'*TDN Rising Star*' **Sierra Leone** (*Gun Runner*) returned to the worktab for the first time since his bang-up second to *Mystik Dan* (*Goldencents*) in the GI Kentucky Derby, breezing a half-mile in the company of his GIII Lambholm South Tampa Bay Derby-winning stablemate *Domestic Product* (*Practical Joke*) in :48.20 (3/31) over the Oklahoma training track at Saratoga.

LUKAS'S MAGNIFICENT PREAKNESS SEVEN

Baltimore, MD--The naysayers said it couldn't be done. **Seize the Grey** (Arrogate) wasn't fast enough, was unlikely to go that far and simply put, was just being thrown into the deep end. D. Wayne Lukas, however, blocked out the noise. The Hall of Famer has been quoted countless times over the years that he has built a career running where he didn't belong. And the 88-year-old proved once again that he not only belongs, but gave yet another master class in winning a Classic in Saturday's GI Preakness S. at Pimlico.

The latest win gave him his seventh score in the second jewel in the Triple Crown, only one behind fellow Hall of Fame trainer Bob Baffert, who registered his most recent win last year with National Treasure.

Earlier in the week, Baffert fretted that he just wasn't sure how his colt, **Imagination** (Into Mischief), would handle being out front on his own. Lukas on the other hand, didn't hide his intent to send the MyRacehorse runner to the front early, if the opportunity arose. But despite both of those contenders' imposing connections, neither colt was favored given the presence of **Mystik Dan** (Goldencents), who had enjoyed a masterful ride by Brian Hernandez, Jr. two weeks ago to win the GI Kentucky Derby at Churchill Downs. Also making the quick return, Derby fourth **Catching Freedom** (**Constitution**) was installed the 7-2 second choice behind Mystik Dan, who was sent off at 2-1, and **Just Steel** (**Justify**). Also trained by Lukas, the B C Stables and Harry Schmueckle runner was given a 10-1 chance following a 17th-place finish after pursuing some quick early fractions two weeks ago.

With Baltimore being inundated with rain early in the week, there was a glimmer of hope that rain would hold off for most of the day Saturday. The weather Gods had quite a different idea, however. Late Friday night, the skies opened, and the onslaught continued through much of race day, breaking off from time to time only to start again. The result was a muddy quagmire that looked like it could swallow a little animal, or a loose-fitting shoe, if one wasn't careful. All week, the possibility of rain also

gave the connections of **Mystik Dan**, winner of a muddy renewal of the GIII Southwest S. and **Uncle Heavy** (Social Inclusion), victorious in the muddy GIII Withers S., confidence that their colts wouldn't have a problem handling the off going.

"I don't worry about things I can't control," trainer Kenny McPeck said earlier in the week of his Derby-winning colt.

Come post time, the rain had ceased but the track was officially listed as muddy/sealed. The start got off without a hitch, except for **Just Steel**, who veered outward bumping with 4-1 chance **Tuscan Gold** (**Medaglia d'Oro**) as Jamie Torres and the GII Pat Day Mile winner loped to the front with **Imagination** up to mix things up from his high draw. With the opening quarter clicking off in :23.98, the grey continued to hug the rail as Frankie Dettori allowed his colt to drift out three to four paths wide around the turn. Meanwhile, **Mystik Dan** assumed a seemingly perfect spot, a few lengths behind the leader, but moving under his own steam. Carving out a half in :47.33, **Seize the Grey** continued to show the way as **Imagination** and **Just Steel** splashed along several paths off the rail. Approaching the quarter pole, **Mystik Dan** swung off the rail to mount his challenge as **Imagination** and **Just Steel** also loomed. At the top of the stretch, it seemed like it was anyone's race, but soon **Imagination** and **Just Steel** began their retreat as **Mystik Dan** seemed to be the only one with the best chance to catch the

loose-on-the-lead runner. Hernandez scrubbed and urged the Derby winner forward, however, try as they might to close the gap late, the duo couldn't catch the free-running grey, who crossed the wire 2 1/4 lengths ahead of Mystik Dan. Closing wide but running out of real-estate late, Catching Freedom produced another great stretch run but had to settle for third, beaten a head for the place spot.

"We didn't have any strategy, per se," said Lukas following the

race. "Once I felt like they were getting over the ground, I didn't think there was any chance [he'd get caught]. I knew they were going to run at us, but I thought we had a great chance to dictate the race from the 1/2-mile home."

He continued, "I also think you can over-coach a little bit on these riders. I didn't want to do that."

Lukas recounted a situation from a few weeks ago where Torres's ride on another barn runner hadn't gone quite as planned, and Lukas didn't hold back.

"If I told him I wanted him to lay third or fourth or midpack, as bad as I chewed his ass the first time, I think he'd have probably tried to do exactly that. But he breaks so well this time and he's on the lead cruising."

And it is as Lukas is so fond of saying, "Take what comes easy."

The victory gave the 25-year-old Puerto Rican Torres his first Classic win, only two years removed from when he started riding races.

"I was going to do whatever Imagination was going to do," said Torres. "I knew he was going to go to the lead. I think we looked at each other, and [Dettori] said, well you go and so I took the lead."

Following another good effort, McPeck was pragmatic about his colt's finish.

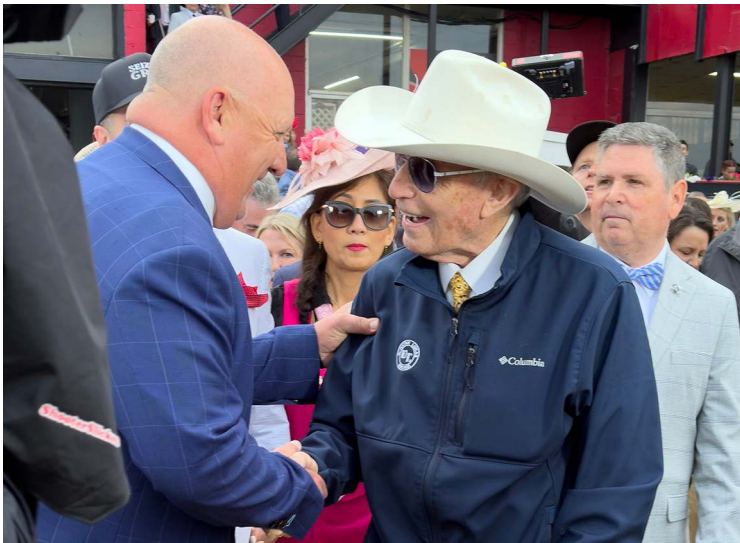
"He ran good," he said. "Wayne's amazing. What can you say?"

“Stolen on the front. He said he was going to go. I think Brian made the right move. Obviously, speed held. That's why they call it horse racing, right?”

Meanwhile, Lukas has become somewhat of an old hat at the Preakness, having won it on six prior occasions with Codex in 1980, Tank’s Prospect (1985), Tabasco Cat (1994), Timber Country (1995), Charismatic (1999) and Oxbow (2013).

“It doesn’t get old,” said Lukas. “It’s still the same. In 1980, I had the first one here I ever ran, and it still feels the same.”

Lukas's latest win also represents the second Classic score for MyRacehorse, who collected their first with Authentic in 2020.

“Isn’t that something, to make that many people happy? It’s a helluva concept,” said Lukas of the 2570 shareholders in the grey. “It really is. To see that many people happy in racing is really special. I’m happy, but I love the fact I could make them happy.”

Lukas indicated he would wait 48 hours before deciding if Seize the Grey would return in the June 8 GI Belmont S. The third jewel of the Triple Crown that will be run at Saratoga.

Seizing the Moment

Seize the Grey's career debut didn't go quite as scripted when he finished a distant eighth at Ellis last July. Catching a sloppy track at the Spa at the end of that month, he came home 1 3/4-length winner over subsequent GII Fountain of Youth winner Dornoch. A respectable third in a muddy edition of the Skidmore S. Aug. 18, the \$300,000 Fasig-Tipton Saratoga yearling purchase

rounded out his juvenile season with a fourth in Churchill's GIII Iroquois S. at a mile in September and third in a Keeneland allowance Oct. 14. Freshened for 2024, he won out of the box in an 8 1/2-furlong allowance at Oaklawn Feb. 24 before coming home third while trying the synthetic in Turfway's GIII Jeff Ruby Steaks Mar. 23. Desperate for some Derby points, Lukas took the colt back to Keeneland for the nine-furlong GI Toyota Blue Grass S. Apr. 6, but the experiment didn't quite pan out when the colt finished seventh behind Sierra Leone (**Gun Runner**). With the Derby off the card, Lukas ran the Kentucky-bred back on the Derby undercard and was rewarded with a 1 1/4-length score over Nash in the Pat Day Mile.

“When we were cruising down the backside, I knew he was dead fit after coming off the Pat Day Mile,” added Lukas of the colt's preparation. “I love that prep.”

Affectionately known as The Coach, Lukas concluded the post-race presser in typical Lukas fashion.

“I want you to do more than you actually think you can do and I want you to be better than you think you can be,” he said, delivering his latest sermon on the mount. “I want you to really dedicate yourself. And to be the best version of you.”

Pedigree Notes:

Seized the Grey becomes the sixth Grade I winner for his deceased sire Arrogate. The son of Unbridled Song is also responsible for Classic winner Secret Oath, winner of the 2022 GI Kentucky Oaks, also trained by D. Wayne Lukas. The winner's

SIERRA LEONE BACK ON THE WORKTAB AT SARATOGA

'TDN Rising Star' **Sierra Leone** (**Gun Runner**) returned to the worktab for the first time since his bang-up second to **Mystik Dan** (**Goldencents**) in the GI Kentucky Derby, breezing a half-mile in the company of his GIII Lambholm South Tampa Bay Derby-winning stablemate **Domestic Product** (**Practical Joke**) in :48.20 (3/31) over the Oklahoma training track at Saratoga. With light rain falling, the pair galloped out six furlongs in 1:14 4/5, according to trainer Chad Brown.

"I thought the horse worked super," Brown said of Sierra Leone, who was once again equipped with the blinkers for the move. "I'm very, very pleased with him. He's settled into Saratoga nicely."

Off as the 9-2 second favorite in the Derby, the \$2.3-million Fasig-Tipton Saratoga topper sustained a long run from the rear and locked up with Japan's **Forever Young** (**Jpn**) (**Real Steel** {**Jpn**}) for the stretch drive. The two exchanged bumps repeatedly and Sierra Leone, who drifted in several paths, was just up for second in a tight three-way photo. Brown holds no concerns

about Sierra Leone's antics going forward.

"I think he was just getting a bit tired in the stretch and those two horses were leaning on each other," said Brown. "I'm turning the page on that. It's just part of him."

The conditioner is giving **Domestic Product** a pass for his 13th at Churchill Downs, as he threw a shoe and grabbed a quarter. While Sierra Leone is on target for the June 8 GI Belmont S. at the Spa, **Domestic Product** is not under consideration for the 10-furlong test, though he has healed up well, Brown said.

Also on the tab for Brown were **Program Trading** (**GB**) (**Lope de Vega** {**Ire**}) and **I'm Very Busy** (**Maclean's Music**), first and seventh home, respectively, in the GI Old Forester Turf Classic on the Derby undercard. The two went a half-mile in company in :49 flat (9/31) Saturday morning and each has the GI Resorts World Casino Manhattan S. on the Belmont undercard as their next target, and Brown is also willing to excuse **I'm Very Busy's** effort.

"I'm Very Busy didn't handle the paddock well on Derby Day and he was not acting right," the trainer said. "He stuck his foot in the hind portion of the gate and that race is a total throw-out for him."

Also headed for Belmont Day engagements are 'TDN Rising Star' **Blazing Sevens** (**Good Magic**), who went four furlongs in :49 flat (47/186) at Belmont ahead of the GI Hill 'n' Dale Metropolitan H; and the GI Acorn S.-bound **Regulatory Risk** (**Omaha Beach**), who galloped a half-mile in :49.52 (81/186) over the Belmont training track Saturday morning.

In other Met-related news, **White Abarrio** (**Race Day**) breezed a half-mile in :47.58 (1/90) at Belmont Friday morning. Third in last year's renewal, the 5-year-old would be making his first start since finishing a disappointing 10th in the G1 Saudi Cup in February.

Brown added that **Resolute Racing's** 'TDN Rising Star' **Sweet Rebecca** (**American Pharoah**) would work Sunday and a decision on a possible appearance in the G1 Coronation S. at Royal Ascot would likely be made the following day.

D J Stable and Robert Cotran's **Hades** (Awesome Slew) is recovering from a small setback, but is being programmed for a pair of starts at Monmouth Park over the coming months, including the GI NYRA Bets Haskell S. July 20.

Upset winner of the GIII Holy Bull S., defeating Domestic Product (**Practical Joke**) and champion Fierceness (**City of Light**), Hades was a well-beaten fifth in the GI **Curlin** Florida Derby and was last seen finishing seventh in the GIII Stonestreet Lexington S. at Keeneland Apr. 13.

"We found he had a little minor problem that we had to correct and give him a little time. I'd like to be in the Preakness but we're doing the right thing," said trainer Joe Orseno, who won the second leg of the Triple Crown back in 2000 with Red Bullet (Unbridled).

If all goes according to plan, Hades would contest the Listed Pegasus S. June 15 and a positive outcome there could lead to a star in the Haskell five weeks later, with the GI Travers S. a longer-term possibility.

"I'm getting him ready for the prep to the Haskell and if he handles that there's a chance he'll show up at Saratoga," Orseno said.

SOGGY CONDITIONS SUIT CALIFORNIA RAIDER BALNIKHOV IN DINNER PARTY

The only member of the field for Saturday's GIII Dinner Party S. with proper soft-ground form, **Balnikhov (Ire)** (Adaay {Ire}) was given a letter-perfect ride by Frankie Dettori and kicked home smartly to score for the third time at the graded stakes level, snapping an eight-race skid in the process.

Allowed to find his own rhythm, Balnikhov anchored himself at the back of the nine-strong field, as longshot **Helms Deep** (Verrazano) showed the way passing the stands for the first time. Favored **Running Bee** (English Channel), the rail-skimming **Highland Chief (Ire)** (**Gleneagles {Ire}**) and **Atone** (Into Mischief) raced more or less as a team about five lengths in arrears. Helms Deep enjoyed an easy time of things on the engine, getting the opening half-mile in :52.77, but Balnikhov was felt for by the Italian three furlongs out as Running Bee took over from Helms Deep at the midpoint of the final turn.

The California raider made eye-catching progress with a rails run inside of **English Bee** (English Channel) and tracked the ground-saving Highland Chief into the final quarter of a mile before edging out three wide for the drive. Accelerating more sharply than Atone to his outside, Balnikhov descended upon Highland Chief and Running Bee three off the inside at the furlong grounds and kept on well as **Crabs N Beer** (Blوفeld) closed nicely for second.

"The horse loved the soft," Dettori said. "He went through it like a hot knife through butter. I only had to find a way out and he did the rest."

Added trainer Phil d'Amato, saddling the rare graded winner outside the Golden State: "I gave him some time off, and he ran a really good race in the San Francisco Mile. I thought this horse is kind of on the upswing. He came back with a really good breeze. We kind of had this race in mind. The connections were going to be there at Pimlico, and we were able to get Frankie Dettori, and everything seemed to work out. Frankie gave him a masterful ride, saving ground, angling out and proving best."

A three-time winner in France for Rodolphe Collet, including a maiden-breaking victory in easy ground at Angers at two, Balnikhov won the 2022 GIII Bryan Station S. the following year and made last year's GIII San Francisco Mile his lone victory from

Sent off the 9-5 choice to collect his first graded win of his career, Frost Free went to the front and was never headed, registering a 1 1/2-length victory in Pimlico's GIII Chick Lang S. Saturday.

Mr Skylight missed the break and dropped to last from his inside draw as Frost Free jumped to the front from post six. In the clear as Sweet Soddy J (**Bee Jersey**) and Cats by Five surveyed the issue following a :23.24 quarter, the grey continued to show the way through a :46.66 half. Comfortably in front with only Cats by Five and Catahoula Moon (Golden Lad) within striking decision, the pacesetter drifted to the center of the track through the lane, but had built enough of a cushion to fend off Cats by Five at the wire. The slow-starting Mr Skylight

came running along the inside late to grab third from Catahoula Moon.

“As he always does, he showed some speed early in the race,” said winning rider Irad Ortiz Jr., winner of the first two graded races on the card. “I never had ridden him before, and I didn’t want to get in his way. I let him do his thing and be happy. I saw in the other race in the slop he didn’t run that well. I was a little concerned about that. I let him be happy, be free and he was there for me whenever I wanted him.”

A first-out winner for Danny Pish, Frost Free closed out the season with a pair of unplaced stakes efforts for Brett Creighton. A distant third in a sloppy Oaklawn allowance in February, he posted a front-running score at that venue Mar. 1. Trying a mile for his next start, the colt tired to third, beaten seven lengths by the well-regarded Nash (*Medaglia d'Oro*), in the Hot Springs S. Mar. 23. Returned to sprinting for his latest, Frost Free was caught late by Valentine Candy (*Justify*) and had to settle for second in the Apr. 27 Bachelor S.

“Were we concerned about the racetrack because your one race on a sloppy track was not that good [at Oaklawn]? That was pretty much the spot we were in at that time,” said Creighton, who was recording his first graded score.

He added, “He’s matured and grown up. He’s improving with every race.”

Of the slow-starting Mr Skylight, trainer Riley Mott said, “That’s wildly disappointing. He was on the rail. There was a little space to his inside. [Jockey] Flavien [Prat] said he broke a step slow and then just went to the open space on the left. Down the backside, Flavien said, ‘I don’t think I’m going to beat a horse.’ So, he ran very well to finish where he did. He got beat three lengths, I think, for the whole thing. Disappointing start, but he ran good. Nothing we can really do.”

Pedigree Notes:

The Chick Lang victory gave **Frosted** his 11th graded stakes winner. A \$27,000 Keeneland September yearling purchase, Frost Free brought \$100,000 from Danny Keene at the Texas 2-year-old sale in 2023. Dam D J’s Favorite is out of Miss Preakness S. winner I’m Mom’s Favorite (Indian Charlie), a granddaughter of dual Grade I-winning Tout Charmant (Slewvescent).

D J’s Favorite is also responsible for an unraced juvenile filly by **City of Light** and a yearling filly by **Essential Quality**. She dropped a colt by **Good Magic** earlier this term.

A one-time graded stakes winner, Fluffy Socks hadn't seen the inside of a winner's circle in a year, but returned in style Saturday, scampering off to an eye-catching 7 3/4-length victory in the GIII Galorette S. on the Preakness undercard.

Off to a smooth start, Tequilera and Blissful (Empire Maker) went to the front as 3-5 choice Fluffy Socks was eased back to a

stalking position, about four lengths off the pace heading into the first turn. Given the soft going, the opening quarter went by in a pedestrian :25.60 and the languid tempo continued through a :50.59 half. Tequilera shook loose leaving the backstretch, but Fluffy Socks soon entered the frame. Collaring the tiring leader in early stretch, Fluffy Socks drew off to score with ease as MSW Five Towns (GB) got up in time to grab second. Tequilera rounded out the trifecta.

It was the second straight stakes win on the afternoon for jockey Irad Ortiz, Jr. following Frost Free (**Frosted**) in the GIII Chick Lang S.

"The ground is a little soft. I don't think the other horses in the race liked it. And she does. She loves the soft and it worked out perfect," said Ortiz. "I was going to the 3/8ths pole, waiting, biding my time and turning for home, I just asked her and she did her thing."

With the victory, Fluffy Socks earned an automatic entry and travel incentive to the G1 Prix Jean Romanet Aug. 18 at France's Deauville-La Touques Racecourse.

It was the third Gallorette in a row and sixth overall for trainer Chad Brown, who won previously with Zagora (2012), Pianist (2013), Watsdachances (2015), Technical Analysis (2022) and Whitebeam (2023). Ortiz also rode Whitebeam.

"I know she was a heavy favorite and she was supposed to do what she did," said Brown. "It was no given, given the soft turf and the slow pace. She has failed before at slow paces. I was really proud of her that she was able to overcome that. Irad really navigated his way off the rail and got her into good ground in the center of this course and she was really able to motor away."

The winning trainer added, "I feel now it's time to step back up into a bigger race. She has been close in some very big races. She has been consistent, I will give her that. For a horse to have wins in our barn from ages two to six, is pretty impressive. Not

all horses can stay healthy and have a sustained career like that."

Despite hitting the board in four of five starts in 2023, Fluffy Socks registered a single win and that was in the GII Distaff Turf Mile at Churchill Downs in May. Off the board in Saratoga's GI Diana S., the homebred was runner-up in last summer's GII Ballston Spa S. before finishing third in the nine-furlong Athenia S. during Belmont at the Big A meet in October. Missing the win by only a head in the GI Matriarch S. at Del Mar Dec. 3, she returned with a good fourth in the 1 1/16-mile GI Pegasus World Cup Filly & Mare Turf at Gulfstream Jan. 27. A close-up third in the GII Hillsborough S. at Tampa Mar. 9, the 6-year-old mare came home a flat sixth last time out in the Apr. 13 GI Jenny Wiley S. at Keeneland.

Ortiz added, "It was a small field. Probably an easier spot [for her]. I think that helps a lot. I think it helps pick up her head, and she knows she belongs. The last few races have been hard for her. The last time [in the Jenny Wiley, I was sad after that because she always showed up. And that day she didn't show up at all. It was nice today to see her back in the winner's circle."

Pedigree Notes:

Fluffy Socks is one of two graded stakes winners for New York-based **Slumber**, the other being Head of Plains's 2022 GIII Transylvania S. victor Sy Dog. The winner's dam Breakfast Time is also responsible for 4-year-old Up and Down (Creative Cause), who is stakes placed. The mare also produced a colt by Exaggerator in 2021 followed by a colt by **Munnings** the following season. She foaled a full-brother to Fluffy Socks last season and was bred back to **Mind Control**.

Super Chow once again proved that a wet track is to his liking as he went gate to wire in the GIII Maryland Sprint S. at Pimlico on Saturday.

Facing muddy going in the GIII Toboggan S. at the Big A in early February, the 4-year-old went quickly from the bell and wired the field to win by 4 1/4 lengths. Over the same surface in the GIII Tom Fool H. a month later, Super Chow powered home a winner, skimming the slop in the same fashion. Faced with a fast track, the dark bay was last seen running third in the GII Carter S. Apr. 6.

Sent off at 4-1 here, the colt assumed his customary place in front up the backstretch and continued to hold that position around the far turn. With Prevalence trying to reach him in the final furlong, the Super Chow kept digging deeper en route to his third graded victory of the season.

"He's a very nice horse," said winning jockey Javier Castellano. "I received the phone call [Friday] to offer the mount, and I said, 'I'm in! I'm open. Looking forward to riding the horse.' It worked out perfect."

He added, "I've been watching him at Aqueduct the last few races, [including] the Tom Fool. I like the way he comes out of

the race, very quick out of the gate. It worked out great today. I didn't have any commitment."

Pedigree Notes:

Lord Nelson, who sired only four crops of racing age before he passed away, is also responsible for GII Prioress S. victress Alva Starr. Dismissed at odds of 19-1 in this first attempt for Mike Maker, he chased in second in the early stages before taking over on the first turn. He led through easy splits of :50.25 and 1:15.81 and dug down gamely in the stretch to pull off the upset.

Sugoi also won his prior two starts this term over the Turfway Polytrack Feb. 2 and Feb. 17.

"I've wanted to claim (Sugoi) this winter at Turfway but I was out-shook on him," Maker said. "I knew he was a talented horse and I was looking forward to having him do what he did tonight --rate on the front end of a turf marathon. This race opens the door to several options including the July 20 (GII) United Nations (at Monmouth) and he's still eligible for the Claiming Crown."

Sugoi becomes the eighth graded winner for **Karakontie (Jpn)**. The unraced Timeless Spirit's last listed produce is the winning 6-year-old gelding **Tapit's Spirit** (Tapizar).

BOLT D'VINE STRIKES FAST, CRUISES TO 'TDN RISING STAR'-DOM

Bolt D'Vine (Bolt d'Oro--Perfectly Divine, by Vindication) was one of two runners in the field with no prior experience, but you'd never know it judging by her performance here. Cruising home as easily as she pleased, the filly carrying Michael House's colors sailed over the wire and earned the 'Rising Star' nod in the process.

Off at 3-1 and vying from off the rail up the backstretch through :22.36 and :45.53 fractions, it looked briefly like her early rival might make a race of it, but when Bolt d'Vine took over passing the quarter marker, the question became how much would she win by...and the answer was 7 1/2 lengths. After clearing the last of her competition to her inside, she kicked away in dominating fashion to leave 40-1 longshot **Fire Ban** (Preservationist) in her wake.

Bolt d'Vine is the fourth 'TDN Rising Star' for Bolt d'Oro.

Pedigree Notes

Bolt d'Vine is the last registered offspring for her dam, who has failed to produce any foals since the newest 'Rising Star' but has produced three-time winning 4-year-old Divine Cross (Cross Traffic). She returned to Cross Traffic for 2024.

Perfectly Divine does hail from a busy family, however, as she is the half-sister to multiple Grade I-winner Tizway (Tiznow) and SW/MGSP Ticket to Seattle (Capote). That sister produced SW Misty Mauve (Paynter).

The pedigree gains Grade I-momentum underneath the third dam Willamae (Tentam), who was graded-placed herself but who made her most notable mark as a broodmare.

From her eight winners, two claimed victories at the highest level as two-time Grade I-winner Will's Way (Easy Goer) and GI Ashland S. victress Willa On the Move (Assert {Ire}) are direct descendants. This female family also includes MG1SP-NZ November Rain (NZ) (Stravinsky) as well as SW No Rain Ever (Aus) (**No Nay Never**).

Since breaking her maiden at first asking last September, Witwatersrand has kept exclusively stakes company, topped the Fasig-Tipton October Digital Sale last year at \$230,000 and took the win in the GIII Mazarine S. over 1 1/16 miles to end her juvenile campaign Nov. 4 and **be named Canada's champion 2-year-old filly**. Unplaced in either start so far this year in Florida, the 6-5 favorite returned to Canada and trailed the field behind C C Royal (Flatter) through the opening half in :46.57. Debuted at Gulfstream in January, Corporate Power has continued to be on the improve for Shug McGaughey, breaking his maiden in his second start Feb. 24. Shipped to New York, he came up 1 1/4-length short of Unique Insight (**Gun Runner**) as the favorite facing allowance horses over a sloppy/sealed track Apr. 12 but still posted a career-best 90 Beyer Speed Figure. Stepped up in class and racing with the addition of blinkers Saturday in his stakes debut, Corporate Power flashed early speed but was outrun and had to race wide as Daily Grind (**Medaglia d'Oro**) led through fractions of :24.39 and :48.35. Briefly put on the back foot around the turn, the 8-5 favorite had to work to re-engage the leaders into the stretch and put in a big effort outside of Imperial Gun to just get up in the shadow of the wire to take the photo finish. A steward's inquiry and rider's objection were both filed into the stretch run alleging interference against Imperial Gun but no change was made.

Grooms All Bizness looked to be ambitiously spotted for his seasonal comebacker in Saturday's Jim McKay Turf Sprint at Pimlico, but he was live on the board and found his best stride late for a second black-type success.

Alertly away from gate one beneath Jorge Ruiz, the Richard Santulli homebred drifted back and settled behind midfield for the run around the turn. Going nicely in hand entering the final three panels, Grooms All Bizness looked ready to take a gap between Beer Can Man (Can the Man) to his inside and Witty to his outside in upper stretch, but the door soon slammed shut. Forced to steady slightly, he was shifted off the heels of Witty inside the final furlong and finished with a flourish--albeit on his incorrect lead--to score comfortably in the finish.

"I would like to thank Jorge Duarte for giving me the opportunity to ride in this stakes," said Ruiz. "I was very excited to ride this horse. There was a lot of speed in this race. I was just hoping that the leaders would slow down. At one point, I had no room to go, so I waited and waited. When I had room, we took off and finished well."

Grooms All Bizness visited the races just four times last year, finishing runner-up in Belmont allowance company last spring before defeating softer company at Monmouth a little more than three weeks later. The dark bay defeated three next-out winners in the June 18 Get Serious S. at the Jersey Shore and had been missing since a close third in Monmouth's Select S. Aug. 13.

Grooms All Bizness is one of 14 stakes winners for his sire, bred by Colts Neck and sold for \$950,000 at the 2010 Keeneland September Sale. Through his agent Reynolds Bell, Jr., Santulli paid \$1.3 million for the gelding's second dam Cat Chat (Storm Cat) at Keeneland July in 1999 and campaigned her to a victory over champion Xtra Heat (Dixieland Heat) in the 2001 GII Nassau County S. Cat Chat, a daughter of 1993 champion 2-year-old filly Phone Chatter (Phone Trick), produced GISW and 2012 GII Black-Eyed Susan S. heroine In Lingerie (Empire Maker) as well as Red Fantasia (Unbridled's Song), the dam of Japanese GSW/G1SP Red Belle Aube (Jpn) (Deep Impact {Jpn}) and GSW Red Bel Jour (Jpn) (Deep Impact {Jpn}). Cat Chat passed away in 2018.

Apple Picker won her first graded race in the Gill Barbara Fritchie S. at Laurel Park Feb. 17, but finished in fourth place in the Gill Distaff S. at the Big A in early April.

Installed as the 3-1 second choice here, the dark bay languished towards the rear of the field up the backstretch and still had plenty to do round the far turn as Swall began to vie for the lead. Weaving through traffic down the lane, the 4-year-old filly moved to the four path at the eighth pole, turned up the pressure on Swall and swept by the leader like a pro.

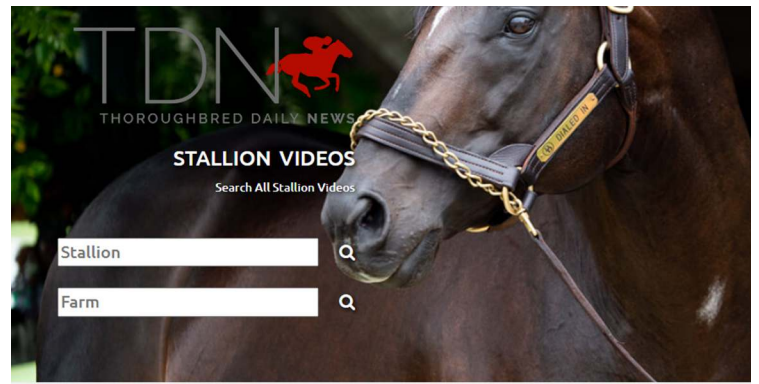

As expected, Cheveley Park Stud's colours were in the winner's enclosure following Newbury's G1 Al Shaqab Lockinge S. on Saturday but it was aboard the Gosdens' 22-1 shot **Audience (GB)** (Iffraaj {GB}--Ladyship {GB}, by **Oasis Dream (GB)**) who uber-excelled in his task of pacemaking for **Inspiral (GB)** (Frankel {GB}) trying this mile for the first time. Labelled a **TDN Rising Star** at two, the homebred grandson of the Thompsons' 2006 Lockinge heroine Peeress (GB) (Pivotal {GB}) had shown what he could do when left alone on the lead with ample space to express himself in last year's G3 Criterion S. at Newmarket, but on the whole on the formbook was a shade below the best here.

Relishing being untethered by Robert Havlin, the 5-year-old had cracked every rival bar **Charyn (Ire)** (Dark Angel {Ire}) heading into unknown territory at the furlong pole and not long after he had drawn any sting remaining from that rival en route to an emphatic 1 3/4-length success. **Witch Hunter (Fr)** (Siyouni {Fr}) was 6 1/2 lengths away in third, with the 2-1 favourite Inspiral a well-beaten fourth and the returning G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. hero **Big Rock (Fr)** (Rock Of Gibraltar {Ire}) only sixth, having stumbled leaving the stalls before trying to lay up too close to the killer pace. LISTED WINNER FAST TRACKER BOUGHT BY WATHNAN RACING

Guy Heald homebred **Fast Tracker (GB)** (Churchill {Ire}), who is two-for-two after taking the Listed Prix de Suresnes at Chantilly at the beginning of the month, has been sold to Wathnan Racing, *Jour de Galop* reported.

Formerly trained by Henri-Alex Pantall, the chestnut holds entries in the G3 Prix Hocquart, the G1 Qatar Prix du Jockey Club, and the G1 Qatar Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe. The deal was facilitated by Richard Brown of Blandford Bloodstock.

"He was very impressive during his last race and is on an upward trajectory," Brown told the French publication. "Guy Heald is a commercial breeder and has been a true gentleman during this process. Finding this type of Classic prospect is difficult."

Out of the unraced Emma Knows (Ire) (Anabaa), the colt is a half-brother to the Prix de Suresnes second My Scholar (Fr) (Pour Moi {Ire}), while his dam is a half-sister to two black-type horses led by the dual Group 3-placed King Of Camelot (Fr) (Camelot {GB}). G1 Australian Cup winner Fifty Stars (Ire) (Sea The Stars {Ire}) is under the third dam.

“He’s got solid group form and he’s learnt to relax more with age, if you leave a horse like that alone he’s going to be very dangerous,” John Gosden said. “He’s been working very well and I didn’t think Rab [Havlin] would be left in splendid isolation out in front, but I knew he would get a hell of a run out of him. We always knew he was going to be part of it and I thought he could maybe finish in the first four or five. As it was, they ignored him and all got racing on the other side. Mrs Thompson kept him in training very kindly rather than him going to Hong Kong so he could be a lead horse for Inspiral and I think he has covered himself in glory.”

In hindsight, anything Audience did at two and three was only every going to be a precursor to what he would be capable of later in his career given that his second dam was a handicapper at three and thrived at four and five. Impressive on that sole 2-year-old start at Newmarket in October 2021, he had failed to go on from that the following season and so was gelded after losing in a five-furlong conditions race. Coming back strong to beat the seven-furlong specialists Jumbly (Ire) (New Bay {GB}) and Pogo (Ire) (Zebedee {GB}) in the Criterion last July, he failed to win again despite running some big races against the best over that trip.

Twice put in the Tattersalls Autumn Horses-in-Training Sale

only to be withdrawn, Audience came to the same venue at which his 3-year-old half-brother Esquire (GB) (Harry Angel {Ire}) had won the Greenham last month to add his name to a list of those who were not supposed to win this including Cape Cross (Ire) and Fly To The Stars (GB), both acting as pacemakers in the 1990s. This was also an eighth success for Cheveley Park Stud, either under the Stud’s name or the names of Patricia Thompson and her late husband David.

Gosden Sr added of Inspiral, “She will come on a bundle for that, the trainer is so hopeless he couldn’t get her fit at home. I didn’t want to take her away for gallops at racecourses, that’s not her game. She was always going to need it, but there will be another day with her and we’re on the road with her. She’s come to make her run and has just got tired--she’s ‘blown up’, as they call it. In her work at home, she’s a lot older and wiser and I’m not going to tell her what she’s got to do, so she’s been quietly doing what she’s happier doing and she needed this race to bring her on for Ascot and I’m delighted with her run. She’s carrying rather a lot of condition.”

While Inspiral is likely to head back to the G1 Queen Anne S. in which she was runner-up last year, Gosden revealed that there are thoughts of returning her to the distance of her Breeders’ Cup Filly & Mare Turf victory in Royal Ascot’s G1 Prince of Wales’s S. [Cont. p4](#)

The win of Audience may perhaps make that decision easier. “The Queen Anne would probably be the aim, as it would be for Audience as well, but talking to Mrs Thompson we would also look at the mile-and-a-quarter race,” he added. “When she won at the Breeders’ Cup, which I know was over an easy mile and a quarter at Santa Anita, Frankie could not pull her up. He came back and said I think we’ve been running her over the wrong trip all the time. So we will leave our options open and see how she is over the next week.”

Cheveley Park Stud’s managing director Chris Richardson said, “It’s a family we’ve nurtured for 32 years, it’s extraordinary how we can go back to the fourth or fifth generation. There’s plenty of speed in the family and it’s a family that has just come alight again. Now we’ll seriously have to consider the Queen Anne for him and whether we step up in trip for Inspiral is a decision we’ll make.”

Havlin added, “He’s a little bit of a thug, he ran some great races last year and really stayed on at the end. I didn’t think he’d be good enough to beat Inspiral, but he’s always threatened to have a good one in him as he’s super-talented. You’re a little bit of a passenger on him, you just let him get on with it--we’ve learnt from experience that you don’t try to organise him. Last year, he would never have got a mile as he was just too much like a bull in a China shop, but he obviously has improved over a mile and there’ll be some nice races to win with him.”

Big Rock’s trainer Maurizio Guarnieri blamed the dried surface for the tame effort of his stable star. “We know that the ground is a real problem and if he had the ground okay for him, after 210 days off then he would have been okay but this is a Goup 1 against horses with one or two races and it is not so easy--with today’s conditions, it felt like the world was against us,” he said. “The horse didn’t show what he can do in heavy and soft

ground--he didn’t change his speed and normally the others are three and four lengths behind, but today he just stayed at the same pace. In my opinion, he could go to [Royal] Ascot if we get some soft ground, which can sometimes happen there.”

Pedigree Notes

Audience, who brings the tally of Group 1 winners for his sire to a dozen, is out of the Listed City Plate winner Ladyship (GB) (**Oasis Dream {GB}**) who also produced the G3 Dick Poole S. winner Dark Lady (GB) (Dark Angel {Ire}) as well as the aforementioned Greenham scorer Esquire by Dark Angel’s son Harry Angel. Ladyship was the best of two black-type performers out of Peeress, who also captured the G1 Sun Chariot S. and G2 Windsor Forest S. and was placed in the G1 Matron S., G1 Prix Jacques le Marois and G1 Falmouth S. Ladyship’s unraced 2-year-old filly by Mehmas (Ire) is named Kinswoman (GB).

ASTON PARK SUCCESS FOR MIDDLE EARTH

Highly progressive last term, Qatar Bloodstock and Ciaran Maher's **Middle Earth (GB)** (Roaring Lion) started the ball rolling for the Gosdens on their red-letter day at Newbury on Saturday when marking his 4-year-old bow with a win in the G3 Sky Sports Racing Aston Park S. Last seen winning the Listed Noel Murless S. at Ascot three weeks after finishing seventh in the G1 St Leger, the 100-30 second favourite arrived from rear after a tardy start with Oisín Murphy timing it perfectly to wear down **King Of Conquest (GB)** (Lope De Vega {Ire}) in the final strides for a nose verdict.

"That was good, the jockey saved every inch and he needed every inch," John Gosden said. "The horse will come on for that, because it wasn't strongly-run for a horse coming from last. He's like his father, he likes good ground, good-to-firm and firm. He's not a lover of soft ground. He's entered in the [G2] Hardwicke and we will have to check. Ciaran Maher owns the other half in Australia so we will chat with them and see what the game plan will be, but that seems the place he is likely to go."

"The plan is to go down to Australia for the Melbourne Cup. We'll probably run him a couple or more times here, we'll not over-race him and then go down there," Gosden Sr added. He hated the ground in the St Leger last year, it was too loose and he does not like it. So if they get one of those downpours in Melbourne, we may as well all stay in the hotel."

British Champions Sprint S. hero Deacon Blues (GB). She is also a half to another who captured that prize for the stable, this time after it had been promoted to Group 1 status, in the former Pegasus Stables' stalwart The Tin Man (GB) (Equiano {Fr}). He also annexed the G1 Diamond Jubilee S. and G1 Haydock Sprint Cup and like all the family progressed markedly with age and experience. The third dam Barford Lady (GB) (Stanford {Ire}) produced the sire Warningford (GB) (Warning {GB}), who also excelled for this yard in winning three renewals of the Leicestershire S. when it held Group 3 status and who was also third in the G1 Prix de la Foret.

SIR ANTHONY O'REILLY DIES AT 88 AFTER SHORT ILLNESS

Irish businessman Sir Anthony 'Tony' O'Reilly has died after a short illness according to published reports. The husband of **the late Lady Chryst O'Reilly** who died last year, he was 88.

"In the coming days there will be many worthy tributes made to Tony O'Reilly's unique and extraordinary achievements in the fields of business and sport," O'Reilly's family said in a statement. "As well as his extraordinary philanthropic vision which was best evidenced by the establishment of the Ireland Funds at a dark time in this island's history.

"But, for us, he was a dearly-loved dad and a grandad. He lived one of the great lives and we were fortunate to spend time with him in recent weeks as that great life drew to a close."

Born in Dublin, Ireland, in 1936, O'Reilly became an international rugby star. He created the Kerrygold dairy company in 1962, while part of the Irish Dairy Board (Bord Baine). Subsequently in charge of Irish Sugar, O'Reilly joined international food company Heinz in the 1969, later being named chairman of that company in 1987, which he remained until 1998. The proprietor of Castlemartin Stud from 1972 to 2014, he also took control of Independent Newspapers in 1973, which lasted until 2009.

Associated with Waterford Wedgwood group by 1990, among other varied business interests, O'Reilly also set up The Ireland Funds, which distributed money from U.S. donors into Irish border reconciliation projects. He was a noted philanthropist. O'Reilly was knighted by Queen Elizabeth II in 2001 "for long and distinguished service to Northern Ireland".

The businessman was declared bankrupt in 2015 when a €22.6-million debt judgement was leveled against him by the Allied Irish Banks, but he had emerged from bankruptcy by January of 2024. He is survived by his six children with his first wife, Susan Cameron, and their families.

Taoiseach Simon Harris called O'Reilly "a giant of sport, business, and media," in a statement. "He was a trailblazer who aimed big on the international business scene. Through his work in the UK, US and Ireland he forged a path that many other international business figures from Ireland would follow...My thoughts are especially with his children and grandchildren at this sad time."

"A legend of the game has passed," Irish Rugby posted on X. "Our deepest sympathies to his family and friends. First capped at 18 he won 29 Irish Rugby caps and was a hero of the British &

Irish Lions. Sir Anthony O'Reilly RIP."

ANCIENT TRUTH (IRE) (Dubawi {Ire}) is a full-brother to Great Truth (Ire), last year's TDN Rising Star who was the first foal out of the G2 Prix du Calvados winner Beyond Reason (Ire) (**Australia {GB}**). Trained like them both by Charlie Appleby, the Godolphin homebred encounters another notable newcomer in Qatar Bloodstock, China Horse Club and David Howden's **Patrol (Ire) (Dark Angel {Ire})**, a William Haggas-trained half-brother to the GI Beverly D. S. and GI E. P. Taylor S. winner Fev Rover (Ire) (Gutaifan {Ire}).

Impressive at this stage of last season when winning Sandown's Listed National S., Elite Status went on to be third in Royal Ascot's G2 Norfolk S. and win Deauville's G3 Prix de Cabourg before finishing well-beaten in the G1 Prix Morny and G1 Middle Park S. Returning with his best foot forward here, he showed speed from the outset to race in the front line and took off two out to book his Royal Ascot ticket.

"I've always thought he was a high-class horse and I think if we can keep him on the right track, the world is his oyster," trainer Karl Burke said. "He is a very good horse with a massive engine, we just lost our way with him. He's one of these horses that just catches the point of his sesamoid at the back of the joint. They are horrible and when they start catching them they catch them every time and they go sore really quickly. It's like having a stone in your shoe or a bad nail in your foot and you keep catching it."

"A few performances last year were disappointing, but it was probably Deauville in the bad ground last summer where it started and we never really got him back properly at the backend of the year," he added. "He was electric in the National Stakes and after that performance it was hard to step up to six furlongs, so we went for the Norfolk." **Cont. p9**

He said, "Sheikh Obaid was always very keen to step him up and probably rightly so, but when we did eventually step him up he was never quite right for us."

"He's proved there today he stays six very well. He's a horse with a big future, I think, and the [G1] Commonwealth Cup will definitely be his next run barring accidents. It wasn't a question of us wanting to make the running today, but what we didn't want to do was pull him around and take a chance of him banging himself. Clifford pulled it off to perfection and he doesn't have to make the running--if he jumps and sits second or third, that's fine. He showed in the National Stakes the turn of foot he has got."

Elite Status is the first foal out of a granddaughter of Dust Flicker (GB) (Suave Dancer), whose daughter Sweepstake (Ire) (Acclamation {GB}) also captured Sandown's National S. before producing Australia's multiple group-winning full-brothers Broome (Ire) and Point Lonsdale (Ire) and last year's G2 Champions Juvenile S. winner Diego Velazquez (Ire) (**Frankel** {GB}).

Dust Flicker is in turn is a full-sister to the G3 Prix de la Nonette winner and stakes producer Dust Dancer (GB), the talented Bulaxie (GB) (Bustino {GB}) who took the G3 Fred Darling S. at this track and to the dam of Dansili's G1 Phoenix S. hero and sire Zoffany (Ire). Dotted Swiss's 2-year-old full-brother to Elite Status named Soldier's Heart (GB) was the Tattersalls October Book 2's joint top-priced colt when purchased for 425,000gns by Stroud Coleman Bloodstock, while she also has a yearling filly by Showcasing (GB) who sold to Sumbe for 135,000gns at the Tattersalls December Foal Sale.

Reflecting on the performance of runner-up Ejaabiyah, Roger Varian commented, "She ran a lovely race. She's a lovely filly who's still a bit green and she took her time to come to hand this spring. The winner looked nice and I think it was a strong little field of fillies. Our filly has shown up well, we're really pleased with her and she will improve from today."

IRON MARE STUNS IN DOOMBEN 10,000

In a thrilling finish to the G1 Doomben 10,000, Ciaran Maher's iron mare **Bella Nipotina (Aus)** (Pride Of Dubai {Aus}) secured her second Group 1 and eighth career success.

Ridden by Craig Williams, Bella Nipotina came from a near impossible position to chase and catch the high-class **I Wish I Win (NZ)** (Savabeel {Aus}), while **Espiona (Aus)** (Extreme Choice {Aus}) denied **Private Eye (Aus)** (Al Maher {Aus}) third place.

Maher was overcome with emotion when chatting to *7HorseRacing* about the bonny mare, "She's unbelievable. You

just can't not love her. Her tenacity, her durability to race in every state in Australia in one preparation. It's phenomenal.

"After she bombed the start, I thought 'Oh well, she's done well, she'll run well but she can't win from there'", but when Bella Nipotina gets these conditions, her confidence really does soar and I thought I Wish I Win was unbeatable, but she was able to pick him up.

"I think she's been talking to Pride Of Jenni, also by Pride Dubai, because they are both just as phenomenal as each other and great horses to train. She's probably in the twilight of her career but to race with as much tenacity as she ever has just shows how good she is.

"I think we'll probably return for the G1 Tattersalls Tiara."

Pedigree Notes

Bella Nipotina is the first foal from the Star Witness (Aus) mare Bella Orfana (Aus), who is closely related to the G2 Gilgai S. victress Hallowell Belle (Aus) (Starcraft {NZ}). Hallowell Belle, like Bella Nipotina, also recorded multiple Group 1-placings during her outstanding career, with seconds in the G1 Flight S., the G1 Blue Diamond S. and third-placed efforts in the G1 TJ Smith S., the G1 Patinack Classic and the G1 The Thousand Guineas.

Incredibly, Bella Niptonia didn't break her maiden until her eighth start when she won the G3 Quezette S. since then the daughter of Pride Of Dubai has recorded victories in the G1 Manikato S., the G2 Sapphire S., the G3 How Now S., the Listed Carlyon S. and the Giga Kick S. and prizemoney of over A\$9.8 million.

Bella Niptonia was a A\$80,000 purchase by Lindsay Park Racing, Andrew Williams Bloodstock (FBAA) and Mt Hallowell Stud from the draft of Rosemont Stud at the 2019 Inglis Premier Yearling Sale. Her sire, Pride Of Dubai is standing at Coolmore this season for \$22,000 (inc GST).
