STREAKING 'THORPEDO' TAKES KENTUCKY OAKS

LOUISVILLE, KY -- All week, trainer Kenny McPeck had been telling the media, 'they better bring a bear because I have a grizzly.' Many would have thought that McPeck, sometimes regarded as a master of hyperbole, was overstating his chances.

It turns out he wasn't.

Armed with plenty of natural speed, Brookdale Racing, Mark Edwards, Judy Hicks and Magdalena Racing's '**TDN Rising Star'** **Thorpedo Anna** (Fast Anna) lived up to her name by scampering to a three-length victory over last year's champion juvenile filly **Just F Y I (Justify)** in the 150th edition of the GI Kentucky Oaks Friday afternoon.

Showing an abundance of confidence in his horse all week, McPeck wasn't overly concerned when the skies opened up early Friday morning and intermittently drenched spectators (and the track) throughout the afternoon. Although the skies blackened menacingly during the paddock proceedings and the post parade, the rain managed to hold for the start of the race.

In the newly furnished paddock before the race, the filly did her best impersonation of a ballerina, dancing on her toes but maintaining her composure despite the controlled chaos created by the swarming media, fans and the incredible mass of camera equipment that would make Kodak blush.

The field loaded into the gate with little fanfare, and they were quickly given the green light. Thorpedo Anna rushed up from post four, and was initially confronted by GII Davona Dale winner **Fiona's Magic** (St Patrick's Day) and the '**TDN Rising Star'** duo of **Ways and Means** with **Into Champagne** (Into Mischief), with the champ Just F Y I a short way back through very solid opening fractions of :22.87 and :46.79. **Oaks cont. p7**

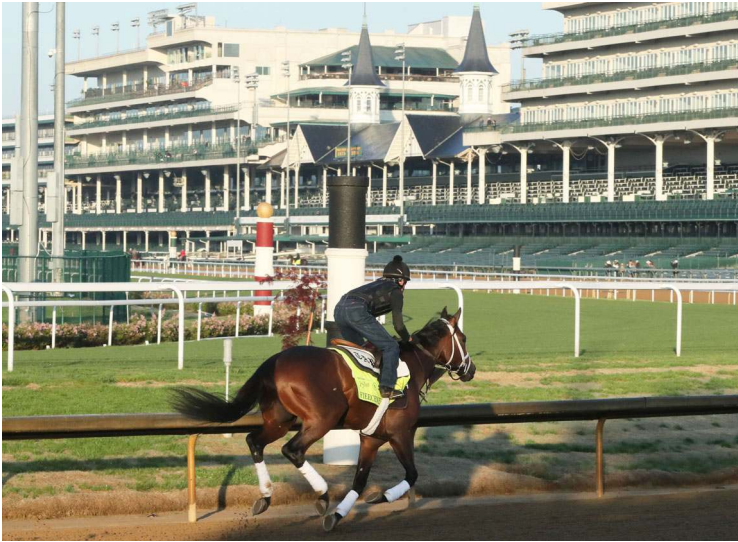

LOUISVILLE, KY -- Weeks and months of preparation, with a healthy dose of good luck, are complete. A full field of 20 will line up for the 150th anniversary renewal of the GI Kentucky Derby at Churchill Downs.

Much of the pre-race hype has revolved around the defending juvenile champion **Fierceness** (*City of Light*). A runaway winner in the GI Florida Derby in his latest start, the '**TDN Rising Star**' has been training like a beast, signaling he is ready to do big things come Derby day. His trainer, Todd Pletcher, will be looking for his third Derby win following 2010 scorer Super Saver and **Always Dreaming** in 2017.

Standing in his way is GI Toyota Blue Grass S. victor and fellow '**TDN Rising Star**' **Sierra Leone** (*Gun Runner*). A confirmed closer, the Chad Brown trainee came from well off the pace to win his first Grade I in style after taking a sloppy renewal of the nine-furlong GII Risen Star S. at Fair Grounds Feb. 17. He will try to employ similar tactics in Saturday's 10-furlong Classic.

"I knew I wanted to run [in the Risen Star] because of the long stretch and the timing of the race," Brown said. "You know it came up a super tough race and the weather was really challenging. But the horse ran against everything and still won...especially on a track that not many horses were closing on that day. This horse was able to overcome a lot and get there. And he's really moved forward from there."

Less fancied in the odds but hinting that he might be sitting on a big effort is Brown's other entrant, **Domestic Product** (*Practical Joke*). The near-black colt took the GIII Lambholm South Tampa Derby Mar. 9. **Cont. p5**

Likely to be employing similar tactics to the \$2.3 million Fasig-Tipton Saratoga salestopper, **Catching Freedom (Constitution)** will try to add to his last out win in the GII Louisiana Derby at Fair Grounds Mar. 23. Trainer Brad Cox will also saddle Blue Grass runner-up **Just a Touch (Justify)**. Cox got off the mark early on Friday's card, winning with Idiomatic (**Curlin**) in the GI La Troienne S. and First Mission (**Street Sense**) in the GII Alysheba S.

“He has definitely improved in the mornings,” said Cox of Catching Freedom, who breezed five furlongs in :59.1 (2/58) at Churchill Apr. 27. “He had to show us a little bit to make us a believer. He obviously made us a big believer in the Louisiana Derby and a few works leading up to that. We have seen a tremendous amount of that and even more since the Louisiana Derby.”

The colt won the Jan. 1 Smarty Jones S. before finishing third in the Risen Star.

“Even though he broke his maiden [at Churchill last October] and won the Smarty Jones, we felt like there was room for improvement,” Cox told TDN. “But he's definitely improved through the winter and throughout the spring.”

In regards to the pace scenario, Cox said, “He is going to have to get a set up, he'll need some pace in front of him. The pace will have to collapse, and if it does, he will be there in the end.”

According to Cox, his other runner offers a natural compliment to Catching Freedom's style

“He's very talented and has tactical speed. He should be in the mix early,” he said. “I think he got a lot out of his last race going a mile and an eighth. He's a smart horse. I think if he gets the trip, he is going to be there. He is a very nice horse.”

Japan is represented by a pair of runners, the undefeated colts G2 UAE Derby and G3 Saudi Derby winner **Forever Young (Jpn)** (Real Steel {Jpn}) and **T O Password (Jpn)** (Copano Rickey {Jpn}). The former has handled his international shipping schedule with aplomb and doesn't seem to have put a foot wrong since his stateside arrival. Both colts are winners over nine furlongs and have given every indication they can extend that another furlong.

Loaded Graded Action on Derby Undercard

An additional seven graded stakes highlight Churchill's Saturday card, including another three at the top level. **Alva Starr** (Lord Nelson), winner of the Apr. 6 GI Madison S. at Keeneland, is undefeated in two starts this season and looks to extend her streak in the GI Derby City Distaff S. Later in the card, the GI Churchill Downs S. features the returning '**TDN Rising Star**' **Zozos (Munnings)**, unraced since a fifth in last fall's GI Breeders' Cup Dirt Mile after taking the one-mile GIII Ack Ack S. over this surface in September. The 5-year-old posted a five-panel move in :59 3/5 (5/58) Apr. 27.

"I like him," Cox said. "He's had two really good works in the last two weeks and he's gotten ready kind of quick. It's a Grade I and I thought he can compete with these horses, so we're taking a chance. I think if he breaks well and has his way, he has a shot."

Last year's GI Hollywood Derby and GI Saratoga Derby Invitational winner **Program Trading (GB)** (Lope de Vega {Ire}) marks his seasonal debut in the GI Turf Classic. **Cont. p7**

He faces the 2023 GI Belmont Derby scorer **'Rising Star' Far Bridge** (English Channel), a winner of a mile-and-a-sixteenth optional claimer at Gulfstream Mar. 31. Representing Godolphin, G2 Singspiel S. winner **Naval Power (GB)** tries to go one better than a second-place effort to Master Of the Seas (Ire) (Teofilo {Ire}), last year's GI Breeders' Cup Mile hero, in a soggy renewal of the GI Maker's Mark S. at Keeneland Apr. 12. Frankie Dettori gets the call.

Rounding out the undercard stakes are the GII Twin Spires Turf Sprint, GII Churchill Distaff Turf Mile, GII Pat Day Mile and GII American Turf S.

Thorpedo Anna Wins The Oaks cont. from p3

As Into Champagne began a gradual retreat, Just F Y I started to unfurl her long legs from her outside berth, moving with purpose three wide passing the quarter pole. From there, it seemed like the mountainous filly was going to push right on past, however Thorpedo Anna had a response. Unfazed by the imminent pressure on her outside flank, the GII Fantasy S. winner scampered off, crossing the wire an unchallenged 4 3/4-length winner over Just F Y I. It was the largest winning margin in the Oaks since the astonishing 20 1/4-length gap Rachel Alexandra (**Medaglia d'Oro**) put on the 2009 Oaks field.

The Chad Brown-trained pair of **Regulatory Risk** (Omaha Beach) and Ways and Means filled the next two spots. Well-supported at the windows, **'TDN Rising Stars' Tarifa** (Bernardini) and **Leslie's Rose** (Into Mischief) finished ninth and 13th, respectively.

“It was a magical moment, because turning for home, she was so relaxed and cruising, I was able to enjoy the roar of the crowd for a few jumps,” said winning rider Brian Hernandez. “And then when I called on her, she responded and just ran away from them.”

After recording their first Oaks victory, McPeek and Hernandez will have the opportunity to complete the rare Oaks-Kentucky Derby double on Saturday when they team up with Mystik Dan (Goldencents) in Saturday's Run for the Roses.

The most recent trainer to sweep the Oaks and Derby in the same year was Ben Jones in 1952 with Real Delight and Hill Gail. The most recent rider to complete the double was Calvin Borel in 2009 with Rachel Alexandra and Mine That Bird.

“It worked out the way I thought,” affirmed Hernandez. “Kenny [McPeek] and I have talked about the race a few times over the last few days. It looked like there was no speed to our inside. So we thought that if we let her run under the wire in the first time, she would get good position, which she did. From there, she is just such a naturally talented filly, she went quick through the half and the whole way around there, really. She was just doing it with her ears up and cruising along.”

Addressing how he envisioned the race, McPeek added, “On paper, it didn't look like there was any speed that was really going to eyeball her. There wasn't anything obvious. She has natural speed. We decided to take advantage of that. [Fiona's Magic], which was the one that was on her outside, was one that I told Brian [Hernandez], 'Look this one is probably going to look at you for a little bit, but I don't think she's going to challenge you for long.' And I think I looked at the board and she was 37-1. But :22 and change, :46 and change made me a little bit nervous, but she was doing it within herself and a natural athlete. Obviously she got there.”

McPeek had finished runner-up in the Oaks on three prior occasions with Swiss Skydiver (2020), Daddys Lil Darling (2017) and Take Charge Lady (2002).

Do the failed swings make finally getting the win all the sweeter?

“It does add to it, but setbacks are part of the game,” said McPeek. “There's an old saying: win like you're used to it and lose like you like it. And so you have to deal with the losses, and you have to learn from the losses. All I have done is try to bring some good fillies into the race. I think I have a couple of thirds and fourths also. So, we were kind of getting an idea of what kind of horses it took. But to punch it over the edge is really nice.” **Cont. p8**

Sorry, 'Just' Not Today

Last year's champion filly Just F Y I ran a winning race, however, appeared to hang a hair at the end of the nine-furlong Classic test.

"I had a great trip. I didn't have any excuses," said Mott of the runner-up. "My filly broke a little funny from the outside post but we got as good a trip as you could possibly ask for. I mean [Junior Alvarado] got her tucked in, she was in position leaving the five-sixteenths pole to win. It looked like we had that filly [Thorpedo Anna] on our radar. It looked like she could probably catch her from there and the other filly just didn't back up."

When asked about Oaks third Regulatory Risk, Brown was seemingly pleased with the filly, a maiden winner who has yet to break through into black-type.

"She really ran super and mission accomplished with her," Brown said. "We were trying to get third. And for a moment there at the quarter pole looking at the fractions, I'm thinking could she inherit, sort of, this win with a pace collapse? That wasn't to be. But she did run great."

Of the fourth-place finisher Ways and Means, Brown added, "The winner was making the fractions and she was a deserving winner. [Ways and Means] just couldn't keep up. Talking to Tyler [Gaffalione] after the race, he said he liked the trip. She was in the clear out of trouble and they were going fast but she's a fast horse. I don't think that had anything to do with it."

Riding a three-race winning streak coming into the Oaks, dual Grade II scorer Tarifa never appeared to get into the mix of things over the sloppy/sealed surface.

"I was disappointed," said Tarifa's rider, Flavien Prat. "She never made any move. I can't blame the sloppy track because she won on it this winter. It just wasn't her day."

Hitting the Mark

The 8 1/2-length winner of an auction-price restricted maiden at Keeneland on debut Oct. 26, Thorpedo Anna backed that up with an equally sparkling performance when airing by nine lengths when stretched to a mile at this venue Nov. 10 to achieve 'TDN Rising Star' status. The 5 1/4-length runner up in the GII Golden Rod S. Nov. 25, she rebounded to win in her latest race when returning as a 3-year-old in the Fantasy at Oaklawn Mar. 30.

"She was relatively easy as a 2-year-old filly," McPeck recalled. "She didn't come around until a little bit later in the season. And we trailed three races together pretty quick with her because she did it so easily. And then it was a matter of putting her on the shelf for a little bit and then bringing her back.

"This past winter, we don't know exactly when, how it happened, but she walked out of her stall lame in behind. And it turned out--we tried to walk her out of it. She wasn't coming out of it. We trucked her to Kentucky and had Dr. [Larry] Bramlage look at her. She had a bruise on her hip the size of--just maybe under the size of a softball. It was very unusual. He said it's no big deal. There's no fracture. It's just a deep bruise. We don't know if she hit it on a stall door or if she did it laying down, getting up. Hard to say."

He continued, "But that actually set us back almost six weeks. And then when we started getting her ready at the Fair Grounds for the race at Oaklawn, I actually had a series of races that I had chosen to bring her into her first race of the season. She was not quite ready for the Fair Grounds Oaks. I thought the [Apr. 5] GI Ashland S. was a good race. I think she could have won the Ashland, too. But the Fantasy fell in order.

"She won easy that day. It was okay, because I thought she was about 80% and she did it like she was 110." **Cont. p9**

McPeek is clearly not afraid to swing for the fences with a talented filly facing colts in Grade I's, as evidenced by Swiss Skydiver returning a month after her Oaks second to take the GI Preakness S. in COVID-reshuffled 2020.

"I have thought about it already," he said when asked if he considered running in the second jewel of the Triple Crown. "And you know, it would be like me to do something like that."

"But we'll have to talk to the ownership. She wasn't nominated for the Triple Crown. I have said all week that I wasn't scared to even run her against colts. I mean, she's that good. We would have to look at the numbers. I think it's a \$200,000 entry fee, which is pretty steep."

He added, "But then again, there aren't a lot of options for 3-year-old fillies beyond this. It doesn't make any sense to come into a GI Black-Eyed Susan [May 17]. I will have to look at what's Belmont week. Ultimately, I would like to get her to the GI Alabama S. [at Saratoga]. I would like to win another Alabama. And there's a couple of nice races in New York later on in the season for straight 3-year-olds."

Eskimo Kisses, fourth in the 2018 Oaks, romped in that year's Alabama and Swiss Skydiver gave him another two years later.

Pedigree Notes:

The victory marked the first Grade I winner for the sadly departed Fast Anna (**Medaglia d'Oro**).

Additionally, the 150th Oaks winner was bred by Judy Hicks, who took on the mare more out of charity rather than the notion that she might breed a Classic winner. Hicks stayed in for a piece of the filly.

"She was premature; seven, eight weeks premature when she was born," she explained. "She was 45" tall, weighed 60 pounds. Her hocks were crushed. And there wasn't much hope of any future for her."

She continued, "So I volunteered to take her from the owners, Mr. Sanford Robertson and Kathryn Nikkel, who bred her. And Mr. Robertson graciously gave her to me when I volunteered to keep her. And I tried to do my magic and it worked."

Thorpedo Anna is the second foal out of the 9-year-old mare. The first, Charlee O (**Tonalist**) earned over \$100,000 on the track. Now a millionaire, Thorpedo Anna was purchased by McPeek for a mere \$40,000 at the Fasig-Tipton October yearling sale in 2022. The mare produced a colt by Cloud Computing the following season, and he also realized \$40,000 when selling at Keeneland last September. The daughter of **Uncle Mo** foaled a filly by Known Agenda earlier this year.

NO STOPPING CHAMPION IDIOMATIC IN THE LA TROIENNE by *Christina Bossinakis*

LOUISVILLE, KY -- Heading up to Friday's first graded stakes race of the day at Churchill Downs, trainer Brad Cox appeared to be oozing confidence in regard to the returning champion older dirt female **Idiomatic (Curlin)** in the GI Fasig-Tipton La Troienne S. In the 8 1/2-furlong test for fillies and mares, the Juddmonte homebred proved that Cox's instinct had been spot on, winning by 3 3/4-lengths over **Free Like a Girl (El Deal)** in the slop.

Installed the 4-5 favorite, she argued the issue with **Dorth Vader (Girvin)**, who cut out opening splits of :23.53 and :47 as second choice **Xigera (Nyquist)** and last season's Kentucky Oaks winner **Pretty Mischievous (Into Mischief)** filled the next two spots.

Assuming control approaching the far turn, Idiomatic was cut loose turning for home, appeared to idle for a few beats but drew off late to win by the authoritative margin.

"She was the class of the field, said winning rider Florent Geroux, who has been aboard the mare in each of her last five starts. "We didn't break as fast as I anticipated...I broke a little flat-footed. I tried to get her in a good spot. I was very content to sit off the flank of the leader on the backside. Once my filly started getting into her stride, you could tell she was getting into a nice rhythm and from there she just went on. You could tell she was looking around a little bit, she gets a little distracted sometimes but she looks like she's back to her old self."

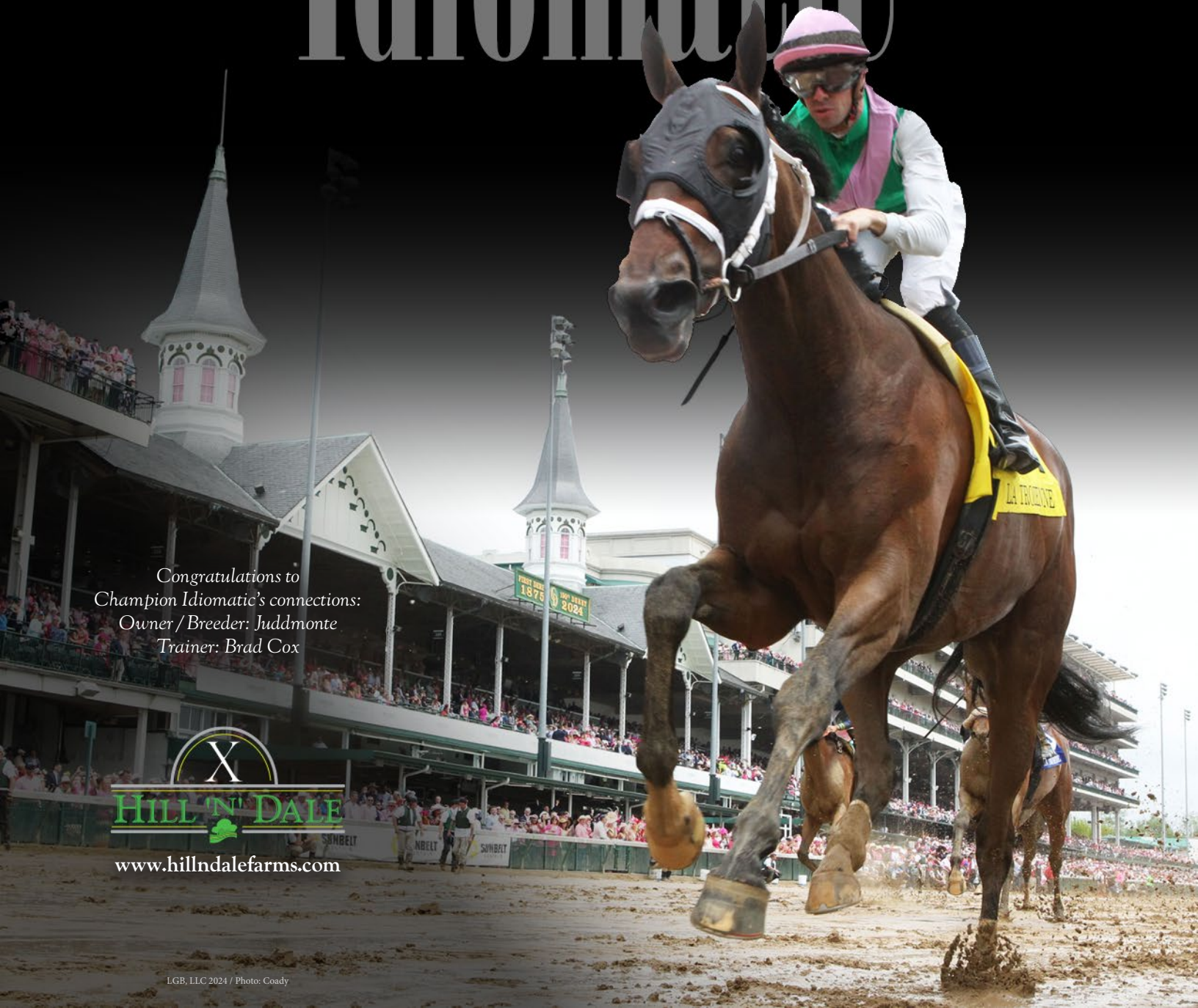
A winner in three consecutive races over Turfway's synthetic early in her 4-year-old season, the homebred was second in the GII Ruffian S. at Belmont, but wouldn't taste defeat again in 2023, winning five races, including the GI Personal Ensign S., GI Juddmonte Spinster S. and GI Breeders' Cup Distaff at Santa Anita.

Added Cox, “I think she runs on anything. I really do believe that. I mean, she obviously put in a good effort here today and she’s performed on synthetics, she’s performed on the fast dirt obviously. But [the wet track] is always a concern. There is always a lot of pressure when they’re the price she is and coming off a layout and with the resume she got being a champion. I enjoy being in the position, but the race had some anxiety behind it.”

As for 'TDN Rising Star' Pretty Mischievous, who was making her first start since a second in the GI Cotillion S. last September, jockey Tyler Gaffalione was pragmatic about the return effort.

“I thought it was a credible effort,” he said. “It was the first time off a layoff and she was bound to get tired. The sloppy track didn’t do us any favors today. It’s never been her favorite surface and she struggled quite a bit down the lane. Very proud of her effort and hopefully it’s a good year for her.”

Pedigree Notes:

From the family of Broodmare of the Year Best in Show (Traffic Judge), Idiomatic represents a deep Juddmonte family going back several generations. Her dam, Lockdown (First Defence), is a out of Rising Tornado, also responsible for her full-sister Champion Older Mare Close Hatches and GI Wood winner **Tacitus (Tapit)**, also runner-up in the GI Belmont S. and GI **Runhappy** Travers S. Third dam Silver Star (GB) (Zafonic) produced multiple European champion Xaar (GB), also campaigned by Juddmonte.

Lockdown has produced only two live foals since Idiomatic, including her most recent, a filly by Into Mischief, in 2022.

MISSION ACCOMPLISHED IN THE ALYSHEBA

LOUISVILLE, KY—Offering a preview of what may be to come in Churchill's next two day's Classics, **'TDN Rising Star' First Mission (Street Sense)** continued a power-charged run for trainer Brad Cox when taking the GIII Alysheba S. The win was the second graded win of the afternoon for Cox, who also took the La Troienne S. with Idiomatic (**Curlin**), and it was the third straight win for jockey Florent Geroux, who also won with Idiomatic and Ova Charged (Star Guitar) in the GIII Unbridled Sidney S.

T O Saint Denis (Jpn) (Kitasan Black {Jpn}), who was narrowly bested by Kentucky Derby candidate T O Password (Jpn) (Copano Rickey {Jpn}) in a half-mile breeze earlier this week, opened a daylight advantage, cutting out fractions of :22.96 and :46.77 as First Mission saved ground along the rail in third. On the far turn, the GIII Essex H. winner moved into second, and at the top of the stretch, he was still three lengths in back of the leader. The pacesetter retained the lead at the eighth pole, however, First Mission was not to be denied, sweeping by his rival late and drawing clear to win by four lengths. **Il Miracolo (Gun Runner)** was third. Grade I-winning **'TDN Rising Star' Tapit Trice (Tapit)** was scratched.

“When you get in a pace scenario like that, you just have to be patient and ride your race,” said Geroux. “I give a lot of credit to [T O Saint Denis]. He ran a huge race. Deep in the stretch my horse was picking up his stride and he finished very easily.”

Named a **'Rising Star'** in his second start at the Fair Grounds in March of his sophomore year, the Godolphin homebred added a win in the GIII Lexington S., and would likely have been a major player in the GI Preakness S. only to be withdrawn on the eve of the race with an injury. A Keeneland optional claimer winner last fall, he was runner-up in the Gil Clark S. over this track in November, and was a non-factoring ninth in the GI Pegasus

World Cup Invitational S. at Gulfstream when returning in January.

After the race, Cox offered, “I felt like we had [the pacesetter] measured. Our horse stays on well and I thought he was going to get there. I was just hoping someone else wouldn't come running on late given the pace early on.”

“I'm proud of the effort,” added Cox. “I think we have him in a rhythm now. I think he's a Grade I-caliber horse, and we believe there is one out there with his name on it, maybe multiples, and this sets us up to take a swing at it.”

Jockey Ryusei Sakai, aboard T O Saint Denis and who will be riding T O Password (Jpn) in the Derby said, “I'm very proud of how my horse ran. This race should be some good experience for me in preparation for tomorrow's Derby.”

Pedigree Notes:

First Mission is the second to race out of Elude, a daughter of Argentine champion and Classic winner Forty Marchanta (Arg) (Roar). The lightly-raced mare was purchased for \$105,000 at the 2022 Keeneland January Sale while carrying a full-brother to the winner. Later named Foil, that colt went to Colts Neck Stable for \$500,000 at last year's Keeneland September Sale. Elude, who is responsible for a yearling colt by Protonico, was booked to **Life Is Good** for this term.

MY MANE SQUEEZE TAKES THE EIGHT

LOUISVILLE, KY -- Often seen jumping up and winning a race on a big day a square price, trainer Mike Maker did just that, taking the GII Eight Belles S. with William Butler and WinStar Farm's **My Mane Squeeze** (**Audible**).

Sent off at odds of 6-1, My Mane Squeeze broke well and was a two-wide fifth as longshot **Asternia** (Astern {Aus}) cut out an opening quarter in :22.46. Urged forward by Luis Saez, she responded quickly and in a flash was on even terms with the pacesetter leaving the quarter pole. Drifting out even further wide turning for home, she ground clear her nearest pursuer and finished with good energy to best **'TDN Rising Star' Impel** (**Quality Road**) with **Asternia** hanging on for third. Favored **Denim and Pearls** (Into Mischief) failed to fire.

"My horse handled the off track beautifully today," said Saez. "She traveled great the entire backstretch and was in a very comfortable position. You can tell by my silks that they are still clean and I think that helped her down the lane. We stayed out of all the kickback and she got stronger as we got closer to the wire."

My Mane Squeeze kicked off a three-race win skein in the Oct. 29 Maid of the Mist S. during the Belmont at Aqueduct meeting before adding the Jan. 14 Franklin Square S. at the venue. A 4 3/4-length winner in the Maddie May Feb. 18, she came home a lackluster eighth in Oaklawn's GII Fantasy S Mar. 30.

"Well, we did a lot of schooling at Oaklawn," added Maker. "She wasn't acting like herself. She was in season in the paddock and she was bad in the gate. That was out of character."

He continued, "We did some schooling [at Churchill] and it looks like it paid off. Maybe the outside post helped, she wasn't in gate too long. But the previous start just wasn't her. I was happy the way she saddled, and then when she loaded in the gate and she was behaving I was happy, and then the way she broke it was like, we'll see if she's good enough."

Asked what is next for the 3-year-old, Maker said, "The plan all along has been the [June 7] GI Acorn S., so we'll take it one step at a time."

Florent Geroux, who was aboard the runner-up, added, "It was a good race for her. She gave it a good try. I don't think the track bothered her. She seemed to be fine on it. I can't be complaining though. I've had a pretty good day today."

From the family of Grade I winner Haynesfield, In Spite of Mama is also responsible for MSW and GSP Rotknee (**Runhappy**)--winner of Thursday's Affirmed Success S. at Aqueduct--and MSP Lookin for Trouble (Into Mischief). DYNAMIC PRICING GIVES BROWN FIRST EDGEWOOD SCORE

It's hard to believe there are any graded stakes on the grass that have not been won by a 3-year-old filly from the barn of Chad Brown, but entering Friday's action, that was remarkably the case. Klaravich Stables' **Dynamic Pricing (Ire)** (Night of Thunder {Ire}) managed to put pay to that anomalous statistic with a fast-finishing victory in the GII Edgewood S. at a soggy Churchill Downs.

Let go at odds of nearly 9-1--a healthy mutuel for any Brown runner--the €170,000 Tattersalls October yearling acquisition broke well enough from gate nine in a scratched-down field of 11 and settled in mid-division three deep into the first turn, with cover on the back of **Way to Be Marie (Not This Time)** as longshot **Maxisuperfly** (Optimizer) cut out a decent pace.

Continuing to slipstream **Way to Be Marie** through the middle furlongs, **Dynamic Pricing** traveled strongly, but three wide on the turn while following the move of **Way to Be Marie** before angling off that one's heels in upper stretch. **Way to Be Marie** had gotten first run, took command and looked on her way to victory, but **Dynamic Pricing** was kept after by Irad Ortiz, Jr. and

was along in the dying strides for the victory. **Dancing N Dixie** (Neolithic) came with a stinging rally down the center of the course to finish third.

Dynamic Pricing nosed out **Way to Be Marie** to graduate at first asking at Aqueduct last Nov. 4 and turned in a bold effort on her sophomore debut, running home smartly to finish third, beaten a half-length, in the Feb. 3 GIII Sweetest Chant S. at Gulfstream. Saddled with a double-digit alley for the GIII Florida Oaks last time Mar. 9, **Dynamic Pricing** was last of 11 after a half-mile and made belated progress to finish seventh, just under four lengths behind **Waskesiu (American Pharoah)**.

Pedigree Notes:

Dynamic Pricing is the 44th worldwide stakes winner and 23rd group/graded winner for her sire (by **Dubawi {Ire}**) and his second American winner at the graded level, joining GIII Robert G. Dick S. winner **Sopran Basilea (Ire)**.

Shemda, a half-sister to G3 **Stanerra S.** and G3 **Irish St Leger Trial** winner **Shamida (Ire)** (**Australia {GB}**), was purchased for 110,000gns by Denis Brosnan's **Epona Bloodstock** in foal to **Showcasing (GB)** at Tattersalls December in 2019, and **Dynamic Pricing** is one of two winners from three to race out of the mare. The other is **Hi Clare (Ire)** (**Kodiac {GB}**), a 24,000gns purchase by Hunter Valley Farm out of last year's December Mares Sale at Tattersalls. Third dam **Shemaka** won the 1993 G1 **Prix de Diane** for His Highness The Aga Khan en route to a divisional championship that season.

Dynamic Pricing is the last listed produce for **Shemda**.

TEC Racing's Fast as Flight adeptly used her ailerons to shoot an approach at the top of the lane en route to earning the first graded stakes of her career in the GIII Modesty S. at Churchill Downs on Friday afternoon.

Formerly in the care of trainer Brian Lynch, the bay was unlucky starting as a late 3-year-old, but she finally broke her maiden at sixth asking at Gulfstream Park early in 2022. Fast as Flight's 4-year-old campaign saw her miss the board in a pair of graded stakes starts--GIII Honey Fox S. and the GIII Suwannee River S.--both at Gulfstream Park. After making the switch to conditioner Martin Drexler, the mare was the runner-up over the Hallandale turf in the Sand Springs S. Mar. 30.

Off at the sumptuous price of 20-1 here, the 6-year-old tucked in along the rail in the first turn behind the pacesetter Heavenly Sunday (**Candy Ride {Arg}**). By saving all the ground behind a pedestrian half-mile of :50.01, Fast as Flight waited patiently for a hole to open, found it as the stretch arrived and cruised passed the leader with less than a sixteenth left to win.

"My owner (Elliott Logan) really picked out this race right after we ran in Florida (in the Sandy Springs)," said Drexler. "I went along with it as long as she trained well. I knew it was a tougher spot than we would like. I thought a couple of stakes up in Woodbine would be a little better of a fit for her which I am sure we will be in. This was something that we wanted to try and this is his hometown and it worked out. It worked out very well."

The beast of the Bayou is now a queen in Kentucky, as Brittlyn Stables' homebred Ova Charged overcame a slow break and managed to gut it out late in Friday's GIII Unbridled Sidney S. It was her fifth consecutive victory, 13th from her 16 lifetime starts and fourth from as many appearances in turf sprint events.

The 3-5 jolly off a 12 1/2-length dusting of her fellow Louisiana-breds in the Mar. 24 Page Cortez S.--for which she earned a massive 113 Beyer Speed Figure--Ova Charged was off a beat slowly from gate two beneath Florent Geroux and was under a ride early, but picked up the beat and slid through underneath the well-backed Stone Silent (Adios Charlie) to wrest command before getting the opening couple of furlongs in a pressured :21.91 over turf labeled as yielding. That pair engaged in a tooth-and-nail battle into and around the turn and they continued their duel into the stretch, where Ova Charged finally got the better of the tussle three-sixteenths from home. Secret Money had crept into it and split rivals to lay down her challenge one off the inside in the final furlong and Run For The Hills was motoring down the grandstand side, but Ova Charged stuck her neck out and flat out refused to lose.

Originally trained by Jose Camejo, Ova Charged was runner-up in the GIII Victory Ride S. on the dirt in 2021 and made a successful turf debut in the 2022 renewal of the Page Cortez. Sixth in a 6 1/2-furlong dirt allowance at Keeneland in her final start for Camejo last April, Ova Charged was victorious in a pair of restricted dirt stakes at the Fair Grounds in December and January before taking out the Feb. 13 Mardi Gras S. on the grass, her first black-type success in open company. Sent away at a dime on the dollar when last seen Mar. 24, the 6-year-old ran them off their feet, stopping the clock in 1:01.90 for the 5 1/2 panels on firm turf. **Cont. p17**

“She’s so easy to train, she’s so smart,” said trainer Shane Wilson, who saddled Mocito Rojo (Mutadda) to an 8-1 upset in the 2019 GIII Lukas Classic at Churchill. “When [jockey Florent Geroux] came back, I asked him, ‘It got kind of tight there, didn’t it?’ And he said, ‘Naw, I had a lot. She just did enough to stay in front.’ She’s a very, very talented filly, and we figured out that it’s better if we don’t waste her time getting bullet workouts every morning. I train her every day, she’s very sound. We put her on the turf because her mother was actually a stakes winner on the turf. So she’ll stay on the grass.”

Brittlyn's Evelyn Benoit bred and raced Star Guitar to 24 victories from 30 starts. A remarkable 22 of those occurred in stakes and he was the odds-on favorite in 19 of them. Star Guitar was third in the 2009 GIII Alysheba S. at Churchill.

Benoit retired Star Guitar to Louisiana and committed considerable resources to acquiring well-bred and accomplished racemares at breeding stock sales in Kentucky. One of three such purchases at the 2015 Keeneland November Sale, through agent James Keogh, was Maryland-bred Charged Cotton, a stakes winner on the grass, who fetched a final bid of \$150,000 in foal to **Street Sense**. That produce, Sethamee Street, was stakes-placed as a 5-year-old in 2021 and the pedigree received a further boost earlier this season when Ova Charged's full-sister Manama Gold capped a productive three-race campaign in Dubai with success in the G3 UAE Oaks, becoming the second graded/group winner for Star Guitar. Manama Gold breezed a half-mile at Churchill on Apr. 26 in advance of a potential start in the Kentucky Oaks, but was ultimately not entered.

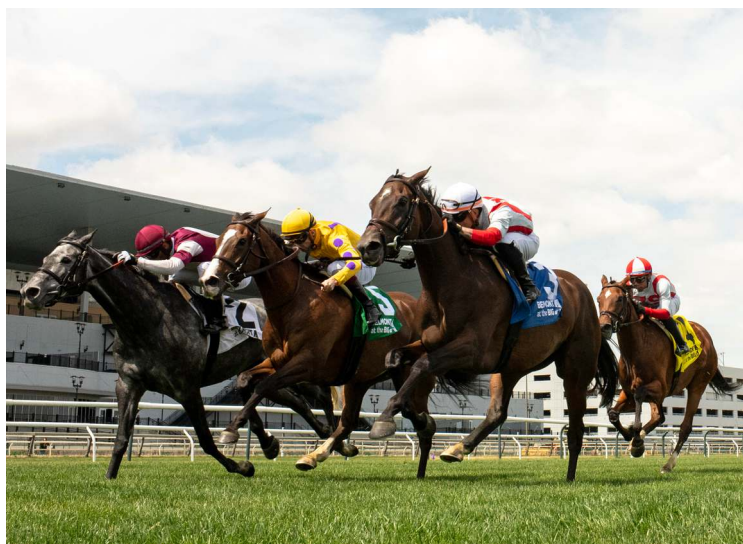
Making her graded stakes debut off a modestly rated first-level allowance victory at Tampa Mar. 16, Klaravich Stables' Royalty Interest made every yard in Friday's GIII Sheepshead Bay S. at Aqueduct as the commonly owned odds-on pop McKulick (GB) (**Frankel {GB}**) could do no better than fourth in a race not run to suit her closing style.

Given a nudge at the break by Eric Cancel to make the lead, Royalty Interest lobbed her four rivals along through a quarter in :25.99 and the first half-mile in just :52.08 as McKulick did the chasing from second. Scarcely out of a high gallop through six panels in 1:18.20, Royalty Interest was asked for a bit of acceleration entering the turn and still had not been asked for her best as they reached the top of the lane. McKulick had every chance from close range, but Royalty Interest had enough in the tank for the win, as Star Fortress rallied to just touch La Mehana out of second.

"She had a smooth race, easy pace and she came with her 'A' game," the winning rider said. "I didn't have to move on her until I got close to the quarter-pole and once I did, she was still full of run."

A debut winner at Tampa last March, Royalty Interest was beaten better than nine lengths into fifth as the 4-5 chalk in the Penn Oaks in June before hitting the shelf. A comebacking second in Oldsmar allowance company Feb. 10, the bay was exiting a one-length tally over the same course Mar. 16, an effort that registered just 79 on the Beyer Speed Figure scale.

Messier, disqualified from first and placed second for causing interference inside the three-sixteenths pole in the local Excelsior S. Mar. 30, lit the lamp as the 3-1 third choice in Friday's GIII Westchester S. at the Big A.

The runaway 2022 GIII Robert B. Lewis S. winner and GI **Runhappy** Santa Anita Derby runner-up vied for command from the outside through opening fractions in :23.26 and :46.16. He shook free rounding the far turn, kicked for home in complete control and had enough left in the tank to hold favored Post Time safe.

Messier, previously campaigned by Bob Baffert in Southern California, was second after leading in the stretch in his first attempt for Rick Dutrow, Jr. in an optional claimer at Laurel Jan. 27. He was cutting back in distance from the 1 1/8-mile Excelsior for this.

"We were happy with the way he run last time, we were thrilled, and we're even happier with this one," Dutrow said. "He's a very nice horse."

As for a potential start in the GI Hill 'n' Dale Metropolitan H. at Saratoga Race Course June 8, Dutrow added, "We have White Abarrio that we're going to run in that race and he's going to be the main danger. I want that to be his race and anyone else that wants to go I'll be happy to do it--I mean, who doesn't want to run in the Met Mile? We'll probably point Messier to the race, I don't know why we shouldn't. He's never had a run at Saratoga and I'm sure he deserves this kind of chance. After this run today, it seems like he's just getting good again doesn't it? We're excited about him."

Westchester S. cont.

The Westchester was the first graded stakes victory for jockey Jose Gomez.

"It's the best feeling in the world," Gomez said. "It is a graded stake, it is what we all want as jockeys. The races all of us want to win, and the owners and trainers want to win. I'm just grateful that I was able to ride him back after last time."

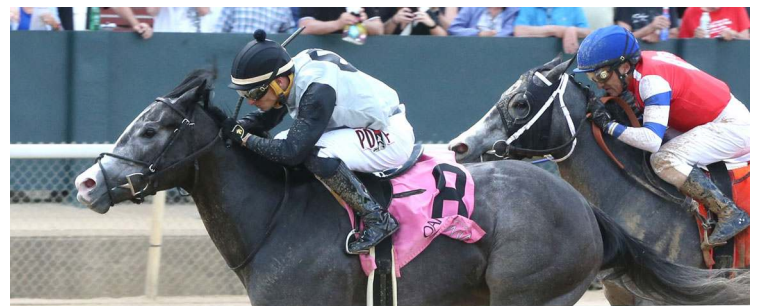

Newmarket Heath's nude brutality awaits a clutch of elite 3-year-olds on Saturday, from the ones who have flashed unusual prowess in the major juvenile exposés to those whose flashes of luminosity have come on smaller and less expected stages. The Rowley Mile's designated strip for the 2000 Guineas is as hostile this horrid Spring as it ever has been and Friday's grey skies and rain only served to extend Europe's winter hangover. Indifferent to weakness, expecting many a flinch and fold from the competitors lined up for the first Classic of the campaign, these 1,760 yards of truth are rarely truly conquered.

SIXTEEN SET FOR 1000 GUINEAS by Tom Frary

Juvenile Group 1 winners **Ylang Ylang (GB)** (Frankel {GB}), **Fallen Angel (GB)** (Too Darn Hot {GB}) and **Porta Fortuna (Ire)** (Caravaggio) head a field of 16 fillies for Sunday's G1 QIPCO 1000 Guineas at Newmarket. **TDN Rising Star** Ylang Ylang, winner of the course-and-distance G1 Fillies' Mile, will be the sole representative for Ballydoyle and is drawn 12 next to Godolphin's G3 Oh So Sharp S. winner and G3 Nell Gwyn S. runner-up **Dance Sequence (GB)** (Dubawi {Ire}) in 13, while Clipper Logistics' G1 Moyglare Stud S. winner Fallen Angel is in stall five and the G1 Cheveley Park S. winner Porta Fortuna is one from the wing in 15.

Karl Burke has never had a stronger hand heading to the Newmarket Classics and believes both Fallen Angel and Newtown Anner Stud Farm's G2 May Hill S. and G3 Prestige S. winner **Darnation (Ire)** (Too Darn Hot {GB}) are closer together than most believe. "Fallen Angel deserves to be favourite on form and she'll relish the mile starting off this year, but there's not a lot between her and Darnation, if at all," he said on Friday during racing on the rain-softened surface. "If it's soft or heavy it will be very interesting, as Darnation relishes that. At the moment, with this rain the owners will be pretty keen to run but it can dry up quickly here." [Cont. p9](#)

G1 2000 Guineas Preview Cont. from p1

Only twice since the War can it be said that the race has been mastered, with the displays of athletic triumph by Tudor Minstrel in 1947 and by Frankel (GB) in 2011 bordering on rude.

“The last of the 2-year-old races,” it has sometimes been labelled, in reference to its position in the calendar. While that may have been true for the genuine carry-over champions such as El Gran Senor, Zafonic or the even-bigger Juddmonte creation 13 years ago, it has proved a downright lie for many. That is especially the case in the most recent renewals, where the likes of Native Trail (GB) (Oasis Dream {GB}), Pinatubo (Ire) (Shamardal) and Air Force Blue (War Front) gave up their seats with varying degrees of fight.

That is the beauty of the Guineas. It is either seamless transition from child to man or a rude awakening for the former head boys no longer able to impose authority on their peers. In Ballydoyle’s TDN Rising Star City Of Troy (Justify), we are almost certainly looking at a multi-generational champion, aren’t we? Maybe, maybe not. Take the three examples above and remember how it just seemed so straightforward as they cantered down to this start, already past the Bushes and home

and hosed...

Trojan Horse Or The Real Thing?

City Of Troy has the form, the stable, the jockey and the athletic prowess to overpower everything here, but the one thing he lacks is a sire proven in this sphere. While Justify’s early start has been impressive, you have to go back to Zafonic in 1993 to find the last 2000 Guineas winner sired by a dirt runner. Several obvious candidates have fallen short subsequently, including a few by Storm Cat and War Front and so it is fair to conclude that this race is all about turf pedigree. Where Zafonic is useful as a comparative tool is he was like City Of Troy last year’s champion head and shoulders above his contemporaries as he enjoyed his “last 2-year-old race” dominating Baratheia (Ire) et al.

Aidan O’Brien believes that his benchmark colt, whose page features the emphatic 2004 Guineas hero Haafhd (GB) (Alhaarth {Ire}), is more work in progress than already-set masterpiece. After the Dewhurst, where Formula One adapted to four-wheel drive, he memorably uttered that “you always see the bottom somewhere, but we’ve not seen it with this fellow.” Quite what depths he’ll have to plumb here remains to be seen, but the purists will be praying that he’ll only be going through the motions once more. The Figures Don't Lie...

Whereas City Of Troy was dazzling with his sectionals in two of this town's big races of the summer and autumn, fellow **TDN Rising Stars Notable Speech (GB)** (Dubawi {Ire}) and **Night Raider (Ire)** (Dark Angel {Ire}) chose to signpost their talent in all-weather novice and conditions races earlier this year.

Notable Speech, which as Charlie Appleby confessed is his last-ditch attempt to derail the hot favourite, showed he is at least in the same ballpark when slicing through the final two furlongs of Kempton's old "Easter Stakes" in under 22 seconds. The trouble is, while City Of Troy is an Irish-trained colt with the bulk of his experience at Newmarket, the big local hope Notable Speech had no runs at two and is unproven on grass.

"Notable Speech is three from three on the all-weather and you are always going to sit on the fence slightly as to whether they can transfer that style of racing to the turf," Appleby said. "We are confident that he can and excited to find out. He is a son of Dubawi, and we know from experience that his offspring can be pretty versatile. His homework has been good and he has had a great preparation so far. We all know we have a couple of nice horses to beat on the ratings and what they have achieved, but I will be disappointed if he doesn't run a big race."

Night Raider is also a turf virgin and if he misses the groove here connections can at least be sure that they have a top-class

prospect for the later part of the season based on what he did against the clock at Southwell. A half-brother to the G3 Palace House S. winner Far Above (Ire) (Farhh {GB}), he needs no further rain with questionable stamina but at least jockey Danny Tudhope is convinced about his ability to see out the mile.

"His work at home has been absolutely outstanding and he's really maturing into himself," he said. "He had a gallop on grass for the first time at the Craven meeting and I thought he handled the track unbelievably well. You might say there's a question mark over him getting the mile, but from the way he's finished his races I'd say he'll stay no problem." **Cont. p5**

Speaking of time figures, there is also no doubt that last year's G1 Prix Jean-Luc Lagardere hero **Rosallion (Ire)** (Blue Point {Ire}) and **Inisherin (GB)** (Shamardal) can be rated in the upper bracket representing Sheikh Mohammed Obaid Al Maktoum. While the former has "previous", Inisherin definitely does not but after he completed the stiff final two furlongs of his Newcastle novice in a staggering 21.63 in March from a wildly-impressive subsequent winner Kalpana (GB) (Study Of Man {Ire}) he belongs in this line-up. This may be too much too soon for the Kevin Ryan-trained son of the late-developing G1 Prix Jean Romanet winner Ajman Princess (Ire) (Teofilo {Ire}) and grandson of the owner-breeder's remarkable font of class Reem Three (GB) (Mark Of Esteem {Ire}), but it would come as no surprise were he to eventually manifest as the best of these.

ALYANAABI (IRE)

Too Darn Hot (GB) - Alyamaama (Kitten's Joy)

Pedigree/form notes: The Shadwell homebred is the first British Classic runner for his young sire and is out of a half-sister to the 2009 1,000 Guineas and Coronation S. winner Ghanaaati (Giant's Causeway). His Listed-winning granddam Sarayir (Mr. Prospector) is a half-sister to the brilliant Nashwan (Blushing Groom {Fr}), whose four Group 1 wins at three included the 2,000 Guineas, as well as Nayef (Gulch) and Unfuwain (Northern Dancer). Winner of the G3 Somerville Tattersall S., Alyanaabi was runner-up in the Dewhurst to City Of Troy.

CITY OF TROY

Justify - Together Forever (Ire) (Galileo {Ire})

Pedigree/form notes: Unbeaten in three starts, including the G1 Dewhurst S. and G2 Superlative S., the Coolmore representative handled the undulations of the Rowley Mile with apparent ease last October. His dam won the G1 Fillies' Mile and is a sister to an Oaks winner, and she has produced three other black-type performers, though none in this colt's league. The European champion two-year-old and a potential superstar.

Sales info: Offered by his breeders Norelands Stud and the Irish National Stud as a foal at Tattersalls, he was bought by David Bowe on behalf of Jeff Smith's Littleton Stud for 100,000gns.

Pedigree/form notes: From a family with form in this particular Classic, his Juddmonte-bred granddam Marching West (Gone West) is a sister to the 1993 winner Zafonic and also to Zamindar, who ran fifth to Entrepreneur four years later. Moorside, who was second in the Cheshire Oaks, was her sole black-type performer.

Ghostwriter won all three starts last year, including over course and distance in the G2 Juddmonte Royal Lodge, and deserves plenty of respect.

HAATEM (IRE)

Phoenix Of Spain (Ire) - Hard Walnut (Ire) (Cape Cross {Ire})

Sales info: Sold at Tattersalls October Book 2 for 27,000gns to Peter and Ross Doyle.

Pedigree/form notes: The impressive winner of the G3 Craven S. after beating Iberian in last season's G2 Vintage S., he is the most seasoned of the field with 10 starts under his belt. Victory here would pull off a remarkable Classic double for his breeder John Bourke, who also bred the 2022 1,000 Guineas winner Cachet (Ire) (Aclaim {Ire}). His dam won twice over six furlongs and is a descendant of Lady O'Reilly's G1 Phoenix S runner-up Yara (Ire) (Sri Pekan).

IBERIAN (IRE)

Lope De Vega (Ire) - Bella Estrella (Ire) (High Chaparral {Ire})

Sales info: Purchased from breeder Ballylinch Stud for 200,000gns by Charlie Hills and McKeever Bloodstock at Tattersalls October Book 2; Ballylinch retained a share when partnering with Teme Valley.

Pedigree/form notes: Out of a Listed-winning miler whose full-sister High Heeled (Ire) won the G3 St Simon S. and half-sister Faraday Light (Ire) (Rainbow Quest) produced the Irish 1,000 Guineas winner Just The Judge (Ire) (Lawman {Fr}).

A winner on debut last year, Iberian was second to Haatem in the G2 Vintage S. before beating subsequent Group 1 winner Sunway (Fr) (Galiway {GB}) to win the G2 Champagne S. Ended the year with a sixth-place finish in the Dewhurst, nine lengths adrift of City Of Troy.

INISHERIN (GB)

Shamardal - Ajman Princess (Ire) (Teofilo {Ire})

Pedigree/form notes: Hails from the same family as Rosallion, their dams both being daughters of Sheikh Mohammed Obaid Al Maktoum's stellar broodmare Reem Three (GB) (Mark Of Esteem {Ire}), whose offspring also include the Group 1 winner Triple Time (GB) (Frankel {GB}). Ajman Princess won the G1 Prix Jean Romanet and this is her second foal.

Inisherin's only run of last year came when second to recent Listed Blue Riband Trial winner Bellum Justum (Ire) (Sea The Stars {Ire}) before returning this season to win a Newcastle novice race in March beating Kalpana (GB) (Study Of Man {Ire}). That form has been franked by Kalpana's wide-margin win at the Craven meeting, and she is favourite for Sunday's Listed Pretty Polly S. **Cont. p7**

Sales info: Bred by Linden Bloodstock, he was bought by Joe Foley on behalf of Clipper Logistics for 155,000gns as a foal at Tattersalls.

Pedigree/form notes: A half-brother to the G3 Palace House S. winner and young sire Far Above (GB), his third dam is the G2 Ribblesdale S. winner and Oaks runner-up Bahr (GB) (Generous {Ire}), whose descendants include the Group 1 winners Bahrain (GB) (Selkirk) and her son Benbatl (GB) (Dubawi {Ire}).

Night Raider was an impressive winner on debut at Southwell a fortnight before Christmas and reinforced that good impression when returning to win at the same track in March.

NOTABLE SPEECH (GB)**Dubawi (Ire) - Swift Ros (Ire) (Invincible Spirit {Ire})**

Pedigree notes: A son of two Guineas winners, this Juddmonte colt is certainly bred for the task but is yet to have been tested beyond six furlongs. The winner of the Ripon Champion Two Yrs Old Trophy, he was second to Vandeeke (GB) in the G1 Juddmonte Middle Park S. and is listed as having undergone wind surgery following that run. JOCKEY CLUB IS IN THE OUTBOX

In what world should a dual listed-winning son of **Frankel (GB)** guaranteed an easy lead under Hollie Doyle for a G2 William Hill Jockey Club S. that hosted no standout be allowed to start at 50-1? Inevitably, the perverse logic of starting odds was laid bare as the Archie Watson stalwart **Outbox (GB)** dominated another lukewarm edition of Newmarket's 12-furlong feature on Friday's warm-up card ahead of the Classic action.

Third in this two years ago and a well-beaten fourth 12 months ago, the nine-year-old was able to saunter on the front end and the writing was on the wall some way out as another **Frankel** in the 11-8 favourite **Time Lock (GB)** laboured in pursuit. At the line, there was 2 1/2 lengths between the veteran and the unexposed blueblood as their sire yet again imposed himself. This time, on the weekend that sealed his fate as immortal god of racing.

Last seen finishing second for the third consecutive year in the G3 Stockholm Cup International in September, Outbox whose finest hour came when upsetting **Frankel's** St Leger hero Logician (GB) in the July Course's Listed Fred Archer S. has an undying appetite for the game and a loyal fan in Doyle who said, "He's got so much ability, but he's so quirky. "He loves being fresh and I got an easy lead and he just got in such a good rhythm. I knew he'd stay and it's nice to have him back. I've had some really good days on him and his last win was the Amir Trophy two years ago, so he was due one. He's nine now and a bit of a yard legend."

Time Lock's trainer Harry Charlton said of the runner-up, "She ran well and Ryan [Moore] was very happy with her, it was just the stop-start pace that didn't play into her hands. I think the key to her is pace and wherever she gets some pace, she will

show her best. She could run in something like the [G2] Hardwicke, but her main aim is the [G1] Yorkshire Oaks."

Darnation's jockey Clifford Lee was also hoping that the forecast stays wet. "She has a good chance as long as it keeps coming," he added. "It stops others, but she gets through it quite nicely."

A second **TDN Rising Star** in the line-up is the G2 Prix Robert Papin and G3 Prix du Bois winner and G1 Prix Morny runner-up **Ramatuelle (Justify)**, who was only second again in her prep, the G3 Prix Imprudence at Deauville last month. "She is a filly with a lot of energy, so it was good to give her a prep run," trainer Christophe Head said of the French representative who races from stall 11. "She has a strong heart. On her comeback at Deauville, it was very heavy ground and she still stayed on well and finished her race, which was a good Guineas trial. She is also strong mentally and easy to deal with, so travelling is not a problem."

"We think there is something special about this filly and that Newmarket will suit her, although we can't be 100% sure. Of course, this is my first Guineas, but from what I see in the morning and her profile, I have the feeling Newmarket should suit her. The start of the race is important and I think she will be up there in the early stages. Her jockey Aurelien Lemaitre has ridden there before and knows the filly well, which is a great advantage."

SEA THE STARS FILLY POWERS TO TDN RISING STARDOM AT HQ

Newmarket's Darley Maiden Fillies' S. played host to the 'TDN Rising Star' performance of subsequent G3 Musidora S. third Infinite Cosmos (Ire) (**Sea The Stars {Ire}**) last term and this year's renewal produced another display of note as William Haggas trainee **Sea Just In Time (Ire)** (**Sea The Stars {Ire}**--My Timing {GB}, by Street Cry {Ire}) powered to a 4 3/4-length triumph in the straight 10-furlong test.

The G2 Ribblesdale and G1 Irish Oaks entry employed a patient approach from the outset and was within range at the tail of the field through halfway. Easing forward inside the last half-mile, the 11-2 chance was stoked up to seize control approaching the final furlong and powered clear of overmatched rivals on the climb to the line for an impressive daylight success. Sea Just In Time becomes the 19th Rising Star for her sire.

"That was nice and I thought she did that well," said Maureen Haggas. "We always thought she was nice and is well-rated, being a sister to Truthful, and we had the older sister as well [Sea On Time], who sadly injured a tendon after winning a maiden when she looked nice. There is no rush to decide where she goes next, I'll leave that to William [Haggas]. I think she probably needs three weeks before she runs again and we could look for a Listed contest for her. There are lots of things later in the year like the [G1] Irish Oaks. Sea Of Class was second here before going on to win a Listed race and then on to win the Irish Oaks. She still needs some time and some sunshine, like we all do!"

Sea Just In Time is the third of four foals, all by **Sea The Stars (Ire)**, and third scorer produced by an unraced half-sister to Listed Criterium de Vitesse victor and G3 Prix Texanita runner-up Beau Ideal (GB) (Exceed And Excel {Aus}). She is a full-sister to a yearling filly. The April-foaled bay's G3 Winter Hill S.-winning second dam Lay Time (GB) (Galileo {Ire}) is a granddaughter of storied champion Time Charter (Ire) (Saritamere).

The owner-breeders are already both Honorary Members of The Jockey Club, with the King having been appointed in 1980. A keen equestrian, he has ridden in races as an amateur as well as being a success polo player.

The Queen joined her husband as an Honorary Member of The Jockey Club in 2015 and she has also been Patron of The National Stud – the breeding operation of The Jockey Club – since November 2018.

Their Majesties enjoyed their first Royal Ascot winner last season when the William Haggas-trained Desert Hero (GB) won the King George V S. and went on to finish third in the St Leger. They also have horses in training with Ralph Beckett, Andrew Balding, Sir Michael Stoute, Richard Hughes and John and Thady Gosden.

Announcing the news, the Jockey Club's Senior Steward Sandy Dudgeon said, "We are honoured that Their Majesties have accepted our invitation to become joint Patrons of The Jockey Club.

NICK BELL BACK ON HIS BIKE FOR AU-DELÀ DES PISTES

Nick Bell, long-time manager of the Rothschild family's Haras de Meautry, will be embark on an epic challenge next month when cycling the length of France to raise money for the racehorse aftercare charity Au-Delà des Pistes.

Bell's quest begins on June 15 from France's northernmost racecourse, Le Touquet on the English Channel, and over the course of the next 11 days he will make his way to the southern racecourse of Hyères, which lies on the Mediterranean, cycling 1,118km in the process.

Born in England, Bell, 63, has been based in Normandy for more than two decades. In recent years, he has suffered a series of health issues including a hip replacement which was followed by a diagnosis of incurable chronic pulmonary sarcoidosis and prostate cancer. Despite this, he completed his first charity cycling challenge in 2021 for Down Syndrome Kerry and then Kerry Mountain Rescue in 2023, only missing a challenge in 2022

when recovering from spinal surgery.

He says, "I've always had in the back of my mind to do an epic journey while I still can. Therefore, I came up with the idea of cycling from the most northerly racecourse in France to the most southerly and it seemed particularly apt, considering my career, to do this ride in aid of Au-Dèla des Pistes, a charity that is involved with the retraining of ex-racehorses."

CLASH OF CHAMPIONS IN NHK MILE CUP

A valiant second in the G1 Oka Sho last month, 2023 Japanese Champion 2-Year-Old Filly **Ascoli Piceno (Jpn)** (Daiwa Major {Jpn}) is looking for redemption in Tokyo's G1 NHK Mile Cup on Sunday having lost her unbeaten record. However, the 18-strong field boasts two champions and plenty of up-and-comers and her task is not straightforward.

The mount of crack French reinsman Christophe Lemaire, the granddaughter of the high class G1 Meon Valley Stud Fillies' Mile heroine Listen (Ire) (Sadler's Wells) won both the G3 Niigata Nisai S. and the G1 Hanshin Juvenile Fillies last year. Stellenbosch (Jpn) (Epiphaneia {Jpn}) stole a march on the Yoichi Kuroiwa trainee in the straight to win the Japanese 1000 Guineas by just three-quarters of a length last out. Ascoli Piceno leaves from stall 14.

Kuroiwa said, "She handled the transportation over to the track well for the Oka Sho, and despite starting slowly in the race, she quickly recovered to get a good position. She got bumped a little turning for home, but despite this, she still ran on well. She's recovered from that race without any problems, and we've been able to make this next race the target for her."

The NHK Mile is, literally, a clash of champions, as **Jantar Mantar (Jpn)** (Palace Malice), the male equivalent of Ascoli Piceno, is also signed on. A winner of his first three starts, just like his female counterpart, the colt is perched two stalls farther out, and has the services of Yuga Kawada. Both November's G2 Daily Hai Nisai S. and December's G1 Asahi Hai Futurity S. were secured by the Shadai Race Horse Company colourbearer. In 2024, he was a good second to subsequent record-setting G1 Satsuki Sho (Japanese 2000 Guineas) hero Justin Milano (Jpn) (Kizuna {Jpn}) in the G3 Kyodo News Hai in February, and wound up a brave third in the 2000-metre colts' Classic after briefly leading in the home straight. He should appreciate the shorter trip.

Trainer Tomokazu Takano said, "He wasn't able to hold off the other two horses in the closing stages last time, and just couldn't find any more at the end, but I was still satisfied with his third-place finish. He's a top-class horse with a lot of ability."

Rulership (Jpn) colt **Di Speranza (Jpn)** sports both of his victories over the NHK Mile journey. He clocked a sharp 1:34.10, with rivals **Arranger (Jpn)** (Real Steel {Jpn}) and **Channel Tunnel (Jpn)** (Greater London {Jpn}) second and third in the G3 Arlington Cup at Hanshin in April. If he handles the rise in class, he could prove dangerous to the champion pair.

Di Speranza's assistant trainer Sho Tajima said, "Two starts ago, he was well back in the run, but last time he could get a better early position in the race, so he's showed us different ways of racing. Switching to the outside in the home straight last time worked very well, and he's now won two consecutive races over a mile."

Although the winner of the other NHK Mile Cup prep, the G2 New Zealand Trophy is not in Sunday's lineup in Ecoro Bloom (Jpn) (Daiwa Major {Jpn}), both the second and third--filly **Bond Girl (Jpn)** (Daiwa Major {Jpn}), and **Yukino Royal (Jpn)** (Dee Majesty {Jpn})--are heading back into the fray and leave from posts five and 17, respectively. **Cont. p16**

If she wins, Bond Girl would be the fifth NKH Mile winner to be ridden by the legendary Yutaka Take, and his first since Logic (Jpn) (Agnes Tachyon {Jpn}) in 2006.

Takahisa Tezuka, the trainer of Bond Girl, said, “She had to miss the Juvenile Fillies last year, so we then thought about going directly to the Oka Sho, but she couldn’t get balloted into that. The New Zealand Trophy became her next race, and despite being off for a while, she put in a good run. The jockey was riding her for the first time, and thought she got into a good rhythm in the race. What’s more, it gained her some valuable prize-money to get entered into races from now.”
