



LOADED SANTA ANITA PROGRAM HEADLINES MEMORIAL DAY ACTION

A trio of graded stakes, led by the GI Gamely S. and GI Shoemaker Mile S., will anchor a stacked Memorial Day holiday program at Santa Anita Monday.

Making her first start since capturing the GI American Oaks Dec. 26, **Anisette (GB)** (Awtaad {Ire}) headlines a deep nine-horse field set for the Gamely. The Eclipse Thoroughbred Partners colorbearer also captured last term's GI Del Mar Oaks.

"We gave her a small vacation that was much deserved," trainer Leonard Powell said of the Gamely's 5-2 morning-line favorite. "She's come back as good, if not better, than before."

Powell continued, "She's fired fresh before, but this is a Grade I. It's different circumstances. There are some really seasoned performers. But while she's up against it from that standpoint, she's up to the challenge."

Hall of Famer Richard Mandella will be represented by last-out local graded winners **Ruby Nell** (Bolt d'Oro) (GII Buena Vista S.) and the streaking **Linda's Gift** (Arrogate) (GIII Santa Ana S.).

The rail-drawn **Olivia Maralda (Ire)** (Kodiac {GB}), a 725,000gns TATDEC purchase by Woodford Thoroughbreds last winter, heads west for trainer Will Walden following a rallying second-place finish while making her U.S. debut in a Keeneland allowance Apr. 20.

ADARE MANOR DOMINATES IN SANTA MARGARITA REPEAT

Facing just three rivals, **Adare Manor** (Uncle Mo) controlled the tempo from the get-go before romping home the easiest of winners in the GII Santa Margarita S. at Santa Anita Sunday. The 1-9 favorite went quickly to the lead and loped along unchallenged through fractions of :23.65 and :48.77. She opened up under her own steam into the lane and was under wraps as she glided under the wire 4 1/4 lengths in front, completing the nine furlongs in 1:50.86.

"She broke really sharp out of the gate," said winning jockey Juan Hernandez. "I didn't ask her, I just let her go. She loves to run behind the pace, but today I was the pace, so she wanted to go. She was a little aggressive out of the gate, she relaxed took a breath, and just kept on going. Today, she just was trying to go a little earlier. She was trying to take off around the five-eighths pole, so I had to hold her for a little while. At the quarter pole, she switched leads and just kept going." *Cont. p4*

Du Jour (Temple City) and **Easter (Fr)** (Exosphere {Aus}), the first two finishers across the line in the GI Frank E. Kilroe Mile S. Mar. 3, will meet again in the Shoemaker Mile. The field of 11 also includes returning 2023 GII Del Mar Derby winner **Conclude** (Collected) and Apr. 4 GIII American S. winner **Johannes** (Nyquist).

The GII Hollywood Gold Cup will showcase a field of eight, including: GIII Californian S. Apr. 20 one-two-three **Mr Fisk** (Arrogate), **Judge Miller** (Curlin) and **Mixto** (Good Magic); and narrow GI Santa Anita H. Mar. 3 runner-up **Subsanador** (Arg) (Fortify).



Santa Anita's blockbuster holiday card also features the return of human stars to Arcadia. International riding legend Frankie Dettori, who tied a Santa Anta record when winning six consecutive races Apr. 6, rides nine of Monday's 11 races. His stakes mounts are **Uncorked** (Uncle Mo) in the Gamely for Phil D'Amato, Judge Miller in the Gold Cup for Mark Glatt and **Funtastic Again** (Funtastic) in the Shoemaker Mile for Wesley Ward.

Flavien Prat, who ranks second in North America this year with more than \$10.29 million in earnings, has seven mounts Monday. In the three stakes, he'll be aboard Olivia Maralda in the Gamely; Subsanador in the Gold Cup for Mandella and Du Jour in the Shoemaker for trainer Bob Baffert.

Reigning three-time Sovereign Award winner Kazushi Kimura, who like Prat and Dettori rode this winter at Santa Anita, returns with six mounts Monday. His stakes engagements include longshot **Yerwanthere (Ire)** (Markaz {Ire}) in the Gamely for trainer Patrick Gallagher, Mr Fisk in the Gold Cup for Baffert and **Dominican Pioneer** (Pioneerof the Nile) in the Shoemaker for Ward.



On the East Coast, trainer Chad Brown will send out an imposing trio, led by unbeaten 'TDN Rising Star' and Apr. 28 Memories of Silver S. heroine Sweet Rebecca (American Pharoah) as he looks to secure a record-extending sixth victory in the GII Wonder Again S. at Belmont at the Big A.

Monday's graded stakes action is rounded out by the GIII Steve Sexton Mile S. at Lone Star Park and the GIII Winning Colors S. at Churchill Downs.

Adare Manor Dominates Santa Margarita (cont. from p1)

Adare Manor captured last year's Santa Margarita as part of a four-race win streak that also included victories in the GII Santa Maria S., GI Clement L. Hirsch S. and GII Zenyatta S. She concluded 2023 with a seventh-place effort in the GI Breeders' Cup Distaff.

In her first outing of 2024, she was second in the Mar. 9 GI Beholder Mile and she was returning to the West Coast after romping to a front-running 5 1/2-length victory in the Apr. 13 GI Apple Blossom H.

With her win Sunday, Adare Manor has won seven of her 12 starts at Santa Anita and has hit the board in all but one of those outings. She became the first filly to complete the Santa

Margarita/Apple Blossom double in one year since champion Zenyatta and the last repeat winner of the Santa Margarita since Hall of Famer Bayakoa in 1989 and 1990.

"Well, we wanted the 'W' and that was the main thing," said winning trainer Bob Baffert. "She was training great for this, she had a big effort last time, but she handled it well and I thought this was a good spot. There won't be another spot until we get to Del Mar for a while. We just really enjoy her and that's why Michael Lund Petersen is in the business, to watch his horses run. He says he needs more, so we're going to buy him some. He needs more action."

Baffert continued, "Michael has learned the ups and downs of racing, it's tough, but it's horses like this that make it all worthwhile and makes it fun. That's why we're in this game. We love our horses, we love competing, we love watching them compete and when you get a good one like this, you better enjoy them because they are hard to find."

Pedigree Notes:

Brooklynsway RNA'd for \$1.2 million at last year's Fasig-Tipton November sale. The mare's filly Nosleeptilbrooklyn (Ghostzapper) sold for \$500,000 at last year's Keeneland September sale. She produced a colt by Uncle Mo last year, but aborted a Tapit foal this year.

Mucho Del Oro, claimed by these connections last summer, scored his second graded victory down the hill with a wire-to-wire victory in the GIII Daytona S. at Santa Anita Sunday. Let go at 11-1, the dark bay gelding skated up the rail to take the early lead as favored First Peace was shuffled back in traffic. Mucho Del Oro was two lengths in front as the field crossed over the dirt track. He scampered further clear down the lane and was all out to hold off the late-closing First Peace.

Claimed for \$50,000 from Peerenboom Racing and trainer Vladimir Cerin out of a winning effort at Santa Anita last June, Mucho Del Oro resurfaced to miss by just a nose when second in the Jan. 28 Clocker's Corner S. He came back to earn his first graded tally in the Mar. 9 GIII San Simeon S. and entered the Daytona off a fourth-place effort in the Apr. 21 Siren Lure S.

Pedigree Notes:

Repeta is also the dam of Funtastic Again (Funtastic), who goes postward in Monday's GI Shoemaker Mile S. The mare has a 2-year-old filly by Volatile who RNA'd for \$250,000 at last year's Keeneland September sale, and a yearling filly by Not This Time. She was barren this spring.

"It depends on the trip, but I think he can get it [the distance]—he's bred to get it and should be able to," David Staudacher, who co-owns the colt with Paradise Farms Corp., said regarding the 10-furlong Belmont distance. "I think he likes the track up there, so we'll see what [trainer] Mike [Maker] decides to do. We just have to see how the horse is doing. He's a really nice horse and we don't want to rush him. We'd love to be in the Belmont, so we have our fingers crossed."

The Wine Steward worked four furlongs in :48.00 (23/180) at Churchill Downs Saturday.

"I was there and he worked pretty easy and looked good," said Staudacher. "Mike is going to have to decide on which race in the next week or so. We're still undecided. He had a couple tough races, so we've got to make sure he bounces back right."

The Wine Steward opened his career with three straight wins last summer, including victories in the Bashford Manor S. at Ellis Park and the Funny Cide S. at Saratoga. He concluded his juvenile campaign with a runner-up effort in the GI Claiborne Breeders' Futurity and opened 2024 with a runner-up effort in the Apr. 12 GIII Stonestreet Lexington S. He was 3/4 lengths behind Antiquarian (Preservationist) when runner-up in the Peter Pan.

TORNADO STRIKES WILL ROGERS DOWNS

Will Rogers Downs was hit by a tornado that tore through Claremore, Oklahoma Saturday night. The tornado, which caused heavy damage to homes and businesses in the area, was an EF-2, according to initial surveys by the National Weather Service. The Enhanced Fujita Wind Scale rates tornados from zero to five, with five being the strongest.

"The property was in the path of the tornado," Travis Noland, a spokesman for Will Rogers Downs, told *Daily Racing Form*Sunday. "At the property itself, there is some pretty significant damage, but we're really grateful from a life, safety respect, there were no reports of any serious injuries."

Will Rogers concluded its Thoroughbred meet May 15. Horses remaining on the grounds Saturday were transported to other facilities throughout the morning Sunday.

A post on the track's Facebook page Sunday morning said, "Will Rogers Downs remains closed as we continue assessing the damage from last night's storm."

Already a stakes winner as a 3-year-old, Girl Named Charlie doubled up in her first try over the Monmouth turf to take the Miss Liberty S. Sunday. Entered off a strong win at Keeneland facing allowance horses April 21, the 7-2 third choice was intent on the front and hustled from a middle gate to lead under Fernando Jara. Left mostly to her own devices through a half in :49.13, Girl Named Charlie was joined by the eventual third-place runner Tax Implications into the far turn while runner up Alpha Bella also began to make a move. Set down off the turn, the daughter of Maclean's Music shook clear and got a bit of breathing room into the final sixteenth to come home a winner.

"I wasn't that surprised we were on the lead like that," said winning trainer Lindsay Schultz. "[Alpha Bella] has speed but that's at a mile and a half and longer races. We talked about the possibility of being on the lead. Fernando Jara rode her forwardly out of the gate and got her to settle really well. Obviously, it worked out. She's a nice filly and plenty capable. She's pretty versatile. If you let her get into a good rhythm, she'll fire."

FALLEN ANGEL COMPLETES SUNDAY GUINEAS DOUBLE FOR TOO DARN HOT

In the space of less than an hour on Sunday, it was Too Darn Hot's world and we were all just living in it. Following the example of stablemate Darnation (Ire), who had dominated the G2 German 1000 Guineas at Dusseldorf minutes earlier to showcase the merits of Darley's second-crop sire, Clipper Logistics' Fallen Angel (GB) also put her G1 1000 Guineas flop firmly behind her to earn top trumps with a clear-cut success in the G1 Tattersalls Irish 1,000 Guineas at The Curragh. Only eighth at Newmarket, the Karl Burke-trained daughter of Agnes Stewart (Ire) (Lawman {Fr}) who had won the G1 Moyglare Stud S. here at two was ideally placed in a prominent position by Danny Tudhope with the pace modest.

Taking control passing two out, the 11-4 favourite bounded clear for a 2 3/4-length success from **A Lilac Rolla (Ire)** (Harry Angel {Ire}), with Ballydoyle's G1 Prix Marcel Boussac **Opera Singer** (Justify) two lengths further behind as a respectable third on her belated return.

"I was confident we would see a different filly from Newmarket," Tudhope said. "I was pleased when the rain came, to be fair."

AMBIENTE FRIENDLY TAKES TO THE LIMEKILNS IN DERBY COUNTDOWN

NEWMARKET, UK -- It's Alex Cairns's day off but he's at the car park next to the Limekilns at 7.30 on Sunday morning.



"She just keeps galloping and stays very, very well. She is very versatile ground-wise and takes everything that comes in her stride."

Burke added, "She showed last year that she's top-class. Obviously we were disappointed with the Guineas, but I find it hard with three-year-olds-you just don't know where you are with them. We sent her down to Newmarket fit and she didn't blow that much afterwards. The ground maybe was a bit quick on the undulations, but that's looking for excuses--we were beaten fair and square on the day. I knew coming out of the Guineas coming into this race that mentally she was in the right place. She just sparked up, especially in the last week or 10 days, and physically she looked fantastic."

Fallen Angel, who also captured the G3 Sweet Solera S. at two, is not necessarily G1 Coronation S.-bound, with Chantilly a viable option. "We've got the option of the French Oaks as well [as the Coronation] and as you can see she stays very well. We'll enjoy today and worry about that later."

Aidan O'Brien was happy with Opera Singer. "I was delighted with her, I couldn't believe she ran so well. She was never away, only in full work less than a month. It was an incredible run really. I was very nervous running her, hoping that she wouldn't get too tired, but she has run some race."

"We were hoping to run with a view to coming back for the Coronation Stakes so that's where she'll go now, but there could be massive improvement in her."

Pedigree Notes

Fallen Angel is currently the last known foal out of the aforementioned G2 May Hill S. winner and G1 Fillies' Mile runner-up Agnes Stewart, whose previous best was the G3 Stanerra S. runner-up Divine Jewel (GB) (Frankel {GB}). Agnes Stewart is a half to the Listed River Eden Fillies' S. winner Sorrel (Ire) (Dansili {GB}), who was also placed in the GIII La Prevoyante S. and GIII Orchid S., while this is also the family of the G1 National S. hero and G1 Irish Derby runner-up Definite Article (GB) (Indian Ridge {Ire}) and the G2 Dante S. scorer Salford Express (Ire) (Be My Guest).

Not many in racing would begrudge Havlin the chance at Classic success either, however. The previous weekend he had ridden Audience (GB) to win the Lockinge S. for the Gosden stable. John Gosden has been his employer for a quarter of a century. Havlin, who turned 50 in December, has sat on myriad Group 1 winners in that time but usually has to give them up for the stable's first jockey come race day. Audience was his second Group 1 winner, and he followed that up with a genius of a ride aboard Sweet William (Ire), kidding the quirky stayer to a last-gasp win the G3 Henry II S. on Thursday.

Havlin jokes about his former Gosden colleague Frankie Dettori when asked if he has been speaking to the

now-California-based jockey about what it takes to win the Derby

"He's been speaking to me about it," he says with a grin. "He rings me about ten times a day. He's been telling me what Lester [Piggott] told him but I can't give away all my secrets."

Cairns was involved with Dettori's first Derby winner, Authorized (Ire), during his days working for Peter Chapple-Hyam. "We didn't go to bed for 24 hours afterwards," he recalls.

It's unlikely that the teetotal Fanshawe would party quite as hard as Chapple-Hyam should he find himself in the position of being a Derby-winning trainer by Saturday afternoon. He would be entitled to do so, however, and a British Classic would be a well-deserved addition to Fanshawe's fine record, which includes Group 1 victories with sprinters, milers, middle-distance horses, stayers, and even two Champion Hurdles. He is quite simply a brilliant all-rounder, a trainer very much in the old-school mould, but in life, as in racing, the old ways are often the best.

Fanshawe arrives minutes later with his wife Jacko. Their son and assistant trainer Tom is aboard the lead horse and switches places with jockey Ross Coakley, while former crack point-to-point rider Andy Sansome vacates Ambiente Friendly's saddle for Havlin. Instructions are issued.

The previous afternoon Fanshawe had walked the Limekilns, the crown jewels among Newmarket's 2,500 acres of gallops, but more rain had fallen on Sunday morning, leaving them on the soft side once more after heavy rain in the town earlier in the week.

"Don't expect any fireworks this morning," he warns. "We're literally just doing a swinger on this ground."

Having cantered down towards the start of the Round Gallop,

the horses appear again on the far horizon, wandering across to where their semi-serious work will commence. Binoculars are raised, Sansome lights up his second cigarette, and only the skylarks can be heard as they jump off. As the horses become less of a speck, the sound of their hooves on the easy turf drowns out even the birds. Ambiente Friendly eases past his lead horse on the bridle.

"Lovely, very happy with that," says the trainer as they ease down after a proper swinging canter over an extended mile. Despite its name, the gallop isn't round as such, but it takes in a right-hand turn early on before straightening along the hedge. In Newmarket, horses engaged in the Derby and the Oaks are permitted to use this gallop the 'wrong way round' in order to emulate, up to a point, Tattenham Corner, but Ambiente Friendly has already proved that he can handle that left-hand turn and descent having won around Epsom's closest replica, Lingfield.

Fanshawe is not one for bold predictions but he's satisfied with what he has seen, six days out from the biggest day of the horse's life. It's a big day for him, too, as well as nonagenarian Bill Gredley, who owns the horse with his son Tim, and provided Fanshawe with his first Group 1 winner back in 1991, when Environment Friend (GB) won the Eclipse.

Havlin, who will be riding in the great race for the third time, also ends the morning thoroughly content.

"He's got a ring bit on but he wasn't keen at all really," says the jockey after handing the horse back to Sansome. "He travelled up well, he was on his left lead up into the turn and, considering he's never run there before, he switched onto his right lead and everything was smooth. I gave him an inch of rein at the

seven-and-a-half [furlongs] and he went away. It was on the soft side, which isn't really what he wants, but for bridle work like that it was perfect for getting the distance into him."

Ambiente Friendly wanders homewards across the Severals, relaxed with Sansome, no sign of any post-work jig-jogging. It is not just the morning exercise that will start to jangle the nerves of all those connected with a Derby runner as we enter the final week of build-up. Has he eaten up? Is he restless in his box? Will he tread on a stone?

Ambiente Friendly's home is in the historic Pegasus Stables, built in 1884 by the brilliant but ill-fated Fred Archer, who won the Derby five times between 1877 and 1886. Fanshawe, who has trained there for 35 years, has long joked that he feels the presence of the multiple champion jockey in the stable still. Perhaps Fred will watch over them now. There is, after all, only one Derby.

WHITE BIRCH IN COMMAND IN THE TATTERSALLS GOLD CUP by Tom Frary

In rude health for Sunday's G1 Tattersalls Gold Cup at The Curragh, Chantal Regalado-Gonzalez's White Birch (GB) (Ulysses {Ire}--Diagnostic {GB}, by Dutch Art {GB}) readily put old rival Auguste Rodin (Ire) (Deep Impact {Jpn}) in the shade for a career-best success. Behind that Ballydoyle supremo in the Derby, the John Murphy-trained grey had returned this term to garner the track's G3 Alleged S. and G2 Mooresbridge S. and the backers were suitably respectful as his odds hardened to 15-8 before the off.


Cruising under a confident Colin Keane with Auguste Rodin just ahead as they raced in mid-division, he was sent alongside that 11-10 favourite with a furlong to go and romped away from there for a comprehensive three-length success as Auguste Rodin ran eight lengths clear of **Crypto Force (GB)** (Time Test {GB}) in third.

"That couldn't have gone better," Keane said after his masterclass. "We got behind the two we wanted to be behind-Ryan brought us as far as we could, then we just quickened up well. He cantered into it. He has plenty of pace, but would have no bother going a bit further. He has matured massively from three to four."

White Birch's ability is nothing new to anybody who witnessed what he achieved from a slow start at Epsom last June and while his season went wayward after that, his path to this test via the proven stepping stones this Spring had him honed to a peak. There may be a wholly different version of Auguste Rodin lying in wait in the G1 Prince of Wales's S., but this was his day in the sun and the trainer John Murphy's son and assistant George was basking in the moment. Cont.



"We've been waiting a long time for one as good as him," he said. "He's a bit more chilled out this year and has progressed from race to race."

"People thought last year when he was a bit slow away from the gates a few times and he was coming from off the pace that he was more of a stayer, but he's getting to show what he can do now. He's got form on very quick ground as well, so he seems to handle them all. Colin was very good on him, as he always is, and gave him a super ride. He's a master of his trade."

Aidan O'Brien was only seeing positives from Auguste Rodin, who ironically was running his first creditable race in defeat. "I thought he ran very well. The ground went against him and he got into a little bit of a speed wobble coming down off the hill and it took a little bit of time to get back in his rhythm," he explained. "Obviously John's horse picked him up well, but we were very happy. He still went out on his shield today and the next time we'll be ready. We were thinking of the Prince of Wales's next, but we'll see what the lads want to do."

Pedigree Notes

White Birch, who also captured the G3 Ballysax S. and was second in the G2 Dante S. at three, becomes the first top-level winner for Ulysses here. Needing all of the unique nine furlongs and 55 yards to get to Horizon Dore (Fr) (Dabirsim {Fr}), last year's G1 Prix Rothschild and G1 Prix Jean Romanet winner enjoyed the perfect tow under cover from Blue Rose Cen (Ire) (Churchill {Ire}) and benefitted from a typically nerveless Alexis Pouchin ride saving ground throughout. Coaxed through a gap to get to Horizon Dore in the shade of the post, the 6-4 favourite had a short head to spare there with Haya Zark (Fr) (Zarak {Fr}) 3/4 of a length away in third.

Mqse De Sevigne, who was sharpened for this with a courseand-distance win in the Listed Prix Jacques Laffitte last month, has fully justified the decision De Rothschild to keep her in training. "She has now won a group 1 against colts, another major accomplishment by this lovely mare," he said, before revealing the season plan. "My father had the dam, it is great for the stud and our breeding program.

"The brother won three group 1s over a mile and a half, so we have to try with her also and therefore our major target is the Arc. We want to try and to have no regrets. She is five and in top form, so it is the right moment. She will have a break now and return this summer in Deauville, in the Rothschild, then the Romanet, two races to build her up toward the Arc."

Pauline Cheboub said of Horizon Dore, "It is frustrating to be beaten by so little in a group 1, but we're happy to see that he is coming back to his best. We will be there at Royal Ascot in the Prince of Wales's."

Trainer Adrien Fouassier said of Haya Zark, "This was a great performance again, top-class. He would probably have done with softer ground, but we have no complaints and he will be back in the autumn."

VICOMTESSE VIGIER SUCCESS FOR SEVENNA'S KNIGHT by Tom Frary

France looks to have a new staying star after the hybrid Melbourne Cup contender **Sevenna's Knight (Ire)** (Camelot {GB}) confirmed the form of the G3 Prix de Barbeville in Sunday's G2 Prix Vicomtesse Vigier at ParisLongchamp. Bought by OTI Management prior to his breakthrough black-type win in Deauville's Listed Michel Houyvet in August, the Ammerland-bred colt had been kept back from big competition by Andre Fabre until his 4-year-old bow when sixth in Meydan's G2 Dubai Gold Cup.

Showing the benefit of that patient approach when domineering **Shembala (Ire)** (Cracksman {GB}) in the Barbeville last month, he was back to affirm his superiority over that filly on four-pound worse terms to continue his path to Flemington. Content to lope in second off the ever-modest early tempo that characterises the marathon events in these parts, the 7-5 favourite was moved up to subdue last year's G1 Prix Royal-Oak winner **Double Major (Ire)** (Daiwa Major {Jpn}) by Mickael Barzalona with 300 metres remaining and found the line with 1 3/4 lengths to spare over Shembala.

Terry Henderson of OTI Racing outlined the plan. "He's progressed a lot since he was a three-year-old and coming back for the group three and now this has really cemented our expectations for better things to come," he said. "It's a breed that does improve with age, it's well known that they tend to be better at four and five and that's one of the reasons we were encouraged to buy him, so I think it's simple maturity--mental and physical." "We've certainly got a man who knows what he's doing when it comes to bringing these horses along, we can now maybe give him one more run in the [G1] Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud and then bring him back again later in the year," he added. "He was put under a lot of pressure from the 800 and Sevenna's Knight was still able to sprint off that, which was a very encouraging sign that he's going to come back in distance and do well. The Melbourne Cup is one of the options. I think what happens in the Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud will dictate what direction we go in, we'll either stay for the serious races at the end of the season or we'll go to Melbourne."

GERMAN 1000 GUINEAS GLORY FOR DARNATION by Tom Frary


Rebounding from a disappointing effort in the G1 1000 Guineas, Newtown Anner Stud Farm's **Darnation (Ire)** (Too Darn Hot {GB}--Monday Monday {Ire}, by Galileo {Ire}) kicked off a stellar double for her sire and trainer with an authoritative win in Sunday's G2 Wempe 104th German 1000 Guineas at Dusseldorf. The sight of a son of Galileo (Ire) out on his own from pillar-to-post at The Curragh might be something soon to be available only in re-runs, but on Sunday his son **Chief Little Rock** (Ire) offered at least one more exhibition in his honour as Wayne Lordan dominated the G3 Heider Family Stables Gallinule S.

Coming on from his return third in Epsom's Listed Blue Riband Trial last month, the G2 Beresford S. and G3 Autumn S. runner-up who started as the 11-4 second favourite had clear daylight on his peers throughout. Continuing the relentless gallop with which his sire is so renowned, he hit the line with 3 3/4 lengths to spare over Stromberg (GB) (Iffraaj {GB}) in a strong Irish Derby trial.

Aidan O'Brien said of the winner, "He stays very well, is an honest horse and could go to Ascot or back here for the Irish Derby. He'd love going a mile and a half. We felt in Epsom it was just a bit of a dawdle for him."

The second dam Gold Chant (Aus) (El Moxie) is kin to the stable's four-times group 1-winning sire Starspangledbanner (Aus), while the family includes other multiple group 1-winning sires in Elvstroem (Aus) and Haradasun (Aus). Amicus's 2-year-old full-brother to Chief Little Rock is named Medallion (Ire), while she also has a yearling colt by Frankel (GB).

O'BRIEN OPTIMISTIC ABOUT YLANG YLANG AND CITY OF TROY AHEAD OF EPSOM

Aidan O'Brien has issued a positive bulletin on his big hopes for Classic glory at Epsom, with Betfred Derby favourite City Of Troy (Justify) and Oaks market leader Ylang Ylang (GB) (Frankel {GB}) reported in good spirits.

City Of Troy must bounce back from a disappointing display in the 2,000 Guineas at Newmarket where he trailed home in ninth behind Notable Speech (GB) (Dubawi {Ire}).

However, he was an odds-on shot for that contest on the back of last year's sensational juvenile exploits, which featured an ultra-impressive Dewhurst triumph, and the Justify colt has been well backed to recapture that form.

Ylang Ylang put in a much more pleasing effort when a close fifth in the 1000 Guineas, staying on strongly to finish just a length behind surprise scorer Elmalka (GB) Kingman (GB).

Speaking at the Curragh on Sunday, O'Brien said, "We're very happy with City Of Troy, all is good so far. I'm told there has been some rain at Epsom, but it was soft when he won the Dewhurst last year."

He added, "Ylang Ylang was fit going into the Guineas and has come out of the race well. Hopefully we'll just keep her ticking over until Friday."

GROUND TO DICTATE WHERE BRIGADIER GERARD WINNER ROYAL RHYME GOES NEXT

Ground conditions will dictate future plans for Royal Rhyme (Ire) (Lope De Vega {Ire}) following his impressive return to action in the Brigadier Gerard S. at Sandown on Thursday.

The Karl Burke-trained four-year-old dominated his rivals in handicap company at Goodwood last summer and went on to win a Listed prize at Ayr before finishing fifth to King Of Steel (Wootton Bassett {GB}) in the Qipco Champion S. at Ascot.

Making his first appearance since Champions Day, the colt was a short price to dispatch of three rivals at Group 3 level and did so with the minimum of fuss under Clifford Lee.

Royal Rhyme holds an entry in the Prince of Wales's S. at Royal Ascot next month, but he would appear unlikely to take up that engagement unless there is some ease underfoot.

Reflecting on his comeback victory, Burke said, "It wasn't the strongest Group 3 in the world, but they're all there to be won and he did it nicely.

"He improved with every run last season and I think it will be the same this year. He wasn't fully wound up by any means. Obviously ground is key with him, but he's a very useful horse on his day on the right ground."

One Burke-trained and Sheikh Mohammed Obaid-owned runner who definitely has the Royal meeting on his agenda is Elite Status (GB) (Havana Grey {GB}), who was a most impressive winner of the Carnarvon S. at Newbury. The son of Havana Grey finished third as a hot favourite for the Norfolk S. at Royal Ascot last year and is set to get a second chance to secure victory at the showpiece meeting in the Commonwealth Cup.

Burke concluded, "I was very, very happy with him, he's a high-class horse and he came out of that race fine. We're heading for the Commonwealth with him, barring accidents."

ROAD WARRIOR REBEL'S ROMANCE ROMPS IN CHAMPIONS AND CHATER CUP

A half-dozen years ago, Charlie Appleby mapped out a plan to send that year's G1 Dubai Sheema Classic winner Hawkbill (Kitten's Joy) to Hong Kong in an attempt to become the first overseas winner of the G1 Standard Chartered Champions and Chater Cup. Those plans were ultimately scuppered, owing perhaps in some part to a down-the-field finish by a then-unexposed Blue Point (Ire) (Shamardal) in the G1 Chairman's Sprint Prize the month prior.

In the form of **Rebel's Romance (Ire)** (Dubawi {Ire}), Appleby surmised that he had the 'right horse' to try once again to crack the Group 1 barrier in one of the world's toughest racing jurisdictions. A hearty traveler, with feature wins on his resume in Germany, America, Qatar and most recently Dubai--where he landed a deep renewal of the Sheema Classic Mar. 30--the homebred continued his winning ways Sunday with a defeat of seven locals by a two-length margin that belied the dominant nature of the victory.

Drawn widest in the field, Rebel's Romance was only fairly into stride beneath his regular rider William Buick, but with a long run to the first corner, there was plenty of time to slot in, and the gelding was allowed to roll forward--as has become his custom--to sit just off the flank of **Moments In Time (Chi)** (Lookin At Lucky). The pace was honest enough for the 2400-metre distance on a course that had taken plenty of rain through the week, and while the leaders had a bit of a break on

the peloton down the back, things got a bit tighter as they hit the entrance to the second turn with a half-mile to go.

Buick went for Rebel's Romance in earnest fully 600 metres from home, knowing full well he was sitting on a stayer of the highest class and that if something was going to catch them, they'd have to be pretty good. Moments In Time stuck on as long and as gamely as he could, but Rebel's Romance asserted his superiority a furlong and a half from home and cruised home an easy winner. Five G Patch (Ire) (Camelot {GB}) closed off well at the fence for second ahead of his stablemate La City Blanche (Arg) (Cityscape {GB}), reversing the first and second placings from the G3 Queen Mother Memorial Cup H. May 5.

Moments In Time held fourth, Hong Kong Derby hero **Massive Sovereign (Ire)** (No Nay Never) was disappointing in sixth and three-peat seeking **Russian Emperor (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) was only seventh in what was likely his final career appearance.

Appleby is hopeful that Sunday's win will pave the way for further Godolphin participation in Hong Kong. The operation's last Hong Kong success came courtesy of Mastery (GB) (Sulamani {Ire}) in the 2010 G1 Longines Hong Kong Vase.

"Having the right horse in Rebel's Romance, we felt he was a horse we could be competitive with and hopefully in the near future, for sure, we'll be looking forward to finding horses to coming over here," the trainer said. "He's a gelded son of Dubawi, he loves his travels. He's a professional now and he's done plenty of travelling now. He prefers to be on a plane than actually in his stable.

"The whole concept of Godolphin was built on being an international stable and hopefully dining at the top table as fortunately as we are today. Hong Kong racing is one of the pinnacles of racing and to come here, you have to have the right horse."

Buick, who received a fist bump from Hong Kong Jockey Club CEO Winfried Engelbrecht-Bresges on his way back to scale, added: "Hong Kong is a special place. I've been coming here for many years now and it's tough to win at any level. It's great to come here with a horse like Rebel's Romance and even better to win."

One race after Blue Point's aforementioned flop in 2018 with Buick in the boot, the Norweigian guided the mercurial Pakistan Star (Ger) (Shamardal) to a victory in the G1 QE II Cup.

Rebel's Romance is likely to return to America for a race like the GI Sword Dancer Invitational S., a 'Win and You're In' qualifier for another crack at the GI Breeders' Cup Turf at Del Mar in November. From there, all roads could lead back to Sha Tin for the Vase the following month.



Pedigree Notes:

Rebel's Romance is a third elite-level winner in Hong Kong for the all-conquering Dubawi, joining the top sprinter Lucky Nine (Ire) and 10-furlong specialist Akeed Mofeed (GB). With the victory, Rebel's Romance leapfrogs Lord North (Ire) as Dubawi's leading money earner.

Sheikh Mohammed's operation purchased Rebel's Romance's second dam Short Skirt, a half-sister to the multiple groupwinning and multiple Group 1-placed Whitewater Affair (GB) (Machiavellian), for 1.4 million guineas (\$2,839,305) at the 2006 Tattersalls December Mares sale and among her four other winners was G3 Nad Al Sheba Trophy winner Volcanic Sky (GB) (Street Cry {Ire}), while her unraced daughter Rose Law (GB) (New Approach {Ire}) produced Godolphin's Japanese listed winner and Group 3-placed Due Process (GB) (Daiwa Major {Jpn}).

There is more Japanese black-type in the third dam, as Whitewater Affair accounted for multiple Japanese champion/Group 1 and poignant G1 Dubai World Cup hero Victoire Pisa (Jpn) (Neo Universe {Jpn}), as well as Group 1-winning miler Asakusa Den'en (GB) (Singspiel {Ire}).

Rebel's Romance's G1 Jebel Hatta-winning half-brother Measured Time (GB) (Frankel {GB}) is scheduled to make a New York appearance as early as the GI Manhattan S. at Saratoga on the Belmont S. undercard June 8. Measured Time was a latest fourth in the G1 Dubai Turf Mar. 30.

The most recent foal from Minidress is a yearling full-brother to Rebel's Romance.

DANON DECILE TAKES CHARGE IN SURPRISE TOKYO YUSHUN VICTORY

A late absentee from last month's G1 Satsuki Sho (Japanese 2,000 Guineas) due to lameness, **Danon Decile (Jpn)** (Epiphaneia {Jpn}) gained compensation with an emphatic victory in Sunday's G1 Tokyo Yushun (Japanese Derby) at Tokyo Racecourse, the second leg of the Japanese Triple Crown.

The 17-strong field featured six of the first seven from the Satuski Sho, including the unbeaten winner **Justin Milano (Jpn)** (Kizuna {Jpn}), runner-up **Cosmo Kuranda (Jpn)** (Al Ain {Jpn}) and sixth **Regaleira (Jpn)** (Suave Richard {Jpn}), who was attempting to become the first filly to win the Tokyo Yushun since Vodka (Jpn) (Tanino Gimlet {Jpn}) in 2007. Regaleira was considered to be the main danger to favourite Justin Milano in the betting, with Danon Decile only the ninth pick at odds of 46-1.

Breaking sharply from gate five, Danon Decile was settled in a share of third with Justin Milano as **Ecoro Walz (Jpn)** (Black Tide {Jpn}) led the field in the early stages. Having saved ground on the inner throughout, he quickly settled matters with an explosive turn of foot once hitting the front entering the final 300 metres, ultimately beating Justin Milano by two lengths. **Shin Emperor (Fr)** (Siyouni {Fr}), fifth in the Satsuki Sho on his previous start, was over a length further back in third, with significant outsider **Sunrise Earth (Jpn)** (Rey De Oro {Jpn}) and Regaleira making up the first five finishers. **Cont.**

It was a first win in the Tokyo Yushun for trainer Shogo Yasuda, while Norihiro Yokoyama became the oldest Group 1-winning jockey at the age of 56 as he celebrated his third success in the race after those of Logi Universe (Jpn) (Neo Universe {Jpn}) in 2009 and One And Only (Jpn) (Heart's Cry {Jpn}) in 2014.

"I thought that the pace would be normal or slow since there were no horses that wanted to set the pace," said Yokoyama.
"But as Ecoro Walz took the front, we were able to wait in good position until the straight, and the horse responded strongly from there. I'm happy to have won the Derby but I'm also glad that my decision to not race him in the Satsuki Sho was not wrong. Danon Decile is a horse with great potential, and we knew that he would be a great horse if we took good care of him. I'm really grateful to the horse."

Danon Decile was having his fifth start in the Tokyo Yushun and his first since winning the G3 Keisei Hai at Nakayama in January. He opened his account at the second attempt as a two-year-old before ending that campaign with a fourth-place finish behind Shin Emperor in the G3 Kyoto Nisai S. in November.

Pedigree Notes

Danon Decile becomes one of four Classic winners and six Group 1 winners for Epiphaneia, who won the G1 Kikuka Sho (Japanese St Leger) himself in 2013. He later doubled his tally at the top level when also winning the Japan Cup the following year.

Already in 2024, Epiphaneia had been responsible for the G1 Oka Sho (Japanese 1,000 Guineas) winner and G1 Yushun Himba (Japanese Oaks) runner-up Stellenbosch (Jpn), while last year another daughter, Daring Tact (Jpn), won both of those races before completing the Japanese Triple Tiara with victory in the G1 Shuka Sho. The first of Epiphaneia's offspring to win a Classic was Efforia (Jpn), who struck in the Satsuki Sho--as well as the G1 Tenno Sho (Autumn) and G1 Arima Kinen--in a brilliant three-year-old campaign in 2021.

Bred by Shadai Farm, Danon Decile was sold to Danon Co Ltd as a yearling for ¥135,000,000 (around \$992,667) at the JRHA Select Sale. He is the third winner from as many runners out of the GI Alcibiades S. and GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies runner-up Top Decile (Congrats). Both his third dam, Barefoot Dyana (Dynaformer), and fourth dam, Spankey's Seconds (Wig Out), were multiple stakes winners in the US.
