

DERBY FAVORITE FIERCENESS DRAWS IN 17, SIERRA LEONE GETS POST 2



Kentucky Derby & Oaks Draw at Churchill Downs Saturday

Featuring \$200-million worth of improvements in its new paddock area, Churchill Downs hosted the draw ceremony for next weekend's GI Kentucky Derby and GI Kentucky Oaks during its opening night card Saturday.

As usual, the proceedings drew some cheers, and jeers, from the crowd. Possibly numbered among the latter, the connections of the 5-2 morning line favorite 'TDN Rising Star' **Fierceness** (*City of Light*) couldn't have been overly thrilled with drawing post 17 for Saturday's Run for the Roses. Campaigned by his breeder Mike Repole, the reigning juvenile champ comes into the race off a scintillating victory in last month's GI **Curlin** Florida Derby. Already developing a bit of a reputation for his propensity for being a one on, one off type of character, the colt's trainer was pragmatic about the post position moments after the draw.

"We just need to break cleanly like he did in the Florida Derby, and I think he has enough talent to put himself in the right spot," Todd Pletcher said.

The colt will be accompanied by Hall of Famer John Velazquez, who was also aboard for the colt's latest three victories, including last fall's GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile at Santa Anita.

SOUTH AFRICAN CHAMPION PRINCESS CALLA BOUGHT BY JOHN STEWART

South African Horse of the Year **Princess Calla (SAf)** (Flower Alley) has been purchased by **John Stewart of Resolute Farm** from Mario Ferreira, Stewart announced on X Saturday morning. Ferreira and trainer Sean Tarry had sent the five-time South African Grade 1 winner **to America in early March for a crack at the Breeders' Cup.**

"We have finalized our international deal and I'm so excited to announce that we have acquired 2023 South African Horse of the Year Princess Calla in a private sale," Stewart said on X. "She is in her final days of quarantine and will be headed to Chad Brown to begin training for a run at this year's Breeders' Cup."

Bred by Maine Chance Farms, the bay also earned Equus Champion Older Mare honours in 2022/2023 to go with her Horse of the Year title, and of her 12 lifetime wins from two to six, 11 have come at the graded level. **Cont. Pg. 6**

His antipodal counterpart in the gate, Peter Brant, Mrs. John Magnier, Michael Tabor, Derrick Smith, Westerberg and Brook Smith's 'Rising Star' **Sierra Leone** (**Gun Runner**) drew post 2, and was installed the 3-1 second choice on the morning line. Trained by Chad Brown, who is looking for his first Derby win, the \$2.3 million Fasig-Tipton Saratoga graduate is undefeated this season, having won the GII Risen Star S. and GI Toyota Blue Grass S. Perfect under Tyler Gaffalione, the 11-time leading rider at Churchill Downs has the mount.

Brown also saddles Klaravich Stables' **Domestic Product** (**Practical Joke**), who will exit post 15. Installed a 30-1 chance on the morning line, the GIII Tampa Derby winner will be ridden by Irad Ortiz Jr.

"Not that bad," said Brown when asked how he thought his

horses drew. "Sierra Leone, he's in just a touch farther in than I wanted but he didn't get the 1 hole, so I'm OK with that. With this particular horse, what I didn't want was the 19 or 20. In fact, it would have been hard for him to drop over without losing ground, significant ground around the first turn."


He continued, "With Domestic Product, I thought it was a very good draw for him. He has a lot of natural speed, he should be in the second flight and I think that Irad [Ortiz Jr.] will have plenty of options from the 15 for that long run down the stretch the first time to sort of position himself hopefully, behind the half dozen speed horses."

The only other horse under 10-1 on the morning line is GII Louisiana Derby scorer **Catching Freedom** (**Constitution**), who was penciled in

at 8-1 while exiting post 4. Carrying the flag for Albaugh Family Stables, the Brad Cox trainee is reunited with Flavien Prat, who was also aboard for his latest victory. **Cont.**

2YOs RETURN TO THE TRACK THIS YEAR

A pair of sophomores were given 10-1 chance--Qatar Racing, Resolute Racing and Marc Detampel's **Just a Touch (Justify)**, runner up in the Blue Grass and Japanese invader **Forever Young (Jpn)** (Reel Steel {Jpn}). The former, who breaks from post 8, will be accompanied by Florent Geroux, while the latter, who won both the G3 Saudi Derby and G2 UAE Derby, will get the services of Ryusei Sakai and will exit the 11 hole.

The trainer with the most prior Derby wins with four, Hall of Fame trainer D. Wayne Lukas, saddles B C Stables' **Just Steel (Justify)**, who drew favorably in post 6. The colt will be ridden by Keith Asmussen, who will be competing in his first Kentucky Derby Saturday. A \$500,000 Keeneland September purchase by Lukas, the colt was given a 20-1 chance on the morning line.

"It's fine," said Lukas. "I just didn't want inside. I don't care for the inside, but anything from probably the 5 out is comfortable."

“I think post positions are a little overrated,” said Cox. “If you have the right horse, you can really win from anywhere. I think both horses [Tarifa and stablemate Gin Gin breaking from post 2] had a solid work the other morning so that’s most important at this stage to me.”

The second choice on the morning line at 4-1, Whisper Hill Farm's '**Rising Star**' **Leslie's Rose** (Into Mischief), drew on the far outside in post 14 for trainer Todd Pletcher. A \$1.15 million Keeneland September purchase, the winner of the GI Ashland S. will be reunited with Irad Ortiz Jr., who has been aboard all four of her lifetime starts.

Last season's juvenile champion filly **Just F Y I** (**Justify**) draws lucky number 13 in the Oaks gate for George Krikorian and trainer Bill Mott. Victorious in last season's GI Frizette S. and GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies, the homebred will be ridden by her regular partner, Junior Alvarado. She was installed the 9-2 third choice on the morning line.

“She won the Breeders’ Cup from the 12,” said Mott. “Hopefully, she’ll have a good clean trip and have a chance to get over. If she’s on her game, she’ll break pretty good and hope it works out as well as it did in the Breeders’ Cup.”

A pair of '**Rising Star**' fillies were weighted at 5-1 on the morning line--GII Fantasy S. scorer and **Thorpedo Anna** (Fast Anna), who drew post 5 and **Ways and Means** (**Practical Joke**), who will exit post 11.

The former is campaigned by Brookdale Racing, Mark Edwards, Judy Hicks and Magdalena Racing and trained by Ken McPeck. The latter, a Grade I placed filly conditioned by Chad Brown, is a homebred for Klaravich Stables. Thorpedo Anna will be ridden by Brian Hernandez Jr. while the latter will be accompanied by Tyler Gaffalione.

G1 Blue Grass S. winner **Sierra Leone** (Gun Runner) led a total of nine G1 Kentucky Derby hopefuls on the work tab a week out from the Run for the Roses. Breezing in company with stablemate and fellow Derby hopeful **Domestic Product**

(**Practical Joke**), the pair went five furlongs in 1:00.20 (15/58) through splits of :13, :24.80, :36.40 before galloping out in 1:13.20 and 1:26.20.

“It [the work] was executed perfectly,” said Chad Brown, the trainer for both workers. “I wanted them to a good five-eighths out in three-quarters but well within themselves. [Sierra Leone] is super fit and it was just an outstanding work. I’m just trying to get him in there happy and sound. He’s a very rare horse. He’s just everything you want as a trainer.” **Cont.**

Joining that pair on the Derby work sheet was two more groupings of stablemates--**Catching Freedom** (**Constitution**) and **Encino** (**Nyquist**)--who also went five furlongs together in :59.20 (2/58) and **Dornoch** (**Good Magic**) with **Society Man** (**Good Magic**) clocked in four furlongs at :46.60 (2/130). They were joined by **Just a Touch** (**Justify**) (five furlongs in 1:00.80 {26/58}), **West Saratoga** (Exaggerator) (three furlongs in :37.20 {8/27}) and **Mystik Dan** (Goldencents) (five furlongs in 1:01.20 {35/58}).

"The track is playing super fast right now," said trainer Danny Gargan. "We thought we'd [Dornoch and Society Man] go in 47 and change, I got them 46 and 4. They went out nice though and ... that's kind of the work for everybody, they're all going around the same time. We wanted to go a little bit slower but they looked good doing it, they were in hand, no one was asking them. We're just hoping they come back good, everything looks good and they're cooling out good."

Trainer Michael McCarthy also confirmed GIII Jeff Ruby Steaks winner **Endlessly** (**Oscar Performance**) for the Derby off his work Friday morning.

"It's been done," said McCarthy. "We'll be running in the Derby."

GI Kentucky Oaks workers were led by **Regulatory Risk** (Omaha Beach) (four furlongs in :49.60 {90/130}) and **Lemon Muffin** (**Collected**) (five furlongs in a bullet :58.20 {1/58}).

There are several workers lined up for Sunday as contenders look to get their final breezes ahead of next weekend. Scheduled to work Sunday are **Stronghold** (**Ghostzapper**), **Catalytic** (**Catalina Cruiser**) and **Just F Y I** (**Justify**).

LAMMAS WINS LAST SAN FRAN MILE

Golden Gate Fields carded its final GIII San Francisco Mile S. Saturday and it was a local favorite who wound up in the winner's circle as Lammas got up in time to nail pacesetter Air Force Red in the shadow of the wire. A 7-year-old gelded son of Heeraat (Ire), Lammas began his career in Great Briton but came to the United States in 2022 and, from 17 starts, has made all but three of them at Golden Gate. Unraced on the grass since a second facing allowance horses last September, Lammas came in on a run of good form, winning three of his last four on the local Tapeta all at the allowance level.

Let go at 9-1, the Manuel Badilla runner showed good early speed from the two hole but was outrun past the wire the first time by a swarm of horses to his outside. Racing between horses from sixth, Lammas settled comfortably off the pace of Air Force Red who was eager up front just ahead of Astronomer (Air Force Blue) as the opening fractions went by in :22.80 and :46.26. Still caught sandwiched into the far turn, Lammas got clear past the quarter pole to come after the leader but had to go wide to do so while race favorite Balnikhov got through along the rail late. In a driving finish, Lammas just edged past Air Force Red who hung on well in the middle and just kept the favorite at bay in third.

Uncorked | Benoit

Australian invader **Uncorked**, making her first start Saturday for trainer Phil D'Amato, impressed under Frankie Detorri to take the GIII Royal Heroine S. at Santa Anita. The 5-year-old mare debuted Down Under and raced in the Southern Hemisphere as a 2 and 3-year-old before shipping to join Brittany Russell's barn on the East Coast last year. Off the board only once in seven starts along the Mid-Atlantic, Uncorked was last third beaten just a length in the Forever Together S. at Aqueduct Nov. 19.

Back at the one-mile distance after several, longer efforts, the 5-1 shot broke wide but was angled down to be just a path off the rail around the first turn. Racing back in the second flight as a pair of rivals kept things tight up front, Uncorked enjoyed an uninhibited trip up the backstretch as longshot Glenall (Ire) (Coulsty {Ire}) and co-favorite Bellabel (Ire) (Belardo {Ire}) pressured one another through fractions of :22.57 and :46.24. Trouble began as the field bunched up into the far turn and Uncorked found herself stymied behind a wall of runners with a quarter-mile to run. Needing a gap, the D'Amato trainee got just what she asked for as the four-wide calvary charge of leaders all swung wide, leaving the rail wide open. 'TDN Rising Star' Justique closed well from the clouds to make a run into second as the final yards came down to three chances but Uncorked was clearly best and won nicely.

"Phil said, 'She jumps quick so make sure you get cover and get her to relax.' She did," said Dettori. "The field opened up like the Red Sea and I got the inside fence, and she just took off."

D'Amato's assistant trainer Julie Witt added: "When Frankie asked her, she responded. She is an Australian bred and they are known for their sprinter-milers down there and they have a heck of a turn of foot. She is really enjoying California and credit to the owners for sending her out here to us and coming up with this idea of giving us a high-quality filly."

Pedigree Note:

Australian sire Pierro, who recently made headlines as the sire of **Winx's record-setting yearling filly earlier this month**, earned his 38th stakes winner, 24 of which have come at the group or graded level. Piaf (NZ) has produced four foals, all of whom have reached the winner's circle with Uncorked being her most successful offspring. This is the family of New Zealand's champion 3-year-old Ztravagant (NZ) (Pentire {GB}) along with GSW/MG1SP He's Remarkable (NZ) (Pentire {GB}) along with Australia's 2007 Broodmare of the Year River Century (Centaine {Aus}). Uncorked sold as a yearling at the Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale for AU\$130,000 (US\$100,545) while Piaf has not reported a foal since 2020.

LIGHT UP RACING ISSUES STATEMENT ON 'BROKEN HORSES'

Light Up Racing, an industry collective which seeks to counter negative reporting and perceptions about horse racing, issued the following statement Saturday about the Hulu/FX/New York Times documentary "Broken Horses," which debuted Friday. The statement is printed in its entirety.

"The recent FX documentary 'Broken Horses' has cast a spotlight on the historical issues and implications of illegal doping in horse racing.

The presentation attempts to address significant challenges within the industry, particularly focusing on the critical issue of racehorses sustaining life-ending injuries and the urgent need for reforms to address doping and medication use.

As Broken Horses highlights, the Horseracing Integrity and Safety Authority (HISA) is now providing the sport with independent federal oversight for the first time in history, encompassing comprehensive veterinary protocols, enhanced track and jockey safety, and a stringent anti-doping and medication control program. While not in place to address the devastating clusters of fatalities at Churchill Downs in 2023, we can look forward to a safer future under HISA's leadership integrity. **Cont.**

Strategically released just a week before the Kentucky Derby, the documentary unsurprisingly leans into historical drama and sensationalism to boost viewership, focusing on illegal activities that thankfully resulted in imprisonment for the inexcusable acts.

Reporting did not, however, emphasize a 34 per cent reduction in the equine fatality rate over the last 15 years, the result of the significant progress already made towards safer racing practices.

Additional equine safety changes made in the last 24 months, under-represented in the documentary's narrative, include:

- Every Thoroughbred is required to have a pre-race veterinary inspection every time it races to help ensure horses with pre-existing injuries do not compete. HISA receives close to 3,000 veterinary treatment reports each day.
- Artificial intelligence is being used to examine compiled data, flagging any horses entered to race who may present potential risk factors for injury. This is similar to how other sports, like the NFL, are utilizing data and AI to enhance player safety.
- Wearable technology has been implemented, similar to that used in human sports, to identify at-risk horses by the algorithms that are generated in the process of training and racing.
- Huge investment in onsite or expedited access to advanced diagnostic imaging like PET scans (an enhanced bone scan), MRIs, and CT scans allow trainers and vets to detect hard-to-identify precursors to injuries.
- There is now a national vets list that places all horses unfit to compete on a comprehensive list that monitors Thoroughbreds throughout their careers.
- The void claim rule deters entry of horses with health or soundness issues into claiming races.

It is imperative that the progress and efforts of countless individuals dedicated to the daily care and safety of racehorses are acknowledged and not overshadowed by dramatized reporting. The assertions in the presentation that leading trainers 'abuse' horses and neglect basic care are not only unfair but are also logically inconsistent with the practices necessary to prepare elite Thoroughbred athletes to race successfully.

Light Up Racing is in full support of all reforms that will push horse racing to achieve the highest standard in equine welfare and transparency, with the goal of positioning our industry for a sustainable future. A constant pursuit to substantially reduce the fatality rate is non-negotiable.

Sabatini, a once-raced maiden who finished third at Turfway Park Mar. 23, swept past the dueling pair of 6-5 favorite Mystic Lake and 3-1 second choice Daring Duchess inside of the eighth pole to win Woodbine's opening day feature. The win marked the fifth of the day from the first eight races of the Woodbine season for apprentice jockey Sofia Vives, who was riding without her five-pound allowance under stakes conditions.

Racing in striking position behind fractions carved out in :22.93 and :45.08, Vives guided her inexperienced mount three-wide into the stretch to take aim at her embattled rivals. Despite signs of greenness, the 13-1 chance rallied nicely under token encouragement and was going away at the finish.

EZELIYA SWOOPS LATE TO SEAL SALSABIL TRIUMPH AT NAVAN

Dermot Weld's stable has yet to fire on all cylinders and, having set the ball rolling with Cork maiden winner Spoken Truth (Ire) (Frankel {GB}) on Friday, made its mark on the pattern-race scene when Ezeliya (Fr) (Dubawi {Ire}--Eziyra {Ire}, by Teofilo {Ire}) swooped late to register a career high in Saturday's G3 Irish Stallion Farms EBF Salsabil S. at Navan.

Ezeliya, who shed maiden status at Cork in the second of two juvenile starts last September, employed patient tactics off the tempo in sixth for most of this 10-furlong test. Nudged forward into contention approaching the quarter-mile marker, the 9-1 chance came under sterner urging thereafter and was driven out inside the final furlong to gain a half-length verdict from Purple Lily (Ire) (Calyx {GB}) nearing the line. Purple Lily's rider Billy Lee got tangled up in his off-side stirrup in the dying strides, but the incident made little difference to the result.

"I thought she would run a big race and she did," Weld said. "It was a very true-run Group race and they went a real good gallop for a mile-and-a-quarter. Chris [Hayes] took his time on her. He planned to sit a little bit closer, but the pace they were going he waited. I loved the way she attacked the hill and saw her race out well. Better ground will suit her better." [Cont. p3](#)

GERMAN DERBY HERO FANTASTIC MOON SET FOR GANAY TEST *By Sean Cronin*

A select field of nine will assemble for Sunday's G1 Prix Ganay at ParisLongchamp, Europe's first Group 1 contest of the season, with G1 Deutsches Derby hero **Fantastic Moon (Ger)** (Sea The Moon {Ger}) among the likely protagonists.

Liberty Racing's 4-year-old added to his Classic score when annexing September's G2 Prix Niel at the Bois de Boulogne venue, but failed to make an impression and was down the field in the following month's G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe. He returned for this campaign with a pipe-opening second in last month's Listed Preis von Dahlwitz at Hoppegarten, but his participation is not certain should track conditions deteriorate overnight. "Fanta is in a great mood and everything has gone according to plan so far," trainer Sarah Steinberg told *GaloppOnline*. "We hope that the weather gods are kind to us and that the amount of rain will be small. He needs a good track to perform at his best, but soft is okay. Anything worse than soft wouldn't be good and, if it is worse than soft, we will make a decision on Sunday morning."

Weld added, "It is a lovely family, a good, tough family and I think she will get a mile-and-a-half. She is a Group 1 filly and there's lots to look forward to. She is in both [G1 Oaks and G1 Irish Oaks] and we will review it and see. We will see how she progresses during the week and make a decision in two weeks time."

Ezeliya, who becomes the 179th pattern-race winner for her sire, is the second of three live foals and leading performer from two winners out of multiple Group 1-placed G2 Blandford S. victrix Eziyra (Ire) (Teofilo {Ire}). WOOTTON BASSETT'S CAMILLE PISSARRO SNAGS TDN RISING STAR IN NAVAN DEBUT

Aidan O'Brien annexed the two latest editions of Saturday's Irish Stallion Farms EBF Maiden at Navan with subsequent Group 2 winners Aesop's Fables (Ire) (**No Nay Never**) and River Tiber (Ire) (**Wootton Bassett {GB}**) and he secured the hat trick after 1.25-million guineas Tattersalls Book 1 graduate **Camille Pissarro (Ire) (Wootton Bassett {GB})** produced a 'TDN Rising Star' display in the extended five-furlong contest. Aesop's Fables and River Tiber also earned Rising Stars in this event and Camille Pissarro becomes **Wootton Bassett's** seventh Rising Star.

Camille Pissarro dwelt slightly as the gates opened, but swiftly recovered and bounded along stalking the leaders out wide in a prominent fourth. Inching closer from halfway to launch his challenge passing the quarter-mile marker, the 10-11 favourite was given one reminder from Ryan Moore's persuader and found another gear inside the final furlong to open up a 1 1/2-length margin back to **New Theory (Ire) (Starspangledbanner {Aus})** at the line.

"He's a horse that has shown a bit at home, it is great to get

him out here and that was a lovely start," said Ballydoyle's Chris Armstrong. "He has got an unbelievable pedigree by **Wootton Bassett** and a fantastic attitude, which is typical of the Wootton Bassetts. The penny was only starting to drop with him in the last half-furlong, which was probably the best part of the race for him. Once he puts the front nine and back nine together, he is very exciting. He's a classy sort, he's one of the smart ones and definitely one for [Royal] Ascot. Whether we get one run into him between now and then, I'm not sure, and we could go there without another run."

Camille Pissarro is the latest of nine foals and eighth scorer produced by a winning half-sister to G2 International Topkapi Trophy, G3 Supreme S. and G3 Criterion S. victor Producer (GB) (Dutch Art {GB}). Joseph O'Brien trainee **Al Riffa (Fr)** (**Wootton Bassett (GB)**), winner of 2022's G1 Vincent O'Brien National S., is on the comeback trail. He was out just twice last term, finishing second in both G3 International S. and G2 Prix Guillaume d'Ornano, with the latter a 3/4-of-a-length defeat by subsequent Arc hero Ace Impact (Ire) (Cracksman {GB}). "The dream is he is an Arc-type horse, but we'll take it race by race with him," his trainer said. "The Ganay is a logical starting point for what we hope is a top-class middle-distance horse. We were proud of his run in the Guillaume d'Ornano. He showed a good turn of foot and came strong in the last 100 yards. That bodes well for what may come this season. He didn't have any significant setbacks [last year]. He had an infection leading up to the Irish 2000 Guineas and he was lame on the eve of the [Irish] Champion [S.]. It was a little frustrating, but his ownership group is patient and, hopefully, their patience will be rewarded."

Another on the comeback trail is Amo Racing's **Crypto Force (GB)** (Time Test {GB}), who has been sighted just once since annexing 2022's G2 Beresford S. at the Curragh. Depth is provided by a home defence which includes G1 Grand Prix de Paris hero **Feed The Flame (GB)** (**Kingman (GB)**), this month's G2 Prix d'Harcourt victor **Zarakem (Fr)** (**Zarak (Fr)**) and the consistent multiple pattern-race winner **Horizon Dore (Fr)** (Dabirsim {Fr}).

His dam God Given (GB) (Nathaniel {Ire}), a Group 1 winner in Italy, is a half-sister to multiple Group 1 winner and sire Postponed (Ire) (Dubawi {Ire}). God Given has 3-year-old colt King's Reign (Fr) (Dubawi {Ire}) and juvenile colt Divine Legacy (GB) (**Siyouni (Fr)**) yet to race.

Her latest foal is a yearling colt by **Sea The Stars (Ire)**. G1 Coronation S. winner Fallen For You (GB) (Dansili {GB}) is a half-sister to the Galileo (Ire) Group 2-placed second dam Fallen In Love (GB).

Juddmonte veteran **Kingman** counts 38 winners from 65 runners (58%) in the States. His eight stakes winners in that jurisdiction (12%) are led by Domestic Spending (GB), a winner of three Grade I events.

MULLINS BECOMES FIRST IRISH TRAINER IN 70 YEARS TO TAKE THE UK NH TITLE

Willie Mullins became the first Irish trainer to take the British National Hunt Trainer’s crown in 70 years after his **El Fabiolo (Fr)** (Spanish Moon) ran second to Jonbon (Fr) (Walk In the Park {Ire}) in the G1 bet365 Celebration Chase at Sandown on Saturday.

Mullins also saddled winners **Minella Cocooner (Ire)** (Flemensfirth) and **Impaire Et Passe (Fr)** (Diamond Boy {Fr}) to win the bet365 Gold Cup Handicap Chase and the G2 bet365 Select Hurdle, respectively during the bet365 Jumps Finale card. Overall, Mullins trained 28 winners to victories in the UK, with his total prize-money standing at £3,489,256. Vincent O’Brien was the last Irish trainer to take the British jumps title back in 1953/54 prior to Mullins.

Mullins said, “It’s fantastic to be champion trainer. I would like to thank all my owners who have been magnificent. They said bring to England whatever you need to win the title, which was tremendous. Between the owners, my staff and my jockeys-- what more could you ask for? You need the horses but if you have got the setup, the horses will come.

“Vincent is the legend of the game and just to emulate something he did is extraordinary and something we couldn’t comprehend doing. We had never dreamed of doing it but after we were pipped at the post in 2016, I said if we ever got the opportunity again then we would go for it. David Casey went through all our horses to find out what was qualified for all races in England, Scotland and Wales.

“What more can I say? I am amazed at the racing public over here, to be welcomed with such open arms everywhere we have gone. I would also like to thank the sponsors for putting on such a great day with a large prize-money pot.”

JP McManus, the owner of Jonbon and many others, notched up his eighth consecutive UK Champion NH Owner on Saturday, as well.

“We have had a good run this year and I have a great team of trainers, stable staff and jockeys and I couldn’t have done it without them,” said the 73-year-old McManus, who won the Grand National with I Am Maximus (Fr) (Authorized {Ire}). “The Grand National was special, it’s the most special race and if I could pick one race in the world I would want to win, it is the Grand National. We celebrated well.”

Harry Cobden was named UK Champion Jump Jockey with 163 winners for the season. He defeated Sean Bowen.

Four-time Group 1 hero Kyprios was last seen posting a gallant second in October's G2 British Champions Long Distance Cup at Ascot and added to his 2022 win in this test with an impressive closing burst here. Positioned second and settled into a smooth rhythm tracking stablemate Queenstown passing the judge first time, the 2-13 favourite loomed large on the bridle soon after turning for home and toyed with the long-time leader before powering clear under urging inside the final quarter-mile to add lustre to his palmares.

"He is a lovely horse to have, we've been delighted with him this year and it is great to get him back," said Aidan O'Brien. "Ryan [Moore] gave him a lovely, uncomplicated ride. Wayne [Lordan aboard Queenstown] set a lovely, even pace and he kept taking him. When he gets there he doesn't do much and that is the way he is, but he was travelling very easily all the way. Everything is good so far and I couldn't be happier really. The plan was to come here, go to Leopardstown [for the G3 Saval Beg] and go to the [G1] Gold Cup [at Royal Ascot]."

Kyprios is the latest of 10 foals, all winners, produced by dual Broodmare of the Year Polished Gem (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}), herself a winning daughter of G1 Irish 1000 Guineas heroine Trusted Partner (Affirmed). He is kin to seven black-type winners headed by dual G1 Irish St Leger heroine Search For a Song (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}), G1 Prince of Wales's S.-winning sire Free Eagle (Ire) (High Chaparral {Ire}) and G2 British Champions Fillies & Mares S. victrix Sapphire (Ire) (Medicean {GB}). Descendants of Polished Gem, a full-sister to GI Matriarch S. heroine Dress To Thrill (Ire), also include G1 Vincent O'Brien National S. hero Thunder Moon (Ire) (Zoffany {Ire}). Kyprios's third dam, the GI Matron S. and GI Spinaway S.-winning US champion Talking Picture (Speak John), is the ancestress of G1 Grand Prix de Paris and G1 Sydney Cup hero Gallante (Ire) (Montjeu {Ire}).

He doesn't have a whole pile of experience, so I'd say he just got a little bit lonely when he got there. The other horse [Rock Of Ireland] seemed to fight back as well. He'll be a lovely horse going forward and he'll have no problem staying a mile-and-a-half. He's a real nice mover, so I'd say quick ground is probably important to him. KITASAN BLACK SIBLING ENHANCES CLASSIC CLAIMS WITH AOBA SHO VICTORY

Sugar Kun (Jpn) (Duramente {Jpn})--a half-brother to Kitasan Black (Jpn) (Black Tide {Jpn}), Japan's Horse of the Year in both 2016 and 2017--put himself in contention for top honours with a narrow victory in Saturday's G2 TV Tokyo Hai Aoba Sho at Tokyo Racecourse, cementing his place in next month's G1 Tokyo Yushun (Japanese Derby) over the same course and distance.

Trained by Hisashi Shimizu, Sugar Kun was partnered by legendary jockey Yutaka Take, the regular rider of Kitasan Black and a six-time winner of the Tokyo Yushun. Take had his mount in a handy position, with four in front of him hard against the

rail, as **Power Hall (Jpn)** (Suave Richard {Jpn}) took the field along in the early stages, initially racing a couple of lengths clear of his closest pursuer.

By the home turn Power Hall had built up a healthy advantage over the chasing pack, but his early exertions soon took their toll and he was a spent force entering the final two furlongs as the cavalry closed in. Gradually Sugar Run made his way to the front, taking over from the tiring **Win Maximum (Jpn)** (Kitasan Black {Jpn}) inside the final furlong, and he just did enough from there to hold off the fast-finishing **Shonan la Punta (Jpn)** (Kizuna {Jpn}) by a head, with **Dual Wielder (Jpn)** (Yoshida {Jpn}) also running on well from rear to take third.

Sugar Kun was gaining his third win from four starts and Take was impressed by the progress the three-year-old has made in such a short space of time as he told www.netkeiba.com, "While Kitasan Black is an irreplaceable champion, this horse has only debuted in February and has shown such remarkable performances in just a few months. I sense growth with each race. Today, he settled well and showed a good response when asked to accelerate. Winning and securing the right to run in the Derby is exciting."

The Tokyo Yushun, the second leg of the Japanese Triple Crown, will be run at Tokyo Racecourse on Sunday, May 26.

Pedigree Notes

Sugar Kun looks potentially another Classic contender for his sire Duramente, who was responsible for last year's Triple Tiara heroine Liberty Island (Jpn). He has also produced Stars On Earth (Jpn), who won the G1 Oka Sho (Japanese 1,000 Guineas) and G1 Yushun Himba (Japanese Oaks) in 2022, plus a pair of G1 Kikuka Sho (Japanese St Leger) winners in Titleholder (Jpn) and Durezza (Jpn). Kitasan Black, a half-brother to Sugar Kun, also won the Kikuka Sho in 2015 before proving himself the outstanding older horse in Japan at four and five. He won a total of seven Group 1 races in his career, including the Japan Cup as a four-year-old and the Arima Kinen on his swansong at five. He was retired to Shadai Stallion Station and has quickly made a huge success of his second career at stud, most notably as the sire of Equinox (Jpn), Japan's Horse of the Year in 2022 and 2023.

Sugar Kun's unraced dam, Suger Heart (Jpn) (Sakura Bakushin O {Jpn}), has produced seven winners and four black-type performers in Japan. As well as Sugar Kun and Kitasan Black, she is responsible for the Group 2-placed Shonan Bach (Jpn) (Stay Gold {Jpn}) and the Listed-placed Everyone Black (Jpn) (Black Tide {Jpn}). Her latest produce are colts by Rey De Oro (Jpn) and Contrail (Jpn) in 2022 and 2023. This is the extended family of noted sire Cee's Tizzy, responsible for dual GI Breeders' Cup Classic winner and Grade I sire Tiznow.

VIBRANT PREVAILS IN BATTLE OF AUTUMN FILLIES

An exciting finish to the G1 Australasian Oaks saw **Vibrant Sun (Aus)** (The Autumn Sun {Aus}) hold off her paternal sisters **Private Legacy (Aus)** and **Coco Sun (Aus)**, giving Arrowfield Stud's The Autumn Sun his second Oaks winner and a trifecta in the Group 1 event.

Vibrant Sun displayed plenty of grit, leading virtually from barrier to box. The Mick Price and Michael Kent Jnr-trained filly first held the charge of the G1 New Zealand Oaks winner **Pulchritudinous (NZ)** (Wrote {Ire}), and despite Mark Zahra losing the rein, Vibrant Sun kept fighting to win narrowly. Zahra celebrated his 30th career Group 1 win on Vibrant Sun, telling *Racing.com* after the event, "I couldn't have had her much slower in the run. I took my time to get there but she's so tough.

"I dropped my rein halfway down the straight and I was cursing that as I couldn't pick it up because it was too long. I rode her out and she kept finding." **Cont. p14**

Co-trainer Michael Kent Jnr added, "We've always liked Vibrant Sun. She won her maiden by 7l and then went to the Guineas. It's been a massive job to get her here and what a gusty win by the filly."

Pedigree Notes

Vibrant Sun is one of four stakes winners for The Autumn Sun, and his second Oaks winner from his first crop, with his daughter Autumn Angel (Aus) winning the G1 Australian Oaks earlier in the autumn. The son of Redoute's Choice (Aus) stood the 2023 breeding season for a fee of A\$66,000. A 2024 fee is yet to be announced.

However, early last week, Arrowfield Stud advised The Autumn Sun had sustained a pelvic injury in his paddock and is currently on box rest for an undetermined period of time. The statement read Arrowfield was hopeful The Autumn Sun will recover in time for the 2024 breeding season, but the decision will be guided by veterinary advice with a long-term focus on health and well-being.

Vibrant Sun was bred by Canning Downs and purchased by Sheamus Mills Bloodstock with Mick Price Racing and Breeding for A\$260,000 at the 2022 Gold Coast Magic Millions. She is the second foal and second winner for the G3 Vamos S. winner Vibrant Rouge (Aus) (Written Tycoon {Aus}), whose closest stakes-winning relation is her fifth dam's half-sister.

Vibrant Sun is her best runner, having also claimed the G3 Alexandra S. in addition to the G1 Australasian Oaks.

Vibrant Rouge was served last spring by Jonker (Aus) having had a run of bad luck at stud, missing to Anders (Aus) the previous season having lost consecutive foals by Pierata (Aus) and Deep Field (Aus).

Bred on a 3 X 4 cross of Danehill, Vibrant Sun is also line-bred

to Best In Show (Traffic Judge) via Redoute's Choice (Aus) and Try My Best.

SANGSTER WINNER CATALOGUED FOR MAGIC MILLIONS NATIONAL BROODMARE SALE

By Keely Mckitterick & Renee Geelan

Climbing Star (NZ) (Zoustar {Aus}) took advantage of the field sweeping wide around the turn to scamper up the inside, taking the shortest route home in the G1 Robert Sangster S. at Morphettville on Saturday, to give jockey Lachlan Neindorf his first Group 1 win.

Trained by Phillip Stokes, the 4-year-old mare paid \$26 to win, beating Annabel Neasham's 3-year-old filly **Learning To Fly (Aus)** (*Justify*) by a neck with Jason Warren-trained 4-year-old mare **Benedetta (Aus)** (Hellbent {Aus}) in third.

"I'm trying to keep it together," said Neindorf. "It was a really good win. She stumbled at the start and I wanted to be a lot closer. From that point on I thought, 'bugger this, I've blown the start so let's go back to the inside and try and ride a race.' That's what we did and we got the favours."

"I was watching the race and I thought what happened, he was meant to get her to the outside," Stokes added. "No horse has been in there all day so it's probably evened out towards the end of the day."

"It's great for Lachie to get the win. Tommy [Stokes] and all the boys have done a terrific job with her. We brought her over, took her back to Pakenham, brought her over and got her to peak on the day. We don't have to go there [the G1 Goodwood H.]. We'd have to be happy with her to do that, but if she pulls up well, we'll look at it."

Pedigree Notes

Climbing Star became the eighth Group 1 winner for Zoustar (Aus), who now has 54 stakes winners. This season, Zoustar has enjoyed the success of dual Group 1 winner Zougotchka (Aus), G1 Coolmore Stud S. winner Ozzmosis (Aus) and G1 Thousand Guineas winner Joliestar (Aus). His sire son Zousain (Aus) has six winners, led by Group 3 winner Drifting (Aus), from his first crop this season, while Ozzmosis recently retired to Newgate Farm where he will stand for A\$44,000. Zoustar stands at Widden Stud where he served last season at a fee of A\$220,000. A 2024 fee has yet to be announced.

A half-sister to Group 3 winner Sansom (NZ) (Charm Spirit {Ire}), Climbing Star is the fourth foal of debutant winning mare Bryony (Aus)—a fitting Group 1 win for Fastnet Rock (Aus) as a damsire on the same day as his retirement was announced. Bryony was a A\$700,000 purchase by Qatar Racing's David Redvers at the 2013 Inglis Easter Yearling Sale and won on debut before fading to last in her only other start.

Again served last spring by Zoustar after producing a filly by him, Bryony is a full-sister to G1 Diamond S. winner Heroic Valour (Aus) (Fastnet Rock {Aus}) and a half-sister to Triple Honour (NZ) (Honours List {Ire}), who won seven races including the G1 Doncaster H.. Heroic Valour stands at Queensland's Raheen Stud. Bryony is also a granddaughter of the G2 Sedgwick Classic S. winner San Pauli Girl (NZ) (Western Symphony).

Climbing Star was a A\$600,000 purchase by Phillip Stokes Racing and Rick Connolly Bloodstock from Widden Stud at the 2021 Inglis Easter Yearling Sale. She is currently catalogued as Lot 433 in the Magic Millions Broodmare Sale.
