COMPLAINT

The CHRB hereby files a complaint against **Baffert, Robert** for violation of CHRB Rule 1843(a)(b)&(d), 1843.1(a), and 1887(a). The person named in this complaint holds a license as a **TRAINER**, license number 087698-01/2022. The offense alleged occurred on or about **August 03, 2019** and is as follows:

The official blood sample #DM15198 taken on August 03, 2019, was reported by Ben Moeller of the Maddy EACL at UC Davis to contain Phenylbutazone (2.88 ug/ML). This sample was obtained from the horse "Eclair" which ran in the 1st race at Del Mar finishing 4th. The trainer of record is Robert Baffert. A split analysis at Texas Veterinary Medical Diagnostic Laboratory confirmed the violation. This violation is a Class 4 drug with a penalty category Class C.

Pursuant to Business and Professions Code Section 19420, 19440, and CHRB Rules, the stewards are empowered to impose penalties for violation of any provision of the CHRB Rules. Such penalties may consist of suspension of any license, fines, and exclusion from all racing enclosures under the jurisdiction of the Board or by any combination of these penalties.

Trainer ROBERT BAFFERT, who started the horse ECLAIR, fourth place finisher in the first race at Del Mar Race Track on August 3, 2019, is fined ONE THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$1,500.00)* pursuant to #1887 (Trainer or Owner to Insure Condition of Horse) for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1843(a)(b)(d) (Medication, Drugs and Other Substances), for violation of #1843.1 (Prohibited Drug Substances – Phenylbutazone (Class 4) second offense in 365 days).

*Rule #1532. Fine shall be paid to the Paymaster within seven calendar days from the date of this ruling, or the license of the person upon whom the fine has been imposed shall be suspended.

**GOVERNING PROCEDURE FOR DISCIPLINARY HEARING
BEFORE BOARD OF STEWARDS**

1. The CHRB will provide you notice and an opportunity to be heard, including the opportunity to present and rebut evidence. (Government Code § 11425.10(a)(1))
2. Every person who is called to testify before the stewards is entitled to have counsel or an observer of his choosing present at the hearing; provided, however, that such counsel or observer shall only participate under such conditions or in such manner as the stewards may direct. (4 CCR 1539)
3. The hearing shall be open to the public as provided in Government Code § 11425.20, which states:
 - (a) Nothing in this subdivision limits the authority of the presiding officer to order closure of a hearing or make other protective orders to the extent necessary or proper for any of the following purposes:
 - (1) To satisfy the United States Constitution, the California Constitution, federal or state statute, or other law, including but not limited to laws protecting privileged, confidential, or other protected information.
 - (2) To ensure a fair hearing in the circumstances of the particular case.
 - (3) To conduct the hearing, including the manner of examining witnesses, in a way that is appropriate to protect a minor witness or a witness with a developmental disability, as defined in Section 4512 of the Welfare and Institutions Code, from intimidation or other harm, taking into account the rights of all persons.
 - (b) To the extent a hearing is conducted by telephone, television, or other electronic means, subdivision (a) is satisfied if members of the public have an opportunity to do both of the following:
 - (1) At reasonable times, hear or inspect the agency's record, and inspect any transcript obtained by the agency.
 - (2) Be physically present at the place where the presiding officer is conducting the hearing.
 - (c) This section does not apply to a prehearing conference, settlement conference, or proceedings for alternative dispute resolution other than binding arbitration.
4. The presiding officer is subject to disqualification for bias, prejudice, or interest as provided in Government Code § 11425.40, which states:
 - (a) The presiding officer is subject to disqualification for bias, prejudice, or interest in the proceeding.
 - (b) It is not alone or in itself grounds for disqualification, without further evidence of bias, prejudice, or interest, that the presiding officer:
 - (1) Is or is not a member of a racial, ethnic, religious, sexual, or similar group and the proceeding involves the rights of that group.
 - (2) Has experience, technical competence, or specialized knowledge of, or has in any capacity expressed a view on, a legal, factual, or policy issue presented in the proceeding.
 - (3) Has as a lawyer or public official participated in the drafting of laws or regulations or in the effort to pass or defeat laws or regulations, the meaning, effect, or application of which is in issue in the proceeding.
 - (c) The provisions of this section governing disqualification of the presiding officer also govern disqualification of the agency head or other person or body to which the power to hear or decide in the proceeding is delegated.

- (d) An agency that conducts an adjudicative proceeding may provide by regulation for peremptory challenge of the presiding officer.
5. Ex parte communications shall be restricted as provided in Government Code §§ 11430.10 through 11430.80, which states in part:
- (a) While the proceeding is pending there shall be no communication, direct or indirect, regarding any issue in the proceeding, to the presiding officer from an employee or representative of an agency that is a party or from an interested person outside the agency, without notice and opportunity for all parties to participate in the communication.
 - (b) Nothing in this section precludes a communication, including a communication from an employee or representative of an agency that is a party, made on the record at the hearing.
 - (c) For the purpose of this section, a proceeding is pending from the issuance of the agency's pleading, or from an application for an agency decision, whichever is earlier.
(Government Code § 114230.10)
6. The board, its executive director, or the stewards, may issue subpoenas for the attendance of witnesses or the production of any records, books, memoranda, documents, or other papers or things, as is necessary to enable any of them to effectually discharge their duties, and may administer oaths or affirmations as necessary in connection therewith. (Business and Professions Code § 19435)
7. The stewards may refer any matter within their jurisdiction to the Board when the penalty the stewards have jurisdiction to impose is insufficient when a hearing cannot be held under the conditions or in the manner prescribed, when a hearing is impractical due to conclusion of the meeting, or for other good and sufficient cause, and they may order the suspension of the licensee pending further Order of the Board. In such event, the Board shall accept the matter for hearing and adjudication or such other action as the Board deems to be in the best interests of justice. (4 CCR 1529)
8. A verbatim record shall be made of all hearings before the stewards in any matter other than those relating solely to riding infractions where the penalty imposed by the stewards is ten (10) days or less suspension, or those relating to license application recommendations. Notwithstanding the previous sentence, and at the stewards' discretion, the racing association shall provide either a certified court reporter or electronic recording equipment to record all hearings. Such recording equipment shall include, but not be limited to, tape recorder(s), at least three (3) microphones and a sufficient supply of recording tapes. The cost of such reporter and recording equipment shall be assumed be the racing association conducting the racing meeting. The taped recording(s) shall be stored and maintained by the Board for a minimum of sixty (60) days after the initial hearing or in the event an appeal is filed, a minimum of sixty (60) days after an appeal is heard and decided by the Board. Upon the request of the Executive Director or his/her designee, the racing association shall furnish an original and two copies of the hearing transcript to the Executive Director. (4 CCR 1537)
9. The decision shall be in writing, be based on the record, and include a statement of the factual and legal basis of the decision as provided in Government Code section 11425.50. (Government Code § 11425.10(a)(6))
10. From every decision of the stewards, except a decision concerning the disqualification of a horse due to a foul or a riding or driving infraction, an appeal may be made to the Board. Appeals shall be made in writing, stating the reason or reasons for the appeal, and shall be signed by the appellant, appellant's attorney, or appellant's representative. Appeals shall be received by a Board employee at any of its offices, not later than seventy-two (72) hours from the date of the decision of the stewards unless the Board for

good cause extends the time for filing. An appeal shall not affect a decision of the stewards until the appeal has been sustained or dismissed or a stay order issued by the Chairman. (4 CCR 1761)

11. The Board shall notify the appellant, the stewards and all licensees or other persons affected by decision under appeal of the date, time and location of its hearing in the matter. The burden shall be on the appellant to prove the facts necessary to sustain the appeal. (4 CCR 1764)
12. The Board, upon due consideration, may overrule any steward's decision other than a decision to disqualify a horse due to a foul or a riding or driving infraction in a race, if a preponderance of the evidence indicates any of the following:
 - (1) The steward mistakenly interpreted the law.
 - (2) New evidence of a convincing nature is produced.
 - (3) The best interests of racing and the state may be better served.However, any decision pertaining to the finish of a race, as used for purposes of parimutuel fund distribution to winning ticketholders, may not be overruled. Furthermore, any decision pertaining to the distribution of purses may be changed only if a claim is made in writing to the board by one of the involved owners or trainers, and a preponderance of the evidence clearly indicates to the board that one or more of the grounds for protest, as outlined in regulations adopted by the board, has been substantiated. The chairperson of the board may issue a stay of execution pending appeal from a steward's decision if the facts justify the action. (Business and Professions Code § 19517)
13. The Board shall issue its decision upon any appeal in writing and such decision is subject to review by the court having jurisdiction. (4 CCR 1763)
14. Chapter 5 of Part 1 of Division 3 of Title 2 of the Government Code is not applicable to this proceeding.

DRUG DESCRIPTION

Phenylbutazone (Bute)

Phenylbutazone is a nonsteroidal anti-inflammatory drug (NSAID) and cyclooxygenase inhibitor. It is a potent pain reliever, antipyretic, and anti-inflammatory. In the horse, it is used commonly for lameness, resulting from soft-tissue injury, muscle soreness, bone and joint problems, and laminitis. NSAIDs work by inhibiting the body's production of prostaglandins, thromboxane, and other inflammatory mediators. Some of these actions may be dose-dependent.

Phenylbutazone can be given intravenously or orally; pain relief and fever reduction usually starts within one to two hours.

California Code of Regulations

Rules and Regulations

Title 4, Division 4

Article 15

§1843(a)(d) - Medication, Drugs and Other Substances

(a) No horse participating in a race shall carry in its body any drug substance or its metabolites or analogues, foreign to the horse except as hereinafter expressly provided.

(d) A finding by an official chemist that a test sample taken from a horse contains a drug substance or its metabolites or analogues which has not been approved by the Board, or a finding of more than one approved non-steroidal, anti-inflammatory drug substance or a finding of a drug substance in excess of the limits established by the Board for its use shall be prima facie evidence that the trainer and his/her agents responsible for the care for the horse has/have been negligent in the care of the horse and is prima facie evidence that the drug substance has been administered to the horse.

§1843.1 (b) - Prohibited Drug Substances

For purposes of this division, prohibited drug substance means:

(b) any drug, substance, medication or chemical authorized by this article in excess of the authorized level or other restrictions as set forth in this article.

§1844(c) - Authorized Medication

Consistent with the intent of these rules, drug substances and medications authorized by the Board for use may be administered to safeguard the health of the horse entered to race provided that:

- (c) Not more than one approved non-steroidal anti-inflammatory drug substance (NSAID) may be administered to a horse that is entered to race and shall be only one of the following authorized drug substances:
 - (1) Phenylbutazone in a dosage amount that the test sample shall contain not more than 2 micrograms of the drug substance per milliliter of blood plasma or serum

§1887(a) - Trainer or Owner to Insure Condition of Horse

- (a) The trainer is the absolute insurer of and responsible for the condition of the horses entered in a race, regardless of the acts of third parties, except as otherwise provided in this article. If the chemical or other analysis of urine or blood test samples or other tests, prove positive showing the presence of any prohibited drug substance defined in Rule 1843.1 of this division, the trainer of the horse may be fined, his/her license suspended or revoked, or be ruled off. In addition, the owner of the horse, foreman in charge of the horse, groom, and any other person shown to have had the care or attendance of the horse, may be fined, his/her license suspended, revoked, or be ruled off. The owner of a ship-in horse is the joint-absolute insurer of and is equally responsible for the condition of the horse entered in a race.

INVESTIGATION:

On August 16, 2019, I received this medication violation report. The official blood sample #DM15198 taken on August 03, 2019, was reported by Ben Moeller of the Maddy EACL at UC Davis to contain Phenylbutazone (2.88 ug/ML). This sample was obtained from the horse "Eclair" which ran in the 1st race at Del Mar finishing 4th. The trainer of record is Robert Baffert. A split analysis was requested in accordance to 1859.25. This violation is a Class 4 drug with a penalty category Class C.

On August 16, 2019 at 1500 hours, I conducted a barn inspection of Trainer Baffert's barn FF 21-40 & GG 1-21. He has 50 horses & 12 pens. Shed row and feed bins were in good condition. He has 30 employees. There is a night watchman. They have 25 different kinds of medications that are not properly labeled and expired. There is no lock on the medication cabinet, however the tack room door has lock capabilities. Dr. Vince Baker advised he would be taking care of the situation. I did locate Phenylbutazone in paste form in the medication cabinet. Picture attached to report.

On August 16, 2019 at 1542 hours, I obtained a statement from Dr. Baker. Dr. Baker stated he is the only Veterinarian that gives Bute to the horses. Dr. Baker said he gives Bute by syringe only and does not know how Eclair tested positive for Bute.

On August 17, 2019, Baffert came into the CHRB Office and signed the Positive Test Notification (PTN) document. I provided Baffert with a copy of the PTN and attached documents. Baffert requested for a split sample to be analyzed. Baffert also stated that he did not know why the horse Eclair tested positive for Bute. Baffert stated he thinks someone is intentionally giving Bute to his horses and mentioned that he would be offering a reward to help solve this case.

On August 17, 2019, I emailed the signed PTN to Deborah Dugally. I also picked up the employee worklist from Del Mar Security. I also received copies of Dr. Baker's Confidentialials from Vicki Cronk at the Del Mar receiving barn. The confidentialials indicated that the horse Éclair received Bute which Dr. Baker administered on August 02, 2019 at approximately 1025 hours. Dr. Baker also administered Tetracycline, (2) Fluvicin pastes, and a Dermacloth on August 02, 2019. No other medication was found to be administered.

On August 18, 2019, Investigator Jennifer Tolman emailed the Split Sample request form to Deborah Dugally and Travis P. Mays (Section head at Texas A&M Veterinary Medical Diagnostic Laboratory).

On September 05, 2019, I received the split sample Positive Letter from the Texas A&M Veterinarian Medical Diagnostic Laboratory (TVMDL) confirming Phenylbutazone was detected in the sample (2.62 + 0.15 micrograms per milliliter).

On September 12, 2019, I obtained a copy of Baffert's worklist from Del Mar Security.

On September 14, 2019 at 0800 hours, I provided the 1844C Report to Dr. Grande.



I received the 1844C report back from Dr. Grande with his recommendations.

The CHRIS history for the last (3) years indicated there was (3) class 4 medication violations.

Baffert has had 1844(c) violations within thirty-six (36) months. On August 5th 2019, Baffert had a Phenylbutazone (510 ng/ml) positive-Case status pending. On October 22, 2017, ruling#LATC028 was issued on case#17LT0003. Baffert was fined \$1,000.00 for Phenylbutazone (3.19 ug/ml). On January 15, 2017, ruling#LATS030 was issued on case#16SA0243. Baffert was fined \$250.00 for Phenylbutazone (2.69).

Baffert is in violation of the following CHRB Rules:

- 1843(a,b, &d)- Medication, Drugs, and other Substances
- 1843.1(a)- Prohibited Drug Substances
- 1887- Trainer to Insure Condition of Horse



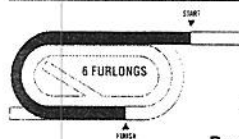
