to the University of Kentucky's Emergency Department. He was evaluated and discharged from the hospital.

Gary and Mary West homebred **Flashy Dancer** (f, 3, **Curlin**--**Actress**, by **Tapit**) came from out of the clouds to earn **'TDN Rising Star'** honors for trainer Brad Cox at second asking at Oaklawn Park Saturday.

Flashy Dancer was off to a slow start and trailed the field of eight through fractions of :23.03 and :46.97 in the 1 1/16-mile affair. The 3-1 chance finally entered the picture rounding the far turn and continued to roll approaching the quarter pole. She still had her work cut out for her, however, as heavily favored Bob Baffert-trained first-time starter **Miss Rockette** (Into Mischief) struck the front at the top of the stretch.

Miss Rockette, a \$1.25-million KESEP yearling buy for Frank Fletcher, kicked for home and looked well on her way while up by three lengths in the stretch, but Flashy Dancer was just warming up. Miss Rockette began to grow leg weary close to home and Flashy Dancer blew right on by to win going away by 1 1/4 lengths.

Flashy Dancer was a well-beaten second on debut as the 9-5 favorite after getting pinched at the start going a mile in the mud at Oaklawn Mar. 9.

Flashy Dancer, a half-sister to last year's GIII Withers S. winner and GII Wood Memorial S. runner-up Hit Show (**Candy Ride {Arg}**), becomes the 26th **'Rising Star'** for **Curlin**. The **Curlin** x **Tapit** cross is also responsible for 2023 Horse of the Year **Cody's Wish**. The winner's dam **Actress**, winner of the 2017 GII Black-Eyed Susan S., is also responsible for a 2-year-old filly by **Medaglia d'Oro**. The West homebred was bred to **Justify** for 2024.

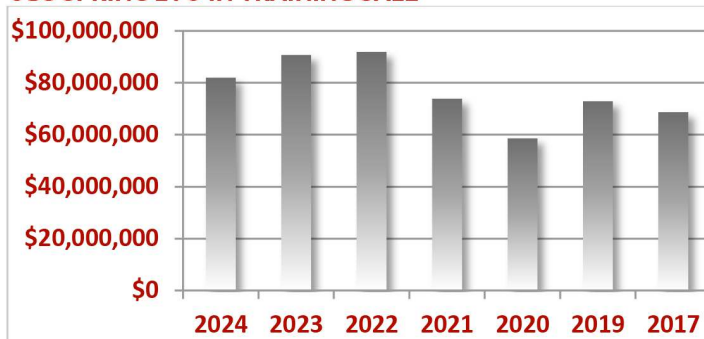

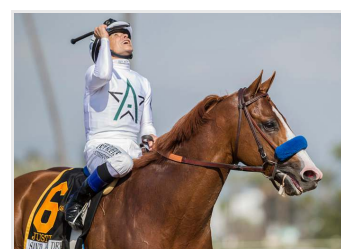

Scuderia Sagam's **Folgaria (Ire)** (Due Diligence--Full Moon Fever {Ire}, by Azamour {Ire}) went undefeated through a five-race juvenile campaign for Stefano Botti last year and, now under the stewardship of that trainer's brother Marco, retained her perfect record with a hard-fought triumph in Saturday's G3 Dubai Duty Free S. (Fred Darling S.) at Newbury.

The February-foaled bay backed up a debut win at Milan's San Siro in May with a brace of Listed contests at Rome's Capanelle and back in Milan. ESQUIRE WINS THE GREENHAM

Saturday's G3 Watership Down Stud Too Darn Hot Greenham S. looked a renewal short of a potential big name beforehand and with a blanket in contention a furlong from home, that was duly borne out. In the event, it was Cheveley Park Stud's 16-1 shot **Esquire (GB)** (Harry Angel {Ire})--a gelding and therefore excluded from the upcoming 2000 Guineas--who emerged on top in the seven-furlong Newbury trial whose relevance to the Classic is questionable this year. Runner-up in York's Listed Rockingham S. and sixth in the Listed Doncaster S. over six furlongs in October, the David O'Meara-trained homebred was free early close to the pace but stuck at it and landed on the front approaching the final furlong. Driven out by Danny Tudhope, the grandson of the operation's top-class Peeress (GB) (Pivotal {GB}) who enjoyed her finest hour here when winning the G1 Lockinge S. had 1 1/4 lengths to spare over the dead-heating 28-1 shot **El Bodon (Ire)** (Churchill {Ire}) and 7-2 favourite **Zoum Zoum (GB)** (Zoustar {Aus}).

"I wasn't sure he would stay the seven today, but today has opened that option," O'Meara said. "We loved him before he won his maiden which was only at Hamilton and then he finished second in a listed race at York, but he disappointed at Doncaster on heavy ground at the end of last season. I thought he could come here today and maybe finish fourth or fifth, but I wasn't sure he would win." [Cont. p5](#)

Folgaria forfeited ground to all five rivals initially, racing at the tail of the field in sixth through the opening fractions, and began inching closer once past halfway. Stirred into action passing the quarter-mile marker, the 5-1 chance was ridden to launch her challenge approaching the final furlong and came under a late drive to prevail by a neck from **Regal Jubilee (GB) (Frankel {GB})**, with **Elmalka (GB) (Kingman {GB})** another neck back in third.

There could not have been a more poignant winner on the day of Stefano Cherchi's funeral, with the young jockey's loss having a heavy impact on the Botti stable. The trainer's wife Lucie was on hand and commented, "You couldn't write this, Andrea [Atzeni] winning the Sydney Cup with Stefano's parents there and now this filly bringing Italian racing to life again. It is

quite special. Marco went to Stefano's funeral and obviously his brother trained this filly in Italy. Everyone is going to be so pleased, especially in the yard. The winter can be so hard for everyone, so it's always so good to have such beautiful horses and those animals just bring us to life. It's very hard to translate the form into English form, but she did nothing wrong in Italy and won all her races fairly easily last year. She's been pleasing us at home since she joined us and is very straightforward. We absolutely love her, hopefully she can do much better things in the future. The immediate plan is likely to be the [May 12 G1] French [1000] Guineas and after that the sky is the limit. She could be an international filly and hopefully not sold too soon for us. She's very talented, she's the champion Italian filly and she has showed now she is good enough everywhere else."

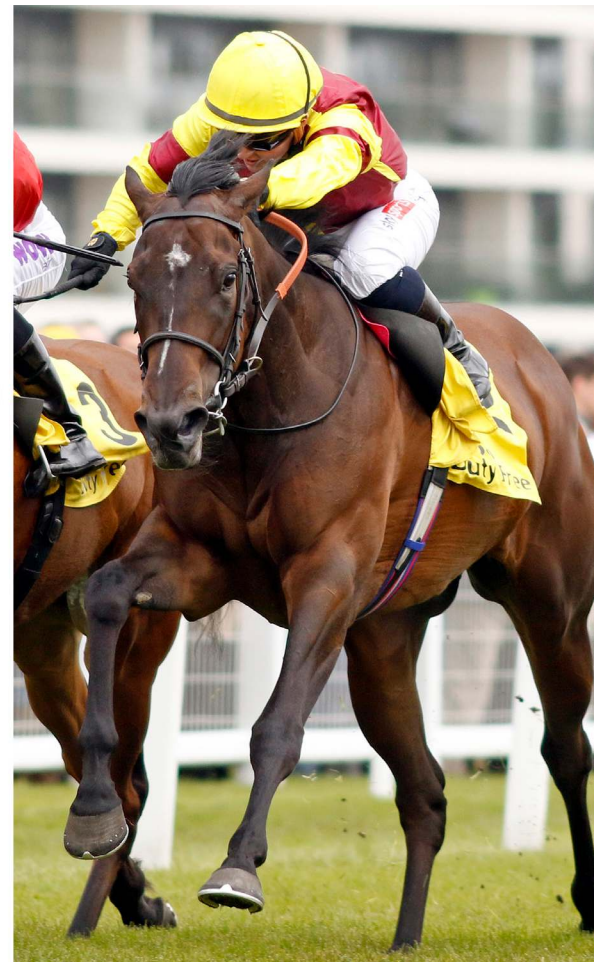

Jane Chapple-Hyam has a smart collection of 3-year-olds and said of El Bodon, "He's one who will improve as the season goes on and we will see how he comes out of this race, but I can't see us going for the Guineas as he showed some speed there." Ralph Beckett said of Zoum Zoum, "We will aim for the [G3] Jersey [at Royal Ascot] and we might end up dropping back to six furlongs with him at some point. I think he will be suited by six furlongs once he's learned his job, he's a slow learner as you can see there."

HAMISH DIGS DEEP FOR JOHN PORTER

TRIUMPH *By Sean Cronin*

William Haggas trainee **Hamish (GB)** (Motivator {GB})--Tweed {GB}, by Sakhee) contested four Group 3 heats last year, going through the campaign unbeaten, and continued on a roll with a game victory, as the 5-2 favourite, in Saturday's G3 Dubai Duty Free Finest Surprise S. (John Porter S.) at Newbury.

The 8-year-old gelding, runner-up in 2022's G1 Irish St Leger, adopted his customary hold-up tactics after a sluggish getaway and settled off the tempo in eighth until well beyond halfway. Making relentless progress in the straight, he gained a slender advantage passing the furlong pole and was driven out to deny old foe **Al Qareem (Ire)** (Awtaad {Ire}) by a neck for an eighth success at Group 3 level.

"He doesn't really do a lot in front, the ground wasn't really soft enough and he had a three-pound penalty, but he keeps winning and that's terrific." said William Haggas. "That's five-in-a-row at Group 3 level and now we have to go up in grade and see if he can cope with that. It will be the [May 9 G3] Ormonde [at Chester] or the [May 17 G2] Yorkshire Cup, but he does need soft ground. It does not rain at York anymore, so that could be a problem. Chester it always rains, so I suppose it will be the Ormonde. He won that last year, but he will have a penalty, so we will see. He's marvellous, but it's nothing to do with me. It's all Maureen. She rides him, eats, sleeps and thinks about him all the time. I take all the glory which is terrific, but she gets all the credit from me."

He added, "If he had to be fed or me, then I would be going hungry."

Maureen Haggas added, "He's a talented horse and has always been a talented horse. He was a really good 3-year-old and ran in the Hardwicke at four and ran really well. He then got a bad injury and was off the rest of the year and most of the following year. He came out and beat Hukum first time back after 18 months off. He is a horse who has had a serious injury and we have to look after him. This [good-to-soft] ground was only just safe [for him], only just. I wouldn't want to run him on this again, he wants proper soft ground."

'BEAUTE' USES HER 'WILES' AT KEENELAND

In this series, the TDN takes a look at notable successes of European-based sires in North America. This week's column is highlighted by the victory of *Beaute Cachee* in the *Jenny Wiley S.* at Keeneland last weekend.

Literato Mare Earns Grade I Ring

Beaute Cachee (Fr) (Literato {Fr}) gave trainer Chad Brown his seventh win in the **GI Jenny Wiley S.** at Keeneland for owners Madaket Stables, LLC, Michael Dubb and Louis Lazzinnaro, LLC ([video](#)).

A mere €1,500 Arqana Autumn yearling when picked up by trainer Gael Barbedette, the Gregor Vischer-bred grey raced for her trainer, Valerie Lucas and J. Georg through a dozen starts before being sold to her current ownership group. Her final French start was a fourth in the G3 Prix de Psyche. Besides winning the Listed Violet S. last year, she placed at that level in the Athenia S. and was third in the GI Matriarch S.

The third foal, third runner and second winner for her dam Sign And Seal (Ire) (Hurricane Run {Ire}), the bay is a half to a 3-year-old colt by Zanzibari, who made €15,000 at the Arqana Autumn yearling sale on the bid of Pegasus Bloodstock. This is the family of dual Group 1 winner Indian Ink (Ire) (Indian Ridge {Ire}).

Sire Literato has three winners from three runners in the U.S., and besides the Jenny Wiley winner, counts GI Garden City S. heroine Alterite (Fr) as his other stakes winner in that jurisdiction.

Blueblooded 'Majesty' Shines at Keeneland

Besilu Stables homebred **Royal Majesty (GB)** (Frankel {GB}) won for the second time in four starts with a two-length victory at Keeneland ([video](#)). Hall of Famer Bill Mott trains the son of GI Queen Elizabeth II Challenge Cup S. heroine Crown Queen (Smart Strike). [Cont. p8](#)

Crown Queen, who joined the Besilu bloodstock portfolio after selling for \$1.6 million during the 2011 Keeneland November Sale, is a half-sister to two-time Eclipse champion Royal Delta (Empire Maker) and fellow Grade I winner Delta Prince (Street Cry {Ire}). The trio's dam, Delta Princess (A.P. Indy), brought \$2.6 million at the same sale when knocked down to Adena Springs. The winner has a 2-year-old half-sister by Kingman (GB), while his dam was covered by Flightline last spring.

Juddmonte sire Frankel boasts a 70% strike rate in the U.S., with 27 of his 53 runners finding the winner's circle. Of his 11 stakes winners there, six have been at the graded level, with both McKulick (GB) and Inspiral (GB) finding Grade I glory on at least one occasion.

Repeat Winners

Godolphin homebred Master Of The Seas (Ire) (Dubawi {Ire}), a winner of both the GI Woodbine Mile and the GI Breeders' Cup Mile in 2023, added the GI Maker's Mark Mile S. to his haul at Keeneland recently (video) for trainer Charlie Appleby. The winner will be staying in America for this campaign.

Just a week after siring his first Southern Hemisphere stakes winner with **Broadsiding (Aus)**, Darley's Too Darn Hot (GB) made headlines again on Saturday.

Broadsiding flew through the mud to secure the G1 Champagne S. and his promising son Perspiration (Aus) secured victory in the Mornington Guineas, marking the son of Dubawi's (GB) eighth individual winner in Australasia.

The James Cummings-trained Broadsiding was on the seven-day back-up, having claimed the Listed Fernhill H. his rider James McDonald warned at the time the son of Too Darn Hot was a serious colt in the making.

On Saturday, he more than proved that assessment correct. Despite the testing conditions, Broadsiding was strong to the line in the time-honoured mile event. **Cont p13**

The race favourite, **Linebacker (NZ)** (Super Seth {Aus}) was gallant in second, while **Fearless (Aus)** (Pierata {Aus}) courageously held third - securing a clean sweep for first-season stallions.

Speaking to *Sky Racing* after the success, Cummings said, "Broadsiding is a very interesting colt. He has continued to improve right the way through this preparation and that makes all the difference to 2-year-olds when you get to the major days.

"He's got that beautiful European blood to assure he had the stamina to win a Fernhill and a Champagne. Broadsiding has managed to stamp himself as quite a horse to follow in the spring."

Broadsiding is the third and final foal from the Street Cry (Ire) mare Speedway (Aus). She won twice over the mile and is a half-sister to the talented Flit (Aus) (Medaglia d'Oro), a victress of the G1 Thousand Guineas and the G2 Light Fingers S. Her only other foal being the yet to race Tony Gollan trained 3-year-old No Brakes (Aus) (Lonhro {Aus}) who was unplaced in a Deagon trial in February.

Speedway is out of the stakes placed Glissade (Aus) (Redoute's Choice {Aus}) who has also produced the stakes placed multiple city winner Flow (Aus) (Street Cry {Ire}).

Broadsiding's third dam is the G3 AJC Breeders Classic winner Steflara (Aus) (Zabeel {NZ}) whose dam is the dual Group 3 winner Blue Storm (Aus) (Bluebird {Ire}) - granddam of the dual Group 1 winner Tropical Squall (Aus) (Prized Icon {Aus}) and the Listed winner Federal (Aus) (Medaglia d'Oro).

Broadsiding has the distinction of being the first Group 1 winner and first stakes winner in the Southern Hemisphere for his triple Group 1-winning sire.

Too Darn Hot hails from the same family as his great, great grandsire Mr. Prospector and is relishing further strains of that great stallion; Broadsiding boasting a 5 X 4 cross.

All but one of his other stakes winners are line-bred to Mr. Prospector with his other Group 1 winner Fallen Angel (GB) owning a particularly interesting pedigree - line-bred to Too Darn Hot's third dam Delsy (Fr) (Abdos {Fr}).

The mare also demonstrated excellent versatility as her other Group 1 win, in the G1 Sir Rupert Clarke S. in November over the same 1400-metre journey, was on a track rated Good. The 4-year-old mare took her record to six wins from 11 starts with earnings over A\$2.1million.

Outsider **Amenable (Aus)** (Lonhro {Aus}) nearly gave his recently deceased sire another Group 1 winner by running second, while **Private Eye (Aus)** (Al Maher {Aus}) ran third.

Magic Time is trained by Grahame Begg at Cranbourne for owner Milburn Creek Thoroughbred Stud who bred her. They took her to the Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale but passed her in short of her A\$150,000 reserve.

Begg told *7HorseRacing*, “She (Magic Time) has been a beauty! Each run has just brought her on and the All-Aged S. has been our main goal. Her Newmarket H. run was good and then she was in a tricky spot in the TJ Smith S. but it had her ready for today (Saturday). She’s three out of four in over 1400 metre and was just spot on for this.”
