Unravelling interweaving black-type form is the task here with G3 Prix d'Arenberg victor **Afjan** once again crossing swords with **Jeudixx** and **Kimi Rey**. Jeudixx finished behind Afjan in the Arenberg and August's G3 Prix de Cabourg, while Kimi Rey was too good for both in July's Listed Prix Yacowlef. Magne Jordanger and Finn Blichfeldt's G2 Criterium de Maisons-Laffitte runner-up **Street Show** is the only other contender with black-type form and should not be discounted. Of the remainder, **Aurorian Clouds**, dual winner **Michael The Great** and unbeaten former Ollie Sangster trainee **Birdcall** make most appeal. [Sean Cronin].
